About 10 years ago, the U. S. government began requiring all U. S. citizens traveling in the Caribbean and elsewhere to obtain and carry U. S. passports. The result was chaos since millions of people applied for passports, overwhelming the government's processing capabilities. Huge delays resulted.

Now, all those passports are coming up for renewal -- so a glut of renewals is about to begin. The State Department says processing time will be about six weeks. So if your passport is about to expire, get it renewed. Most local post offices have the paperwork you need, and many can do passport photos as can AAA offices.

4. Bill Introduced To Force Airlines to Provide Adequate Seat Pitch; What It Could Mean

As we previously reported, jetBlue is renovating all its cabins to add larger video screens, smaller bathrooms, and less seat pitch -- 32 inches instead of 34 in some seats. But it quickly adds that it is replacing heavy old thick-back seating with thinner, lighter, but more comfortable seating that consumes less space. Bottom line, it says, is that it will be able to sell more seats without sacrificing "the jetBlue experience" or the "most room in coach" it has long offered.

JetBlue is among the best in passenger cabin roominess. Spirit is among the worst and American has been bad for years, after it reversed its "more room in coach" campaign a number of years ago.

Cramped aircraft cabins generating thousands of complaints led a member of Congress to introduce legislation to remedy the long-festering problem. Here's that report: http://tinyurl.com/im2dgnm

If the bill passes, what may it mean? Less cramped cabins most likely, but also higher airfares since fewer passengers may fit on airplanes if carriers don't want to use the Jet Blue type of renovations.

5. Grapevine: Francesco Corallo Looking To Buy Sapphire Resort

The owner of Starz and other casinos in SXM and elsewhere, Francesco Corallo, is said to be seriously interested in buying embattled Sapphire Beach Resort in Cupecoy beach as well, the rumors say, as neighboring Ocean Club and undeveloped property across the street from both resorts near Blue Mall.

Bruno Sitbon, who as we previously reported is fighting Sapphire developers / owners Philippe and Jean Verdier in court for control of Sapphire, heard about this rumor recently and asked Corallo about it. The Sitbon family says that Corallo has denied the rumor.

The Sitbons also said that while ownership of the resort is being contested in court, the Verdiers are enjoined from selling it to any third parties.

9. Oyster Bay Beach Resort to Install Skimmers To Remove Seaweed

Oyster Bay Beach Resort chief honcho Ricardo Perez says the resort has ordered and will soon install booms/skimmers well away from shore to keep sargasso seaweed off its part of dawn beach.

The devices, designed specifically to combat invasive sargasso seaweed, include vacuum technology to gather and suck the seaweed and pump it to shore for gathering and disposition.

Although some large sea turtles nest on dawn beach, they are historically seen at its southern end, far from Oyster Bay.

10. La Bamba Beach Bar, Kim Sha Beach, Demolished by the Dutch Side Government

The La Bamba saga / soap opera continues.

First it was open on Kim Sha Beach between Royal Palm and Atrium Resorts. Then the government sold land it owned on which La Bamba was situated to a business owned by Sudi Ozkan, the Turkish billionaire who owns Princess Port de Plaisance Resort, in return to Ozkan giving land near its resort to the government for a sewage treatment plant. La Bamba was told to get out and it did, going to Soggy Dollar in Simpson Bay.

Then it gets complicated, but La Bamba reopened on land adjacent to its old location on Kim Sha beach. A government change seems to have voided the land swap. So there La Bamba was on what the government apparently thinks is *its* land. The government doesn't like things like that so it gave a few hours notice then bulldozed the place and removed all the resulting debris. We're told nothing's left.

Meanwhile, Sudi (remember him?) through his company went to court to fight the current government coalition to keep the land swap in place. That's where it stands right now, but see the next story.

11. Port de Plaisance Owner Files Injunction, May Have Designs on Kim Sha Beach

As you read in story #10, Turkish billionaire and Port de Plaisance resort owner Sudi Ozkan through one of his companies is in court to stop the SXM government from reversing a land swap agreed to by the predecessor Dutch Side government. The agreement it likes is one which gives it a few acres on the beach.

Word on the street is that Ozkan wants to build a hotel on the public Kim Sha beach between Atrium and Royal Palm, which is exactly the site that the proposed American Clinic "medical tourism" project was eyeing a few years ago. If anyone thought he wanted the land for a family picnic, they don't know much about Sudi Ozkan. A high-end hotel was also an integral part of the American Clinic proposal. We may be witnessing an interesting chess game here.

Ozkan also owns the currently undeveloped land abutting Cupecoy Beach opposite Blue Mall and has supposedly been trying to sell that to a private developer as well. If he does, it will likely make access to that very popular clothing-optional beach quite problematic.

He could also develop that property himself

12. Minister Emile Lee of Princess Heights Calls for Dutch/French Hospital Cooperation

Emile Lee, who heads Princess Heights Luxury Boutique Suites Hotel on the hill opposite the Westin Dawn Beach, was elected a while back and became part of the new Dutch Side government. His portfolio: health. (Why it wasn't tourism is beyond us.)

