SECTION 1: Getting There: Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. Peak of Hurricane Season is Right Now

The statistical peak of the Atlantic hurricane season is this week. The good news, though, is that no storms are expected in the next few days.

There is increased weather activity across Africa, however. Storms crossing Africa East to West exit the coast and can develop into Cape Verde tropical storms or hurricanes that can threaten the Caribbean or the US. Sandy, dry Saharan air can inhibit tropical storm formation -- and its effect on the rest of this hurricane season is still not clear.

A couple of tropical waves are currently situated in the far Eastern tropical Atlantic, slowly heading westward. Meteorologist Rob Lightbown of Crown Weather says those tropical waves bear watching, since they can further develop as they move westward.

As always, you can click weather on www.everythingStMaarten.com for satellite images and radar loops of the tropical Atlantic. As we've noted before, we will post news immediately on our Facebook page and send an e-mail to our JMB Website Supporters members should any weather systems threaten St. Maarten.

If you live or work in any area that can be threatened by tropical weather, we urge you to sign up for Crown Weather bulletins and updates. They are the best early warnings you can get and will cost you next to nothing.

2. Got AA or US Airways Reservations? Check Your Flights

If you have reservations either on American Airlines or US Airways, you should know that their in-process merger is resulting in a number of

flight changes. Those changes involve flight times, days, equipment, routes, etc.

For whatever reason, the changes seem to be affecting American Airlines more than legacy US Airways flights.

Also be aware that some previously nonstop flights to St. Maarten on American Airlines are being eliminated in favor of connections in Miami, the big American Airlines hub. When confronted with this change, a number of passengers are opting for nonstops from JFK to SXM aboard JetBlue, which still offers them.

Regardless of what airline you're flying, it's now the lowest end of low season — at least until mid-November — so check carefully to avoid surprises regarding your flights.

3. Air Canada to Fly Rouge 767s From Toronto Twice Weekly

We reported a couple of weeks ago that Air Canada was increasing service to St. Maarten. What we didn't know at the time was of they are also using wide-body aircraft — specifically, Boeing 767s for their twice-weekly flights to SXM from Toronto.

Air Canada will also be using branded "Rouge" aircraft, intended for leisure travel. Here's more: http://bit.ly/1x1q0Or

When we checked the Rouge website on Monday, the new SXM service was not yet posted there; it doesn't begin until December 20.

4. Get Global Entry To Ease Your Return to the USA

Global Entry, a fairly new program from the U.S. Customs and Border Patrol (CBP), enables trusted travelers to get through US Customs much more quickly and easily than is otherwise possible.

To become part of the program, you complete and exhaustive application, pay a fee, and go to an interview at a location determined by CBP. The process can take several weeks, but at the end of the day, departures from US airports and arrivals back in the US from overseas are expedited significantly.

The program is being expanded to many new airports.

In addition to overseas flights, Global Entry includes the domestic pre-check program, which lets you speed through security check-in lines when taking US domestic flights from many airports. Depending upon the airport, you may be able to leave your shoes on and leave your computer in its case.

For more information, go here: http://www.cbp.gov/global-entry/about, where you can also find an online application. Do it soon, however, since

it often takes several weeks to get your credentials.

5. New "FBO" Private Jet Facility Update

If you've visited St. Maarten in recent years, you know that Princess Juliana airport can become rather cluttered with dozens of private jets during Thanksgiving, Christmas, and much of the winter.

The jets are scattered about the airport, some of them near the lagoon end of the runway.

We reported a few months ago that construction would soon begin on an FBO facility — fixed base operations, which is industry jargon for private jets. Construction of the facility either is already underway or is about to get underway, and should be finished in roughly a year. We'll get pictures and post them on our Facebook page once construction gets to the stage where it's appropriate -- by year's end.

6. Demolition Along Airport Road: About The Parallel Taxiway Coming to Princess Juliana Airport

As we've been reporting for quite some time, Princess Juliana International Airport is expanding. Recent visitors to the island over the last two or three years have seen an increasing number of buildings along Airport Road sold to the airport and marked as airport property — no trespassing. The most famous of these properties was the Turtle Pier restaurant, renowned for its lobster night and its beautiful over-water location.

Several changes are coming. Here are three of them, not necessarily in chronological order.

First, a new Fixed Base Operations facility is being built to accommodate private jets (see related story).

Second, a new taxiway parallel to the existing east-west runway will be built, which means that after landing, aircraft will get off the runway to enable other arrivals and departures. Without the taxiway, arrivals and departures must wait while landing aircraft plod back up the main runway to the terminal. The new taxiway will enable the airport to accommodate significantly increased traffic. Airport Road itself will relocate north as the taxiway is built near the current site of Airport Road. Once the taxiway is open, you'll understand why the western terminus of the new Causeway is where it is.

Most important to passengers, perhaps, is that the main terminal building will be enlarged within a few years. Shaped something like a nearly complete half oval, the current terminal will be expanded to a complete half oval. The employee parking area on the east side of the current terminal is actually tarmac; the terminal will be expanded over part of this area, with the addition of a couple of gates to accommodate increased air traffic.

As these changes unfold over the next few years, we'll keep you posted and we expect to run pictures both on Facebook and here in our newsletter.

7. Timeshare News Updates -- Caravanserai and Simpson Bay / Pelican Resort

We know many readers are anxiously looking for updates on the status of both Simpson Bay Resort and Caravanserai.

So far, there is nothing to report.

