1. When Returning to the US From Overseas, Be Sure All Electronic Devices are Fully Charged...

Or They Could Be Seized

The TSA is asking a number of overseas governments to enhance their surveillance of passengers with electronic devices on flights to the United States. The reason: the TSA is concerned that terrorists could potentially package bombs disguised within ordinary looking cell phones, iPads, e-readers, or laptop computers.

If you're traveling anywhere outside the United States with such devices, be sure they're fully charged before you get to airport security. In many airports, possibly including SXM, you will be asked to turn on the devices and if you cannot do that, the devices may be seized.

2. Southwest Airlines Starts Serving Three Caribbean Islands; SXM Service Due

We recently reported that we expect Southwest Airlines to start serving the Caribbean in general -- including SXM. Southwest executives are among our readers and they told us that SXM is not in the airline's immediate plans, but it's definitely in their gunsights.

Southwest acquired Air Tran not long ago and is now adding / rebranding flights to Aruba and a couple of other Caribbean destinations as Southwest flights.

We have zero doubt that SXM service will be coming from Southwest, and our hunch is it will be 12-18 months from now, possibly sooner.

We previously said we believed flights to SXM would come from BWI. Interestingly, flights to SW's initial Caribbean destinations will actually be from BWI plus Atlanta and Orlando.

3. After Arthur, Little Near-Term Hurricane Activity is Imminent in the Tropical Atlantic

As Arthur swirled northeast away from Cape Cod Friday night, meteorologist Rob Lightbown of <u>www.crownweather.com</u> said it was the only game in town, and that no other storms appeared in the offing near-term.

However if you look at the satellite image of weather crossing Africa east to west at <u>http://everythingsxm.com/sxm/weather/index.shtml</u> you'll see a number of intense storms. Were this August, that would portend Cape Verde storms which could affect SXM. But there is much dry air in the Atlantic and there has been much Saharan dust there, both of which impede tropical storm formation.

What will happen? Stay tuned. This Atlantic hurricane season has already been more interesting than expected.

Prices are low for two reasons: a) lower demand (no northern cold to escape from) and b) hurricanes. 6. The American Clinic's CEO Vows Help for New St. Maarten Medical Center

As we reported last week, Dutch St. Maarten vice Prime Minister Theo Heyliger has announced plans for a new St. Maarten Medical Center intended to replace the current facility in the Bel Air area.

As we've also reported in the past, a select international team has been working for some time to make the vision of an American Clinic medical tourism facility a reality for St. Maarten.

Dr. Sam Hess, Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of The American Clinic (TAC), has vowed significant support for the new St. Maarten Medical Center project. He said that the project would be very beneficial to the health care needs of the local population.

Dr. Hess added that the American Clinic has been and will continue to work closely with the St. Maarten Medical Center (SMMC) with regard to providing specialist care that is not currently available on the island. All referrals to the American Clinic will be made through primary care physician referrals or from the SMMC directly.

"Also we will endeavor to work with the SMMC and its staff to provide educational programs and screenings in the community. We are dedicated and committed to partnering as closely as possible with SMMC and the government of St. Maarten to augment the current system and make St. Maarten a pillar of medical excellence in the Caribbean. All of our work will potentially translate into millions of dollars in cost savings per year and prevent needless deaths and progression of disease.

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"We are committed to working closely with SMMC to improve the quality of medical care available to the people of St. Maarten. We are not interested in competing with SMMC.

"Our project is unique when compared to other medical tourism wellness facilities throughout the world. Rarely does a medical tourism project help the resident population. We on the other hand have committed to assisting SMMC and the Social Health & Insurance Organization (SZV) in providing the best medical care and preventing delays in diagnosis and treatment which is what the people of St. Maarten want," Dr. Hess said.

"Families would be able to be present for their loved ones' procedures and provide post-operative love and support right here at home. This would prevent the necessity for people to have to travel to other Caribbean islands or South and Central America where they may not speak the language and where many complications have occurred.

