1. Lots of Cruise Ships: Harbor Stays Busy

Lots of cruise ships continue to visit SXM, making things very busy at the A. C. Wathey Cruise & Cargo Facilities. April vacation in many school systems across the US adds to the crowds. Although high season is technically over, the island continues to be busy thanks to the freezing cold, snowy winter experienced in North America. April's cold spring in the Northeast has helped, too.

5. SXM Smaller Hotel of the Week, #4

Beyond the big hotels like Westin and Sonesta Maho, and timeshares like Simpson Bay and Oyster Bay, which we've covered here many times, SXM has numerous smaller hotels with lots to offer.

This is the fourth in a new series of brief articles on many of those hotels. Below, you'll see a list of all resorts covered so far, in reverse chronological order, most recent first. Watch for other articles in this series coming for the next several weeks.

When we first visited SXM on our own in 1979, our charter package included a stay at The Summit Resort. At the time its chalets were painted brown and white, looking more like alpine Swiss residences than tropical ones. Today, the chalets are coral and a light tropical green. Inside are free fast internet access, wide-screen TVs, big beds, and all the other condo-like amenities you'd expect. Their pool deck, which houses both a restaurant and a bar open to the public, offers stunning hilltop views of the quiet northern lagoon with visibility of Marigot, neighboring Anguilla, and even Creole Rock in the Anguilla channel. Inside the resort, which consists of dozens of chalets, are tropical gardens with lots of butterflies -- the gardens are the pet project of General Manager Ms. Patricia Evans, one of the most talented young managers on any island. (The lady is an MBA.) We continue to recommend Summit Resort highly; they are a multiyear recipient of our Everything St. Maarten Award of Excellence. The resort and the restaurant both give discounts to JMB members -- see the Secret Website for details. If you're not a member, you're spending too much on SXM; see article #27 re: our Membership Sale, which ends this Thursday, April 30. .

7. Dollarization Apparently Still on the Table for Dutch Side

Ever since "Country St. Maarten" was founded 4 1/2 years ago on 10/10/10, the old Antillean Guilder has remained its official currency. There was never any intention for that situation to be permanent. The major choices were some new currency, or dollarization.

For Americans, it doesn't matter much. Dollars are everywhere and are universally accepted although dollar Travelers Checks are not generally accepted, except at casinos. Dollarization is still under consideration apparently ... we'll continue to watch, no news yet.

Regardless of the final decision, we expect dollars to continue to be very widely accepted.

8. Marriott Is Likely Brand of New Hotel Coming to the Harbor

We've reported in detail recently about the big new resort coming to the Dutch Side Harbor. It looks like both the Seminole Tribe (Hard Rock Hotels) and Marriott are interested and the folks in the Harbor Group of Companies have said they prefer a Marriott.

We do not know who will operate the new resort hotel. We do know that Columbia Sussex operates the Westin and that -- as a huge operator of hotels, casinos, and resorts -- Columbia-Sussex had originally considered branding the Dawn Beach property a Marriott. Westin won out.

9. Hazy Future at Alegria / Caravanserai

For many months, there has been talk of plans to bulldoze much of what's left of Caravanserai Resort. One official of a hotel management company in New York that's apparently connected with Alegria reportedly has said that everything there except Dunes Casino will be bulldozed. If that's the case, it would explain why the resort doesn't seem to care about the fact that it's not at all busy.

There has not yet been any significant demolition on the property, nor has anything formally been introduced to the public about what's going there. One rumor which we're trying to confirm says that Marriott, or hoteliers using the Marriott brand -- remember them? -- are interested in putting a Marriott Renaissance hotel on that property. Whether that will happen -- and if so, what effect it might have on resort plans at the harbor -- remains to be seen, but we're watching as always. There are no plans for any timesharing at that location -- but Marriott does do timesharing.

10. SPN Sports Bar Becomes Coconut Grove Restaurant With TVs...

Restaurateur Pierre (Pete) Ferland operates Pineapple Pete, Sushiitto, The Alley, and until recently SPN Sports Bar in Simpson Bay. When major sports events have happened, SPN was packed; when they didn't, it wasn't.

Pierre knows what he is doing and is a greatly admired, award-winning restaurateur. He has received the Crystal Pineapple Award in the past as well as our Everything St. Maarten Award of Excellence -- this year for both Pineapple Pete and Sushiitto.

Now he is transforming SPN from a Sports Bar to Coconut Grove, a restaurant with TVs. Yes you will be able to watch your favorite sporting events -- right now basketball, hockey, baseball, and soccer -- but it's more of a

restaurant now as opposed to a sports bar where you'd watch TV while having a few beers and munchies.

Knowing Pierre, we know he'll do a fine job -- and for us it will still be the place do go to eat and watch sports on TV.

11. Club Orient Naturist Beach "Wicked" Busy

Much of the country has April school vacations and last week, it was lots of folks from Massachusetts. They and many others invaded the naturist beach at Club Orient, southern end of Orient Beach, French Side, for an all-over tan. Even at the end of March we were already seeing some high school and college students apparently trying naturism for the first time at Club Orient, and loving it.

It *is* "wicked" busy on the beach.

The Celine catamaran, built by hand by Captain Neil Roebert in South Africa before he sailed it across the Atlantic in 1996 (ask him about that sometime), was a great little cat that took thousands of people on island excursions for many years. Securely tied to its pier last fall, it was hit and sunk by a much larger boat that was not securely moored when Hurricane Gonzalo struck SXM.

The blessing was that at the time Neil was working on a catamaran / motor yacht that is close to twice the size of Celine -- and without sails it can go under the Causeway even when the Causeway "turntable" bridge isn't open.

The Celine Too runs scheduled trips a number of times each weekday and on some week nights, and it is available for charter for trips to nearby islands. You can set the itinerary, menu, etc. Beautiful boat, fantastic crew, and a great experience all around. See www.sailstmaarten.com or call Neil at 721-526-1170.

20. Seaweed Update

The Sargasso seaweed we've reported on since last summer does not affect the whole island and is certainly not constantly around. It tends to affect some eastern-facing beaches some of the time. Western facing beaches usually have no trace of it at all. And the naturist beach at Club Orient, open to everyone, is well shielded by a reef and is clean and beautiful.

21. Best Brunch: Westin, Without a Doubt

22. Exploring Anse Marcel

Anse Marcel, French Side, is best known as the region where the Pinel Island Ferry is. Go to Anse Marcel and bring your camera.
