1. Weather Stays Hot & Dry; Brush Fire Danger is High (See also story 19)

SXM news media hasn't covered it to a significant degree yet, but the island's grassy areas are bone dry now, with little significant recent rain. The island can use rain to reduce the likelihood of brush fires.

If you smoke, be careful out there; dry season can lead to brush fires from carelessly discarded smoking materials.

We're interviewing Regina Labega, who has years of tourism experience in SXM and has headed SXM Airport for the last several years. We're asking her about the timing of the new parallel taxiway; the planned central car rental facility (like in many US cities); the FBO facility for private and corporate jets, which come here by the dozens; and the latest on future airline service, like Southwest Airlines, British Airways, Arke Fly, and more. We expect to publish the results of our interview here next week.

4. Government Tells Us It Is Working on Timeshare Consumer Protection; What You Can Do

Unlike governments in the US, which constantly barrage voters with information about what's going on, the government of St. Maarten is relatively secretive, working in a number of closed-door meetings out of the public eye.

In the past, we've requested an interview with Claret Connor, the Minister responsible for tourism and a number of other areas. We still expect that interview to happen, but it's not imminent. We know he's up to his ears. We asked someone inside government point blank this week whether anything is actually going on related to timeshare owner consumer protection. The response: a strong "yes," though the government here doesn't give progress reports. (We've known this contact for years and he has always been straight with us.)

5. Simpson Bay Resort Rising To The Top of Timeshare Lists -- But Resales Are Slow To Catch Up

The heavy floor-to-ceiling renovations at Simpson Bay Resort, already completed in most buildings, are delivering quite spectacular changes that according to timeshare owners exceed all their expectations. We've received a lot of mail about it.

A few years ago, Simpson Bay / Pelican was a pariah, widely reviled and not wanted. But now it is a Cinderella story with lots of rave reviews from timeshare owners and other visitors. This year, the big Marina building is being redone.

The price of resales isn't rising as fast as their actual value though. So, it's a buyer's market. If you want to buy a unit being renovated this year, do it now; the prices are at their lowest and will only go up after renovations have been completed.

6. Top Timeshares: Royal Islander, La Vista, Summit, Mary's Boon, Bel Air, Oyster Bay Beach Resort,

and Divi Little Bay; Caravanserai & Sapphire, Not So Much

Not too many years ago, we were receiving so many emails about bad timeshare resorts that we published the "Timesharing In St. Maarten Email Forum" weekly. When the complaints started to decline, we blended that publication into Weekly News but we still occasionally publish timeshare owner comments.

Bottom line, though, is that most resorts are getting quite good marks from their timeshare owners. The two biggest exceptions: Caravanserai Resort, where owner Manek went bankrupt and the new owner declared all timeshare contracts null and void and was supported by a local court. Supposedly this is being fought in court. The future there is as clear as mud for all concerned.

The other exception is Sapphire Beach, where the Verdier Family has managed to alienate many of its timeshare owners through what they regard as quite inadequate maintenance. So many complained to RCI that RCI slammed the door shut on Sapphire exchanges, in or out of Sapphire, as we noted again last week. That situation won't change for another two months at least, but lately we've heard no further Sapphire complaints. Whether the Verdiers are finally doing their jobs -- or merely putting "lipstick on a pig" -- is for RCI to decide, but for now, reports are improving.

The good news: the other resorts listed in our headline are all getting nearly unanimous positive reports. The only real complaints about Oyster Bay regarded last fall's seaweed invasion, but complaints about that should be addressed to Mother Nature. That resort did as much as any resort possibly could to keep the beach clean of seaweed. We were there Sunday and it was clear, calm, and beautiful -- virtually free of seaweed. If you own there, it's time you went....

7. Why We Don't List Flamingo & Royal Palm

Although most timeshare owners we hear from who own at Flamingo and Royal Palm like their units, what they don't like is the enormous Annual Maintenance Fee increases they've been hit with. Those increases -- which some timeshare owners allege violate increase limits in their contracts -- have made their AMFs about the highest on the island, much higher from what we've seen than any others on the island. In our humble opinion, that borders on profiteering and we don't like it. Diamond Resorts, a US company which you might want to Google, is behind both timeshares.

The cost of these things is paid by duties on items coming to the country in containers (all kinds of freight including food). Food prices are already high and it seems unlikely the government would do any project resulting in still higher process.

16. Restaurant Question: How Can "Daniel Busby" Run Three Restaurants Even Though He Doesn't Exist?

Mr. Busby's Beach Bar, Daniel's By The Sea, and Island Pizza are all under the same roof -- scratch that, the same wonderful canopy of palm trees -- on the beach at Dawn Beach, Dutch Side, near Oyster Pond.

During the day, the restaurant is known as Mr. Busby's Beach Bar and at night, it transforms into candlelit dining on soft chairs at Daniel's by the Sea.

The same man -- Daniel -- is chief honcho at both restaurants. So, he must be Daniel Busby, right? Busy guy.

Busy guy, yes. Daniel Busby, no. The restaurant was purchased years ago from its former owner -- that would be Mr. Busby -- and today it is under the watchful eye of Daniel Jurczenko. If you've been around SXM for a number of years, you may remember Antoine's on Front Street, where we dined many years ago. "Antoine" was (and is -- he is alive and well and loves early morning fishing) Daniel's father. So, being a restaurateur is in Daniel's genes. If he speaks nearly perfect English with a bit of a NY/NJ twang, that's because he worked there for a while and knows American tastes.

But enough history. Busby's and Daniel's and Island Pizza share an unbeatable seaside location. Busby's for unmatched breakfasts and lunches and Daniel's for unrivaled ambiance and wonderful classic Italian dining featuring our favorite, their homemade fettuccine. Specials at night sometimes include fresh snook caught by ... wait for it ... Antoine, the man himself.

Third, vervet monkeys are another story. They travel in groups so if you see one, a dozen more are probably not far away. We've seen one

on this trip, running across Oyster Pond Road. Wherever residents have vegetable gardens, monkeys come.

They also like alcohol and have been known to finish people's drinks outdoors....
