1. JetBlue To Increase Seating Density and Add Bag Fees -- But It's Not a Bleak Change

JetBlue will be replacing its current traditional thick-design aircraft seats with thinner seats which it says will maintain user comfort at current levels while enabling the airline to add two new rows of seats per A320 aircraft. The latter addition should placate the airline's shareholders, who have been after a change like this for years.

Passengers may be concerned that the additional two rows of seats will substantially cut legroom. In fact, legroom will be only slightly less than it currently is, JetBlue offers by far the most generous legroom of any low-cost carrier; that will not be a problem.

In addition to this change, the airline will move to a three-tier pricing strategy, updating something that it has been experimenting with. Here's JetBlue's press release: http://investor.jetblue.com/phoenix.zhtml?c=131045&p=irol-newsArticle&ID=1991164

2. Colorado State Talks About the 2014 Hurricane Season

Hurricane activity in the Atlantic basin was below average in 2014, matching predictions made throughout the year by the Colorado State University hurricane forecast team.

Eight named storms, six hurricanes and two major hurricanes formed during the 2014 Atlantic basin hurricane season from June to November. The CSU team originally called for nine named storms, three hurricanes and one major hurricane. It later revised its predictions to 10 named storms, four hurricanes and one major hurricane.

The CSU team attributed the relatively quiet season to several factors:

- Tropical Atlantic sea surface temperatures were slightly cooler than normal.
- · Mid-level air was much drier than normal.
- Vertical wind shear, especially in the Caribbean, was quite strong.
- · Sinking motion dominated the tropical Atlantic and Caribbean.
- Though an El Nino did not develop as predicted, the large-scale circulation in the tropical Atlantic resembled conditions typically seen in El Nino years.

A brief qualitative outlook for the 2015 hurricane season will be issued on Dec. 11 with a first full forecast for next season issued on April 9, 2015.

3. Slight Dip in Cruise Arrivals Expected; What It Means to You and To SXM

As we reported last week, a senior official of Royal Caribbean Cruise lines has said that that carrier will be reassigning some ships from Caribbean duty to China, helping to relieve the overcapacity it currently sees in the Caribbean market.

It could be that some other carriers will follow suit, but in any case the number of ships coming to St. Maarten will be decreasing starting next year.

This isn't necessarily bad news. To fill the glut of staterooms available in the current overcapacity situation, cruise lines have been cutting prices, enabling a less robust demographic to take cruises. Consequently, when people in this demographic visit Front Street, or other places on the island, they tend to have less money to spend. Once the overcapacity situation has been relieved, cruise lines expect higher prices and a higher demographic of passengers aboard. If that expectation pans out, Front Street and the island could benefit from less congestion and heightened income, a good thing.

As this moves forward, we'll keep you posted.

From The Editor: We originated and ran this story a week ago. A number of national news organizations read this newsletter and we saw the same story picked up last week by numerous US newspapers and even *NBC Nightly News*. We love it when that happens and we'll keep doing our best to deliver stories that matter to our readers around the world. -Ed.

Airlines at the moment have quite good fares to the Caribbean; do what we suggest in article 4, above, to get them. With jet fuel prices plummeting and more new, efficient planes coming into service, airlines are doing quite well and the need to have sales has diminished.

Most planes are uncomfortable as dense seating seems to be a permanent malady. Jet Blue will keep its leadership in legroom even as it, too, soon adds seats to its mainstay A320 airbus aircraft. The new seats are thinner but just as comfortable as current seating. So they continue to deliver the "Jet Blue experience" (extra legroom and more) while adding more paying passengers to each flight. Airline shareholders want profits after years of losses and that's exactly what the airtlines are delivering.

But we digress. Do what we recommend in story 4, and buy your tickets now. At worse, airfares will stay flat -- but over the long term demand is high, capacity is controlled, and that inevitably means higher prices.

6. Judgement Coming on Caravanserai: Where To Find The Bottom Line

About a week and a half ago, the judge hearing this case in St. Maarten told representatives of Alegria and timeshare owners of the former Caravanserai resort to continue talking in an effort to resolve the current impasse over the discontinuation of timesharing by the new owners of Caravanserai.

The judge said that if the two parties couldn't agree, he would make a ruling. A number of people on the island believe that his ruling could favor timeshare owners — but it ain't over until it's over, and our bet is that this case has a long way to go and it may well be held up in Dutch courts. We all hope to be surprised by an agreement — and we'll report whatever happens quickly on our Facebook page; see the link, above.

