1. For Now, Storm Formation in the Atlantic Stays Unlikely

Thanks in large measure to a significant amount of Saharan dust that's blowing across the Atlantic basin east of St. Maarten, and to adverse winds in the tropical Atlantic, tropical storm formation in that area is currently unlikely. Forecasters are saying this may continue for a bit.

The Cape Verde hurricane season — during which the most significant storms for St. Maarten often form — is pretty much over. The entire hurricane season ends November 30, though storms have been known to form later and some have hit St. Maarten well into November.

We'll keep you posted here and on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u> as this awful hurricane season hopefully winds down.

2. Cruise Ships Returning Soon To SXM

Cruise ships start to return to St. Maarten in the first half of November. The island is talking with a number of operators to increase visits.

Many restaurants on the island already have reopened, though progress appears to be faster on the Dutch side. Cruise ship passengers often visit Philipsburg, where a number of stores are expected to be open to greet them.

We'll post more when ships start arriving...

3. Airlines Already Increasing Flights To SXM

Airlines will base their scheduling of flights to SXM based upon the volume of available beds more so than on demand. However, they are about to find out that demand is high and passengers anxious to visit the island are finding previously underutilized sources of accommodations helpful in making reservations. See more about accommodations in section 2 and especially in section 4 of this edition.

American Airlines already has resumed a flight a week from Miami, fed by widespread connections. And JetBlue restarts some service from JFK early next month, far ahead of its original announcement. Delta and some other airlines from the US already are serving the island, and Air France is providing service via connections.

4. Get Up-To-Date Tropical Outlooks, Watches, & Warnings

Major updates to the Weather section of our everythingSXM.com website were completed over the last few weeks.

In addition to many new real-time tropical weather graphics — including satellite images and new loops — our weather site has now been updated with the National Hurricane Center's latest tropical outlook; tropical weather discussion (for true weather geeks); and the latest forecasts, watches, and warnings for all active storms, plus new track models.

As we've said before, if you are in the path of an approaching storm, never use any website for life or death advice: always rely on directives from local authorities.

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

- 1) Crown Weather Services whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well.
- 3) Our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming. They were knocked off the air by Irma but are now back.

9. Irma Damage Estimate Now About USD\$5-Billion Island-Wide

Hurricane Irma damage estimates on St. Maarten/St. Maarten now top \$5 billion, \$3.5 billion of which is on the French side.

There, virtually everything was destroyed along Orient beach; Boulevard de Grand Case saw virtually all of its buildings pummeled, and downtown Marigot was hit with a punishing storm surge and breakers crashing into and through many buildings.

As we previously reported, hundreds of boats were sunk on both sides of the island and many vehicles were ruined by salt water, 185mph+ winds, flying debris, or a combination of all of these. The current damage estimate we are sure is closer to reality than its predecessors. But the final bottom line cost to the island will probably be even higher once lost tourism revenue is calculated in.

We'll keep you posted.

10. Summit Resort, Destroyed by Irma, Closing Permanently

Built in the early 1970s, Summit Resort was one of the few remaining vestiges of St. Maarten's charming, serene past.

Consisting of dozens of mostly two-story chalets painted in tropical colors in a garden setting, Summit harks back to a time when resorts were a place for pure relaxation in the natural splendor of true tropical ambience.

It was never posh, but nobody needed posh. Knowledgeable tourists, knowing the tradewinds off Simpson Bay lagoon provided refreshing breezes virtually every night, left their windows open at Summit — no real need for air conditioning here, though every room had it..

King size beds with green bedspreads bespeckled with gorgeous tropical flowers lit up the rooms, where ceiling fans helped the tradewinds on their way. There were modern conveniences, of course, including cable TV, free Internet access, a pool deck with a genuinely spectacular view of Simpson Bay lagoon, Marigot harbor in the distance, even Creole rock and Anguilla as well as the northern mountains.

Late at night, daring souls occasionally skinnydipped in their pool under the stars.

But it all came to a punishing end when Irma visited on that early September day, exactly 22 years after vicious Hurricane Luis which was puny by comparison to Irma. As we reported soon after the hurricane hit, she destroyed most of Summit's wood frame buildings, blew pieces of the pool deck hundreds of yards away, removed roofs, and in a few hours had done more damage to Summit than all hurricanes from the prior 44 years put together.

