1. Hurricane Activity Likely to Jump by Mid August

Meteorologist Rob Lightbown of Crown Weather said this week:

A Very Busy August In Terms Of Tropical Storm & Hurricane Activity Across The Atlantic, Caribbean & Gulf Of Mexico Is Expected: There are troubling signals in the data that suggest that tropical activity across the Atlantic, Caribbean and Gulf of Mexico could really ramp up as we get into the first and especially the second week of August. In fact, we think that it could be a very busy August in terms of tropical storm and hurricane activity across the Atlantic Basin...

...What troubles me is that the overall wind shear from the eastern and northeastern Caribbean through the Bahamas into the Gulf of Mexico has been below average and more favorable for development than what is usual for this time of year. Should this continue, we could see favorable to very favorable environmental conditions for tropical development and strengthening in close to the United States, Bahamas and Caribbean Islands during August.

Even more potentially troubling is that there are some signals in the long range guidance that an upper level ridge of high pressure could build over the northeastern United States. Should this happen and we do see a pattern change that turns the mean eastern US trough into a mean eastern US high pressure ridge, it could guide any developing/intensifying tropical cyclones into the Caribbean, Bahamas, southeastern United States and Gulf of Mexico. This is something that is just a possibility right now, but it is ... being watched very closely.

Finally, history has shown that when tropical storms or hurricanes form in the area between the Lesser Antilles and the coast of Africa during June and July, like we have seen this year, it usually leads to an active hurricane season. ... This early season activity indicates that the environmental conditions will be favorable for tropical disturbances to develop as they push off of the coast of Africa during the peak of the hurricane season from August 15th to October 15th. So, as of now, we have had two tropical storms form already in the area between the Lesser Antilles and the coast of Africa and this *indicates to me that we are in for a more active than average Atlantic Hurricane season*.

According to <u>Colorado State University's Dr. Phil Klotzbach</u>, there were 11 other years between 1851 and 2016 that saw two or more tropical cyclones form in the area between the Lesser Antilles and the coast of Africa prior to August 1st. Only one of these seasons (2013) was quiet. Four of those eleven years were among the most active hurricane seasons on record: 1887, 1926, 1933 and 2005.

All of this is not meant to scare you, but instead to steer you towards getting prepared for the rest of the 2017 Atlantic Hurricane Season. If you haven't restocked your hurricane preparedness kit, take this quiet period to do that. **Prepare now to not be scared should a hurricane threaten or impact your area.**...

4. Protecting Timeshare Owners Without Gouging Them

In response to last week's article about huge retroactive timeshare fees being levied on Sapphire Resort timeshare owners, one very unhappy Sapphire owner wrote: "The retroactive billing is in addition to the HUGE assessment levied last year. And the increase for us is 71.4% in one year, the same as the retroactive fee they want. Where is the government now?"

As usual, the SXM government has remained mute. All it has said in the past is that it is looking at setting up a new bureaucracy, the Timeshare Authority, which some estimate could add a \$200/week cost to annual fees on every timeshare week owned on the Dutch Side. We strongly oppose that. There are far better ways to control and reign in abuses such as the one allegedly being forced on Sapphire timeshare owners *right now*.

To timeshare owners, a mute government is a government that <u>does not care</u> about their contribution to SXM's economy, which is huge. *The government needs to take creative, concrete action to protect timeshare owners -- not gouge them into oblivion by what is tantamount to a huge new tax levy*. Such a levy -- for the over-kill Timeshare Authority bureaucracy -- really could kill the goose that lays the golden eggs.

9. Govt. May Reroute Traffic To Prevent Fence-Hugger Injuries...

In a move that has both astonished and bewildered St. Maarten tourists and residents alike, a Dutch Side official is examining closing Beacon Hill Road that runs from Maho to Alegria (formerly Caravanserai) Resort into the entire Beacon Hill residential / villa / condo community, and rerouting traffic into Simpson Bay where it would enter Beacon Hill from the vicinity of Bada Bing.

