1. United Airlines Adopts New Frequent Flyer Rules Based Less on Miles & More on What You Spend

Following the lead of its rival Delta Air Lines, United Airlines last week adopted new frequent-flier rules which reward high-paying business customers at the expense of leisure travelers. United's frequent-flier awards will be based on what fliers spend rather than how far they fly.

2. Jet Blue Extends Its Schedule To February 11

The big legacy airlines change their flight offerings daily, always offering seats about 350 days ahead.

JetBlue, on the other hand, updates its schedule every several weeks on an irregular basis, generally offering seats about eight months ahead. It just expanded its schedule to include flights as late as February 11, 2015.

JetBlue also does something else that's unusual but that is of great importance to SXM passengers. In most cases, both outgoing and incoming flights to the same destination are sold on a one-way basis at equal pricing, which means a \$200 one-way fare to St. Maarten from city X is the same price as a flight back taking the same route on the same day of the week.

What this means to JetBlue passengers is that if you plan to depart for SXM before February 11 but return after, you can buy the outgoing one-way trip now and the return when the schedule opens up later dates.

If we had to guess when the schedule is going to be extended beyond 2/11 — it would be that the announcement would come in early August and include flights to late March or early April. But it could well happen sooner.

3. Orlando Now Gets Convenient Connections to SXM Via Jet Blue

JetBlue continues to expand its service to Florida, particularly in both Orlando and Fort Lauderdale.

The airline is adding service to St. Maarten by way of San Juan through convenient connections with Seaborne Airlines in San Juan. Seaborne gates — all of them, we believe — are adjacent to the JetBlue section of the San Juan airport, making possible quick connections and early arrivals.

4. About The Quick Connection To SXM from BOS via SJU

During each of the last two years, we have chosen to fly JetBlue to St. Maarten from Boston via San Juan.

One thing that concerned us was the speed of the connection and whether JetBlue could, in fact, do it. The connection was only a bit more than half an hour.

Both times we have made this connection without a problem — and so has our luggage.

On our most recent St. Maarten visit, we got off the plane, visited the rest room briefly and while we were still in the rest room, boarding was announced at an adjacent gate for the flight to St. Maarten. Yes it is quick, but our experience is that these outgoing connections (outgoing from the USA) are being very efficiently handled. Don't hesitate to book it.

5. CBP's Global Entry Highly Recommended for Your Return to the USA

Returning to the United States from any international destination can be a royal pain without the assistance of Global Entry, the U.S. Customs and Border Patrol program which includes a thorough background check on passengers and gives them credentials that enable them to get priority service. Global entry also includes the Pre-Check domestic security service which expedites security processing at selected airports across the country.

Although the program costs \$100 per person and gives you credentials that last for five years, the cost is well worth it in terms of time saved and convenience. Beyond that, the program is being rolled out to more and more airports, benefiting travelers both domestically and internationally.

St. Maarten is talking about instituting preclearance for US bound passengers. Even there, we expect that Global Entry will significantly expedite your return processing to the US.

6. Summer Weather In SXM

Although the calendar may not yet reflect it, summer has come to St. Maarten and with it, hotter temperatures and longer-lasting showers.

The 2014 hurricane season only began a couple of weeks ago and has begun quietly, as is usually the case this time of year. Some possible activity in the Bay of Campeche fizzled. The season for St. Maarten tends to get going in August and its peak is in early September, though both later

September and October can be busy from a storm perspective.

As we've mentioned before, forecasters say this year will be quieter than many, but it only takes one storm to mess things up. And unfortunately, even relatively quiet years in the past have had their share of big storms.

7. What's New at Caravanserai?

The Caravanseral situation is complicated. Caravanseral is the sprawling resort on the ocean just south of Princess Juliana Airport, Dutch Side.

Allegedly, resort owner Manek owes Scotia bank about \$15 million and he doesn't have the money. We know he was asking some rich friends to help bail him out, to no avail.

Apparently in response to this, Scotia bank has tried a couple of times to auction the property off but there were no takers. Nobody wanted to pay that much money for what is an essentially unfinished resort requiring millions for completion located in a place that historically has been a bull's-eye for hurricane attacks.