7. Just Who Is The New Owner of Caravanserai / Alegria?

His name is Ray Sidhom, and he's the head of EVO Payments International which is based in the US. His bio is here: http://evopayments.com/about-evo/leadership/ray-sidhom/

Mr. Sidhom's vision for Caravanserai is that of an upscale resort hotel, not a timeshare, and he believes the circumstances under which he bought the property allow him to proceed accordingly. Many disagree and this will be decided in the courts.

There is absolutely no question in the minds of consumers that SXM must have timeshare owner consumer protection, something that has been discussed for years but never adopted.

The timeshare industry, and the hundreds of thousands of timeshare owners who are the *de facto* backbone of tourism in St. Maarten, are all critical to the island's future as a prime tourism destination. Timeshare owners currently are vulnerable to takeovers like this that torpedo their investments, sabotage faith in the island, threaten the island's reputation, and threaten the long-term viability of St. Maarten is a tourism destination.

If you bought a new Jaguar, you'd love to take it out on the highway and see what it could do. We're sure that Mr. Sidhom has a similar vision for Caravanserai/Alegria, though he certainly could have done a better job of handling his initial interaction with Caravanserai timeshare owners.

It's Mr. Manek, the previous owner of Caravanserai, who is the focal point of most consumer outrage by Caravanserai timeshare owners. It was Mr. Manek who collected millions of dollars from timeshare owners and who has since all but vanished.

We've heard from very reliable sources in Grand Case that three long-time culinary institutions there have been bought out by the same French company.

The word is that both Ti Provençal and Rainbow will be converted into boutique hotels, while Sol e Luna will continue as an upscale restaurant. Sol e Luna will in fact have a swimming pool outside the building, apparently with a swim up bar. These are rather radical changes for Grand Case and as always, we'll watch the progress and keep you posted.

11. Orient Beach & Le Galion - Past, Present, & Future

When we first visited this island in 1977, naturists flocked to Le Galion beach hotel at Embouchure near Orient beach. They followed the well-worn footpath to the beach, where a few dozen naturists constituted a busy day. There was not a single building on the entire beach, just a little refreshment cart called Pedro's. There soon appeared a sign proclaiming the imminent construction of Club Orient, the now world famous naturist resort at the far southern end of Orient beach.

In those days, you could walk "nood" from one end of the beach to the other, and you would likely encounter no one wearing any clothes.

Now the beach is heavily built-up, and regulations about being clothed mean that only at Club Orient can you stay naked.

Le Galion was destroyed by a hurricane, causing naturists to scatter to other locations. Based upon the spectacular success of Club Orient, development sprang up from one end of the beach to the other. The French side government has expressed concern about this and seemingly would "like" to return the entire area from Le Galion through parts of Orient to its pristine state, were that possible.

Because of the extent of development on Orient, more regulations are inevitable but removing the current businesses is not bloody likely, though change is to be expected. Its *definition* is an open question.

The situation is much different over at Embouchure, where Le Galion is located. As we noted last week, the building will be demolished within the next 12 months or so (sooner, not later) and it will be replaced by what amounts to a nature reserve with parking and a refreshment stand.

This does not sit well at all with the owner of Tropical Wave restaurant at Le Galion, who hasn't even been formally told yet that he's going to be thrown out next year. The proprietor, Patrick Turner, is bewildered at how, after 30 years of legal operation there, he can simply be told to get out.

That's not the only problem. Other businesses in the area, including the Butterfly Farm, may well face a similar fate.

To us, it seems like the dictionary definition of throwing the baby out with the bathwater.

This story, like Caravanserai on the Dutch Side, seems far from over.

12. Theo Heyliger Withdraws from Prime Minister Contention

Elections were held on the Dutch side many weeks ago, before hurricane Gonzalo struck if we remember correctly, but a new government has yet to be installed.

We don't quite get the parliamentary system that's used here. Theo Heyliger was the top vote getter and initially said he would become Prime Minister. Some politicians in the Netherlands, of which St. Maarten is a part, has been making a lot of noise lately about integrity though some of the members of the Netherlands government seem to have issues in that area. In any case, Mr. Heyliger has announced that he'll be a member of Parliament but not Prime Minister -- for now, anyway. There have been rumors about who the Prime Minister will be, but nobody really knows. Neither does anybody know when this situation will be resolved and the new government installed.

By contrast, the US practice of knowing the results of an election before some of the polls even close is refreshingly expeditious.

We do not yet have any idea what effect, if any, Mr. Heyliger's removing himself from potential Prime Ministership will have on the future of timeshare owner consumer protection legislation.

