1. Jet Blue To Drop SJU-SXM Flights

Jet Blue Airways has announced that it's discontinuing flights between St. Maarten and San Juan airport effective early in May. .

When it introduced the flights several years ago, JB talked of ramping up to three flights daily. But multiple weekend nonstops from Boston and multiple daily nonstops from JFK reduced the need for SJU-SXM service, and local business was insufficient to sustain it.

The airline's popular nonstops from New York and Boston are unaffected. If you have reservations on this route, contact Jet Blue.

2. Important: Why It's Urgent to Renew Your 2016 Expiring Passport Now

In 2006, US Customs and Border Patrol mandated passports for US citizens traveling to the Caribbean. Those millions of passports come up for renewal this year, so renewals are likely to take up to six weeks - possibly more.

If yours expires this year, renew it soon. Expedited service is available at a premium. Forms are available at many post offices.

5. Sapphire Court Decision Due in Two Weeks

March 8 is the date when the courts in St. Maarten are expected to rule on Sitbon versus Verdier, where the Sitbon Family, which has managed Sapphire for the last few years mostly with its own money, will be told whether the courts will enable it to take over the resort per a purchase and sale agreement it says binds the Verdiers, original Sapphire developers.

If they succeed, the Sitbons promise a new level of quality and timeshare owner satisfaction with the facility, which has been the subject of intense criticism from timeshare owners alleging misuse of maintenance fee monies.

Thousands of Sapphire timeshare owners have either walked away from their weeks or have sold them for pennies on the dollar. Its image, timeshare owners allege, is worse than Pelican Resort was when it was at its worst under the old Martin Vleitman management regime. Taken over by Royal Resorts after bankruptcy and renamed Simpson Bay Resort, that property has been totally renovated and is receiving rave reviews from timeshare owners who stuck with it.

6. What's New at Sapphire?

Jan Borsje, acting GM at Sapphire under the Verdier family on a three-month contract, appears to be making significant progress there. Recent timeshare owner reports have been positive concerning room cleanliness and some new refrigerators. A model unit shows what the Verdiers are thinking for renovations they have said they will pay for. "Lord knows they have the money," one Sapphire timeshare owner told us. "They've collected it from us for years and there's no evidence they did anything except sit on it."

Others are even more pointed. "They clean the place up a bit every year, but at the end of the day it's the same old place with the same crew of unresponsive owners. Most of them don't even bother to answer their phones." Another called the current changes "lipstick on a pig."

The court will decide what happens next and we'll report on their verdict in our first issue after March 8. We've interviewed Jan Borsje and the Sitbons and will have much more on this next month.

8. Orient Beach Businesses Protest French Side Project Mismanagement

If Harvard Business School ever wants a case study on how to screw up a country's economy by bungling renovations in an area where tourists congregate and spend, this is it.

The French Side's decision to demolish and replace about a dozen and a half businesses between Pedro's and Kon Tiki on Orient Beach has been a disaster of galactic proportions.

The demolition, site prep, and construction processes were apparently done with little input from restaurant designers or owners, or from architects knowledgeable regarding building oceanfront businesses. The businesses that were to occupy the buildings claim lots of design noncompliance with French law. Others say that seawalls built in the project will exacerbate erosion, not stop it. Rents, businesses say, also border on profiteering -- €2500/month.

But the proverbial straw that broke the camel's back just happened. Businesses owed keys by the builders / Collectivite can't get them because they guy with the keys took a long vacation. Also, businesses had to pay for electrical and water connections to be set up. The Collectivite didn't fund that.

Business owners not yet in their buildings, who have now lost most of high season, are livid. They threatened a protest last Thursday on the main paved road into the area to dramatize their grievances.

It gets worse: see next story.

9. Le Galion Hotel To Be Demolished After Easter, Taking "Tropical Wave" With It

As if the Orient Beach Disaster weren't bad enough, now the Collectivite says after Easter it will finally demolish the derelict Le Galion Beach Hotel on Le Galion Beach. It was walloped by Luis and other hurricanes and has been an eyesore for years. They say they want to clear out asbestos and develop a park.

What took so long?

Tropical Wave Restaurant has been doing business at that location for about 39 years and it gets it water and electricity from that building. No problem, the Collectivite says; it can move next door.

