4. Want to Buy a Yacht?

It could be the beginning of a new and wonderful adventure for you.

5. Caravanserai New Owner Disclosed; Who Is He?

The new owner of Caravanserai resort took over there last Monday. Everything we've heard so far is very positive in all respects and our hunch is that at the end of the day Caravanserai timeshare owners should in general be quite happy with what happens.

The name of the new owner is Ray Sidholm, apparently the same Ray Sidholm who has been a major player in the credit card processing business for a number of years.

We know he had the financial wherewithal to buy the resort with a full understanding that it needs quite a bit of changes not only to bring it up to competitive Caribbean standards, but also to finish a major building project that is now a dormant skeleton.

There is a great deal to be done with Caravanserai, but the potential of that property is quite enormous. New ownership appears committed to excellence and is already looking for a number of new employees to start things rolling in the right direction. Within the next couple of weeks, we're going to try to get in contact with Mr. Sidholm so we can report in detail what timeshare owners and others should expect.

As always, we'll keep you posted.

6. Changes Planned for Caravanserai -- Including Its Name

We've heard a number of things over the last several weeks that were represented to us as plans for change at Caravanserai under the new ownership. We're not into publishing rumors, so we're not going to pass along what we've heard -- with one exception. Marty of the Dream Bar at Caravanserai has said that one of the plans is to change the name of the resort, which is not a bad idea at all. We have no idea whether consideration is being given to hooking up with a name brand for marketing purposes; it would not surprise us at all if that happens, and if it does, we're sure it would be one with a high-end reputation. But we don't know; we'll do our best to find out and pass along the information.

Timeshare owners, of course, are concerned with whether the attitude of the new owners will be better than that which has been displayed over the last several years by former owners. Our hunch is that there will be many improvements. By law, anyone buying the resort must honor existing contracts of timeshare owners.

As always, as we noted above, we'll keep you posted.

7. The Unique Charm of The Island's Smaller Hotels

St. Maarten / St. Martin has a number of smaller hotels which have a unique charm and, usually, a dedicated long-term staff that really knows what it's doing.

In no special order, here are four such resorts that we have recommended for a number of years:

First, Mary's Boon Beach Plantation: located on beautiful Simpson Bay beach, Mary's Boon is a St. Maarten classic. When you're there, definitely ask about Mary — she was quite a character, and deserves to be depicted on the big screen. The resort itself has been renovated and upgraded by Mark and Karla Cleveland -- painstakingly over a number of years. Just do it. You won't be disappointed.

Second, La Vista Resort in pelican key. La Vista has a unique country charm that will make you fall in love instantly. Whether you choose the original resort on the hill or the new section by the sea, this place will make you happy. They have a beautiful ocean view pool and a great little restaurant called the Hideaway which has been an island favorite for many years. It has also been a selection in our restaurant of the week articles here in *St. Maarten Weekly News*.

Third, Summit Resort Hotel, which was the first place we visited when we went to St. Maarten on our own for the first time in 1979. Its tropically colored chalets are beautifully decorated and include widescreen TVs and free Internet access. An on premises restaurant on the pool deck and a co-located bar offer extraordinary views of the northern lagoon as well as mountains on the central and northern part of the island, plus the neighboring island of Anguilla and even Creole rock in the distance, which you can see through the telephoto lens of your digital camera.

Fourth, in our opinion L'Esplanade on the French Side of the island is one of the finest St. Martin hotels. Gorgeous inside and out, great facilities, meticulously cared-for, maintained, and superbly managed. Great property. Near both Grand Case and Orient Beach.

8. What Are The Best Timeshares on SXM?

Below, we've selected a number of St. Maarten timeshares that we think are worth your consideration, either as a place to stay or for buying timeshares for sale, if you want to enjoy the same experience every year. You'll find many timeshares for sale or for rent directly from our members / timeshare owners on our www.everythingsxm.com.

Although Summit resort hotel, mentioned in the preceding article, is no longer selling timeshare, occasionally you will see a Summit resort timeshare available for resale. When they're available, if you're in the market you should strongly consider them, for a number of good reasons. First, this resort is well-managed and well-maintained. Second, the annual maintenance fee has always been one of the most reasonable on the island. Third, the location is near Simpson Bay, Cupecoy, and the French side border, which makes it fast and easy to go practically anywhere. Fourth, the views are extraordinary. Fifth, the hotel bar is a great place to relax and it shares that extraordinary view.