13. A Convenient Place To Get Quality Souvenirs in SXM

Until it went out of business a while back, we used to recommend Rima, a beachwear and gift emporium on the pond fill in Philipsburg. Rima continues to function online, but no longer has a retail store on St. Maarten. (Rima online will soon offer JMB members discounts, one of a number of new businesses joining our discounts program, JMB Website Supporters.)

Last week, we walked into the Promenade "Mall" which in reality is a small retail alleyway next door to Little Switzerland in the heart of Philipsburg. We found Ashwin Sakhrani's Dimples Gift Shop, a place that offers embroidered T-shirts, sterling silver, Cuban cigars, resortwear for people of all ages, souvenirs, snorkeling equipment, and more. One difference we noticed quickly with some other retail establishments Is that Dimples caries really high-quality stuff, the kind of product you expect to last for years. We were quite impressed.

15. Where To Hear Caribbean-Style Christmas Music

Ever since we returned to the island before the middle of this month, when channel surfing on our car radio we have noticed Caribbean Christmas music, particularly on stations from neighboring Anguilla. If you like Caribbean Christmas music or have never heard it and want to, channel surf any time and you'll find it, probably until after New Year's.

Among the perennial favorites are "I want a piece of pork, I want a piece of pork for the Christmas," "Don't be like Santa and come just once a year" (a girlfriend's plea), and the unforgettable "All I get is a card," from a spurned boyfriend.

It's always interesting down here, and there is no snow to shovel.

16. Greek Night Returns at Vesna Taverna

It was only a couple of years ago that we first met Vesna and Yannick, the married couple who are behind Vesna Taverna in Simpson Bay, located a couple of hundred yards north of the Simpson Bay drawbridge.

Vesna is open seven days a week for breakfast and lunch and is now open for dinner as well from Wednesday through Sunday, as we noted last week. Vesna normally serves American, French, and Greek food, but read on.

One of the highlights of the week at Vesna is Saturday night, which is Greek night. Vesna spends the day cooking a significant number of Greek specialties, both meat and vegetarian, which she serves during the dinner hours. We'll say just three things here: first, make reservations since this is a very busy night; second, explore new menu items, letting your taste buds guide you; and third, leave room for dessert.

Vesna Taverna is also excellent for any meal during the day, as well as dinner Wednesday through Sunday.

17. Why People Make U-Turns on "The Hill"

If you're heading toward the union road in Marigot from Philipsburg, the customary way to get there is to drive over the hill into Cole Bay.

But sometimes, the hill isn't the best way to go, particularly during rush hour. (Yes, St. Maarten has rush hours.) Along the road on the hill, there is a 90° turn to the left. At the heart of the turn, you see what looks like a glorified driveway going uphill. If you watch the driveway, you'll find that it's actually a road taken by a number of cars, mostly local. The road in fact used to the dirt until several years ago when it was paved; we took it when it was dirt, which can be quite challenging and also a tad unwise.

Even today, we don't suggest taking the alternative to the hill on rainy days, since the road can get quite slippery. But that root is the reason many people occasionally do U-turns when going over the hill; they're simply detouring to the other route to Marigot.

18. Best Place to Watch Sports: SPN

If you are among the thousands of people who receive this newsletter by Sunday, November 23, and want to know the best place to get your fix of Sunday football, the answer is the SPN Sports Bar next to Pineapple Pete in Simpson Bay. Other than casinos, which can be smoky, SPN is a superb location with excellent and inexpensive sports bar food and reliable television reception.

St. Maarten is on Atlantic Standard Time, an hour later than the US East Coast. It means the game between the Lions and the Patriots starts on Sunday at 2 PM St. Maarten time.

19. Sargasso Seaweed on SXM Is Limited

Although it is still hanging around and some East-facing beaches, the amount of Sargasso seaweed now on the island seems to be slowly diminishing, as we've been reporting over the last couple of weeks. We're also seeing sand on beaches which had eroded from hurricane Gonzalo now replenishing itself around the island.

Will keep you posted.

20. Why You Should Tell Your Credit Card Company Before You Travel Overseas

Banks today are more conscious than ever about credit card fraud, especially given the screw ups this year by Home Depot and Target, among others.

For that reason, banks keep a close eye on unusual account activity and they may slam the door on any charges where they see such activity, even if the dollar amount is small.

Consequently, we suggest you contact your credit card companies and tell them in advance when you're traveling, to avoid unnecessary inconvenience. Also, keep an eye on the charges shown on your electronic credit card statements. You don't want surprises.

