

### 1. New Tropical System Could Affect SXM This Week

Although most readers on the US East Coast are watching tropical storm / hurricane Hermine closely right now, there is a developing tropical system in the central Atlantic headed westward toward the Leeward Islands that bears serious watching from SXM.

<u>Crown Weather Services</u> said a few days ago that if a blocking high pressure system develops over the Atlantic as expected, this storm could easily hit the leeward islands this weekend (September 3 and 4). That is a bit earlier than was expected earlier. The good news is that when it hits the northeastern Caribbean, it is not now expected to be a tropical storm or a hurricane, but instead a tropical wave — that could mean heavy rains, rough surf, and winds. There appears to be a high likelihood that this system will become either a tropical storm or a hurricane after it gets to the Western Caribbean or the eastern Gulf of Mexico this coming week.

It's clearly visible on <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u> though at this writing Friday night it still looks ragged -- as expected.

It will need to be watched very carefully for threats to the US mainland.

### 2. Is Cathay Pacific or Hainan Airlines Coming to SXM? Unequivocally Perhaps

If you believe the lead story in the next section, which regards a prospectively huge Chinese hotel / apartment investment in St. Maarten, then it's logical to expect either Cathay Pacific or Hainan Airlines, two international airlines based in China, to start making daily trips from Beijing and Shanghai to SXM in the next few years.

Or, maybe not.

Chinese officials have said that they will increase tourism from China to SXM by one million tourists per year, which would be the equivalent of a few 747 Jets daily all year long. Since the proposed new hotel/apartment structure doesn't have anywhere near the capacity required to house all those tourists one must wonder where they would go, if they came.

They've reportedly made the exact same comment on other islands where they also reportedly have proposed other similar large developments. Then again, they -- reportedly again -- don't speak English.

Much more on the proposal and reaction to it in St. Maarten is in the next section.

### 4. 776-Room Hotel/Apartment/"Showroom" Complex Coming to Bel Air

When they heard the news Friday morning that a 776 room hotel/apartment complex roughly 12 stories tall was going to be plunked on Bel Air beach near the Bel Air timeshare resort, on land formerly for the defunct Barbaron Resort, most people thought it was April 1, not September 2.

Almost everyone was incredulous and a lot of people were angry. You'll see our story on reaction below.

In almost total secrecy, with no public hearings, the Dutch side government has approved a huge Chinese-financed project to develop a 776-room combined hotel/apartment/"showroom" facility on Bel Air beach.

Here's the link to the Daily Herald story, news of which surprised them as much as it did everyone else.

More about this project is publicly <u>un</u>known than is known. The project is called "Pearl of the Caribbean," though whether that will be its name at launch is anyone's guess. Groundbreaking is this month. There have been many hotel projects on St. Maarten that broke ground and subsequently croaked -- Aquarius, Barbaron, and apparently Mandara among them. Whether Pearl will meet a similar fate is unknown.

The project consists of 326 hotel rooms and 450 apartments. The developer, who was also not identified but may be the mostly Chinese government-owned Greenland Group, says the apartments will be used largely by Chinese nationals who will use it as a headquarters property for making investments throughout the Caribbean and presumably elsewhere. But Chinese officials have said exactly the same thing on other islands, *SXM Weekly News* has been told.

The Chinese officials spoke to the government through a Turkish intermediary. They spoke no English and the Turk spoke no Chinese. How that worked, we don't know. The group reportedly promised one million Chinese tourists coming yearly to SXM as a result of this project. But 326 rooms is nowhere near enough to house them, if they come. It's also not known whether the beach land where this huge structure is intended to be built could handle such a high mass. It's also unclear where everyone will park, what infrastructure changes will be required on area roads, whether the hotel will have international branding, its room price range, whether there are any casinos, shops, or restaurants involved, etc.

It is also not known whether any of the construction will be done by local craftspeople. Having it built by Chinese labor would be of zero benefit to the local economy but politician Richard Gibson, running for office, who announced

the plan, seems to think it's almost as cool as the second coming.

It's also odd that such a project would be located in St. Maarten at a time when so many people have been whipped into a negative frenzy regarding Zika and, of course, Cuba. But the Chinese do have lots of money and they have to invest it somewhere — and somehow, they apparently decided on St. Maarten.

