SECTION 1: Getting There: Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. Hurricane Season Begins June 1

The 2015 Atlantic hurricane season begins June 1, less than two weeks away. Forecasters have predicted a less active season than usual, but it only takes one storm to screw things up. As always, we'll be watching and we'll let you know immediately if anything threatens the island.

In the meantime, you can check satellite images in the Caribbean by clicking weather at www.everythingstmaarten.com. If you are potentially in the track of a hurricane along the US East or Gulf Coast, or if you live in St. Maarten, we strongly urge you to buy a membership with www.crownweather.com, upon which we have relied for years for the most accurate storm forecasts. It is well worth the small outlay.

2. Southwest Expands Caribbean Service from Hobby; When To SXM? And From Where?

Southwest Air is expanding its service from Houston Hobby, where it's developing an international gateway. It has announced several new Caribbean flights but nothing to SXM - yet.

We remain convinced that Southwest will be flying to SXM sooner rather than later -- possibly as early as next high season -- but most likely from BWI as its initial main port of embarkation.

It could add Hobby later, but we don't think that's likely, certainly not any time soon.

3. Will JetBlue Be Expanding Service to SXM?

We predicted JetBlue service to SXM from both New York JFK and from Boston Logan well before it happened.

We are now repeating two similar items we previously reported.

First, we're convinced that JetBlue will be introducing service from Ft. Lauderdale (most likely) or possibly Orlando (less likely) within the next year.

Second, we are convinced they will also offer weekly nonstops from Washington National, where they're expanding, which will have a downward pricing impact on competitive flights from that area (esp. Washington Dulles and BWI). That may still be a year or two out, but we do believe it will happen. It will also be interesting to see a possible fare war between Southwest and JetBlue -- Southwest from BWI and JetBlue from nearby Washington National.

We'll keep JMB members posted on whatever we see/hear about this.

5. Caravanserai Timeshare Owners Group, TOCA, Cuts Off New Memberships, Appears Poised To Begin Offensive

Late last year, some Caravanserai timeshare owners -- armed with determination and no list of timeshare owners -- formed a timeshare owners association with the apparent eventual intention of going to court to squeeze some justice out of their situation. They promoted the association as best they could, hoping to share the burden of litigation since there is no such thing as class action lawsuits in SXM.

As many readers will recall, many but not all Caravanserai timeshare owners were notified by email last fall that their timeshare contracts with the old Caravanserai resort were null and void. A new party had bought the resort at

a bankruptcy auction and those folks had no interest in timesharing. Voiding the contracts meant that timeshare owners in fact owned nothing and had no rights at all, regardless of their "investment."

The island government has been talking for a long time about enacting timeshare owner consumer protection with teeth, but that still has not happened. Nor was there any obvious serious, lasting public attempt by the Dutch Side government to mediate and settle the dispute between timeshare owners and the new owners of Caravanserai, since renamed Alegria with the slogan "A world of happiness."

Effective May 13, TOCA stopped accepting new members. We infer from that that the group may be preparing to go to court sooner rather than later, though the group has made no formal announcement of its intent one way or the other.

Since there is no class action in SXM, any litigation that occurs will have an effect only on those litigating: it will not apply to people who are not a party to the litigation. We do know that the law firm involved is Lexwell, <http://lexwell.net/>.

8. Huge Uproar Over Plan To Put Housing on Emilio Wilson Estate

SXM is in a state of tumult over the government's apparent decision to lease out part of the Emilio Wilson Estate -- beautiful historic untouched preserved land in the center of the island -- for housing. Environmentalist Reuben Thompson writes:

Over the past twenty to thirty years, many residents; cultural- heritage activists, environmentalists, archaeologists, the late icon Mr. Emilio Johan Wilson himself and a number of international experts have called for the establishment of the Golden Rock and Industry Plantations, commonly known as the Emilio Wilson Estate, as a National Park and Protected Area. Numerous studies have concluded that the Estate is of immeasurable Cultural, Historical and Ecological value.

Mr. Wilson often expressed his desire to have the estate protected as he understood the significance of his property, he was however hesitant to trust anyone, including Government with the responsibility to protect and properly manage his estate. Wilson often expressed his concern that "they would look to build and mess it up", apparently he had good reason to be hesitant.

