1. Hurricane Season Begins With a Bang: What's it Mean?

The 2017 hurricane season began June 1, although the first named storm of the season had actually formed in the mid Atlantic many weeks earlier. This past week, two new storms formed. One, tropical storm Cindy, came ashore near the Texas Louisiana border, dumping inches of rain onto soil that was already soaked, not just in the US Southeast, but also in the Midwest. Flooding was widespread.

Although forecasters have predicted a busier than usual hurricane season this year, thanks to warm ocean temperatures and favorable conditions, Massachusetts-based <u>Crown Weather</u>'s Rob Lightbown tells us he expects the next few weeks to be relatively quiet. After that, things are likely to get busier, he says.

Some people are describing the Northeast's cold, wet Spring, leading to a hot summer, as "hurricane weather." Interestingly, Rob says there's an element of truth to that. We'll tell you in detail what he said right here next week.

Our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u> (<u>ESXM</u>) will post outlooks, advisories, watches, and warnings that apply to St. Maarten as well as to coastal areas where our nearly 300,000 readers live. As always, we'll keep you posted here in *SXM Weekly News* as hurricane season unfolds.

2. Cruise Ship Stops In SXM Increasing, But Is That Good?

As we previously reported, some cruise ships cut visits to St. Maarten last winter. Despite the fact that port St. Maarten has been congratulating itself regularly for the numbers of visiting tourists, Front Street merchants have been telling us for some time that business was poor over the winter and worse during the summer this past year. The problem is that larger ships have a lot more cabins to sell; to fill them, they charge low prices. Bottom line, a lower demographic.

It gets worse. As we've also reported, in many cruise ship itineraries, St. Maarten is visited late in the game — after many passengers have already spent much of their souvenir money. On the other hand, many people are introduced to St. Maarten in that single day cruise stop — and a not-readily-discernible percentage of them later returns to the island.

There's another factor at play here for this coming winter, and that's Rainforest Adventures' chairlift on Sentry Hill (see story 16). Despite the fact that many stayover tourists and possibly a majority of Dutch Side residents have long vehemently opposed the project, it may well be pivotal to bringing more people to St. Maarten and improving the economy.

The big questions are whether the island's infrastructure is ready to handle an increased influx — a big question indeed — and how people may react if increased congestion results, since practically nothing has been done over the last couple of years to ready the infrastructure for an increasing number of tourists.

3. Tropical Weather Advisories -- What's "TWOAT"?

As we've mentioned frequently, our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u> frequently publishes outlooks, advisories, watches, and warnings from the National Hurricane Center. The tropical weather outlooks are preceded by the acronym TWOAT which may be all you see (without clicking more) when the outlooks are posted on our site.

TWOAT means Tropical Weather Outlook Atlantic.

We thought you'd want to know.

4. Global Entry: Time to Renew?

If you were an early adopter of either the Global Entry or Pre-check programs of the US Department of Homeland Security/Customs and Border Patrol, it could be that your credentials will expire as soon as early next year. If you're not traveling soon, we suggest you go to the Customs and Border Patrol website and get started on renewing your Global Entry or Pre-check membership.

To be sure, there are fewer questions to be asked when you are renewing rather than when you first applied. Nonetheless, turnaround is not at all immediate: give yourself a few months time, at least, before you travel out of the country.

Here's the website on which you renew.

5. Make 2018 Winter Reservations Now...

If you're planning to travel to SXM during high season — from this December through next April — make your reservations now, if you haven't already.

That's especially true if you fly on weekends, when seats are at a premium.

If possible, we suggest you fly midweek. Seats are cheaper then and because of current high airfares, you may save enough by switching to pay for your midweek hotel.

Extra days are often available at <u>Baker's Suites</u> in Simpson Bay; <u>Summit Resort</u> in Cupecoy (see separate story, # 9); and Simpson Bay Resort, which completed a massive \$35 million renovation less than a year ago. You can make reservations at both Baker's Suites and at Simpson Bay Resort through links on the timeshare rentals page of our site, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>.

d) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

We're quoting this from an online post (edited for space):

"It truly was awful. I will be writing a review.