We've heard a few unconfirmed reports this week that Manek has fired the resort's management team. We were surprised to hear that he was even still involved with the management of the resort, since Scotia bank owns it and Manek is the debtor.

There have been negotiations with some suitors, but so far nobody has bought anything. Caravanserai shut down Bliss because of alleged nonpayment of rentals, but that is unrelated to the potential sale of the resort. (See separate story).

We'll continue to keep you posted.

8. Reminder: Radisson Blu Is No More; Now It Is a "Riu Plaza"

As we've mentioned before, the Radisson Blu hotel in Anse Marcel on the French side was bought by Riu hotels and is now a Riu Plaza Hotel, unaffiliated with Radisson.

If you had reservations at the Radisson some time over the next few months, we suggest you contact the Riu Plaza directly to be sure your reservations will be honored and to check on the status of any deposit you may have made. Again, Riu and Radisson have no connection.

9. Scotia Bank, Simpson Bay, Robbed; Nobody Hurt; Thieves Still Sought

Last Wednesday, a small number of armed thieves walked into the Scotia bank in Simpson Bay during the day, shot their guns toward the ceiling and made off with an as yet unclear amount of cash.

Their getaway vehicle was found not far away in Cay Bay. Police blocked off a church in the area but nothing was found.

The police have asked for help from the public in conducting a very active investigation.

We talked about the police chief last the week in highly complementary terms. He had been with the Rotterdam police in Holland before becoming police chief in Aruba for several years prior to moving to St. Maarten a few years ago. Under his leadership, and thanks to community policing activities, crime has gone down in the last few years on the Dutch Side and the department is run with a great deal of professionalism.

We'll let you know when these hoodlums are caught.

10. Cupecoy Beach Access Changes Again

You'll read some details about this in the next story, but the bottom line is you can no longer park along the street to get to Cupecoy beach on the Dutch side near the French border.

Enter the lot through the curb cut just west of Ocean Club and park in that lot. From the lot, walk the relatively short distance to baby beach or to the main beach in front of the Shore Pointe condominiums.

11. Porto Cupecoy May Be Behind Boulders Placed at Cupecoy Beach to Block Parking

It has been alleged by persons close to the situation that Porto Cupecoy may be behind the placement of boulders along the road near the Shore Pointe condominiums, blocking access to tourists and locals alike wishing to go to Cupecoy beach, one of the most beautiful beaches on the island and a key reason many tourists visit year-round.

Attempts to contact Porto Cupecoy so far have proved fruitless. Nonetheless, we're doing some things behind the scenes to try to get these boulders PRO version Are you a developer? Try out the HTML to PDF API

If you like Cupecoy beach and want to be able to visit it during your next trip to St. Maarten, it's very important that you speak up about this situation. The boulders are impossible for individuals to move. They require beachgoers to park a significant distance away, making beach access very difficult or impossible for some of the older people who are absolutely crucial visitors and contributors to the island economy.

12. One More Reason to Love Cupecoy...

Besides its sheer beauty, its long-standing status as a clothing optional beach, and be attentive service of Dany and John, the is yet another reason to head for Cupecoy beach. That's the fact that its natural sandstone cliffs, in some places, contain the kind of sand that is perfect for a mud bath.

Go down the stairs to Baby Beach, and to your right you'll find a sandstone cliff facing the walk way. In the crevices of the hill, look for dried mud, or sand. Put a small amount of it in a cup, wet it slightly, and you're in business with sand for a mud bath. It's great stuff.

Leave it on for good 15 or 20 min. for maximum effectiveness.

13. Bliss Nightclub Assets Auctioned Off, Closed

Arguably one of the island's most popular, successful nightclubs is no more.

Located at Caravanserai, the Bliss nightclub allegedly failed to pay both its electric bill and also allegedly owed \$55,000 in back rentals to Caravanserai, which led the resort recently to close the place down. This past week, all of Bliss's assets were sold off at auction.