The proposal is in response to the death of a New Zealand tourist who was blown backwards by jet blast from a departing aircraft last week after being unable to hold onto the airport fence, on which there's a huge warning that jet blast can cause serious injury or death. It was the first jet blast death on the island, though many have been injured.

Traffic cannot be rerouted quickly. For one thing, part of the area where the traffic would go has only beach and no current road. Building a road there would be highly problematic since after hurricanes the road could be washed away, possibly stranding residents.

Worse, this would throw all Beacon Hill business and residential traffic into Simpson Bay, greatly worsening current traffic jams there.

The plan would call for the road to be for all practical purposes removed, the fence pushed farther away from the runway, and the curbs removed. That latter move would eliminate the problem of flying bodies slamming into curbs, causing injury. But it would cause beach sand to go everywhere in storms, including onto the runway. It could greatly hamper the ability of fire, police, and ambulances to access Alegria and all of Beacon Hill.

Businesses are already howling because of the effect it could have on cruise ship tourists --cabs would be hampered from getting them as close to the fence as possible.

Lastly, many responding wondered why the quick and "inept" knee-jerk reaction to one tragic death which is in such stark contrast to multiple tourist deaths by drowning each year on both the Dutch and French Sides of the island. "If deaths are so undesirable, why don't they require lifeguards on every beach? That could save several lives a year. This plan will likely save no lives while inconveniencing hundreds to thousands of people every day and screwing up the island economy in the process. It just doesn't make sense," one tourist said.

10. Jewelry Store, Souvenir Shop Held Up

As Fall approaches, sometimes robbery rates seem to increase. This year it appears to have happened early.

From the St. Maarten police:

On Monday July 17th at approximately 10.45 a.m. the Emergency Central Dispatch received a call of an ongoing armed robbery at **Divinity (sic) Jewelers** located on Front Street across from L'Escargot restaurant. Immediately several police patrols were sent to the scene to investigate what had taken place.

While approaching the scene three unknown men with their faces covered were seen running away from the scene. The police summoned these men to stop but they refused to do so. Several warning shots were then fired by police. One of the suspects surrendered while the other continued running away. This suspect was immediately arrested

while a search for the other two continued. During the arrest of the suspect items stolen from the jewelry store were recovered. A vehicle which would probably be used as an escape vehicle was also confiscated.

The suspect was taken to the Philipsburg Police Station where he remains in custody for questioning. The search for the remaining suspects continues and the Police Department is asking anyone who may have information regarding this robbery to immediately get in contact with the Detective Department by call 54-22222 ext 213/214, the police anonymous tip line # 9300 or the Emergency Dispatch 911.

They're looking to catch up with much of the world on this. The issue is that it would raise the price of liquor which will reduce sales to tourists and hurt some businesses. Here is the story.

12. Possibly Coming Next Door To AUC: Two 20-Story Buildings...

What do you think of the idea of two 20-story apartment/condominium towers going up in Cupecoy?

A source of island information which has been exceptionally reliable to us for many years tells us that land is now being cleared across the street from the Starz casino and in front of AUC, which is apparently the site of the two apartment/condominium towers. They are to be constructed, we are told, by the same organization that has built many apartments/condominiums off Jordan Road near the Caribbean International Academy and Summit Resort.

Although our source says the project already has been approved by VROMI, a unit of the Dutch side government, it has not been announced -- so approval may not yet have been granted.

We'll keep you posted. Please see the next article.

13. ... Where Is the Infrastructure?

There appears to be nothing on the Dutch side resembling a zoning board in either the US or Canada.

Whenever any developer wants to build a commercial or residential structure in virtually any North American community, that developer must go before a board and prove that the project meets all zoning regulations and that any adverse community impacts would be mitigated. By law in many places, these meetings are open to the public, enabling people to learn about the projects and comment about them.

There doesn't appear to be anything like that in SXM. In some cases, projects appear to go before government officials in secret and are only announced after they are a *fait accompli*.

Three cases in point: first, the large condominium project that was originally expected to be constructed behind Shore Pointe condominiums, on land where a slave wall was discovered. For whatever reason, that project has stalled.