"They first didn't give us the right room. My dad was upset because he likes the view we normally have. I went down and spoke with [a woman from the hotel]. I told her we would accept either end of level 4 or 5, but we did not want to go down and we preferred the side we always got. She said they were all booked. I then asked her if I knocked on all those doors people would be in there. She told me she would have to call security on me So then I point blank asked her if she was lying to me and she said no. So we took a room on the opposite end on the 3rd floor.

"The first night we had air, however my parents sheets were dirty and had food on them. My bathroom was so gross I couldn't even shower in it. The second morning, the pipes bursts, getting all of our stuff wet. At this point [someone] comes in and tells me that we are getting moved to the 5th floor on the side we like because it is available, proving [name deleted} is a straight up liar. Haven't seen her since or I would literally give her a piece of my mind....

They made no offer to reimburse them for something that is honestly priceless. Then we get to the 5th floor. Monday night we had air. Tuesday we lost air but it wasn't so bad. Wednesday was awful and they did bring us a box fan but I could barely sleep in 80 degrees. Thursday it had gotten to 90 degrees and we had enough. They said they will reimburse us, which it better be for the FULL amount.

"My mom is currently over there as we speak, so I will keep everyone posted. Thank you, Marty Dijkhuis, Dan Keepes, Pat, and Marnix Peeters for all of your help in getting us relocated. We ended up getting a place over at Simpson Bay Villas and it has been truly lovely. We are all really sad about what has happened over the years because we truly loved that place and all the friends we have met along the way. My parents stayed there on their honeymoon 40 years ago so it obviously holds a special place in all our hearts but they are truly ruining it and it makes me so sad...."

14. GEBE Strikes Again

GEBE - an acronym for the former unpronounceable Dutch name of the Dutch side's electricity and water company — did it again last week. (In case you're wondering, it's Gemeenschappelijk Electriciteidsbedrijf Bovenwindse Eilanden).

Under usual circumstances, the lights go out in one or more sections of the Dutch side and after a while, GEBE says something went wrong at the main power station causing the outage and they were working to fix it.

For whatever reason, GEBE appears to be totally incapable of figuring out what a shunt is. Consequently, when it needs to "upgrade its system" the lights and the water both go out, coming back on hours later with a bang. Power surges often occur when power returns, sometimes blowing out refrigerators and other appliances. That's why many people who live on the island use surge suppressors. It's also why, during a nighttime power failure, you may see some residents outside in pajamas taking a bucket full of water from their pool to their bathroom....

Regardless, this was a week of power outages like those we normally see in November. They were monumentally inconvenient during summer heat.

We won't get into why this might've happened. We'll only say that St. Maarten is not Tanzania and its electric generating company should be far more reliable than Tanzania's. Unfortunately, it appears that it isn't. Somehow once November is over, power seems to become more dependable for the winter. Why they can't do that year-round is a question that has never been answered.

It's going to be a long, hot Summer. Be thankful most resorts have generators. (The French Side has no similar issues.)

15. Insel Air May Be Sold

Insel Air, the carrier from Aruba and Curaçao that for quite some time has flown old MD-80 jets to various places in the Caribbean, was grounded several months ago due to serious equipment issues and financial problems.

On multiple occasions over the last few years, Insel jets were stuck in St. Maarten when something went wrong and were unable to fly for days. In one case, an Insel MD-80 sat near Airport Road for days without one of its engines — not a good thing.

Now, Avianca, the Colombian carrier, is reportedly in talks to buy Insel. We'll see where that goes and we'll keep you posted.

16. Rainforest Adventures Chairlift Opens This Summer

As we reported last week, the new chairlift climbing Sentry Hill is expected to open late this Summer as part of the Rainforest Adventures project.

As we also reported last week, there is great opposition to this from island residents, who did not want the pristine Emilio Wilson estate to be touched in any way. The chairlift is expected to be popular among cruise ship passengers but less popular, perhaps, among stayover tourists, especially those who become aware of why many locals oppose it.

We contacted the project's developers last week and submitted several questions:

a) do the seating platforms on the chairlift have seatbelts;

b) is there dependable backup electricity generation so that when power goes off, as it most certainly will, backup power can prevent the seats from swinging severely in a sudden stop, possibly propelling passengers off the seats;

and

c) when is the completed project scheduled to be inspected by government authorities, and who exactly are the inspecting government authorities.

