1. Blizzard Strands Thousands Going To/From the East Coast

For many, getting stuck in St. Maarten due to bad weather at home isn't fun. Vacation days are used; kids miss school; appointments are missed; unbudgeted money gets spent. But back home, for folks waiting to fly to SXM, it can be worse: days of delays getting flights; time wasted; vacation days lost; unlimited frustration; and in many cases, timeshare days down the drain.

It happened to thousands last week in the northeast and elsewhere. Never fun. See next story.

2. How To Deal With Flight Delays / Cancellations

If you took the unusual step of buying from a travel agent, go there and complete your changes. If you bought online, try making changes there. If you bought from your airline by phone, chances are the phones will be jammed. Trying to call at odd hours may help except in the most severe situations, like a Hurricane Sandy-type event, when the back-in-service dates aren't quickly predictable.

Grin and bear it; Mother Nature is in charge, as always.

4. Timesharing's Decline in SXM Has Long-Lasting Effects on Island's

Economy...

Dutch St. Maarten has no timeshare owner consumer protection laws. So when timeshare resorts "screw" timeshare owners (to use a word said on-air by the island's most popular TV talk show host, Oral Gibbes), not only does the government usually fail to act, but also the timeshare developer receives no real punishment.

It has happened at many resorts. The most egregious examples are Pelican Resort (when it went bankrupt); Caravanserai Resort (when it was bought at bankruptcy auction and Ray Sidhom, the new owner, emailed timeshare owners telling them that their contracts were null, void, and worthless; Sapphire Resort, where timeshare owners allege that developers Jean and Philippe Verdier do not maintain the resort properly; Atrium Resort, where new owners levied huge fees after taking over; Simpson Bay Resort, where thousands of timeshare owners left when the resort levied huge Supplemental Maintenance Fees to pay for renovations that its owner, Royal Resorts, decided to do at timeshare owners' expense; and Royal Palm Resort, where new owner Diamond Resorts, not exactly the most revered of timeshare operators (Google them), raised Annual Maintenance Fees to absurd levels allegedly not allowed in timeshare owners' contracts.

In untold thousands of cases, timeshare owners have sold their weeks for pennies on the dollar -- literally. Consequently, many thousands of those "distressed" weeks appear to have been bought by people who previously couldn't afford timeshares at all. And many of those people bring food with them from home, cook in their rooms, seldom if ever eat out, and buy little if anything on the island.

You see evidence of this everywhere.

Most restaurateurs we've talked to -- and most Front Street merchants -- tell us business this year is down 20-25% from 2014. Why? We are totally convinced it can be traced in part back to the total failure of the Dutch Side government to enact meaningful timeshare owner consumer protection legislation, which has caused many tens of thousands of timeshare owners to walk away from their timeshare weeks -- and from the island itself.

"You shouldn't punish merchants as well," some merchants have asserted. But fleeing timeshare owners said, "You did nothing to help us." The island appears to have mortally wounded the goose that lays the golden egg.

5. ... As Bad Decisions Concentrating on Cruise Ship Passengers Come Home to Roost

Before the Great Recession, cruise lines were doing great and ordered lots of new ships. During the Great Recession, cruise lines were desperate to put warm bodies on ships and offered record low fares. Result: big ships loaded with passengers sailed into SXM, bringing upwards of 18,000 passengers some days. Bottom line: the low demographic of many of these passengers delivered hordes of window-shoppers to town, keeping stayover tourists (remember them? They're timeshare owners...) out of town because of the congestion. So... few sales.

Most jewelers we talked to said business was down big time last year, 20-25%. SXM has concentrated on attracting more cruise ship passengers and it got exactly what it wished for, but that demographic does not buy. The Harbor, a government business, saw a rental opportunity near the port so it rented properties to a few businesses there. Shoppers visit those shops, then get lured to the airport or Orient Beach instead of Front Street. Result: major drops in retail sales downtown, which translates into drops of turnover tax those businesses pay the Dutch Side government. All of this is a major reason the government keeps claiming poverty -- poverty it caused by focusing on attracting hordes of cruise passengers who don't buy anything, instead of supporting timeshare owners who have historically spent a lot on each trip.