We did tell you a few weeks ago that the sale at auction of Pelican Resort by Royal Resorts in 2010 was nullified by St. Maarten courts. We still don't know exactly who brought the suit that resulted in the court action. We also believe that there are negotiations going on between the parties or their representatives, but we have no substantive corroborated data on the contents of those negotiations. When we do, we'll post it here in *SXM Weekly News*.

We also told you that Caravanserai Resort was sold at auction for \$14 million. The name of the buyer has not been released and the sale has not yet closed, though the provisions of the auction require the closing within the next couple of weeks.

Timeshare owners are particularly concerned about what these sales mean to them. We wrote about that subject in a previous issue but the fact is, nothing has been announced and no one really knows. We do not have any reason to expect, however, that either resort will be required to close temporarily as a result of the events we just described.

8. Pack Light: Clothing Optional Vacationing in SXM

Crave to vacation without heavy luggage? Want to return home with no tan lines?

SXM has two solutions. The first is the well-known Club Orient, now nearing 35 years of age, the island's first naturist resort. It's located on the southern end of Orient Beach on the French Side and is "nood" throughout.

"CO" is closed until October 6 and is busy preparing for the season. Tennis courts are being completely resurfaced, the Welcome Center is getting a new look, and many villas are undergoing renovations.

Club Orient suggests booking promptly since February is already 80% sold out -- and the Euro has been dropping in value and is now at about \$1.30.

Club Fantastico, on the hill overlooking Orient Bay, is based in a large home and is also clothing optional with a "nood" pool as well. It has off-season specials, too.

9. In The Dutch St Maarten Election, Theo Heyliger Comes Out on Top -- Sort Of

Since somewhere in the 1990s, Theo Heyliger has been the most popular political figure on the Dutch side of the island.

He was behind all of the major infrastructure projects undertaken since that time — the vast upgrading of the Dutch side cruise and cargo facilities; the Philipsburg boardwalk; the redesign of both Front Street and Back Street; the new airport terminal and other major airport changes to come; the Simpson Bay Lagoon Causeway; and other projects.

That's why it was no surprise late last week when Mr. Heyliger won the Dutch side parliamentary elections.

You would have thought that this victory would propel Mr. Heyliger forward as the country's new prime minister, but you would be wrong. In St. Maarten, the government has a parliamentary system and there are somewhere around a dozen political parties. Although Mr. Heyliger's "up" party garnered more votes than any other party, after the election three other parties signed up for coalition. Their combined votes controlled

eight seats in parliament, whereas Mr. Heyliger's party's votes controlled only seven — so there will be another coalition government and Mr. Heyliger, who won the election, will be the loyal opposition. (Go figure.)

What's particularly interesting about this is the individual personalities of some of the key members of Parliament. Heyliger is in the opposition because of the alliance of three other parties. The real difference is one member of Parliament — so, were one of the eight controlling coalition politicians to change his or her allegiance from the new coalition to Mr. Heyliger's UP party, the new government now forming could fall and yet another new government would be established under Mr. Heyliger.

Far stranger things have happened. If you're a political junkie, the next year or two in St. Maarten will likely be fascinating to you.

10. New Government Coming, But What's It Mean to Timeshare Owners / Tourists?

Tourism is St. Martin's bread-and-butter, by far its single dominant economic force. In fact, Rotary on the island currently is promoting the theme that tourism is everybody's business. The attitude of people in every business is noted by tourists: when they feel welcomed everywhere, they feel good and would like to return.

But what about the new coalition government now forming, what does that government mean to tourists?

The answer, of course, is we don't know, but there is one thing for certain: the orientation toward keeping tourists the vital economic engine they are isn't about to change. The island has no readily available alternative.

The Simpson Bay Causeway has cut traffic congestion; airport expansion projects will cut congestion there; and further traffic projects are designed to further cut traffic congestion. And there is always consideration of other things the government can do to attract and hold tourists' interest and keep them safe and happy.

As always, we'll watch this closely for you and keep you informed here and on our Facebook page.

11. Chikungunya Seems Well Under Control

Although it isn't all that rainy, the rainy season is coming, and with it, somewhat more frequent and longer-lasting showers. It is in wet conditions that mosquitoes can thrive.

But after its experience last December, the island has been educating the public about how to prevent mosquito breeding and it has taken on mosquito fogging as a major national priority. Consequently, it's rare that you even read about Chikungunya now in the local papers.

As we've mentioned before, late last year Chikungunya was increasing even as dengue fever was declining — and dengue fever can be lethal for

healthy people at times. Chikungunya is not fatal, though it can be quite dangerous to people who are already ill. The island is doing everything it can and everything it should to overcome Chikungunya and it has done guite a remarkable job.

As you'll see in the next article, most tourists have paid attention to what the island has done and are reacting by booking tickets back to St. Maarten. That doesn't mean there is no Chikungunya in SXM; it hasn't disappeared. But it is apparently well controlled now and smart tourists know how to use mosquito repellent to protect themselves.

12. Outlook for the 2014-2015 High Season -- Big

For a lot of reasons, the outlook for the 2014-2015 high season in St. Maarten is quite excellent.

Last winter, which was severe across much of North America, made many people want to go to St. Maarten — but thousands canceled their trips because of fear of Chikungunya.

With an improving economy, a largely successful fight against Chikungunya, and a potentially even more severe winter ahead, anecdotal evidence suggests that this may be a record year for St. Maarten tourism, last year's issues notwithstanding.

One strong piece of anecdotal evidence is simply how early many timeshares offered for rent are being rented or sold at the asking price. In some cases there is even competition for weeks.

Airlines apparently agree, since a number of them are increasing the size of aircraft used on routes to St. Maarten and/or are increasing flight frequencies.