By press time late Saturday, we had not yet received answers to these questions. We'll publish those answers when we receive them.

19. Great SXM Souvenirs That Benefit a Good Cause: Ron & Carol Zenaro

This bears repeating and sharing:

If you ever visit Toppers during happy hour each Winter, you probably run into Ron and Carol Zenaro. We'll let them tell their own story:

Carol and Ron Zenaro of Shrewsbury, MA lost their 36 year-old son Scott of cancer in 2010. Scott fought a 6 year battle against the disease, but was granted an extra 2.5 years of life with the help of Lazarex Cancer Foundation. Lazarex helps endstage cancer patients find experimental clinical trials and pay for the associated costs (and in Scott's case, living expenses in California). It's focused on patients who have been told they have no other options and it gives them one last hope of a cure.

After losing their son, Carol decided to make one-of-a-kind glass heart bead bracelets for donations of \$20 or more, forwarding ALL of the proceeds to Lazarex. Uniquely, Lazarex founders pay for all foundation operating expenses, so 100% of the Zenaro's donations go straight to helping patients. Through their efforts, the Zenaros are approaching \$81,000 worth of donations from Carol's bracelet sales. With the help of people living and visiting in SXM, the Zenaros have exceeded their original goal of \$80,000.

In the dead of winter, the Zenaros are found at Topper's Restaurant after 4pm with plenty of Carol's bracelets for sale, which make great "gifts with a purpose" since many of the beads are acquired in SXM. Or, you can contact the Zenaros at <u>zenaro.carol@gmail.com</u>.

We've done it -- they're quite beautiful and extremely special.

20. Fresh Lobster You Can Pick from a Tank

Many St. Maarten/St. Martin restaurants offer lobster. But only a relative handful have an actual pool from which you can personally select yours.Before we list those places, we want to refer you to the list of seafood restaurants on our site; a link to that list is in our Restaurant of the Week article, story #31 in this issue.

Also, some of the best seafood restaurants don't necessarily have public lobster pools although they may serve lobster. Pineapple Pete is one example; they sell more lobster thermidor than most of their competitors combined. And Big Fish is known for its many fish dishes and -- though it does not have a lobster tank at this time -- it does serve lobster dishes.

Daniel's by the Sea in Dawn beach has a very big lobster tank that's frequently refilled with fresh Saba Lobsters.

Skip Jack's in Simpson Bay has its lobster pool in the center of the restaurant — but it also has several additional pools on premises, out of sight. Skip Jack's is one of the biggest seafood restaurants on the island and it may well sell more lobster than anyone else.

Oceans 82 in Grand Case also has a large lobster pool.

If you don't like Lobsters or Seafood, see our restaurant of the week listings (story #31); we show dozens of different restaurants featured over the last year or so.

21. Delicious Upscale, Authentic Mexican Dining

Most of the Mexican restaurants in populous US cities and on St. Maarten serve Tex-Mex food — not authentic Mexican.

Finally, Royal Resorts, owner of Simpson Bay Resort and a number of resorts in Mexico and elsewhere in the Caribbean, has opened a truly authentic Mexican restaurant, La Patrona, on the Marina Plaza at Simpson Bay Resort.

My wife has been a great fan of Mexican food all her life, but it wasn't my thing until I tried La Patrona. From experience with both TexMex and authentic Mexican dining, I can tell you unequivocally that the real stuff is far tastier -- truly delicious.

The restaurant was designed by Mexicans, from the floor to the ceiling and of course everything on the menu. The general manager is a woman from Mexico ("La Patrona"), Julieta Sanchez, a very pleasant, knowledgeable individual.

No problem if you don't like spicy or if you like super spicy — they are highly responsive to your dietary and spice needs. We particularly recommend the shrimp salad as an appetizer and the Chicken Tampico as a main course.

Definitely buy a bottle of wine with dinner: it's inexpensive and good. The food is flat out terrific: definitely make sure they are on your list during your next trip.

Not another multi-level home party idea

Although working at your own leisure and the venues for providing the experience may be identical to a home-party, thats where the similarities stop.

Were developing kiosk and pop-up retail concepts as to not limit licensees from only hosting in-home events. Weve also structured the license so that you will earn guaranteed revenue per perfume-making attendee plus added revenue should there be additional product sales.
