SECTION 1: Getting There: Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. Dry Weather Prompts Heads-Up From Fire Officials

Dutch side fire officials issued a warning at the end of March for vigilance against the possibility of brushfires, in consideration of the island's recent prolonged dry spell.

If you're a smoker or if you do any outside burning on the island, including the use of grills, please be extra careful as dry season continues.

2. New Flights, New Airlines, and More: What's Coming to SXM Airport

A lot has happened at SXM Airport during the last year, but a great deal more is coming. That includes new airlines, new nonstop routes from more cities in the US, runway reconfigurations to enable incremental flights, and much more.

We spent 90 minutes late last month with Regina Labega, managing director of the Princess Juliana "SXM" Airport and the island's former director of tourism. She gave us substantial insights into the future of the airport. Since so much of what the airport does directly affects American and Canadian tourists, this article is oriented toward key developments coming to the airport that will affect arriving and departing tourists. Here goes:

The departure lounge has been completely reconfigured to provide a more customer friendly experience. The ambience reminds us of terminal 5 at JFK, the new JetBlue terminal, which has a number of shops and restaurants centrally located. The shops at Princess Juliana are centrally located at the exit from Security, enabling passengers to get souvenirs, drinks, gourmet burgers, and much more at new shops on the concourse.

But that's only the beginning. Much more is coming, Ms. Labega told us.

Better WiFi. Among the things that are coming are improved free Wi-Fi, with stronger signals and higher capacity. "We want everyone who wants to use Wi-Fi to be able to use it easily and effectively. Its quality isn't yet what we want it to be but it will be," Ms. Labega said.

Video Wall. A new video wall with enhanced flight information and airport site information is being installed.

Environmentally friendly landscaping has been planted, and environmentally positive LED lighting has been installed both on the runways and within the terminal building.

Interisland Hub Expansion. The airport has been intimately involved with the Air Services Development Committee of IATA. Through that committee, SXM Airport/Princess Juliana is working to enable the provision of local services in St. Maarten as a Preferred Hub Partner. This means that more electronic kiosks and E-gates are coming to the airport, expediting check in for all interisland passengers with passports by Thanksgiving day of this year. Initially there will be six kiosks which will provide 30-second turnaround for check ins for interisland travel.

Preclearance for US Citizens. The airport has been speaking with the United States TSA about the possibility of offering preclearance in St. Maarten for passengers with US passports headed back to the United States. This would enable immigration clearance to be completed for US bound passengers before they leave St. Maarten. Discussions are ongoing and an ETA is not yet known, since this requires payment by the airport to the TSA for providing the service. Expedited global entry check-in for trips back to the United States would be included, we were told.

Concerning airport capacity and terminal growth...

Terminal Expansion. The current employee parking area at the Eastern end of the terminal is actually on tarmac, and plans are underway to move employee parking elsewhere. By next season this time that area will be available for parking private and corporate jets, many of which could not be accepted during the 2014 – 2015 season due to lack of room. Eventually, the terminal will grow on this property, enabling the addition of a few new passenger airplane gates. That's expected to happen around 2020.

A New Main Runway Bypass is planned for the Eastern end of the runway. An arriving aircraft will be able to pull off the runway into the Bypass area enabling aircraft behind it to take off. The Bypass is expected to be completed during the 2016 – 2017 season. The parallel runway which we've written about before will be constructed in a future phase of airport growth, probably around 2020. The Bypass will enable the airport to accommodate additional traffic in the near-term.

Expanded Jet Fuel Storage. You may have noticed a number of fuel trucks traveling daily through Simpson Bay. Many make the trip to the airport to keep its fuel farm full. Nonetheless, fuel stored at the airport is still only a one-day supply. The airport is working to move and grow its fuel farm to enable the storage of a larger supply which would be adequate for a longer period of time.

The Central Car Rental Facility about which we've written before is still on the drawing boards, and it is expected to become a reality within about the next couple of years. The location will likely be near the current Crazy Cow location across the street from the airport. The facility would have its own garage enabling car rentals to be processed and customers to leave the facility inside their cars, removing the need for anyone to be shuttled to an individual off-site car rental facility.

More Nonstop Flights from More Airlines in Additional Cities to SXM. Concerning airlines and service from Canada, the United States, and Europe...

Ironically, JetBlue nonstops from San Juan seem to have been affected adversely by its lower-cost flights to New York and Boston. St. Maarten residents who had previously shopped in San Juan are taking advantage of lower-cost flights to Boston and New York and shopping there instead, Ms. Labega said. The San Juan flights are being promoted increasingly to help ensure their continuation, however.

More JetBlue Nonstops from Boston. The airport says that its nonstop flights from Boston have been a huge success and they may be further expanded.

JetBlue Nonstops from Ft. Lauderdale. Beyond that, JetBlue appears highly likely to be adding nonstops from Fort Lauderdale to St. Maarten, perhaps as early as this year.

Southwest Airlines Flights to SXM from BWI. In addition, Southwest Airlines is expected to introduce nonstop service from the United States to St. Maarten late this year or early next year — and that would be year-round service.

Possible Southwest Flights from Ft., Lauderdale and Elsewhere. At launch, Southwest service is expected to start from BWI Airport but it may well expand to Fort Lauderdale and even Houston Hobby. Once Southwest gets into a market, it tends to go whole hog — so it would not surprise us at all for Southwest to wind up providing nonstop service from both New York and Boston a few years from now. Definitely one to watch very closely since it could well affect flight costs from a number of cities.

