

1. Saturday's AA 1753 (CLT-SXM) Makes a Bad-Weather Go-Around Look

Simple

As we told our JMB Website Supporters members last Friday, the weather all weekend was forecast to be very wet with some wind, and those conditions could persist through early this week.

On Saturday, American flight 1753, a Boeing 757 from Charlotte carrying 136 passengers and a crew of six, approached the airport in very rainy conditions. Ceiling conditions were low, and the aircraft broke out of the low ceiling just in time to determine that it needed to do a go around, which crews are well trained to do under such circumstances.

Video of the approach was shot by the new Maho Beach Cam and within hours surpassed 100,000 views. Although some people seeing the video characterized it as scary, it really wasn't — it was really something that happens on a daily basis. A long-time senior captain for a major airline told us the following after seeing the video: "A go-around is always the right thing to do, if things aren't just right. With showers around and possible windshear, the go around is essentially spring loaded. (It's even possible the pilots even verbally reviewed to each other the GA sequence/flow on the way down final, based on what they saw ahead - "in case we go around, it's _____). For

challenging environments/airports like SXM, I imagine they had lots of fuel to do a couple of attempts before a divert to SJU. It's either going to look right (safe) all the way to touchdown or you go somewhere else."

A bad weather go-around isn't exactly simple, but it is very much routine.

2. Airport Closed Part of Easter Sunday Thanks to Heavy Rains

SXM Airport was closed part of Easter Sunday afternoon due to torrential rains, forcing a number of approaching passenger aircraft into a holding pattern well northeast of Puerto Rico, where they stayed out of busy traffic lanes in the Caribbean. Weather finally improved at around 3:45, enabling the planes to perform normal approaches to the airport.

Some aircraft went to other islands to refuel, standing by until their position in the landing sequence was set. There were delays in excess of an hour for some landing flights, plus similar or longer delays for some takeoffs. We expect that Customs and Immigration both saw longer than usual delays due to the quick arrival of numerous aircraft once the airport reopened. It was expected that departure delays would be exacerbated by the number of aircraft hoping to take off even while additional aircraft were landing.

In related news, <u>the Dutch side government issued a press release on Sunday afternoon urging motorists to avoid</u> <u>flooded areas, of which there were many thanks to the deluges</u>. The entire press release was posted on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>.

3. Weather Unpleasant for a Few Days

Chief meteorologist for <u>Crown Weather</u>, Rob Lightbown, said late last week that the northeastern Caribbean should expect quite rainy conditions all weekend long, and into the early part of the coming week. We posted that information to our JMB Website Supporters Facebook Site, which we had mentioned to Website Supporters members previously; that page is not available to the general public.Mr. Lightbown said that conditions are expected to improve by midweek, or possibly sooner.

We have long recommended that people who live in the track of serious storms, not only in SXM but also across the entire Caribbean and North America, subscribe to Mr. Lightbown's services, which are very inexpensive, have a great track record, and have been exceptionally timely. 4. 2017 Hurricane Season Just Six Weeks Away

Hurricane season 2017 is almost here. It starts June 1, 2017, and ends on November 30. Storms during June and July are relatively rare, but they do happen. Storms tend to pick up in frequency in August and start simmering down late in October.

As we previously reported, Crown Weather Services has said that this season is likely to be less busy than usual because of the possible development of an El Niño situation. They said that the northeastern Caribbean should have a slightly less busy time this year than usual, hurricane wise. But with warm ocean waters near Florida and the US Gulf Coast, those areas seem more likely for a potential storm impact.

8. A Little Story About the Big Changes at Simpson Bay Resort

Those of you who have read us for any number of years know that Simpson Bay Resort has not always been on our "good" list.

When timeshare owners took over the resort in the 1990s, their hearts were in the right place but they really had no experience running a resort. In retrospect, at the very beginning, they probably should've brought in someone with real hospitality expertise. On the other hand, when Richard Sutton was brought in from Royal Resorts, many timeshare owners didn't trust him (including us) simply because he was an unfamiliar outsider.