One final important reminder. We often see people putting pocketbooks, camcorders, cameras, laptops, iPads, and other valuables into their car trunk. They seem to think nothing of it. If we see it, so do bad guys. Never leave valuables in your car. If you have a Kensington lock and a laptop in your hotel room or timeshare, please use it; if you don't have one, Blue Point sells them inexpensively on the island.

21. Why You Might Want to Stroll Down Back Street

Although the commercial heart of the Dutch side is Front Street, downtown Philipsburg, many locals also shop on Back Street, where you can find low prices on everyday cosmetics, toothpaste, soap, nail clippers, etc. They also have good prices on inexpensive cologne -- think smelly sneakers. Check it out.

22. A "Tail" of Two Iguana Farms

Long story very short, the iguana farm is coming along very nicely at the 90° eastward turn on the road to Dawn beach/Busby's/Oyster Bay Beach Resort / Westin from the Philipsburg area. It had been built a couple of years ago, then was torn down and moved next door, we think because of border issues. In any case, the buildings are white and green and do not yet have signs. A woman who we think was an employee told us she thought it should open sometime in December, though we doubt it. We don't have any idea what the price will be but we did wander around one morning and found a number of iguanas, all skittish about visitors.

There is no other iguana farm but, if you go to the stream across the street from the Westin Resort and Casino at Dawn beach, you'll see a road sign warning of an iguana crossing and about a dozen iguanas in or near the stream. Within the past year, these iguanas have become accustomed to people and will look to you for their morning baguette or other suitable snack. They also are happy to hang out should you want to take pictures. Many more are in the big tree that's in the swampy area.

23. Where To Find New England Style Fish & Chips

One of our past Restaurant of the Week selections, Skip Jack's in Simpson Bay, widely regarded as one of the best spots for seafood on the island, is the only place here that might have traditional New England fish and chips featuring cod and haddock. But cod stocks new New England are collapsing, so fresh cod will be increasingly difficult to find. Skip Jack's is still an excellent place for fish and chips even if they choose another fish.

Vesna Taverna, which we mentioned elsewhere in this issue regarding the Greek night, also has fish and chips, but theirs is made with grouper. When we saw it a couple of weeks ago, we ordered it well done, or crispy, and it was quite delicious. It doesn't taste like cod, but it's quite good anyway and even more flavorful.

24. French Side Go-Kart Track Rebuilt; When Will It Open?

The French side go kart track administration building burned down more than a year ago. We noticed a few days ago when we went by the area that the two-story building had been reconstructed. No one was around, so we couldn't find out when the track will reopen. The track provided discounts to our members so we will let you know when it reopens.

25. Fresh Sushi, Reasonable Prices

Just a quick reminder to the sushi lovers among our readers that Sushiito at Princess Port de Plaisance Casino is, in our opinion, the best place to get sushi on the island. It has great food, very reasonable prices (unusual for sushi here), and Elisa, formerly of Bikini Beach on Orient beach. Definitely give it a try and let folks know we suggested you visit.

Sushiito is owned by Pierre "Pete" Ferland, the "Pete" of Pineapple Pete Restaurant and the SPN Sports Bar in Simpson Bay. You will find them among the dozens of SXM restaurants offering discounts to our JMB Website Supporters members. 26. "Restaurant Of The Week": Spiga (Big Changes This Year)

Every year Spiga surprises us. When you think it can't possibly get any better than it already is, it surpasses your expectations. Again.

The first thing we noticed on Saturday night was toward the back of the restaurant, where there's a new, second dining room and beyond it, an all-new, larger kitchen. Interior decoration is 98% done and the "sand" coloring is instantly relaxing and welcoming. The room should enable Spiga to turn away fewer people this year since it adds 26 comfortable new seats. The room can also be configured to handle parties; ask for details.

One hallmark of a restaurant that cares about the happiness of its patrons is its responsiveness to special dietary requirements. Spiga knows what it's doing and it excels at delivering consistently above expectations.

Although I normally order steak here -- which is always butter-tender and beyond delicious -- this time we went for Dover Sole and shrimp risotto along with Brussels Sprouts. The sole was perfectly cooked and flavored and the Brussels Sprouts were cooked to perfection, tasty and succulent without being overdone. Of course we started with our long-time favorite, Lara's pumpkin ravioli.

If you try only one recommendation from this edition, make it Spiga -- easily one of the island's top restaurants. Gourmet Italian at

reasonable prices (Dollars are accepted at par with Euros). Just absolutely extraordinary dining. See http://www.spiga-sxm.com/