The first time we visited St. Maarten we went to the old Mullet Bay Beach Resort (MBBR) which until hurricane Luis hit had bordered the Mullet Bay golf course. That visit was part of a group meeting from New England Life. We enjoyed the island and returned less than a year later — visiting Summit Resort which at the time had chalets painted in white with brown molding.

It was our first real SXM vacation experience and we loved it, as did thousands of other regulars. After visiting with and explaining the fate of Summit to its employees late last week, owner Bruce Jakubovitz sent this message to the resort's timeshare owners:

Dear Summit Resort Hotel and Vacation Club Member.

As you know by now, Hurricane Irma struck the island of St Maarten in the early morning hours of September 6, 2017 as a Category 5 hurricane with sustained winds of 185 miles per hour and with wind gusts of over 200 miles per hour. The impact on our beautiful island was devastating. The impact on the Summit Resort Hotel was catastrophic.

Some of the Summit's buildings were flattened completely by the force of Hurricane Irma's winds. All but one of the Summit's two-story buildings had their second floors either partially, or completely blown off. Our single-story buildings lost roofs and suffered other damage. The pool deck was completely blown away with pieces from it landing by our front entry gate. Our General Manager's living quarters were destroyed as were the living quarters of our Head of Housekeeping. Our restaurant, bar, reception office, laundry facilities and maintenance building were each either destroyed or heavily damaged as well. There is not a single part of the Summit that has been spared from the destructive force of Hurricane Irma.

It pains me deeply to write this but the Summit Resort Hotel is closed for good. The cost of rebuilding far exceeds the amount of insurance for which the Summit qualifies. Had the Summit been destroyed by fire, insurance proceeds might have been enough to cover the cost of rebuilding. Hurricane insurance is prohibitively expensive however, as many of you may know, and our coverage does not provide anywhere near enough to rebuild. Having opened in 1973, as one of the first hotels on St Maarten, and having survived numerous hurricanes over the years including Luis, Marilyn, Lenny, Gonzalo and so many others, we were done in by Irma which was reported to be the most powerful storm ever recorded in our area. The loss is simply too great and we have no plans to rebuild or to reopen at any time in the future.

Like me, many of you have been visiting the Summit for decades and it truly is your "home away from home" in St. Maarten. I know that many of you think of our staff like your own family and they think of you the same way. Unfortunately, some of our staff lost their homes in the hurricane and all of our staff will soon be unemployed as there is no way to keep them on the payroll when the hotel has no revenue. For this reason, I greatly appreciate the donations that so many of you have made to our fundraising campaign to support the Summit staff. Article 2 of the Summit Resort Hotel and Vacation Club Terms and Conditions states:

"Should the Unit not be available due to acts of God or other reasons beyond the reasonable control of the Lessor, the Member may receive his pro-rata share of the insurance or condemnation proceeds so generated or the Lessor may elect to repair or rebuild the Unit and extended the Member's benefits for the length of time use was not available."

Unfortunately, repairing or rebuilding is not a possibility given the enormous gap between, on the one hand, the estimated rebuilding costs and, on the other, our limited insurance coverage and our limited revenues from timeshare and hotel operations. Therefore, in accordance with our Terms and Conditions, each of you will be receiving a prorata share of the limited insurance proceeds generated. We are waiting for our insurance company to complete its assessment and to finalize the amount it will pay out in total. Once this is done we will be able to calculate the prorata share of the proceeds that each Member is entitled to and communicate this to you. This is likely to be a low number though given the sublimit imposed by our insurance carrier for damages caused by hurricanes.

We will need each Member's correct physical address, telephone number and email address in order to get this information to you. If this letter has been forwarded to you by someone else, please make sure to contact us, at info@thesummitresort.com, and give us your up to date information.

On a personal note, I would like to thank each and every one of you for your many years of visiting the Summit, for the friendships you built and maintained with our staff, for the support you offered for all the upgrades and improvements we did to the property over the years and for the warm and friendly atmosphere that each of you helped create at the Summit.

I am proud of all our accomplishments, and of all the awards we won over the years as well. Especially that, in what turns out to be our last year in business, we won TripAdvisor's highest honor, the Travelers' Choice Award. The Summit was never about the physical buildings and rooms but, rather, the Summit's beauty was in its people and each of you were one of those wonderful Summit people.

I hope you each have good memories of the Summit, as well as lots of pictures too, and will cherish those in the years to come.

