4. TSA Precheck Continues Its National Expansion

TSA Precheck enables you to be cleared well in advance of any travel so you get through security that much faster. It's international equivalent is Global Entry, which enables you to use Precheck in the US and walk right past the waiting lines when you return to the USA from overseas. It's worth every penny and it's expanding to more US airports. If you go to SXM, get Global Entry; see http://www.cbp.gov/travel/trusted-traveler-programs/global-entry

Start now for travel in Fall and Winter. It takes a while and you'll need an in-person appointment.

5. One Not So Great Review of Sapphire

We've reported several times in recent months that the majority of reports we're hearing from Sapphire Resort have been very positive, in all respects. We never said the resort is perfect -- it isn't -- but it has been improving.

Not everyone is happy with the current state of affairs there. We bring you the following story from Ralph S. It happened on a big Carnival holiday, when many Sapphire employees apparently took off to celebrate (condensed):

"We are very disgusted with Sapphire Resort. Last year they told us they were going to redo everything. Well, guess what: No changes have been made in our unit. To name just a few things that I confronted: our shower does not work; our toilet runs constantly and overflowed today (Wed.) flooding the entire first floor, in spite of my calling the front desk 3 times, with someone coming three hours later, with the excuse that today is a holiday (carnival parade); two light bulbs in the hallway were burned out; the coffee pot doesn't work; the dishwasher is so rusted out that we can't use it; we have no wine glasses in our kitchenware, and they never came back to take care of all the overflow of water on the downstairs floor.

I put towels on the floor so that we wouldn't fall on the slippery tile floor. This has been the most stressful vacation we have had and will probably not return. I just wanted to let you know about what a terrible place this is getting to be and I am hoping you will write this up in you newsletter."

13. Club Orient, Many Others No Longer Accepting Travelers Checks

As we reported a few months ago, some of the top SXM merchant banks processing credit cards have started refusing Travelers Checks. Consequently, many restaurants and other businesses across the island also are not accepting travelers checks.

Many people are using Scotia Bank ATMs, probably because Scotia Bank has an agreement with Bank of America under which you can use your BofA Debit Card to withdraw cash at any Scotia Bank ATMs without paying any fees.

14. Summer Vacation With The Kids: Where to Go, What to Do

It can be hot during the Summer and sometimes showery, particularly later during Summer.

Lots of choices for stuff to do with kids.

First: the Butterfly Farm, best early in the day when it opens. Endlessly fascinating. Wear bright clothing and they might just land on you and relax a bit. Fourth: See story 23 about Star Wars' Yoda, who's alive and well in SXM.

Fifth: Lunch at Trattoria Pizza Pasta is a great idea -- delicious Italian food in a relaxed atmosphere. Great pizza, too.

and Sixth: At night take them for an early dinner to IZI -- they'll be mighty impressed if it's their birthday....

15. Summer Vacation Without The Kids

Actually, some of the things we suggested to do with kids are just as much fun without them - like all of the things in the prior article, story 14.

Of course, there are other romantic things to do here. Like exploring Pic Paradis on the French Side ... you might enjoy a zipline trip at Loterie Farm. Or you can try naturism at any of the beaches in the next article. Guys concerned about their first experience should read about Jeffs in article 17....

16. Three Good Choices For Trying "Nood" Recreation in SXM

First, we use the term "nood" since you know what it means and we don't want spam filters to think we are anything other than a St. Maarten / St. Martin newsletter, in which case they might try to snag us.

Here are our three top choices, all of which you'll find on island maps::

Cupecoy Beach, Dutch Side not far from the airport, vies for the "most beautiful beach in SXM" title with Happy Bay, but it's most gorgeous later in the afternoon, when the golden sun interacts with its sandstone cliffs to display some truly amazing colors. Cupecoy is across from Blue Mall. You can park next to Ocean Club or near Shore Pointe and walk to the beaches. There are two...one in front of Shore Pointe, and the other a bit farther east. John and Dany rent chairs and offer food and drink. At "baby" beach, there is sand in the rocks on the western side which can be mixed with

water -- create your own mud bath. Beach size varies with weather.