"Importantly, post-operative and post procedure care would be provided on the island by the physicians who performed the procedures rather than being hundreds or thousands of miles away. Because we are a center for medical tourism, we can use our resources and funds received from the tourism component of our project to provide care for Dutch St. Maarten residents at reasonable predetermined tariffs.

"TAC envisions having the specialist and equipment in place to cater to the needs of the St. Maarten people while working side by side with SMMC which would continue to be the national hospital of the country that meets the basic health needs of the population.

"TAC's role comes into play in areas that SMMC is not able to focus on. This is where the synergy between both health care institutions would be a win-win for the community of St. Maarten," TAC CEO Dr. Sam Hess concluded.

Upon completion of its funding efforts, the American Clinic would be located near Kim Sha Beach in Simpson Bay, close to both Princess Juliana International Airport and the island's super megayacht facilities.

It was a tremendous afternoon. Far from traditional airport fare, their burgers were exceptionally good -- high-quality, very tasty, highly creative, and meticulously crafted.

The tastes are delightful, and very fresh. The beef was painstakingly researched and sourced to ensure absolute top-quality, taste, and consistency.

Early reviews from visitors to Johney Burgers rave about the taste and the quality. The only complaint is that Johney Burgers' location in the departure lounge at Princess Juliana airport makes it impossible to visit there until you're leaving the island. In fact, the catchphrase "so good you almost want

to leave early" is taking hold among those who have been to Johney Burger and wish it were more readily available.

Next time you go to St. Maarten, leave room for lunch at Johney Burger. You can pick up your Burger there and take it next door to the Flights bar; both the bar and that restaurant welcome you to do that. And Flights has outstanding drinks.

8. Blue Water Bar & Grill Coming to Indigo Bay

Blue Water Global Group, Inc. will build its flagship Blue Water Bar & Grill™ in the pristine Eco-Friendly Indigo Bay development. It's the second restaurant approved for beachfront construction; the first, Kokomo, opened in December 2013.

Key aspects:

Blue Water's building site (Lot #L04) measures approximately 1,552 square meters (16,706 square feet) and is located on a picturesque white sand beach. This Blue Water Bar & Grill™ location will feature a large, open-aired tik i roof, swimming pool with swim up bar stools, two fire pits, and beach and pool lounge chairs with full drink and food service. The restaurant's footprint measures approximately 415 square meters (4,467 square feet) and seats up to 203 people: 98 under the main tik i roof, 64 under tropical cover, 26 at the bar, and 15 at the swim up bar.

Indigo Bay is an Eco-Friendly commercial and residential development encompassing approximately 150 acres of lush tropical and beachfront land. Indigo Bay is St. Maarten's newest and closest attraction to the Port of St. Maarten.

No estimated completion date was announced, but we wouldn't be surprised to see this project open late this year or early in 2015.

9. Marechaussee To Stay in SXM Until 2019

Marechaussees, who are essentially Dutch Military Police (similar to French Gendarmes), have extended their contact with the Dutch Side, enabling them to continue to augment Dutch Side police services through the end of 2019.

10. No Avoiding It: Boston Now Has Chikungunya, Too

As you've no doubt heard, since Spring the Chikungunya virus has spread into many states in the USA, with the latest confirmed cases in Boston.

In every case where Chikungunya has been reported in the United States, those contracting it had recently visited the Caribbean. Local officials across the USA noted that there was no contagious concern related to Chikungunya because it does not spread human to human. Moreover, the particular strain of mosquitoes known to carry the virus that causes Chikungunya is present in the tropics and not present across almost all of the

United States. That said, some doctors are expressing concern that it could be spread by other mosquitoes here in the US.

You will no doubt hear more about Chikungunya in the United States but it should not be a cause of alarm. Other serious illnesses can be spread by mosquitoes in the US, including West Nile virus and Eastern equine encephalitis. As always, regardless of where you travel, take precautions against mosquito bites.