11. Is Ocean Club "Closed Permanently"?

Ocean Club St. Maarten's Facebook Site reads "closed permanently" -- or it did through Saturday night, to the astonishment of a number of Ocean Club timeshare owners who visited its Facebook site after unsuccessful attempts to contact the resort.

We wrote to the resort to ask whether the resort was in fact closing permanently. Their Facebook site on Wednesday was revised to read, "The Ocean Club is closed until further notice, due to the devastation caused by hurricane Irma. To our Members, you will be updated via email as we have done previously. If you are a member and have not received an update email from us, please let us know via info@oceanclubstmaarten.com." In response to that email, we simply received a brief form letter: "Please be informed that the due to damage caused by Hurricane Irma, the resort is closed until further notice."

There has been serious damage to the resort based solely upon observation of aerial photographs, one of which we posted on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>. But the resort by press time had not answered our very specific question about closing.

Hopefully they are not "closing permanently" and simply are too busy coping with this catastrophe to bother with press questions.

12. Timeshare Resorts' Escape Hatch: Force Majeure Clause

Although we've been aware of the existence of these clauses for some time, we don't think timeshare owners have even read them, let alone understand them.

Force majeure clauses in timesharing contracts and elsewhere — according to a Google search — mean this:

A "force majeure" clause (French for "superior force") is a contract provision that relieves the parties from performing their contractual obligations when certain circumstances beyond their control arise, making performance inadvisable, commercially impracticable, illegal, or impossible.

St. Maarten timeshare resorts are honorable businesses that live up to their commitments to timeshare owners. But Irma was the strongest hurricane on record in the Atlantic basin, and the second strongest known tropical cyclone in the planet's recorded history. As you're well aware, Irma it ravaged the island and damaged or destroyed some 90% of its buildings.

If you have not yet heard from your timeshare resort about its future — or if you have not read that resort information in the Files area of our Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site — you should be aware of this clause and you should check your timeshare contract to see whether it's there.

If your resort closes, this clause explains how it can happen.

13. More Than 100 Royal Islander Employees Get \$500 Each in Food Vouchers

To bring you up to date we [made] the first distribution of \$51,500 on Tuesday October 17th 2017 when Ed Misiph, a long time owner at the Resort whom is known to many owners, and myself are traveling at our own personal expense to the Resort to personally distribute the delivery of your contributions.

All employees and folks who are part of the Royal Islander experience (103 folks) will receive Food vouchers worth US\$500.

We are also taking 200 lbs of clothing to be shared. Once we are there we can consult with the folks on the ground as to how best distribute the balance of relief and the best use of funds. One idea I am considering is shipping a container of clothing and other goods in the new year from my winter home in Florida. More information will be forthcoming. Please note more funds are needed so if you know people who may not have contributed please share my posting.

Some are listed on AirBNB and others on VRBO, but many local listings will be in the hands of Anju Snow at Island Real Estate Team, our real estate partner on the island headed by Arun Jagtiani.

This Wednesday, October 25, our much heralded Villa rental page on everythingSXM.com goes live. It currently (as of today, Monday) shows villas we recommend and contacts for reservations. JMB Website Supporters members who own villas are now entitled to submit villas for rent to us to be added to this page — so you should expect a significant number of additions coming soon. The page is here.

It's a distinguished recognition since only the top 1% of all restaurants receive this coveted award. Spiga is currently on its annual closing and is making repairs to some damages caused by Irma. We'll let you know when we hear it's reopening.

17. Lee's Roadside Grill Reopens; Court Date Delayed Until Nov 17

Lee's Roadside Grill suffered significant damage when St. Maarten was struck by hurricane Irma. Thanks to aggressively executed repairs, Lee's has already reopened.

As many readers know, Lee has been waging a long battle with his landlord. The landlord wants to throw Lee's out of the building and Lee's wants to stay right where it is.

A court date had been set for mid September, but that was abandoned because of the hurricane. Another court date

has now been set which may decide things: November 17.

As soon as we hear any results, we'll post them here and also on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>. Lee also posts news <u>here</u>.

18. Canoa's Sherman Marten's Rum & Peas is Open

Although our headline for this story is a bit funky, the message is crystal clear.

As we recently reported, the Canoa restaurant on the pier at Greathouse Marina was destroyed by hurricane Irma, as were many other restaurants.