He's doing a great job, most recently calling for cooperation between the Dutch and French Sides to offer superior hospital care on the island. Right now it is not widely regarded as superior.

Instead of competing, he suggests health facilities on both sides of the "small" island work together to share top-quality resources. We hear health care in Holland is top-drawer and that a key member of the Dutch Parliament agreed recently to help the Dutch Side build a quality new hospital facility. The current St. Maarten Medical Center has too few specialists, too few rooms, outdated facilities, etc. It is not a trauma center and Americans visiting it say

it does not compete at all with the quality of American healthcare.

We'll keep you posted.

13. Orient Beach Sees Progress, But It's Complicated

The squabbling between prospective and actual tenants of orient beach's new buildings continues. Several places are open, others are empty, and nobody seems to be happy. The Collectivite has yet to address the €2500/month rents that are regarded as outrageous by tenants.

Meanwhile, the Collectivite is upset that some tenants have erected new structures on their deck resembling the old demolished shacks -- apparently without permission. It is not threatening to demolish them (as the Dutch Side would do) but it does say it wants them to get permission.

Note to the Collectivite: for paying you €2500/month rents, you should be kissing your tenants' butts instead of making it nearly impossible for them to do business. Make it easy for them to do business; that's what effective governments do. That way everyone wins....

14. A New Source of French Pastry Near Super U

Au Pain Gourmand is excellent... but much of the day, expect long lines. The later you go the less they have. It's a 50-foot walk from the Super U pedestrian exit.

15. More Than 200 Boats Set To Compete in Heineken Regatta

Another big Heineken Regatta is shaping up on the island, once again with over 200 competing boats. The early March event is the single biggest week of the Dutch Side's tourist season. For more, click "Media" at www.heinekenregatta.com.

17. Where to Hike in SXM

Get one of cartographer Michal Kasprowski's SXM roadmaps either directly at discount (see the Secret Site) or from Van Dorp in Simpson Bay at retail. His latest maps feature hiking trails across the island. One of the best is at the rugged shoreline in Guana Bay.

18. The Sheer Beauty of Baie Lucas

One of the most naturally breathtaking stretches of coastline on this island is Baie Lucas, just north of Oyster Bay on the French Side of the island. Stretching from Oyster Pond northward along the coast, the road passes by the bay, by the Embouchure Bay observation deck, and ultimately to the village of Orleans on the French Side where there's a very busy little bakery near the main road to Orient.

Bring your camera... lots to see here.

19. SXM Horseback Riding

There are many spots offering it, but one we'd suggest is the stable next to the Butterfly Farm in the Orient area. Mean reason: location. You'll follow a neat shoreline route that's beautiful and fun for you, your friends, and seemingly the horses as well. Check it out.

20. Kids Activities on SXM (for School Vacation Weeks)

- a) Butterfly Farm, Orient Bay off the road to Club Orient; go early for the most activity and wear brightly colored clothing.
- b) Carousel, Simpson Bay; great Ice Cream and the island's only working carousel. Opens early afternoon.
- c) The St. Maarten Party Bus, Dutch Side; great fun for the whole family on their daytime island tours.
- d) Loterie Farm, off Pic Paradis Road, French Side north of Marigot; very scenic area, pool, natural restaurant, zipline, wild monkeys (sometimes).
- e) Maho Beach, Dutch Side, watch planes land. Not suitable for very young children who could have the daylights scared out of them by very low approaching aircraft.

Q. What's so special about SkyMed? Aren't these companies all the same?

A. Not by a long shot. Most other programs take you to "the nearest appropriate facility," not home like SkyMed. If you're in SXM, that means SkyMed competitors would likely take you to Puerto Rico. Some others also raise prices after you reach a certain age. Or they cancel you on a particular birthday, or cancel your membership when you get sick. SkyMed does none of that. Sign up for SkyMed today and when you reach age 109 you pay the same price as everyone else. Once you're a member, there's no age or health discrimination -- as long as you pay your membership fee you're good to go. (Applies to all annual and longer memberships. Q. You mean they don't cancel me if I get really sick?

A. No, they don't. Once you're a member, as long as you continue to pay your membership fee your membership continues regardless of your health or age, if you buy an annual or multiyear membership and keep it in force. SkyMed does not throw you out if you get sick. If you allow your membership to lapse, you will need to reapply to determine of you're still medically acceptable -- so just don't let it lapse.

Q. We travel for weeks at a time. Do we have to tell SkyMed where we're going?

A. No, you don't. As long as you're home in the US or Canada more than six months per year, you're fine. If you spend more than half of each year away (in aggregate), then you're considered an expatriate (ex-pat) and would need a program custom-tailored for ex-pats because you're away a majority of the time and that means you represent
