1. Low Season brings more troubles to GEBE

GEBE, SXM's electric company, seems to have lots of breakdowns particularly in low season. It controls both electricity and water. Sometimes it warns people (usually with water outages, all of which should be entirely preventable) but many times it doesn't.

GEBE had more trouble again this past weekend. Here is what they wrote to customers (word for word -- grammatical errors are all theirs):

Dear Customers,

We hereby inform you that minutes after 5pm one of our biggest engine (sic!) tripped and cause (sic!) us to loose (sic!) power in severals (sic!) districts. Our engineers are working on starting up a smaller generator to assit (sic!) with load while working on the engine.

- 2. PDP cable feeding -- Parts of Union Road and Port de Plaisance

- 6. Saunders including Cay Hill and parts of Bush Road
- 7. Belvedere including Dutch Quater (sic!) and Oyster

Pond and Dawn Beach 8. Madame Estate

End of quoted announcement. Perhaps they should simply have said "almost everywhere."

2 - Timeshare Rental Weeks Scam Means Changes in Future Ads

Seeing an online ad for a timeshare rental, a scammer entered the Royal Islander Resort recently, told the front desk a specific room was empty and available, and offered to pay them \$400 for it for a week, about half the weekly rental the timeshare owner had wanted. The resort refused since the timeshare owner was actually in the unit, having decided against renting it.

Such tactics, if successful, would cheat the timeshare owner of the rental price and create the possibility of overbooking by the resort. Although scammers can get specific room info from renters in advance when calling about advertised units, listing unit numbers online facilitates that and could allow this scam to take off.

That's why we will change our online rental form to warn advertisers not to list specific unit numbers in their ads -- only the *type* of unit.

Effective immediately, we will strip unit info from all incoming ads but *not* on ads already posted.

Of course, you can replace current ads on our site anytime through the "Submit an Ad" link on our Members-Only Secret Website, if you are a JMB Website Supporters member. Free ads (up to 10 per 12-month period) are a benefit of JMB membership.

5 - The Stark Difference Between Short-Term and Annual SkyMed Memberships