Fortunately, Sherman Marten's culinary expertise is still on display at his newer restaurant in Simpson Bay, Rum and Peas. That's the restaurant that consists of a number of large shipping containers.

The Greathouse Marina owners are scheduled to return to the Marina this week, after which we may hear more about the future of the Marina and the businesses on it, which included Pier Grocer and a rotisserie chicken take-out place.

19. Vesna Taverna Sets Night Hours

Vesna Taverna, long one of our favorite restaurants on the island, reopened for breakfast and lunch a couple of weeks ago and for dinner last Friday night.

Dinners are currently served only on Friday and Saturday night. When that changes, as we're sure it will, we'll let you know. If you haven't yet visited Vesna's, check their website: vesnataverna.com. The restaurant is terrific and has been a long time recipient of our Award of Excellence from everythingSXM.com.

20. What's Happening in Grand Case - And Why

If you walk through Grand Case, chances are you won't see a great deal of progress in restaurant rebuilding. Either before or soon after the storm, a number of restaurateurs left the island and some have yet to return. In addition, not all restaurateurs own the property in which there restaurants are located. Rebuilding is up to the property owner; nothing can begin without their input.

The next few weeks should see an uptick in rebuilding. We have eyes in Grand Case and will keep you posted on what's happening there.

21. Marine Trades Assn Launches New Website for Yachts

If you're a yacht owner, crew member, or captain, you can benefit from reviewing the new website of the St. Maarten Marine Trades Association which delivers substantial information. Here's the site.

The homepage picture is one of the best images we've seen of Venus, the late Steve Jobs' yacht as it was entering the lagoon at some point well before the storm.

22. Electricity "Close to Normal" On Both Sides of SXM

Neither water nor electricity is fully back to normal yet on the island, but we're told electricity right now is nearly

normal.

The desalination plant that produces water for the Dutch side was beat up by Irma. The last news we had on it was that it was not yet fully back in service. Bottom line, there is lots of progress but it still will be a while before the island is fully back to what it was.

If you plan to return soon, do not expect SXM to be like it was. It's quite different -- slower, quieter, enormous mountains of debris concentrated at some points, many places closed, boats still submerged, cars looking like King Kong threw them at walls, hundreds of businesses beaten into unrecognizability.

This will take a while.

23. Richard Branson Eyes Marshall Plan for Rebuilding Caribbean...

After World War II, there was a massive plan for rebuilding Europe called the Marshall plan, named after Secretary of State George Marshall.

Branson, who heads both Virgin America Airlines and Virgin Atlantic, and as well as numerous other ventures, has proposed and is attempting to implement a Marshall plan for the rebuilding of Caribbean islands that were all but destroyed by hurricane Irma last month in the Caribbean.

Here's that story.

24. French Side Looks at Tinker-Toy Like Beach Building Solutions

A few years ago, a comparatively mild-mannered hurricane named Gonzalo whacked a number of old restaurants on Orient beach between Pedro's and KonTiki upside the head.

The restaurants were long in the tooth, didn't have real running water, and were becoming what the Reserve Naturelle regarded as eyesores.

Although the Reserve's new buildings looked sterile when they were first inhabited by beach businesses, those businesses soon personalized the buildings and by last winter, the new buildings had taken on unique personalities that were well-suited to the beach.

Then Irma came, demolishing all the new buildings plus hundreds of others. All she left were the new units' bright, shiny roofs -- sitting atop rubble.

The French Side has apparently had enough of this. It's now saying it wants the next iteration of replacement beach buildings to be capable of disassembly should another major storm approach. Our sense is that they would like structures similar to big tradeshow booths, that can be taken down, put in crates, and removed in hours to someplace safe. That's vaguely reminiscent of tinker toys -- also relatively easy to disassemble.

We'll keep you posted.

25. Two SXM-Related Travel Disasters

Donald Thompson and Mary Beth Fairbrother read *SXM Weekly News* and were preparing for a trip to St. Maarten, so they got SkyMed for the trip. <u>Only weeks later in SXM, Don fell and broke his hip.</u> After an ambulance trip to the hospital, they both decided they needed and wanted to get Don home for treatment. I believe the civilian side is going to be in a crisis over the coming years with a shortage. It's a long story, but in a nutshell, Congress (which as you know is great at screwing stuff up) changed pilot requirements after the Colgan Air Crash in 2009 which has made it VERY difficult

and very \$\$\$ for a young person to get into aviation.....and now we are starting to see the results."
