Lead Story: Polar Vortex in September's Forecast -- Prelude to a Worse-Than-Normal Winter

If you intensely disliked last winter's worst weather in the US and Canada, be warned: it's coming back -- in September, no less.

And to make matters even worse, long-range forecasts all seem to be pointing to a winter that is colder and snowier than normal -- and that begins earlier than normal.

Read the bad news here -- if you dare.

1. NOAA Revises Hurricane Season Forecast: Increased Chance of a Below Normal Season

The news is good, if you believe the latest information from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, NOAA.

They're saying that there is now an increased chance of a below normal Atlantic hurricane season. They had predicted a below normal season before, but they're now saying it's more likely to happen.

Of course, if you're in the line of fire for one of the few Atlantic hurricanes NOAA still expects, this forecast is of little consolation. No significant activity was expected by any Atlantic hurricane forecasters during the weekend of August 9 and 10th, the two days before the cover date of this issue of St.

Maarten Weekly News.

Not every forecaster agrees with the NOAA forecast, particularly our "Ace" forecaster Rob Lightbown. See next article.

2. NOAA Could Be Wrong, If Madden-Julian Goes as Lightbown Says: An Alert for Everyone Near the Coast

During the last several hurricane seasons, we have often recommended Crown Weather Services and its chief meteorologist, Rob Lightbown.

In the last few days, Rob said that he is expecting an uptick in tropical activity due to the Madden Julian oscillation, something which most television meteorologists never talk about. Rob does, because it affects the likelihood of tropical systems forming.

In this case, Rob has said that the movement of the Madden Julian oscillation could be problematic in the Atlantic. In this one case, we should all hope he is wrong.

However, at about 3 PM on Friday afternoon, when we wrote this story, we looked at this image:

http://tropic.ssec.wisc.edu/real-time/europe/images/irnm7.GIF. It's a satellite image of monsoonal storms moving from east to west across Africa. These storms, when they exit the coast and head toward the Cape Verde islands, can give birth to tropical storms or hurricanes, if they hold together. Those storms can then threaten the Caribbean basin and the United States. When we looked at that map, it showed some very big storms crossing Africa. On Saturday morning, things looked a bit quieter across Africa, but still stormy. When you look you will see the then-current image, not what we saw.

3. US Customs & Border Patrol Eases Return of US Passengers from Caribbean

4. In the Bay, Bertha Beaches a Boat

Roughly a week ago, St. Maarten was being stared in the face by tropical storm Bertha, which fortunately for the island was well South and West. The storm did bring wind and rain plus very rough seas.

For the sailing yacht Sydkorset, which was moored off Simpson Bay beach, the day was almost a disaster. A St. Maarten Daily Herald report said that the beautiful yacht was ripped loose from its mooring in the Bay by high winds and started drifting toward rocks on the beach. The captain was aboard and put up a sail to change the boat's direction, which thankfully worked.

At the end of the day what happened next was good news: the boat came to rest on the bay's sandy beach. Later, with Coast Guard help, it was refloated and was last seen sailing away apparently none the worse for wear. Even better, there were no reports of any injuries.

5. Why Tide Changes in SXM are Hardly Noticeable

The farther north you go in the US and Canada, the more you'll notice the difference between high tides and low tides on ocean beaches. In fact, the Bay of Fundy in New Brunswick, Canada, is well-known for its extreme tide changes.

Ever wonder why you don't notice tide changes in St. Maarten? They do exist, but are much less extreme than those experienced in latitudes closer to the North and South Poles. For example, when spans for the Simpson Bay Causeway were brought in through the current Simpson Bay drawbridge, special attention was made to ensure that the passage was made during the correct tide-affected water depth.

But if you're on a beach, the change will most likely pass unnoticed. You're in the tropics, mon.

7. Caravanserai Auction Set For Wednesday, 10 a.m., at Pasanggrahan - Court Lets It Go Ahead

This coming Wednesday, August 13, some St. Maarten notaries (vaguely like lawyers) have scheduled an auction involving Caravanseral beach resort including the Dunes casino.

There were legal efforts to stop the auction, perhaps most notably by someone who thinks he owns the Dunes casino. Those cases were decided on Friday, August 8. All the rulings went in favor of mortgage holder Scotia Bank (Bank of Nova Scotia) so the auction will go ahead as planned.

The auction is set for Wednesday at 10 AM at the hotel noted in the title, if there are bids; they were due by the end of last month.

This is at least the third or fourth time the resort is been put up for auction. The price this time is a mere \$12-million, down from \$20-million during the first auction.

11. Trans-Border Agreement Signing Due Aug. 18

Although French St. Maarten and Dutch St. Maarten share a borderless Caribbean island, they are still two independent countries, though in recent years cross-border cooperation has been increasing.

On August 18, a week from today, a transborder agreement is scheduled to be signed which will further increase cooperation between the governments on both sides of the island. It will contain provisions involving a joint wastewater treatment plant, a drinking water project, and a joint environmental impact study regarding the Simpson Bay lagoon. There is already very substantial cooperation between police on both sides of the island.