Our headline said that this project also contains a show room, an expression that was never defined. A showroom could be a place for shows — like a theater. Or it could be a place for meetings or even a convention center, which is very badly needed on the island. There are convention facilities at Maho and at the Westin, but there is nothing to attract larger scale conventions to the island. Even if this facility were to have a convention center, 326 rooms is nowhere near the volume that would be needed to attract larger conventions to SXM.

We'll keep our eye on this. Groundbreaking is this month. There is no announced target for completion.

### 5. Island Reaction To The New Hotel

Social media Friday morning exploded in anger over this project. We guess close to 100% of the people expressing themselves said it was a horrible idea, with many asking if the date was April 1 — April Fools Day. One well-placed woman we know said she thought Richard Gibson's announcement of this plan would hurt him at the elections this month since opposition is overwhelming.

The process by which the Dutch side government reviews and approves major projects is almost always cloaked in secrecy, as we said earlier. There is no such thing as open meeting laws in SXM. In many cases, projects are seen, reviewed, and approved entirely in secrecy, leaving citizens unable to voice their opinions and concerns.

Although this project has been "approved" by the current government, new elections occur this month, after the groundbreaking -- so there would be no surprise if the project were to come to a screeching halt at the hands of a new government after the elections.

Besides labor, other open questions include infrastructure impacts, environmental impact on the fragile Bel Air beach area, and other consideration which will get microscopic examination by everyone in the coming weeks.

If this project contains a true world-class convention center component, all bets are off; but we don't think it does. "Exposition space," which it will have, differs greatly from a true convention center.

We're watching for you, as always.

### 6. Our Reaction

We frankly don't feel good about this project at this point. It strikes us as being far too big for the site; self serving to those who are building it, who said Chinese salespeople and property developers will occupy the apartments; it will put a huge hit on the ecology of the area, not to mention on water, electricity, and roads; building it on the beach may not even be feasible at all.

We are sure that local nature organizations will not be happy with this idea, since it is highly likely to fill in a lagoon behind the beach in order to make room for the structure — much as Columbia Sussex did with wetlands that

existed off Dawn beach before it constructed the Westin on that location.

The only way this would make sense to us is if it had a very big convention center component which, as we said, is unlikely. That world-class component could draw people to SXM year-round.

We'll keep you posted.

### 7. What Will This Do To The Timesharing Industry?

At this point it's far too early to hypothesize what if any effect this project could have on St. Maarten timesharing.

The critical fact for government officials to understand is that timeshare owners, for more than 25 years, have been the financial mainstay of the island. They return yearly, stay over, patronize restaurants, buy jewelry, visit beach bars, buy souvenirs, etc. Although events like the Caravanserai Debacle, the Pelican bankruptcy a few years ago, Sapphire's issues, and others have caused a huge outflow of timeshare owners in recent years they have been replaced by lower financial demographic individuals who don't spend as much but at least still come to the island.

The island must keep that demographic happy and not allow it to degrade further.

Bottom line, the timeshare "sector" has been hurt in recent years both by itself and by the continued lack of strong timeshare owner consumer protection legislation. We don't think this project, if it ever happens, will by itself make the timeshare industry any worse off. *Please see stories 12 and 13.*

#### Q. What's so special about SkyMed? Aren't these companies all the same?

A. Not by a long shot. Most other programs say in their fine print that they take you to "the nearest appropriate facility," *not* home like SkyMed. If you're in SXM, that means *SkyMed <u>competitors</u>* would likely take you to Puerto Rico. Some others also raise prices after you reach a certain age... Or they cancel you on a particular birthday, or cancel your membership when you get sick. *SkyMed does none of that*. #### Q. How fast are the evacuations?

A. That depends on a number of factors. First the patient must be medically stable and ready to fly. Even though emergency medical evacuations are aboard ICU-equivalent medevac jets, the patient's stable health during the trip is of paramount importance. He / she must be medically stable to take that trip. Although arrangements for the electronic transfer of medical records, reserving flight and medical crews and the jet itself, making hospital arrangements at the destination hospital, and setting up ambulances at both ends of trip must all be completed beforehand, nonetheless it generally takes only a matter of hours before you're in the plane on the way to hospitals and doctors you know and trust near home. ### Q. We travel for weeks at a time. Do we have to tell SkyMed where we're going?

A. No, you don't. As long as you're home in the US or Canada more than six months per year, you're fine. If you spend more than half of each year away (in aggregate), out of your home country (USA or Canada) then you're considered an expatriate (ex-pat) and would need a program custom-tailored for ex-pats because you're away a majority of the time and that means you represent increased exposure.