Second, the infamous Pearl of China project, a 776 room colossus that apparently would consists mostly of apartments for Chinese hemispheric salespeople. It was originally slated to go on Bel Air beach but didn't meet requirements for that property. Government ministers then said perhaps it should go on Mullet Bay beach, which would likely ruin one of the favorite relaxation spots for people from both sides of the island. The latest news, published here a few weeks ago, was that project backers were looking at Cupecoy beach itself, known for its remarkable sandstone cliffs which could well crumble during construction or after. We still hope that project never happens; many people believe it will contribute nothing to SXM's tourist economy.

Third, the two 20-story towers covered in the preceding story. As if the plan to close current access to Beacon Hill through Beacon Hill Rd. wouldn't screw up traffic enough, this plan could put perhaps thousands of additional cars onto the narrow two-lane road that goes from Cupecoy to the airport — a sure prescription for gridlock.

SXM Weekly News believes it's essential that infrastructure be fully capable of handling the increased traffic which will inevitably result from all this development -- should it actually happen. Effective government guardianship of the infrastructure means that roads must be seriously improved, the long-planned expansion of SXM Airport must be expedited, and more. There are no real estate taxes on SXM -- perhaps it's time that be considered on properties worth in excess of a certain amount. And SXM must prioritize a \$20-million annual promotional budget -- like Aruba. With that much promotion, it will have lots of tourists and all the funding it needs to make certain that infrastructure keeps pace.

Otherwise, SXM has a good shot of being known not as the Friendly island, but as the Gridlock island if all this development proceeds - not a good thing.

14. French Side Meets About Stinky Seaweed

As we reported last week, for a time ferries to Pinel island had to be shut down because of the exceptionally large amount of seaweed at the ferry terminal in Cul-de-Sac. The Pinel island beach itself was unaffected by seaweed, but the boats couldn't operate out of Cul-de-Sac because of seaweed there.

The French Side government met to discuss this and is working on advanced solutions, beyond what it has been doing since 2015 when the problem initially got serious.

Sargassum seaweed from the Sargasso Sea, far North of SXM. Changing ocean conditions, blamed by some people upon climate change, have caused millions of tons of Sargassum to be washed over a wide swath of sea, affecting the US Gulf Coast through Texas and into Mexico, and much of the Caribbean.

15. Dutch Side Signs MOU for Trash to Energy Plant

St. Maarten and Aruba share many things, the most ignominious of which is a large dump that sometimes catches fire. It has been the source of massive complaints in SXM, since cruise ship passengers see it upon arrival.

In recent years, many have suggested a trash to energy project which would slowly eliminate Trash Mountain and general electricity. Now, the island is moving in that direction: here's <u>the story</u>.

No details were provided about the size of a plant, when construction might begin, or when the plant might enter service, Nor was there any information on how its services would become aligned with GEBE, the "current" power company.

By the way, GEBE suffered another blackout several days ago....

16. Air France in Rough, Stomach-Jarring Takeoff

Airplanes are designed to withstand heavy turbulence, and flight crews are trained to handle it.

Nonetheless, turbulence rocked an Air France flight last week as it departed SXM Airport. It was taped by the airport webcam. We posted the video on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>. See it <u>here</u>.

18. Sublime at Summit, Spartaco at OBBR

To get there... drive from Mullet Bay toward Cupecoy, and you'll find Jordan Road -- a sharp right turn at the top of the hill before you descend toward Sapphire Resort. Follow Jordan until you see the gate at Summit Resort. If space allows, park in their lot and walk to Sublime on the pool deck.

If you're an old hand at SXM, you may have heard of Spartaco, a rather spectacular restaurant in Almond Grove that went out of business years ago.

Now, Oyster Bay Beach Resort General Manager Ricardo Perez has recruited Spartaco to run Infinity Restaurant at his resort. Spartaco has been there for months and his restaurant is getting rave reviews.

19. What Happened to Don in SXM?

Like the rest of us, Don and Mary Beth, from Rhode Island, love St. Maarten. During their visit to the island a year ago, Don fell and broke his hip.