From the time Wilson purchased the estate in 1954 to his passing on July 5, 2002, Emilio kept his property in relatively the same state as it had been for generations, a tangible tribute to our many ancestors who were born

on, slaved on, lived and died on the property.

Based on my professional expertise as an environmentalist I too have often formally provided Government with advice regarding and submitted objections to plans for the development (read destruction) of the Emilio Wilson Estate in my capacity as a board member of the Emilio Wilson Estate and Sint Maarten Pride Foundations.

On March 18, 2015, Government one-sidedly decided to be in favour of editing the draft zoning-plan for the Cul de Sac area in order to facilitate the proposed Rain Forest Adventures Project, to grant the estate in long lease to Rain Forest Adventures (RFA) and to make provisions for the development of housing on a significant portion of this legally recognized National Monument.

Our Prime Minister, in his capacity as acting Minister of VROMI, perhaps through no fault of his own, seems to have been left with little choice but to formalize the agreements made by those who immediately preceded him as Minister of VROMI.

This granting in long lease of the Emilio Wilson Estate to Rain Forest Adventures for sixty years and in particular Government's intention to allow the construction of residences on this last bastion of Cultural and Natural Heritage is an inexcusable insult to our ancestors and constitutes a crime against our descendants.

There is no justifiable reason for these decisions which are in direct conflict with the area's status as a National Monument and will have immediate detrimental consequences for the residents of the Cul de Sac Valley.

Here we are, "Country Sint Maarten" where some of our decision makers constantly allude to independence, and the fact that we can handle our own affairs, yet Government forgoes a prime opportunity to showcase the island's ability to properly manage its own Natural and Cultural Heritage, opting instead to peddle the Emilio Wilson Estate off to foreign investors and to allow a housing project to desecrate the area. Why does our Government deem Sint Maarten incapable of managing its own heritage?

I can write a book or two on the reasons why Government's granting of the aforementioned long lease is improper and does great injustice to the people of Sint Maarten: the internal Ministry of VROMI documents on the long lease to RFA which were recently leaked and placed online, alone, are full of inconsistencies, inaccuracies and questionable decisions, but the fact of the matter is that over the years I have already said all there is to say regarding the Emilio Wilson Estate and there are no words to truly describe the consequences these decisions have on the wellbeing of the little that remains of our Cultural Identity and Natural Heritage.

Instead I will close off with some questions, perhaps one of our Honorable Members of Parliament will do their homework and care to call the Minister of VROMI into Parliament or take things a step or two further and advocate for the launching of a parliamentary inquiry into this case;

* Were the building and monument permits issued to Rain Forest Adventures (RFA) in 2012 placed on public review? Was the general public permitted the opportunity to provide input regarding future plans for the Emilio Wilson Estate, which is a National Monument? Was this information placed in the National Gazette as legally required?

* Was the Monument Council heard regarding the issuing of a monument permit to RFA?

* Considering Government is so intent on facilitating RFA, why did Government not opt to establish the entire Emilio Wilson Estate as a protected Area and make provisions for RFA to operate in it?

* Why did Government find it necessary to lease the Emilio Wilson Estate, a National Monument, to a foreign entity for 60 years, the equivalent of 3 generations?

* Were independent Environmental Impact Assessments (EIA) and Social Impact Assessments (SIA) carried out with regard to the RFA project as well as the plans to develop housing on the Emilio Wilson Estate? If not, then why not?

* Have the residents of St. John's, the Wyatt gap, Saunders, Mary's Fancy been informed of the noise pollution which will likely be associated with the establishment of the RFA amusement park at the Emilio Wilson Estate?

* Has an independent professional analysis been made of the stability of the Rock Formation to the top of the Emilio Wilson Estate/ Sentry Hill considering that the formation has shifted significantly in recent years?

* Has Government sought input from the Monument Council regarding allowing the development of housing on the Emilio Wilson Estate?

* Does Government intend to revoke the Monument Status of the Emilio Wilson Estate to facilitate the construction of housing on the Estate?