Despite its problems, the government needs to solve this quickly. It has an elephant knocking on the door and that elephant will soon enter the room. It's name: Cuba.

Things are not going to get any easier.

6. Where To Pick Up a Timeshare For a Fraction of Retail (and Why)

Why? Simple: Most timeshare properties on SXM are fine, well-run businesses that do right by their timeshare

owners. Nonetheless, if you want a SXM timeshare condo for a fraction of what the resort would charge, buy directly from the timeshare owner -- not the resort. Go to our www.everythingsxm.com and click Timeshare Rentals / Sales and you'll find hundreds of them. Most are for sale for far less than the timeshare owner paid, and way less than you'd pay the resort.

We also accept ads only from our JMB Website Supporters members, people who are not strangers to us. It pays to be careful when you buy.

9. Three Boats Catch Fire in Lagoon; Extensive Damage But No Serious Injuries

Miraculously, no one was seriously injured late Wednesday afternoon when a boat repair turned into an inferno on a 45-foot catamaran and immediately jumped to a nearby cabin cruiser and a power boat.

The catamaran owner was removing a leaking gas tank when something went wrong and fire erupted. He jumped into the water to escape, and came away with minor leg injuries. We posted pictures from artist Patty Meotti and from Island 92 radio, located across the narrow end of the lagoon, on our Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site. Urgent news of interest to tourists is often posted there as it happens.

The SXM Daily Herald also posted a complete story on its site.

10. Pregnant Women Cautioned About Zika Virus

The good news about Zika is that it is a milder cousin of Dengue Fever and Chikungunya, with some people not noticing symptoms at all and others having mild flu-like symptoms and a rash.

For pregnant women, possibly in particular those in their first trimester, Zika is quite a menace, however. It can cause birth defects including small heads (microencephaly) and infant death. Pregnant women have been cautioned not to travel to areas where the disease is present and on request airlines are cancelling trips and refunding payments for pregnant women who were traveling to areas where the virus is present.

As of a few days ago, there was one confirmed case of Zika on French St. Martin and several suspected cases. There were no known cases on the Dutch Side. Authorities are galvanized by the threat and are putting into motion steps to hit mosquito breeding sites and help prevent any real outbreak. In 2013, when Chikungunya came here, they responded a bit slowly; they don't intend to make that mistake again.

If you are pregnant or trying to get pregnant, it may be wise to avoid any area where Zika is widespread. Brazil is worst hit in this hemisphere. The World Health Organization has much info on Zika for pregnant women here: http://tinvurl.com/iyebw26.

Zika is spread by the "vector" aedes agypti mosquito which is black with white racing-stripe-like markings. We've seen only one ever, in 2013.

11. Topper Throws Reception for Sam Runza and Cugini (Authentic Italian) Is Mobbed

Topper Daboul, one of SXM's most popular restaurateurs and a close friend of Cugini Restaurant owner Sam Runza, threw a reception for Sam a week ago, just days after Sam had returned to SXM from Toronto. In Canada, Sam spent nearly a year fighting cancer -- now he's "home" for another couple of weeks working at the restaurant from 7-9 nightly, looking forward to seeing old friends and new. The Simpson Bay restaurant (located near Fedex and Carousel) has been busy.

The reception, at Topper's Simpson Bay location, was attended by many dozens of Sam's friends, a number of whom donned custom-made "Sam's Club" t-shirts. Sam talked frankly about his fight and said he still believes in

miracles. "Come to Cugini for me," he said. Definitely go to meet one of the warmest people on SXM and of course, for Cugini's outstanding and authentic Italian dining. Everything is made from scratch so relax and enjoy, it does take a bit of time but is well worth it.

12. Indian Merchants Donate \$15,000 To Gamali Benjamin Foundation

Gamali Benjamin was a bicycle police officer working in downtown Philipsburg a number of months ago when he intercepted robbers at a jewelry store. He thwarted the robbery, gunfire erupted, an accused robber was shot, and officer Benjamin was mortally wounded, the first Dutch Side police officer ever to die in the line of duty. No customers or passers-by were injured.