Second, pelican resort/Simpson Bay resort. Although this resort has had more ups and downs than your average elevator, during recent years it has seen nothing but substantial improvements – and the fact that they were seriously overdue does not diminish the magnitude of the accomplishments.

Third, La Vista resort. See what we wrote about them in the preceding story; this is a great place and easily one of the island's top timeshares.

Fourth, Oyster Bay Beach Resort. Conveniently located next door to one of the island's finest restaurants, Daniels by the sea, and its daytime incarnation, Mr. Busby's beach bar, Oyster Bay has excellent accommodations, reasonable pricing, and is located right next to Dawn beach, one of the island's most beautiful.

Fifth, Divi resort on Great Bay beach in Philipsburg. Located next to an historic Fort, Divi has a commanding view of great Bay beach, its own ocean beach, multiple restaurants, and outstanding accommodations. Definitely give it a try.

A number of people have been requesting it for years, and now it's finally happening: US-style road signs on the Dutch side of St. Maarten.

The bad news: no English signs are expected on the French Side, and certainly none like those in the US. The Dutch-side signs should materially help visitors unfamiliar with SXM.

10. New Dutch Side Government Will Be a Work in Progress

Politics in St. Maarten is even more rugged, if that's the word, than it is in the US. It doesn't often lead to fistcuffs, as is the case sometimes in the UK, but the dialogue can get quite feisty.

As we mentioned previously, several political parties that lost the election have banded together to form a coalition government on the Dutch Side. Theo Heyliger's UP party, which won the election (received a plurality of all votes cast), was outflanked by the losers, who in aggregate got more votes.

We expect the next several months to be interesting from a political perspective, and we'll keep you posted about what happens in the Dutch side government.

11. Why "Market Basket" Should Open in SXM (But Won't)

As many of you learned from North American media, the New England-based Market Basket supermarket chain made history last summer because of its love for its unseated president Arthur T. Demoulas.

For decades, Arthur T. and his cousin, Arthur S. Demoulas, fought over the popular chain, started by their ancestors in 1917.

The store offers what have been proven to be the lowest prices throughout New England. Its nonunion employees are paid substantially above minimum wage and many participate in a lucrative profit-sharing program. When Arthur S. gained control of the board, he had Arthur T fired as president. Subsequently, employees protested in front of the company's headquarters and customers boycotted the business virtually *en masse*, slashing its receipts by 95%. Harvard Business School will be discussing this case for decades.

Facing collapse, Arthur S sold the chain to Arthur T for \$1.5 billion.

In St. Maarten, no similar chain exists. All the markets charge high prices, blaming them on the cost of shipping to St. Maarten. In part, that's true, and port taxes play a role. But while the Market Basket boycott was underway, we couldn't help but think: what if some gutsy CEO simply chose to offer truly reasonable prices to customers who both needed and wanted them? His or her market would be immediately popular and incredibly busy. It's something for businesspeople on the island to think about...

12. Seaweed Situation Smouldering Seaside

St. Martin's seaweed situation continues to simmer slowly by the sea side. Sargasso seaweed, from the Sargasso Sea (check it out in Wikipedia) sometimes moves with shifting currents and winds up on beaches where it is demonstrably unwelcome.

Fortunately, this tends to happen in the late summer and fall, when there are fewer tourists on the island. The good news is, it affects mainly Atlantic facing beaches-- a minority of the island's ocean beaches.

Sargasso seaweed is only of seasonal significance, since it sails away unceremoniously with shifting seaside currents. When you get here in November or after, it will be long gone.

13. Where is Vesna?

Vivacious Vesna, the young lady who along with her husband doles out great American and Greek food at Vesna Taverna in Simpson Bay, recently left on a busman's holiday and is exactly where you might expected her to be – in Paris, learning more about her craft, as she and her husband Yannick did last year. She will be back in November, and we know that thousands of customers will look forward to seeing her then. In the meantime, the restaurant is open as usual for breakfast and lunch every day under the capable management of Sally and her helpers.

We first discovered Vesna a couple of years ago and very strongly recommend the restaurant.
