SECTION 1: Getting There: Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. Jet Blue to Increase Total Ft. Lauderdale Flights to 100 Daily: Why It Matters for SXM

We remain convinced that JetBlue will, at some point, inaugurate nonstop flights from Fort Lauderdale to St. Maarten.

So what?

The airline announced this week that it expects to have upwards of 100 flights a day at its South Florida focus city, Fort Lauderdale. Lauderdale will become to Jet Blue what other airlines call a hub, with flights from many major cities across the country. That will enable connections to major destinations in the Caribbean. Lesser destinations will be served through the airline's Caribbean hub in San Juan.

We'll keep you posted as JetBlue expands service from Fort Lauderdale into the Caribbean.

2. Rainy Season Is Usually Not "Rainy"

The events of a couple of weeks ago, during which about 6 inches of rain fell over a few days, were unusual for this time of year in that the rainy season is just beginning and that no tropical storms or hurricanes were involved.

The difference between dry winter weather and less dry summer weather is usually rather simple. In addition to the summer being a bit hotter, there are occasional tropical waves, tropical storms, or hurricanes in the area that can cause occasional rainy days.

In addition, tropical showers during the rainy season tend to be a bit more frequent and longer in duration.

The bottom line is that the rainy season is *not* continuously rainy. There's a lot of sun — and extended rainy periods are unusual.

3. Hurricane Season Begins June 1; 2014 Hurricane Names

The 2014 Atlantic hurricane season begins on Sunday, June 1. Because of an expected El Niño, forecasters say this season will have fewer storms than usual but some caution that land falls on the US Gulf coast and along the US southeast coast may be more likely this year. Of course, it only takes one storm to cause a lot of damage.

8a. The Caveat in Selecting Inexpensive Short-Term Medical Evacuation Protection

Short-term medical evacuation protection from SkyMed gives you an inexpensive way to get a medical evacuation jet home from within "the SkyMed universe" should you become critically ill or injured while traveling. (See the previous article for description of the SkyMed universe.)

If you travel every year and purchase short-term protection for each trip, at some point you will cross what insurance agents describe as the line of uninsurability -- a point after which you can't buy insurance. SkyMed, of course, is not insurance -- it's a membership plan that provides medical evacuation to its members when they become critically ill or injured while traveling. Nonetheless, SkyMed protection does require medical prequalification. If you choose to get short-term memberships for a few days every year, you must medically requalify with each different purchase, and eventually you will cross the "line of uninsurability" and you will not medically gualify for SkyMed membership. That's the pitfall of short-term memberships -- you may not qualify to buy one when you may need it the most. That's why we urge you to check out the extremely low monthly pricing now available for SkyMed ultimate memberships.

9. Curtis Heyliger, Vice Prime Minister Theo Heyliger's Oldest Child, Killed in Car Accident

For nearly 20 years, we've written about the political career of vice Prime Minister Theo Heyliger, a young man who has spent most of his life in politics.

Early Wednesday morning, May 28, Curtis Heyliger, Theo's oldest son who was only about 20 years old, lost control of his vehicle near the Dollar store on L B Scott Road north of Le Grande Marche near Philipsburg. His vehicle hit both a wall and a home before flipping over. Young Mr. Heyliger passed away before rescue workers could cut him out of the wreckage.

10. Reminder: Don't Bring Travelers Checks

Invented in the 1800s, travelers checks have had a long and colorful history. But in an age of ATMs and electronic payments through smart phones, the days of travelers checks appear to be numbered.

Multiple banks in the Caribbean have discontinued accepting travelers checks from their merchant partners, forcing those merchants to stop accepting travelers checks themselves. When this first happened last winter, we reported it, and we have repeated it several times since. The number of banks involved is increasing and now even some casinos are no longer accepting travelers checks.

Our advice: leave the travelers checks at home, or bring only a few with the realization that you may not be able to use them. Bring your ATM cards.

There have been skimmer scams on some ATMs in St. Maarten. To our knowledge, however, these have not included Bank of Nova Scotia (Scotia Bank) ATMs, and it is Scotia Bank that has wide-ranging reciprocal agreements with other banks for acceptance of their ATM cards without bank fees. Before coming to St. Maarten, check with your bank to see if it is involved in this reciprocity -- and get the details. Bank of America participates with Scotia Bank in this reciprocal program.

11. Author Tim Stelma's SXM Trilogy Concludes with "Sandy Ground" Novel

llene may be the most avid reader you might ever hope to meet. She devours 300-page books in a day. When we asked her some time ago to be our official reader of author Tim Stelma's trilogy of St. Maarten-related books, she quickly agreed.

13. Capture the Light Show from the Simpson Bay Causeway

If you have had the good fortune to visit St. Maarten since December 23, 2013, then you've probably driven on the Simpson Bay Lagoon Causeway. Not only does it save a great deal of time in traveling around the island and reducing traffic tie-ups in Simpson Bay, but at night it also is a show unto itself.

Although you can't see them while driving across the Causeway, from almost anywhere in Simpson Bay you can see the kaleidoscopic color changes of the LED lighting system along the outside of the bridge, covering its entire length. Bring your video camera and prepare to use it, it has become a major tourist attraction.

14. Beaches with Shade

How do you define shade?

If it's palm trees, get yourself to Mullet Bay Beach or Happy Bay, because you'll find palm trees at both. If it's beach umbrellas you're after, try Club Orient -- where you can get shade as well as an all-over tan. If you'd like to choose from palm trees or umbrellas — or get both at the same time -- go to Mr. Busby's Beach Bar on Dawn beach, where you'll find both plus great food.

No matter where you go, the tropical sun is very powerful.