In the years since, it has become totally clear to us that Mr. Sutton knows his business extremely well — his approval ratings among timeshare owners in Cancún, where Royal is headquartered, are through the roof. After years of having to deal with this situation in the Caribbean, Royal was able to assume ownership of the resort after its bankruptcy a few years ago.

When we interviewed Mr. Sutton more than a year ago about what he inherited, he told us the infrastructure of the resort when Royal Resorts took it over was a mess, to put it mildly. The renovations undertaken by Royal were massive, requiring everything to be pulled out from floor-to-ceiling (practically, as the movie said, to infinity...and beyond).

Consequently, Simpson Bay Resort today is like an entirely new destination resort, with further enhancements coming. We've toured the entire place and were greatly impressed — so much so that we gave the Suttons and the resort our Everything SXM Award of Excellence this past winter. Timeshare owners substantially funded the renovations through Supplemental Maintenance Fees, but a good chunk of the total investment at the end of the day will also have been made by RRG. Timeshare owners we have spoken with who stuck with the project couldn't be happier.

17. Trump's "Dollar Is Probably Too Strong" Comments May Cause Dollar /

Euro Effects

Regardless of your politics or ours, Pres. Trump recently said that the dollar is probably too strong. He was speaking from the standpoint of US-based global businesses trying to sell overseas — companies like, for example, General Electric and Boeing, which are at a disadvantage because of the strong dollar.

From the perspective of tourists visiting St. Martin, however, the strong dollar has real advantages: the exchange rate with the Euro (used on the French Side) is close to 1:1, and a number of French side restaurants still accept dollars at par with euros. Super U, the most popular supermarket on the French side, was recently charging \$1.05USD per Euro required: the French side economy as we noted is denominated in Euros. Should the dollar fall in value, purchases and the French side could become more expensive. Hopefully that won't happen, from the perspective of US-based St. Martin tourists.

19. About The Mission of SXM Weekly News

Who are we, and why exactly are we here?JMB Communications is a Massachusetts-based marketing company whose CEO, Jeff Berger, fell in love with SXM in 1977 when he visited there as part of a New England Life sales conference (he did Communications in their Boston headquarters). Digital officials told Jeff informally that altavista was going public, and invited him to be listed at the time of launch. "At the time they launched, and for a while afterwards, I was the only technology writer, technology marketing writer, Massachusetts freelance writer, and so on on altavista. I quickly started getting calls from friends in St. Maarten who thanked me for mentioning them on my St. Maarten website. The problem was I had no St. Maarten website — just the writing sample. That's how this began — 100% accident."

It's just his love of the island that has kept <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> going all these years.

<u>Hired gun? No.</u> "We are not, and never want to be, a PR organ for the island. That's not us. Our audience and our focus is American, Canadian, and European visitors to the island. Although we spend a fair amount of time there, we're tourists too. So we write from the perspective of tourists about what tourists should expect on the island and we deliver news and information of genuine value to tourists — warts and all. It was tourists who actually compelled us to start taking our 'St. Maarten website' seriously, which is exactly what we've done since the website began about 25 years ago.

"Our mission is as it has always been, to deliver news and information that St. Maarten / St. Martin visitors can use to have better trips. People seem to like what we do since we now have over 290,000 readers worldwide, and our SXM site has now had over five million visitors. Hopefully we'll surpass 300,000 readers perhaps by late this summer."

20. Is Your Passport About To Expire? Why You Should Renew Quickly...

Your passport should be renewed much earlier than you probably think. The following information is from the Department of State of the United States:

Application for a passport renewal should be done approximately nine months prior to the passport's expiration date. There are three reasons for renewing your passport so early.

One, the earlier you apply, the less likely you are to need expedited services. Expediting a passport can be quite expensive. You can avoid these additional costs by starting the process early.

Two, it can take up to three months to process the passport renewal application. Usually, the process is completed in 4-6 weeks but it can take longer, especially during peak travel periods or when new passport requirements are being instituted.

Three, many countries require visa applicants to submit valid passports that have at least six months validity remaining from the time of entry into the country. Applying early for the renewal would insure that your passport met this requirement.