12. Bikini Beach Manager Accused of Assaulting a Man Using a Metal Detector on "His" Beach

According to a story published in the Daily Herald on last Thursday, a man with a metal detector claims he was assaulted on Orient beach by the manager of the Bikini Beach Bar.

Nick, a former manager at the St. Maarten Yacht Club, said he has filed a complaint with the gendarmerie for the way he was treated. " I had my headphones on and was walking across Bikini Beach when the guy from the restaurant came up to me and said he didn't want me on his beach with a metal detector and I had to leave. I was two rows back in the water and they were stacking up the chairs at the time so that's when I started with the metal detector."

The Beach Bar manager, David, dispute disputed Nick's version of what happened. "I intervened because we still had people sitting on the lounges and he was bothering them with the detector because it caused the sand to fly about. I asked him to stop doing it we have a responsibility to our own customers reading in the chairs. I suggested he come back and do it early in the morning or late in the evening when the beach is empty but he started shouting and became very rude. It was clear to me he had been drinking. He hit me in the face first that's why I pushed him but I didn't want to get into a fight with him so at that point I called the gendarmes. At some point the metal detector broke I don't know how but it was not broken intentionally."

Ever since Elisa Cohen was forced out of her Bikini Beach Bar, we don't go there at all....

13. 42nd Central American Bodybuilding Championship October 2-4 in French SXM

If you're into bodybuilding and happen to be on the island early in October, you'll be able to see the 42nd Central American Bodybuilding Championship on the French side from October 2 to October 4. All we know about it so far is that it will have about 300 athletes from 28 countries. As we learn more. we'll pass it along.

14. Dutch Side Police Chief Making Good on a Long-Time Promise

When he first took office in 2010, Dutch Side Police Chief Peter de Witte promised he would serve until July, 2014, and then step aside to enable a local to take over as police chief. Now, he's making good on that promise.

Over the next few months, a search will be undertaken for a new police chief who will be carrying forth the current chief's highly effective community policing initiatives, which have been largely responsible for a significant drop in crime on the Dutch side of the island. Chief De Witte will not participate in the search, but he will be heavily involved in bringing the new chief up to speed in preparing him or her to take over the department within a few months of being hired.

15. Police Sign Agreement for a Community Police Substation at Maho

Although there is currently a Dutch side police substation in Simpson Bay at the drawbridge, the police department believes other substations are necessary to carry out its community policing policies, which have paid off well especially in the last couple of years.

To that end, it's about to open a community police substation in Maho, which would become the focal point of police activity on that part of the island. The Maho, airport, and Cupecoy areas are very busy, so the substation is guite welcome.

16. Two Police Dogs Join Dutch Side Force; Focus - Drugs & Firearms

The St. Maarten police force is being augmented by two highly trained police dogs, which have undergone exhaustive preparation outside St. Maarten.

The dogs, now paired with specially trained Dutch side police officers, will be focused on detecting both drugs and firearms.

17. On Dutch Side, Sharp Decline in Armed Robberies

The Dutch side police department has reported a sharp reduction in criminal activities. An article in the St. Maarten Daily Herald reports:

- "Theft related offences, including burglaries, robberies, plain thefts and thefts of cars have gone down. Dwelling burglaries have fallen by 37 per cent since 2010, and have gone down from 366 burglaries in 2012 to 307 burglaries in 2013. There were 160 robberies in 2013, as opposed to 199 in 2012.
- " 'Car thefts had gone down from 183 in 2012, to 154 in 2013. That means less than half the amount of cars was stolen in St. Maarten, compared to French St. Martin.
- "'Our Police Force works in a completely different way to the French, who have their local police force as well as the Gendarmerie,' De Witte said. 'Community Policing and increased visibility are things that have worked for us in bringing these figures down."
- "Only theft of items from vehicles had gone up from 250 to 258. Tourists with rental cars are often the victims of these theft crimes, as it frequently happens that items such as cameras and wallets are left inside the car within view from the outside.' "
- "A leaflet is currently being produced which will be distributed in places frequented by tourists, to warn them not to leave items visible in vehicles. The police hope this will help as a preventative measure so they will be able to report a drop in this type of theft next year.
- "There were three homicides in 2013, down from 10 in 2012; 2010 saw seven homicides with a peak in 2011 of 18 homicides, which was attributed to the Vesuvius murders. Although homicides were down to three, attempted homicides had gone up from 11 to 14. Police Chief De Witte said that a substantial number of these were linked to domestic violence cases."

We've always advised against leaving any valuables in cars, particularly in trunks -- cameras, handbags, etc. We often see people put valuables in their trunks and if we see it, so do "bad guys." Don't do it....

18. Dutch Side Not Now Considering Medical Marijuana

Despite the fact that many states in the USA are legalizing medical marijuana, and in some cases recreational marijuana, no such consideration is underway in either Dutch or French St. Maarten.

In fact, local officials say in essence that such consideration is complicated not only by the fact that the United States as a country still considers the possession of marijuana a criminal offense (you can't take it on airplanes), but also by the fact that St. Maarten is part of the kingdom of the Netherlands and its laws play a role here.

So, nothing is imminent, and stiff penalties continue to apply.

19. Beach Bonfire Ban Buoys Baby Turtles
