

Although there has been plenty of sun during the past week in SXM, there has also been plenty of rain — mostly at night. Christmas winds have been strong during much of the week as well.

In the next few weeks, the winds will moderate and showers will become less frequent and generally lighter.

c) Our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

d) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

See significant National Hurricane Center Outlooks and Advisories as they relate both to SXM and to the US East and Gulf coasts on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>.

11. After a Long Battle, Lee's Roadside Grill Must Close March 31, 2017

For as many years as most people can remember, Lee's Roadside Grill opposite Royal Palm Beach Resort in Simpson Bay has been a dining landmark, primarily as a restaurant but also as a choice for deep-sea fishing.

Lee's recently lost a court case and as a result, must close its doors at its current location by March 31, 2017. The closure is clearly hard to take for the restaurant's owner, who has been battling with the property owner over his right to the property for a long time.

We've heard nothing about a possible location change for the iconic restaurant but it wouldn't surprise us if the owner does try to make a move; we'll try to find that out and let you know. In any case, there currently appears to be no way to avoid the order to vacate the premises by March 31.

12. "Mardis in Grand Case" Starts January 17

Years ago, when Pascal Potin was the co-owner and operator of the LAlabama restaurant in Grand Case, he was also the head of the Grand Case Restaurant Association and in that capacity, pushed the idea of a Tuesday night weekly celebration to enhance business in "the culinary capital of the Caribbean," Grand Case. It's an enduring celebration that features bands, street dancers, street musicians, food kiosks, crafts kiosks, and much more. If you're looking for a quiet dinner that night, go elsewhere; it gets quite noisy. But it's a fun experience which you'll very much enjoy — and you'll find parking relatively easy in central locations with shuttles.

13. Today is Boxing Day in SXM

No, it has nothing to do pugilism.

Boxing Day, the European tradition, comes the day after Christmas and it's when people create gifts for those who provide services, postal carriers, delivery people, and others, as we understand it. It's also a shopping holiday in some countries, similar to Black Friday in the US.

In Dutch SXM, it's a holiday during which most businesses shut down — kind of an extension to the Christmas holiday and, this year, Hanukkah. Most businesses are penalized if they open on Boxing Day or other national holidays; the exception is restaurants and hotels.

14. The Down & Dirty Story of Dutch Side Potholes

Years ago, potholes on the Dutch and French sides of the island were a constant source of irritation and anger to locals and tourists on both sides of the island.

In recent years, they've not really been a problem; road crews on both sides of the island fixed potholes before tourist season really began, generally before the end of December.

There's no major problem on the French side, but things on the Dutch side are not what they should be. There are serious potholes along A. Th. Illidge Road, the main Dutch side road traveling northward toward the French side from Philipsburg, and on the Union road, the main north-south road between Marigot, the French capital, and Cole Bay, Dutch side. There are also (for now) less serious potholes in Simpson Bay.

Hopefully the Dutch side will get rid of these quickly — but they've been around for weeks and usually by now they've been taken care of.

15. Make Reservations Early For Celine Too's Sunset Cruise / Dinner at Stone

Ever since it was first announced a few weeks ago, Neil and Johann Roebert's sunset cruise aboard the Celine Too motor yacht combined with dinner at Johann's recently relocated on-the-water Stone Restaurant on the southern end of Simpson Bay lagoon (his driveway is between Tropicana casino and the new Rum and Peas restaurant in Simpson Bay) has been a huge smash hit.

Those who have traveled with Neil before know what a pleasure it is to be on his boat. In its beautiful new location, Stone chef/owner Johann really gets to show his stuff. We went to a party there days ago and the food was terrific.

16. About The Emilio Wilson Estate Chair Lift & Zipline

As we wrote Christmas Day on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>, one of the most controversial new construction projects on the island is underway at the Emilio Wilson estate. A zipline and chair lift are being constructed which will take tourists to the top of what to most Americans is a small mountain. In the opinion of environmentalists, the project is a disastrous eyesore which wrecks what had been a rather pristine natural area which should have been left intact for future generations. Even its zipline has been criticized; it's supposed to be the steepest in the hemisphere but its environmental credentials have been roundly criticized by the people in charge at Loterie Farm on the French side, a masterpiece of environmental preservation with its own highly popular zipline through a pristine forest.

We'll be posting pictures of construction very shortly on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>. The project is on a Hill just north of the Grand Marche supermarket on L. B. Scott Road. It will include a snack bar and souvenir store as well as an outstanding view of Philipsburg, Great Bay, neighboring islands, as well as a panoramic view of the Dutch Side dump in Philipsburg which may well be on fire when you see it; it often is.... (Don't worry, the wind doesn't usually blow in this direction.)

It probably would've made more sense to solve the dump problem first and then build this, but nobody's perfect. Thousands of people every month will likely enjoy the chair lift up the side of the mountain every month once it opens this coming spring. We'll let you know.

18. A Look Back at "Old" SXM Restaurants: Story #5

Over the years, St. Maarten/St. Martin has been home to many restaurants of varying descriptions. This series briefly describes a number of restaurants from both sides of the island that have passed into history but have not left our memory.

Surf Club South: His name was Andrew Susko, a benevolent curmudgeon if ever there was one and a

crackerjack chef who left Jersey with his girlfriend to open a Jersey Shore Beach Bar under a mammoth brafestooned tree in the heart of Grand Case. It didn't fit but it fit perfectly — both at the same time. The restaurant went on to be famous throughout the Caribbean and beyond, with what was written up widely as the best burgers in the Caribbean and lots of other special treats.