Expanded Service from Europe. Internationally, both British Airways and Virgin Atlantic are looking closely at St. Maarten. Thompson Airways already flies to St. Maarten from Sweden and may add other markets. Arke Fly will add flights from Amsterdam and that could affect fare levels from there.

Canada is currently served by Air Canada, Sun Wing, Rouge, and WestJet, all of whom are doing very well and expanding service.

An airport hotel with 120 - 130 rooms is expected to be built across the street from the Airport by the 2017 – 2018 season.

Rapidly growing Brazilian Carrier Azul Airlines, founded in 2008 by Brazilian-born JetBlue founder David Neeleman, is also eyeing SXM. It would not surprise us to see them serve the island within the next couple of years.

Ms. Labega also said more entertainment is coming to SXM Airport to provide an island cultural showcase to passengers ... and more island photography will enhance the facilities.

In 2014, passenger traffic grew by 7.3% over the prior year despite Hurricane Gonzalo and Chikungunya affecting the 2013-2014 season.

As always, we'll keep you posted on all of these and many other airport developments.

3. Daily Herald: SXM Airport To Extend Runway, Closing Maho Beach & Sunset Beach Bar Permanently

Panic ensued early this month when the *SXM Daily Herald* published an article reporting that Maho Beach and Sunset Beach Bar would be permanently shut down because of a planned airport runway expansion project. The article said planes would be diverted to Anguilla and passengers would be sent to SXM by ferry. The project was called "Project Alpha-Foxtrot-Oscar-Oscar-Lima," using airline parlance. That spells "A-Fool" since the article was an April Fool's Day joke, following a long tradition of similar "jokes" on April 1 of years past by the Daily Herald..

In other words, it's a hoax and it won't happen. The airport was not amused, and neither were a lot of other people who were apparently unaware that the Herald does this every April 1 like clockwork.

Incidentally, Anguilla's runway is too short and the terminal doesn't have the capacity of SXM Airport, and neither do the ferries. So... don't worry ... be happy now. More: <http://tinyurl.com/o8e28xm> and <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=L3HQMbQAWRc> .

4. That \$500 JetBlue Gift Certificate Promo is Bogus

Another widely publicized recent hoax was that JetBlue would give \$500 Gift Certificates for people referred to them. That wasn't true either....

5. Hurricane Season Prolog

So far, initial predictions for the 2015 Atlantic hurricane season are looking positive for normally hurricane-prone Caribbean islands. Forecasters as of now are predicting a lighter than normal Cape Verde season -- that's significant for SXM since storms affecting SXM generally form in the eastern Atlantic near the Cape Verde islands. The ocean there is colder than normal right now and wind shear is expected to be high, which is likely to reduce the chance of tropical storm formation near the Cape Verde islands.

The reason for the lower ocean temps may be vast melting of the Arctic ice cap and of ice in Greenland, both affected by climate change.

Of course, one storm is all it takes. And storms can still form close to the islands. The season begins June 1 and ends November 30 and as always we'll keep you posted.

11. "St. Maarten Quarter," Huge Waterfront Development Project, Draws Lots of Critics; Will It Kill Philipsburg?

A month ago, we told you about a major new hotel development proposed by Royal Caribbean next door to the Dr. A. C. Wathey Cruise & Cargo Facilities. Now details and a photo have been released. The proposal is serious and getting a lot of attention on the island -- and not all of that attention has been positive.

"Sint Maarten Quarter is designed to create a fun-loving, vibrant waterfront destination with appeal to Island visitors and guests of all ages. Offering a blend of shopping, entertainment, recreation, and hospitality, Sint Maarten is a place with appeal to both visitors and residents. By creating a vibrant waterfront, Sint Maarten Quarter fills an important gap along the water's edge and helps transfer the Great Bay into one of the signature experiences for the Caribbean," says the website of the project's designers.

A *Daily Herald* article <http://bit.ly/1GzFVGc> reported that "A four-star 200-room hotel -- either Hard Rock or Marriott brand -- will include an infinity pool, meeting and conference rooms, and a fitness centre and spa. [Mark] Mingo [head of the government-owned corporation that runs the harbor -Ed.] is in favour of Marriott. A zip-line attraction will both start and end on the property, have no impact on traffic, and is meant to be a quick, fun attraction that can zip up to six guests from 0 to 60 miles per hour. A Reef Lagoon is planned, which will include stingray and shark sections, as well as an aquarium where visitors can walk underwater. These are proven tourist attractions, but are not found bundled together, which will make the development a novelty in the Caribbean. The Reef Lagoon will allow tens of thousands to experience Caribbean sea life without causing damage or environmental stress to St. Maarten's reefs. Retail brands selected include those popular in Europe, the United States, and South America. The retail products were chosen to complement local offerings and not become another jewelry mall.

"Other elements include a casino, up to 500 parking spaces and up to nine yacht slips," the Herald added.

Critics are saying the project is bad for SXM, that it will divert people away from Philipsburg businesses, be a sitting duck for hurricanes,

etc. The full story has yet to be told to St. Maarteners and until it is, we'll just watch it for you and express no opinion until all the facts are clear.

The island needs a high-draw convention center hotel but Philipsburg may not be the best location for it; Mullet bay might be ideal. It strikes us as more of a resort hotel, an odd project for Royal Caribbean which is behind it and an odd location as well.

In any case, as always, we'll keep you posted.

Cugini is in Simpson Bay between Carousel and Fedex, open every night but Sunday.