Last week, Indian merchants in SXM donated \$15,000 to the Gamali Benjamin Foundation, intended to help the families of officers lost in the line of duty. Numero Dos is Dany's Beach Bar at Cupecoy Beach. Parking, \$5 (or free). The paid parking is closer. Drinks served, chairs for rent, LoLo food (the chicken is great). Undress on the beach, not at your car.

Number Tres is Happy Bay. It's a 10-minute trek from Friar's Bay where you park. Limited services. Bring a blanket.

Q. You mean they don't cancel me if I get really sick?

A. No, they don't. Once you're a member, as long as you continue to pay your membership fee your membership continues regardless of your health or age, if you buy an annual or multiyear membership and keep it in force. SkyMed does not throw you out if you get sick. If you allow your membership to lapse, you will need to reapply to determine of you're still medically acceptable -- so just don't let it lapse.

Q. I have a few medical issues and I'm in my 70s. Will SkyMed accept me?

A. In its brief application process, completed online or by phone or in person with a rep, SkyMed asks for your name, DOB, current Rx medications, medical conditions, and hospitalizations in the last six months. It also asks where you want to be transported when you need an emergency medical evacuation. It now also requests your passport number to help expedite customs / immigration should you require an international medical evacuation flight. *The vast, vast majority of applicants are readily accepted.* You do not have to be in "phenomenal" health at all. By the way: if you travel very little and only for short periods, you can apply for SkyMed's short-term memberships. They cover all pre-existing conditions.

Q. We travel for weeks at a time. Do we have to tell SkyMed where we're going?

A. No, you don't. As long as you're home in the US or Canada more than six months per year, you're fine. If you spend more than half of each year away (in aggregate), then you're considered an expatriate (ex-pat) and would need a program custom-tailored for ex-pats because you're away a majority of the time and that means you represent

increased exposure. That program is called X-Pat - the program for American and Canadian expatriates living overseas. Even as an ex-pat living in SXM, you can still be transported back to your city of choice in the USA or Canada.

Q. Does SkyMed cover pre-existing conditions?

A. Yes, right away for short-term memberships and after just a 90 day waiting period for all memberships lasting a year or longer. To make sure you're covered for everything when you travel, including pre-existing conditions, just buy your annual or multi-year Ultimate SkyMed membership more than 90 days ahead of your initial date of travel.

Q. Do you require a physical exam for renewal or when I reach a certain age?

A. No, SkyMed requires neither. Once you join and buy an annual or multiyear membership, we'll renew it every year upon payment of your renewal fee. No physical exam is required regardless of your age or health if you've paid your membership on time. You can be age 109 and still be protected by your SkyMed membership.

Q. What is the maximum age for applying for membership?

A. No maximum.

Q. I seldom travel now. Do you have short-term plans?

A, Yes, at about \$18/day per family or about \$9/day for singles. Since they only last a specified number of days, they end when the term of coverage ends. If you want another short-term plan later, you must apply again and medically requalify. Annual plans cost roughly \$1.30/day for your entire family (parents and minor kids); plans for singles are less. *Annual* and multiyear plans are renewable without medical requalification, assuming they haven't lapsed.

Q. I'm from Canada. May I join SkyMed? I have to get back to my province if I'm seriously ill or my health insurance won't work.

A. Both Americans and Canadians are eligible to join SkyMed. American and Canadian ex-pats living overseas also are eligible.

Q. What types of policies are there?

A. SkyMed Memberships (often called policies by members though they actually are memberships) come in several flavors: short term, for people who travel little and for short durations; "annual" for people who want full-year protection that is guaranteed renewable for life when you pay the membership fee on time regardless of age or health at the time of renewal; and Ultimate multiyear memberships which offer low annual cost, maximum benefits, and global coverage and are also renewable for life regardless of age or health when membership fees are paid on time.

Q. Which membership gives the biggest bang for the buck?

You clearly get the most for the least with our three-year or five-year Ultimate memberships. The basic SkyMed plan covers you in the USA (all 50 states), Canada, Mexico, Bermuda, the Bahamas, all the nations of the Caribbean including Cuba, plus Costa Rica and Belize. The Ultimate membership covers you globally - or you can add a global rider to annual memberships (at \$100/year) which adds rest-of-the-world coverage. SkyMed does not cover countries where there are open hostilities -- Iraq, Iran, Syria, Somalia, North Korea, etc.