After vicious hurricane Luis upended the tree and wrecked the restaurant in 1995, Andy and Cheryl moved to another location not far away which they soon quit for the iconic Andy and Cheryl's restaurant that lasted for several years on Orient beach until the recent reconstruction, when Cheryl retired. Andy had passed away a few years ago, and his blueberry pancakes, ricotta pie, lasagna, and numerous other memorable Italian recipes disappeared into fondly remembered history.

Q. What's special about SkyMed? Aren't these programs all the same?

A. Virtually all "competitive" programs say in their fine print that they take you to "the nearest appropriate facility," *not* home like SkyMed. If you're in SXM, that means *SkyMed <u>competitors</u>* would likely take you to Puerto Rico. Some others also raise prices after you reach a certain age... Or they cancel you on a particular birthday, or cancel your membership when you get sick. *SkyMed does none of that*. Sign up for SkyMed and when you reach age 109 you pay the same low price as everyone else. <u>Once you're a member, there's no age or health discrimination</u> -- as long as you pay your membership fee on time you're good to go. (Applies to all annual and longer memberships. Short-term memberships, lasting only a few days, require medical requalification when you buy another -- which is why we recommend annual or multiyear memberships. *Why risk the hurdle of medical requalification?*)

Q. What other evacuation-related services do you offer besides the evacuation itself?

A. There are 18 evac-related services, all of which are important. See our downloadable **SkyMed Benefits PDF** on our <u>SXM Weekly News PDF Archives</u> page.

Q. How fast are the evacuations?

A. That depends on several factors. For her / his own safety, the patient must be medically stable and ready to fly. Even though emergency medical evacuations are usually aboard ICU-equivalent medevac jets, the patient's stable health during the trip is of paramount importance. Arrangements for the electronic transfer of medical records, reserving flight and medical crews and the jet itself, making hospital arrangements at the destination hospital, and setting up ambulances at both ends of trip must all be completed beforehand -- but despite that, it generally takes only a matter of hours before you're in the plane on the way to hospitals and doctors you know and trust near home. Bottom line, *SkyMed does it as quickly as it can be done assuring the patient's health and safety during the medical evacuation and the flight home.*

Q. Do they cancel me if I get really sick?

A. No. Once you're a member, as long as you continue to pay your membership fee your membership continues regardless of your health or age <u>when you buy an annual or multivear membership and pay your renewal fees on time</u>. A. You do not have to be in "phenomenal" health at all. By the way: if you travel very little and only for short periods, you can apply for SkyMed's short-term memberships; they cover all pre-existing conditions in full, immediately. *Just remember that you must medically requalify every time you need a new short-term memberships instead of short-term*. Those memberships cover all pre-existing conditions in full after only 90 days. More on that is below.

Q. We travel for weeks at a time. Do we have to tell SkyMed where we're going?

A. No, you don't. As long as you're home in the US or Canada more than six months per year, you're fine. If you spend more than half of each year away (in aggregate), out of your home country (USA or Canada) then you're considered an expatriate (ex-pat) and would need a program custom-tailored for ex-pats because you're away a

majority of the time and that means you represent increased exposure. That program is called "X-Pat" - the program for American and Canadian expatriates living overseas. Even as an ex-pat living in SXM, you can still be transported back to your city of choice in the USA or Canada. (**Important:** see the question, "*Does SkyMed cover us no matter where we travel?*" which is below.)

Q. Does SkyMed cover pre-existing conditions?

A. Yes, right away for short-term memberships and after just a 90 day waiting period for memberships lasting a year or longer. To make sure you're covered for everything when you travel including pre-existing conditions just buy your annual or multi-year Ultimate SkyMed membership more than 90 days ahead of your initial date of travel. You can also get a short-term membership for immediate travel and separately apply for an annual or longer-term membership to take effect after the short-term plan ends: that way you cover any pre-existing conditions in your short-term membership.

Q. Do you require a physical exam for renewal or when I reach a certain age?

A. No, SkyMed requires neither. Once you join and buy an annual or multiyear membership that SkyMed approves, they'll renew it every year upon on-time payment of your renewal fee. No physical exam is required regardless of your age or health if you've paid your membership renewal on time. You can be age 109 and still be protected by your SkyMed membership. In some cases, based on your application, SkyMed may request a medical statement from your doctor about certain conditions.

Q. What is the maximum age for applying for membership?

A. There isn't any. Apply away.

Q. I seldom travel now. Do you have short-term plans?

A, Yes, at about \$9/day per person or maximum \$15/day per family. Since they only last a specified number of days, they end when the term of coverage ends. If you want another short-term plan later, you must apply again and medically requalify. Annual plans cost roughly \$1.30/day for your entire family (you and minor kids); plans for singles are less. <u>Annual and multiyear plans are renewable without medical requalification, assuming they haven't lapsed.</u> That's a key advantage over short-term plans.

Q. I'm from Canada. May I join SkyMed? I have to get back to my province if I'm seriously ill or my health insurance won't work.

A. Both Americans and Canadians are eligible to join SkyMed. American and Canadian ex-pats living overseas also are eligible.

Q. What types of policies are there?

A. The Ultimate membership covers you globally through SkyMed Global -- or you can add a global rider to annual memberships (at about \$100/year) which adds rest-of-the-world coverage, also through SkyMed Global. SkyMed does not cover countries where there are open hostilities -- Iraq, Iran, Syria, Somalia, North Korea, etc.

Q. I already belong to SkyMed but I'm pretty sick now. Will SkyMed drop me?