There, the Collectivite says Tropical Wave must pay €3000/month plus health premniums plus taxes. "I'll be working for the Collectivite," the owner says, adding that there would be nothing left to live on after paying such a huge rent. And his prices would have to skyrocket. He sells at low prices to locals, mostly; but the Collectivite clearly wants to "upscale" the property following on its Orient Beach activity -- and we all know how successful *that* was.

This will spill over into the streets and into the courts. There are a lot of unhappy business owners on the French

Side. The economy remains bad there despite the near parity of the dollar and Euro, and the government seems to be doing little to help.

We'll keep you posted.

10. Has Zika Disappeared from St. Martin / St. Maarten?

The bad news: no, it hasn't. The good news: there have only been two confirmed cases here, one from the French Side and the other, confirmed this week, from the Dutch. The person in the Dutch Side case had traveled recently and may have contracted Zika overseas.

Zika shows no symptoms in the majority of cases. Except for pregnant women or those attempting to become pregnant, it's no big deal. It comes and goes and you may not even notice it.

But for pregnant women it's huge. It is suspected of causing microcephaly, a birth defect where the brain is unusually small and the baby dies weeks after birth.

If you are pregnant (especially first trimester) or trying to become pregnant, you should see your doctor for travel advice. For others it is not a big deal.

Bear in mind, however, that this mosquito-vectored disease can also be spread by having sex with an infected person. Researchers are investigating other modes of transmission; vaccine development; and genetic modification of the vector mosquito (aedes agypti) to stop the spread of the disease.

16. St. Maarten / St. Martin's Best Ice Cream

17. St. Maarten's Best Supermarket

Without a doubt, the single best supermarket on the island is Super U next to McDonald's in Marigot. It's clean; very well stocked; has some of the most reasonable pricing on the island; very fresh fruits and vegetables; and helpful employes who are happy to answer questions. (No deer-in-headlights looks when you ask.)

Go. It's on the French Side but you'll find lots of Dutch Side folks there as well.

18. Why You Should Try to Pay Cash on the French Side

When you buy by credit card on the French Side, your bank exchanges currency and you lose, regardless of the fact that most markets accept dollars at par with Euros *when you pay cash*. Many banks also tack on a fee for international transactions.

Instead, get debit card cash advances and pay cash. You'll save quite a bit of money. (B of A account holders, use Scotiabank ATMs; reciprocity means no Scotiabank ATM charges.

19. Use Your Wireless Phone With Caution in SXM...

Roaming charges really add up. People who are here for a while often buy a local phone and use it instead; it's much cheaper. Or, get your smart phone unlocked and plunk a local SXM SIM card into it; that's the best of all worlds. (If you're here a while, suspend service on your home cell phone to save \$.)

We think Chippie is the best provider.

If you'd rather rent than buy, go to Sharon's Cell Phone Rentals at Royal Palm Beach Hotel. Prices are very low and the service is excellent.

20. High Tide and Low Tide in the Tropics

In the Bay of Fundy in New Brunswick, Canada, the total amount of water flowing when tides change is 160 billion tons. It looks like a 50 foot wall of water there. See more: http://bayoffundytourism.com/tides/

Fortunately, the closer to the equator you get the lower the tides are. In SXM you don't even notice any tides, which is quite convenient. The only thing affecting water here now is storms moving up the US East Coast; they can and do create rough conditions here. "When Boston gets a storm, my beach gets washed away," says Dany, owner of the Cupecoy Beach Bar. He's absolutely right....

21. Review of Local & Regional Airlines

There are three principal local airlines here. In terms of numbers of flights, Winair, the national airline, is the biggest. It operates mostly small, rugged Twin Otter airplanes capable of getting into the small and challenging airports in St. Barths, Saba (Google / YouTube them), and other islands. Winair is dependable, safe, courteous, and quite likable, according to locals we talked to about it. Twin Otter flights are quick so prop noise is no big deal.

LIAT (Leeward Islands Air Transport) is most widely known for missing its schedule and sometimes stranding people, as the *Daily Herald* reported a few weeks ago. Some locals have told us it should change its name to *Leave Island Any Time*.

The last airline on this short list is Insel, which flies to a number of locations, most of them from its hub in Curacao. The most memorable info we have on Insel is its mechanical issues. Twice in the last year or two, we've seen aging Insel DC-9 aircraft stuck in SXM with an engine removed. No one was hurt, and the airline says it maintains its planes by the book, but why would planes with disabled engines happen at least twice in so short a period?