Given the current situation at Caravanserai, the future use of the nightclub property is uncertain. There is lots of empty space available on the Dutch Side for new restaurants and nightclubs.

14. Cautions To Remember When Driving on French St. Martin

Driving laws on French St. Maarten are tough and are rigidly enforced by the Gendarmerie. There are severe penalties for the use of cell phones by drivers; for failure to use seat belts; and for drinking/driving.

Gendarmes regularly are at the side of various roads on the island in marked or unmarked vehicles watching passing cars, and they will have no

hesitation to stop you for any violation. They also have been seen at various places where people are known to drink, such as exit roads from Orient beach and near restaurants both in Grand Case and Marigot.

The laws on the Dutch side are not as tough, as we understand it, but we expect enforcement there to pick up as the police force on the Dutch side gets closer to its designed size.

15. Why Not To Run Out of Prescription Drugs in SXM

If you intend to spend a significant amount of time in St. Maarten, it is very wise to bring all of the prescription drugs you expect to need during your entire stay with you, instead of relying on filling prescriptions on the island.

There are no major US drug chains on the island — no CVS, no Walgreen, just small local pharmacies.

Beyond that, pharmacies on this island are either French or Dutch, which means they carry drugs made in France or Holland which often contain directions that aren't in English.

If you have to see a doctor when you're on the island, you will likely receive a prescription for one of those drugs. Always contact your doctor at home to be sure there are no unexpected drug interactions. It's never wise to take chances on this.

16. Wise To Watch Your Credit Card Statements

We've mentioned before that there have been incidences of credit card skimming at ATMs on the island. There have also been incidences of unexpected charges. They are not frequent or widespread, but they have happened.

Therefore it is wise to patronize establishments with which you are quite familiar and in which you have confidence. When you do charge, it's always sensible to check your credit card statements and verify their accuracy.

17. Road Work in Marigot Set To Snarl Traffic Again There This Summer

As was the case last summer, there is road work again this summer in Marigot which may result in significant traffic delays there. There is also summer roadwork on both Front and Back street in Philipsburg, though that work is not expected to last more than a couple of days.

18. Chikungunya Comes to the USA

The Chikungunya virus has made it into the United States, as you probably heard last week in news broadcasts.

In the Caribbean, Chikungunya is transmitted by the aedes aegypti mosquito, which is called a vector for transmission.

That type of mosquito, which is black with white spots, may appear in some states in the deep South, but as far as we know it is <u>not</u> present across much of the United States.

It is not known whether any other type of mosquito in the United States could become a vector for Chikungunya.

Although it is interesting to see that Chikungunya has entered the US, the situation should not be regarded as threatening. There is no person-toperson transmission of the disease; it is spread only by the vector mosquito.

In the US, some mosquitoes can transmit Eastern equine encephalitis and the West Nile virus. They're serious enough without having to worry about Chikungunya. Relax, take sensible precautions, and enjoy your summer, regardless of where you are.

19. Using Your Kindle or Nook or...

If you bring your E-reader to St. Maarten, you will be with a lot of company.

Last winter, we saw more people using Kindles or Nooks or related devices across the island than are actually reading paperback books.

Free Wi-Fi is widely available in many hotels and nightspots making the use of these devices convenient and easy.

20. Hotel Lending Library Locations on SXM (There are Lots)

If you bring paperback reading material with you to St. Maarten, you'll find there are many places on the island where you can trade your books for others.

If such lending libraries are not obvious, ask at the front desk. Some lending libraries are hidden from view, but front desk or other personnel will be happy to show you where they are.

The most unusual lending library on the island is probably at Summit Resort in Cupecoy. That resort is next door to the medical school of American University of the Caribbean and consequently, medical students staying at the resort may sometimes leave used medical books among paperbacks in the lending library in the resort's front office.

21. Hawksbill Sea Turtle Nest Protected on Simpson Bay Beach

This is the time of year when mammoth sea turtles, some of them weighing hundreds of pounds, come ashore on various island beaches to lay their eggs. Their nesting sites are protected by law since the turtles are endangered. If you see any turtles, contact the front desk of your resort and let them know so the area can be marked off and protected.