Happy Bay Beach, north of Marigot on the French Side, is that quintessential palm-fringed tropical beach, where another Danny and John offer help. It's usually very guiet -- a couple of dozen people is a really busy day.

Club Orient at Orient Beach, a few hundred yards long at the beach's southern end, is the island's official "nood" beach. Club Orient is the largest of the island's two naturist resorts and is the only one on the beach. Club O is almost always busy. When a "nood" cruise hits town, thousands of people will be here; otherwise it's hundreds. Club O has the Papagyo Restaurant where you can be served "nood" -- and the always busy Perch Bar. During the winter we saw numbers of first-time couples trying naturism here. Heads up: don't forget sunscreen.

17. Our First Time at a "Nood" Beach in SXM

We were on vacation in St. Maarten and we had taken a one-day catamaran excursion to nearby St. Barths with a couple we had met on our flight from Boston. It was the late 1970s, when the now well-developed St. Jean beach in St. Barths (long referred to in Jimmy Buffett's Autour du Rocher; see http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-xNk38LOVQI&feature=kp) was still undeveloped, natural, and relaxing. (Now, restaurants there charge \$10+ for bottled water.)

None of us had any experience with social "noodite". On this trip – our first St. Maarten vacation -- for the first time we had noticed toplessness on some beaches but no "noodite".

We were two entirely normal, married heterosexual couples. St. Jean beach had a sign which read, "Nudisme Interdit" – French for keep your clothes on. While three of us sunbathed, the other quy strolled the beach. He quietly said to me afterwards, "I'd always regret it if I didn't tell you that there are two girls about 24 years old sunbathing "nood" about 30 yards down the beach right after from bushes." I didn't know that; we were separated by lots of bushes.

I shortly walked down the beach and thought to myself, "Why don't we do that?" It looked comfortable and fun.

We never broached the thought to the other couple; it seemed pretty clear that they were more conservative than we were. But my wife agreed that the next morning for the first time we'd try Orient Beach in St. Maarten, shown as "le beach naturiste" on a then-current St Martin road map.

[Point of information: St. Maarten / St. Martin is half Dutch and half French – two countries and two cultures on one island, hence the different spelling. Orient Beach is on French "St. Martin."]

A Changed Place

Most couples I've talked to since our "first time" experience either grew up in families that practiced nudism, or were just curious, like we were.

Orient at that time was far different than today. Visit Orient now, and you find the expansive Club Orient naturist resort at the southern end, perhaps the most flat-out enjoyable naturist resort in the Caribbean. Although "noodite" is normal throughout Club Orient (including at the popular Papagayo restaurant), it's no longer practiced on the rest of the beach, thanks to "Nudity Prohibited" signs now posted by the French government. Pity, certainly, since hundreds of naturists once walked the entire beach with no hassle at all.

In 1979, there was nothing but a small drink cart on the beach - no buildings at all -- and most of the people who visited "Pedro's" walked there via a well-worn path from the Le Galion Beach Hotel, a clothed resort on nearby Embouchure Beach (also known as Coconut Grove or Le Galion Beach) on the island's Northeast shore. Le Galion was later destroyed by a hurricane, but its concrete shell stands and little concessions are today housed inside.

Method to his Madness

We strolled onto the beach, bought a couple of drinks, and spread out our blanket. The beach was (and is) huge, a mile or so long. That morning, it had perhaps 50 people on it, most of them at the Southern end near Le Galion, and the crowd grew only slightly as the day wore on. (Today crowds on the entire beach during an average day can total a few thousand).

My wife went topless, laid on her stomach and buried her face in a book.

Like most guys, I was a bit uneasy - concerned that, at some point, my happiness at being there might become physically apparent. After all, I was only human. So I decided it would be "mind over matter."

22. Day Trips to Saba

We do not recommend the boat trip on the "Edge" to Saba. The trip over is easy; the trip back, against a current which can be quite rough, may well require extensive use of barf bags. Unless you are an experienced sailor this is not for you. (The Edge is fine -- we just don't recommend this trip to anyone who has ever had a seasickness issue.)

Saba is different from any nearby island. Fly over from Princes Juliana and take your camera. Saba airport is quite remarkable and so is the island. This is a great place for divers. JMB members: see discounts for Scout's Place in Saba on our Secret Website.