22. Where to Feed Iguanas, Where to Feed Donkeys

Iguanas: Two places; first, the tiny pond opposite the gate house at the Westin Resort and casino, Dawn Beach, Dutch Side; and second, the area near the pond between Orleans, French Side, and the scenic overlook at Baie Lucas, French Side.

Donkeys: On the road to the French Side dump at the top of the hill. You can see the hill by looking to the left from the Pinel Island ferry landing.

23. About Iguanas, Mongoose, Wild Monkeys, & Raccoons

SXM has interesting wildlife which includes everything noted above.

Iguanas are noted in story #22. They are all invasive... they displaced the local iguanas some time ago. Most are green but older ones can also be orange. Bright green ones are young. They are fierce-looking vegetarians.

We've seen about eight mongoose this trip, all in the Dawn Beach / Oyster Pond area. They have rust-colored to light brown fur and are low slung and quite long including their long tails (as long as some iguanas). A good picture of a light-colored one is here: http://tinyurl.com/h3snm4k

Yes there are wild monkeys here, descendants of former pet monkeys. We've seen two on our current trip, one near Oyster Pond and the other near Orient Beach. They seem to have weathered the drought fine. Estimates are that there are about 2,000 on the island. Are you likely to see them in a two-week trip? Probably not. Most likely spot: Loterie Farm near Pic Paradis, French Side. We saw about two dozen chowing down on small fruit trees there two years ago.

Raccoons are here too. We saw an expired one a few years ago and one evening last week, we saw one slowly ambling across the road near the Cadisco gas station in Grand Case. They also are believed descended from pets.

24. Speaking of SXM: Hear Jeff Berger Every Monday Morning on Island 92

Jeff is live on the air every Monday on Island92 radio, 91.9 FM between 930 and 10am Atlantic time (one hour ahead of EST). You can also listen on their website, www.island92.com.

25. Food Talk: Hear Topper Every Thursday Morning on Island 92

Topper is a fascinating guy who loves cooking and talking about the best ways to make great food. We count him among our closest friends on SXM. His restaurants are Topper's in Simpson Bay (near Royal Palm Resort), and Toppers by the Sea at Flamingo Resort, on the beach. Melanie, Topper's wife, runs the Topper's Rhum distillery.

Topper is on the air on Island 92 (91.9FM) most Thursdays somewhere between 10 and 11 with food/menu guidance and advice. It's plain talk about ingredients you already have at home and it tells you very simply how to make better food -- which is exactly what Topper does every day in his restaurant.

Topper is great to his people and their loyalty and quest to give excellent service is obvious. He hired a young lady 10 years ago who asked for a job. She started by picking up cigarette butts and other stuff in the parking lot. She did a great job so a year later he moved her to dishwasher -- equally great job. Then short order cook: ditto. Then after a few years chef. Now, 10 years later, that young lady is head chef at Toppers, one of the busiest of all SXM restaurants. She beams. It's a great thing to see and Toppers food is very reasonable and delicious. Try his lobster (way less per lb.. than many other places) and his filet mignon, tender and delicious. He's known for his home cooked brisket (which he cooked kosher for a certain island Rabbi not long ago) and for his meatloaf, but he has lots of choices for all appetites.

Both Toppers and Island 92 are winners of our 2016 Everything SXM Awards of Excellence.

26. Want to Help Island Dogs? Here's How

Although the stray dog situation here has improved, there are still too many. People adopt island dogs and others

27. Restaurant of the Week

Easily one of the best restaurants you'll ever encounter in the Caribbean is a quintessential tropical experience in a class by itself. Her smile is worth the trip but of course the food and the view are what you come here for. The view is amazing (just look up between the gazebos) and the food easily matches it. Busby's has lots of sandwiches, fish, salads, and much more at lunch, with eggs, sandwiches, french toast, and pancakes at breakfast. Go for either meal. Their Island Pizza is next door, where experienced chefs build great thin-crust pizzas. We visit Busby's dozens of times during every trip to the island.

At night, Busby's morphs into Daniel's By The Sea Italian Restaurant. Cushions soften the seats and candles add to the atmosphere. Great stuff.