* Have the residents of the Cul de Sac valley, many of whom attended numerous zoning plan meetings regarding ideas for the district been consulted regarding the RFA and housing plans for the Emilio Wilson Estate?

* What direct consequences do the housing plans for the Emilio Wilson Estate have for the water-retention

capacity of the area?

9. Total Blackout Hits Dutch Side

Giving credence to the notion in some quarters that the Dutch Side electric grid is held together by bubble gum and spit, all the lights went out on the Dutch Side a few days ago, thanks to a cable that overheated and various other problems. The outage lasted a few hours.

GEBE, an acronym for an unpronounceable name, is the Dutch Side electric and water company. It seems to find the causes for its outages quite readily but seems unable to prevent them, though their frequency has declined in recent years. This one brought forth a lot of anger toward GEBE but nothing from them about any permanent solutions being on the horizon.

10. Maho "All Inclusive" Stance Hurting Maho-Area Restaurants; How You Can Help

You'll read elsewhere in this edition about a number of restaurant comings and goings. We expect there may be more in the Maho area, in the wake of the Sonesta Maho beach hotel's move toward being an all-inclusive property. What that means is that the guests who had used restaurants in the Maho area will now disappear since they will be using the restaurants inside Maho that are included in their room rate.

We have never advocated that any St. Maarten visitors go to any all inclusive property on the island. St. Maarten is known for its restaurants — close to 400 of them — and the variety and quality of those restaurants is probably unparalleled on any other island. You would be depriving yourself of a major part of the entire St. Maarten / St. Martin experience by not visiting a variety of island restaurants while you are visiting SXM.

The switch to all-inclusive status by the big Sonesta Maho beach has hurt area restaurants -- apparently even the landmark Pizza Pasta restaurant next door to Casino Royale.

If you love St. Maarten restaurants, patronize them; Trattoria Pizza Pasta, listed here last week as our Restaurant of the Week and a winner of our 2015 Award of Excellence, is an institution on the island and continues to be one of the most consistent and excellent places to dine on either side. We urge you to support it and other independent restaurants across St. Maarten and think twice about going to any hotel that is all-inclusive on an island that has been known for years as the Culinary Capital of the Caribbean.

11. Chikungunya Virus Update

A year ago, the incidence of the Chikungunya virus dropped precipitously after being near an epidemic level at the end of 2013 and the beginning of 2014. Education programs, heavy spraying, and increased prevention activity by ordinary citizens has had Chikungunya at almost invisible levels for the past year.

As the dry season ends, the island will continue to be vigilant against Chikungunya and its relative, dengue fever. We will continue to keep you posted but right now, as long as you continue to use mosquito repellent, nothing much is happening with Chikungunya or Dengue across St. Maarten / St. Martin.

12. Just in Case: Hand-held Bug Zappers

About a year ago, we bought a small handheld bug zapper on the island from in a small Asian grocery store. The bug zapper arced in its handle so we returned it and got another. The problem was that current ran through the grid constantly, making it unsafe to touch even when the on-off button was off, and wearing out batteries quickly.

If you are in New England, or visit here this summer, and you want to get a bug zapper to take to St. Maarten, buy

it at Ocean State Job Lot. Their price for the last few years has been about five dollars for one that is bigger than most badminton rackets. It is safe, batteries last a long time, it is large, and it works. We intend to take the batteries out, bring it with us to St. Maarten next time, and use it. Our experience with zappers bought on the island may not be typical, but it was not positive.

13. Sargasso Seaweed Update: Where to Go

We don't know whether the Sargasso seaweed outbreak on which we have reported previously was caused by climate change, a temporary shift in ocean currents, hurricane Gonzalo, bad karma, or something else. But the fact is that it affected the island for a number of months, particularly East facing beaches. Whether it will be around this summer, we don't know, but we can tell you this: from November through this spring, the condition of beaches on the west side of the island was excellent, and it remained so. The southern end of Orient beach, use by Club Orient and naturist visitors, remained remarkably clean probably because it's protected by a coral reef.

During our SXM trip we had a great deal of fun at many beaches and we know your experience will be the same.

14. Deep Sea Fishing

15. How To Adopt an Island Dog
