

SECTION 1: Getting There: Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. Cape Verde Hurricane Season Ends -- But It Ain't Over 'Til It's Over on Nov. 30

The Cape Verde hurricane season ended as September closed. It bears that name because storms that could potentially affect St. Maarten form there in August and especially in September. After that, conditions in the tropical Atlantic tend to become hostile to storm development.

Bear in mind, however, that hurricane season itself does not end until November 30. From now until then, cyclogenesis -- the formation of hurricanes -- can occur in the Gulf of Mexico, the Caribbean, and off the southeastern coast of the US. Also bear in mind that some serious storms in the past have formed during this period and wreaked havoc in St. Maarten.

The good news is that this has been a mild year for hurricanes so far and forecasters tend to believe it will stay that way. On the other hand it PRO version Are you a developer? Try out the HTML to PDF API pdfcrowd.com

2. Ottawa To Get Weekly Nonstops to SXM Starting December 15

Canada's Sun Wing airlines, which already operates a few flights to St. Maarten, has a new one this winter: weekly nonstops from Ottawa Ontario to the island, which will make it far more convenient for many residents of Ontario to reach SXM. Check the Sun Wing website for specifics and reservations.

Bear in mind, of course, that JetBlue Airways, which has nonstops from both New York and Boston, flies out of Burlington Vermont and Buffalo New York, both of which are near population centers in Ontario and Québec. They didn't pick those locations out of the "blue" -- in part, they picked them because of their proximity to Canada and in consideration of high Canadian airfares.

3. Fall Weather in SXM

As we've mentioned before, this is the rainy season in St. Maarten. But rainy is relative – it just means that showers may last a bit longer and there may be an occasional tropical wave, though the frequency of waves diminishes the farther into the year we progress.

In just two months, it will be December, home of the famous December winds — and Christmas worms. The winds make some northeastern facing beaches quite windy, but the cure to that is to spend more time in the water.

At home, of course, the weather is starting to get colder. If you haven't made your SXM reservations yet, now is the time. Take a close look at the first article in section 3 of this newsletter for a great new way to get low-cost airfares.

8. Car Slams Into Toppers & Marty's Gyros, Fire Erupts; No One Hurt

When Melanie Daboul's telephone rang in the middle of the night last week, she had no idea what to expect. Looking at the clock, she knew that the restaurant had closed only a short time before, when a contingent of Dutch Marines who were relaxing headed back to their barracks. What she learned was startling: a car had gone out of control on Welfare Road, slammed into her sign demolishing it, then slammed directly into the building, wrecking outside chairs, severely rearranging Topper's office, damaging the adjacent Marty's gyros restaurant — and then the car caught fire.

As if that weren't bad enough, the car severed some GEBE water pipes which then spewed a lot of water through the messed up restaurant.

The fire was quickly put out by the St. Maarten fire department and damage was mainly confined to the sign, the furniture around the exterior of

the building, and Topper's office. The very good news was that no one was injured, including the two or more young ladies who were in the car that went off the road. They later apologized to Melanie.

For Topper's customers the news is even better: the restaurant was quickly cleaned up, furniture replaced, and it was open as usual the following day. A new sign is being ordered.

9. Harbor, Airport Likely To Get Casino Licenses

If the Dutch side allows slot machines at various locations, it stands to reason that should make the use of slots convenient for people who might not otherwise be exposed to them. On impulse, air travelers might very well be tempted to use slot machines that could well appear in the departure lounge at the Princess Juliana airport.

Not all cruise passengers get off the ship; a number stay on board. Were there casino gambling available right at the harbor, it would be easy for those people to try it out without having to venture far from port.

Of course, other businesses won't like this idea since it could well siphon off funds that could otherwise be spent in their establishments. But the bottom line is that anything that enhances the ability of the government to function without further raising turnover taxes is a good idea, in our opinion. Any turnover tax increase – and we know such an increase is being considered within government circles — could have a very chilling effect on the island's tourist oriented economy, a bad idea. We're not big fans of casinos, but this does sound to us like smart marketing.

10. Dutch Side Coalition Apparently To Be Replaced by One-Party Government

Over the last few weeks, we told you that an assortment of political parties had banded together after the recent parliamentary elections to form a coalition government. Together, these disparate parties had received votes for one more member of Parliament than Theo Heyliger, the island's most popular politician who had received a plurality of the popular vote. Although Heyliger was the top individual vote-getter, he was outflanked --

and others formed a coalition to keep him out of power.

It appears that did not last. As we mentioned in previous articles, such a coalition involving many individuals where only one seat determined the majority was tenuous; the coalition could collapse if one person changed his or her mind.

That has happened, apparently, and it looks like Mr. Heyliger is likely to take over after the vetting process has completed.

Across the pond in the Netherlands, the Dutch Parliament at the Hague is hearing what appears to be a constant barrage of insults hurled at St. Maarten. We won't go into details, but they don't seem to be enthralled by the idea of Mr. Heyliger potentially becoming prime minister in a one-party government. (Politics; don't you love it?) But there is also much discontent on the island with how the Dutch treat their countrymen on the island. Some people are saying openly that they feel they are treated as inferiors who are not really Dutch. It is not known at all whether there is any thought being given to independence in the sense that the United States declared independence from Britain all those years ago. We don't think St. Maarten wants that at all. But St. Maarten also has a lot of pride and it isn't happy with what it's hearing.

12. Gendarmes Increase Presence at Le Galion

French gendarmes have had their hands full with the crime situation there, but when told there is a crime problem somewhere, they seem to be doing a significantly better job of responding.

Case in point: there have been some recent thefts of personal property from Le Galion beach, which is immediately south of Orient beach (a hike). There was also one alleged carjacking at Galion. Gendarme patrols have been increased significantly, and controls in the area have also been increased. Controls, as we reported in the past, are highway checkpoints where gendarmes check for papers, seatbelts, illegal use of cell phones, driving while drunk, weapons, and so on.
