3. Now, Divi Little Bay Becomes The Target of Timeshare Owner Anger on SXM

A Facebook post today said that Divi Little Bay is sending out large bills for 2016 (sic!) timeshares -- in some cases more than double the usual maintenance fee. If you can scan and send us any explanation provided by Divi, we'd appreciate it. Initial reaction from a few Divi timeshare owners was negative to the point of saying "time to sell."

We have asked Divi to comment.

4. Oyster Bay Beach Resort Receiving Bouquets - and Brickbats

Winning awards and other accolades from its timeshare owners has become old hat to Oyster Bay Beach Resort, which has won quite a share of them in recent years.

The resort used to sell "flexible" weeks at a low cost, enabling people to stay there in the dead of winter for short money.

But eventually there are more would-be guests than rooms, so OBBR solved that by selling upgrades to time-specific dates -- that upgrade route costs money (a fair amount of it) but it also guarantees specific calendar weeks.

Selling winter week-specific upgrades further reduced inventory available for internal trades, so some formerly happy owners who always had traded found themselves unable to do so. Result, brickbats.

OBBR General Manager Ricardo Perez, who personally has received a number of OBBR awards, says it's a supply and demand situation. He said OBBR is willing to set aside specific winter weeks on a permanent basis, which timeshare owners want, but at a cost. Off season weeks are worth less; in-season weeks are more expensive, but some owners still aren't happy. Simpson Bay Resort in its "Pelican" days many years ago did exactly the same thing.

It's like trading a new Honda Civic (a great car) for a Lexus RX 350 (an outstanding car). The difference does cost money. It never should have happened since the "pilot" could have lost control and the drone could have been a serious danger to airplanes, passengers, and people on the ground in the path of departing jets.

We notified authorities and we know an investigation is already underway. The *Daily Herald* put it on its front page today (Monday) and ran an editorial pointing to the need for legislation to control drones and protect people... even if the drone pilot's only intent was to make a fun video. This was a dangerous and unnecessary situation.

19. Should You Still Go to the French Side for Gas?

French Side gas is now around € 1 per liter. Some stations do € = \$ and some don't. On the Dutch Side, prices are in guilders per liter. For years the Dutch Side was pricier, but now it's close; Delta Petroleum near McDonalds in Dutch Quarter is reasonable though chaotic. We still like the Cadisco station near the stadium in Marigot, opposite Simply Market. Pricing is still far higher at both than in the US, but good for SXM.

20. Where To Get Authentic SXM Johnny Cakes

Usually, Caribbean Johnny Cakes (nee: Journey Cakes) are fried dough in the shape of sandwich rolls. You can get a variety of sandwiches on Johnny Cakes (or other breads or rolls) at [Mr. Busby's Beach Bar](#).

Don't confuse them with Kenyon's Johnny Cakes, made in Rhode Island by one of America's oldest manufacturers since 1696 (not a typo). See <http://www.kenyonsgristmill.com/home.html> -- a good place to visit next summer.

21. SXM Government Making Life Difficult for St. Maarten Sea Palace Guests

Taxis should be able to transport passengers to and from hotels without interference from anybody. But for guests of the Sea Palace Hotel, it's not that easy. To make it nice for cruise ship passengers, Front Street is sometimes barricaded as a pedestrian mall. So cabs need to drop off passengers and all their luggage a distance from the hotel, and pick them up the same distance away, unless they get police permission first -- which is inconvenient to all concerned, especially when there's no fast resolution.

Taxi drivers who move barricades without doing any planned hotel drop-off or pickup should be fined. But there should never be anything limiting their ability to bring hotel guests to their hotel or take them to the airport. There's no excuse for interfering with that; it makes the "Friendly Island" look less friendly.
