SECTION 1: Getting There: Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. Latest News on Tropical Storm Bertha

Thankfully, tropical storm Bertha is not going to give St. Maarten her worst. The storm was crossing the central Leeward Islands on Friday, and was forecast to head for the US Virgin Islands, the Dominican Republic, and Puerto Rico. Its effects in St. Maarten on Friday night and Saturday were forecast to be heaw rain, high winds possibly to tropical storm strength, and some thunderstorms.

This time of year, the island is always prepared for hurricanes. This storm was expected to cause some street flooding and possibly other minor damage, but nothing compared to what effects could be expected were this a potent hurricane.

All in all, as of Friday afternoon when this article was written, the news seemed to be good. Once again, meteorologist Rob Lightbown's forecast was right on the money. For more, see www.crownweather.com.

3. Phoenix Air, New Interisland Carrier, Promotes Its Services

Phoenix air is not from Phoenix, Arizona. It's from St. Kitts. Why they call themselves Phoenix air is beyond us, especially since the mythical Phoenix rose from the ashes — not a good analogy for an airline these days.

The carrier serves a number of Caribbean islands and will be expanding to St. Maarten later this year. It has mostly small aircraft plus one 737 which apparently it plans to use on flights to either New York or Miami or both, although it has applied for routes to neither city.

One word of caution before you rush out to buy tickets: the airline is not the least bit cheap, and in prose written about it we have never seen the words low-cost or discount.

4. Panama's Copa Airlines To Have Five Weekly Flights to SXM, Up from Two

As a tourist destination, Panama has been growing quickly. In recent years, its airline, Copa Airlines, has added a number of US destination cities. Panama City also acts as a hub through which Copa flights from South America can connect with its flights to St. Maarten, which means the airline feeds the island during the summer, which is winter in South America. St. Maarten needs that because right now, most of its business comes during the (real) winter from North America.

Now the airline says starting this fall, it will be increasing its service from Panama City to St. Maarten from 2 to 5 flights per week. If you've thought of visiting Panama, you may now be able to fly there from St. Maarten as your St. Maarten vacation ends, and see what you think of it. We've talked to a few folks who have gone and virtually all of them said there is no comparison with St. Maarten. Copa flies to a number of US cities from Panama City.

SECTION 2: Accommodations: Hotels, Inns, Timeshares

5. Club Med Furthering its SXM Location Due Diligence

Club Med last week -- considering locating a new resort in St. Maarten or St. Martin (or in St. Barths or Anguilla) -- spent a lot of time in SXM checking out in detail several possible locations.

The fact that a big Club Med will locate either on or near SXM is a huge deal for the island since its only major airport, Princess Juliana, will be the principal point of arrival for the hotel's guests who will be arriving principally from North America and Europe.

The hotel is expected to have about 400 rooms, take up about 500 feet of frontage on the ocean, and will be opening in 2018 or after. We've contacted the president of Club Med and hope to have timely updates as this process unfolds.

In a press interview, the CEO said St. Maarten does offer huge advantages over neighboring islands because of both its infrastructure and its airport, a major regional hub.

As always, we'll keep you posted.

7. Having Sold Radisson Blu SXM, Radisson Now Has Aruba Property Up for Sale

We saw something Friday morning which not only got our attention, but also made us wonder what exactly is happening with the Radisson chain of hotels. As you recall, the former Radisson Blu St. Martin resort, which for years was a Habitation property, was sold by Radisson this year to Riu Plaza hotels. That ownership change became effective a couple of months ago. The resort never did make any money, owing largely to the global economy collapse and the disparity between the US dollar and the Euro -- and the fact that Radisson spent close to \$100-million upgrading the place.

But we were surprised to learn that Radisson now has its Aruba hotel and casino up for sale. That was a surprise because the economy is doing well and Aruba appears to be doing well too. Not quite sure why this is being sold during an improving economy, but we assume Radisson has its reasons.

We're sure most other parties agree with the idea, at least publicly, although it is an open question about who will actually enact transparency legislation if elected.

15. Taking Kids to SXM? Make Sure They Have Current Passports, Too

The bad news is that summer is waning fast — only a few more weeks until Labor Day. In the US, Halloween candy has already hit the shelves, and we have zero doubt that Christmas stuff will be on the shelves in some stores next month. (That would be September, folks.)

We also know that thousands of you will be going to St. Maarten in the next several weeks, some of you with kids. This is just a reminder to check their passports (yes, they do need passports) to be sure they are current and not about to expire. If you need it, local passport offices do have expedited service — at a cost. You also more than likely would have to go to an actual passport office, and not an agent like the US Post Office. You do not want to be surprised when you get to the airport with invalid passports and are told to go home.

16. Reminder About Gendarmerie Road "Controls"

We repeated a warning last week advising you to be sure to buckle your seatbelts, avoid using your cell phone, and avoid drinking and driving, particularly on the French side of the island, where gendarmes are out in force around-the-clock and fines are heavy. The Dutch side is stepping up its controls as well, so it's advisable to follow this advice on both sides of the island.

Controls can occur anywhere. When we were on the island of February, we saw gendarmes several times on the dirt road exiting Orient beach near the Butterfly Farm. We've read reports which say they are still in that area regularly, but we've seen them all over the French side and of course on the Dutch side as well.

Be careful out there.

17. Mammoth Four-Engine USAF Boeing C17 Globemaster III Jet Rescues USCG Helicopter At PJIA

Although it isn't the biggest transport aircraft in the U.S. Air Force's fleet, the big four engine C-17 from Boeing, the Globemaster III, still dwarfs commercial airliners. When a C-17 landed at Princess Juliana airport last week, it got a lot of attention. It was there to pick up a US Coast Guard helicopter. The bright red helicopter easily fit into the body of the C-17.

20. Restaurant of the Week: Daniel's By The Sea

The nighttime incarnation of Mr. Busby's beach bar, Daniel's by the Sea near the northern end of Dawn beach next to Oyster Bay Beach Resort is an outstanding Italian restaurant and what may be the best location on the island to spend a summer evening.

Caressed by nearly constant tradewinds day and night, the restaurant offers a huge selection of your favorite Italian dishes, with specials offered every night.

We urge you to look especially closely to appetizers and desserts, both of which are very special here. You can get shrimp, crab, or lobster salad, too - all fresh and delicious. There are succulent steaks, seafood including fresh lobster from their own pool and sometimes fish delicacies you may not see elsewhere, homemade fettuccine of course, and vegetarian selections. It is late afternoon on Friday and it is torture to write this from Boston, but we will be back in St. Maarten soon enough to savor the wonderful food from Daniel's.

Two other notes. First, next door is Island Pizza, owned by the same folks; if you like, you can have pizza for dinner with virtually any topping you desire. And second, this is one restaurant that doesn't take a break. Though a couple of employees at a time will take summer vacation, the restaurant never closes — it's open seven days a week 52 weeks a year. You've got to love that kind of dedication.
