1. Hurricane Season Ends Nov. 30

Although there are only a few days left of the 2017 hurricane season, unfortunately all of us will remember it the rest of our lives.

Hurricane Irma was the most powerful Atlantic hurricane in history and the second most powerful tropical cyclone in recorded world history. It made a direct hit on St. Maarten with sustained winds of 185 mph and gusts reported to be in excess of 220 mph.

Hurricane season begins June 1 and ends November 30, although storms have been known to form outside of that schedule. We will keep our eyes open even after the season ends.

To see a substantial amount of information about Caribbean weather all year long, go to our everythingSXM.com website and click Weather; that brings you to our Weather Center which offers current satellite images and image loops, weather radar, and tropical forecasts.

Should anything unexpected happen affecting weather in SXM, we'll report it quickly on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>.

2. SXM Airport Runway Lights Being Replaced

The LED landing lights which guide aircraft on SXM Airport's runway and its taxiways were knocked out by hurricane Irma. New lights have arrived and are, as we understand it, in the process of being installed.

Once they are installed, tested, and operational, the lights — in concert with the control tower, which had also been knocked out by Irma but was later restored — will enable aircraft to fly into and out of SXM Airport at night. See much more about airport operations in stories 3, 4, and 21.

3. Bigger Tents Due at SXM Airport

While SXM Airport's terminal building continues to undergo repairs to its roof and infrastructure, which were heavily damaged by hurricane Irma, arriving and departing passengers are served in temporary tents outside the terminal building. We've heard that those tents may be replaced by larger versions to accommodate passengers from increased numbers of incoming aircraft.

Regardless of what size the tents are, local people are greeting arriving tourists warmly and welcoming their return to the island. The precise date of the main terminal's return to service is not yet clear; as soon as we know, we'll pass along the information. We asked airport staff members but had not heard from them by transmission time for this issue.

4. Which Airlines Are Flying to SXM From Where?

We're keeping a close eye on frequently changing airline schedules involving service to SXM.

American Airlines, Delta airlines, JetBlue Airways, and United are the main US carriers to SXM. We update information about their points of embarkation from the US to SXM and the frequency of service as soon as we receive their schedule updates. That information will shortly be posted in the Files area of our Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site, in conversation threads, or both.

Since it takes almost three days for this newsletter to reach all of its recipients, it makes no sense for us to post that info here since it could change by the time you read it. So, for the latest data, do see our Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site. We'll be posting updates there upon receipt.

5. Get Up-To-Date Tropical Outlooks, Watches, & Warnings

Major updates to the Weather section of our everythingSXM.com website were completed over the last few weeks.

In addition to many new real-time tropical weather graphics — including satellite images and new loops — our weather site has now been updated with the National Hurricane Center's latest tropical outlook; tropical weather discussion (for true weather geeks); and the latest forecasts, watches, and warnings for all active storms, plus new track models.

You can access all this information free, as always: just go to everythingsxm.com and click "Weather" in the masthead.

If you are prospectively in the path of any future approaching storm, we urge you to visit crownweather.com and to sign up for their incredibly inexpensive detailed forecasting service. It's by far the best on the web and it can prove highly useful to you, your family, and your business.

As we've said before, if you are in the path of an approaching storm, never use any website for life or death advice: always rely on directives from local authorities.

6. Four Sources of Current SXM Weather Info (Revised 10/8)

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

- 1) Crown Weather Services whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well.
- 3) Our Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming. They were knocked off the air by Irma but are now back.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

9. Two Big SXM Timeshares Re-Open Soon

Both Atrium Resort and Sapphire Beach Club are reopening early in 2018.

Sapphire Beach Club was built very well and has made it through several hurricanes including Irma in comparatively good shape. Like virtually all SXM structures, it has required some post-Irma fixups. But the Beach Club is expected to reopen early in 2018.

Atrium Resort is already serving craftspeople involved in rebuilding SXM, and it is advertising its availability to the community. Timeshare owners are saying that they have been told their units will be available early next year. Timeshare rentals from Atrium for 2018 already have been posted on our everythingSXM.com website.

Bel Air Beach Club will open during March, as previously announced here.

14. Court Rules Against Lee's; They Must Vacate by February 1

Lee's Roadside Grill, an institution in Simpson Bay for decades, appears to have exhausted its last appeal and has been ordered by the court to vacate its current premises by February 1, 2018.

Although the court has had its say, few customers expect Lee to go meekly. Some customers are already saying in

social media that regardless of what other businesses go on that property, they will be met by a customer boycott.

There are other properties in the area that could be available should Lee's decide to relocate.

We don't expect this will be the last you'll be reading here about Lee's Roadside Grill.

Richard at Lee's posted this on their Facebook site: "Lee's Roadside Grill is 25 year establishment by a local in Simpson Bay that has reopened, with no help from the SXM government, but for the people of SXM to try to bring normalcy for the people and the island. Does the Sxm government not see this? what is their motive for not supporting Lee's and the island folks? Lee's is a tax revenue generating business for the benefit of everyone. So many businesses closed because of Irma and now they are closing a business that is open. No surprise Holland wants back in to restore all the wrongs."

15. Meyers Named New Dutch P/M; Elections in February, New Parl. in April

Franklin Myers, who has long been involved in Dutch side politics, has been named Country St. Maarten's new Prime Minister.

As we previously reported, former Prime Minister William Marlin was thrown out by Parliament after they conducted a vote of no-confidence and Marlin lost his majority coalition government.

New elections are now expected in February with a new Parliament expected to be formed in April even though no one except Marlin seems to want elections.

Here are details.

19. "Below Deck" in SXM Winding Down

The long-time Bravo cable network hit Below Deck, about yacht crews, shot last March in SXM, only has a few more episodes to air this season. The primary theme this year seems to be how does a luxury yacht deal with a green crew.

SXM offshore and onshore attractions are featured in the production. We do know that some taping was done for a crew dinner at Toppers but we don't recall having seen that dinner yet in the broadcast — so it may still be coming.

We've asked people associated with the production whether there has been any decision on renewing Below Deck. They haven't heard but since Deck is one of Bravo's biggest hits, we expect it to be renewed.

We also don't know whether filming will be done again in St. Maarten. We're told it could even move out of the Caribbean -- that has not been decided.

If it is renewed and you are interested in being on the program as a charter guest, you'll need to contact Bravo and submit information to the production company. You do pay a reduced rate for the charter, but it isn't inexpensive and there is very little privacy.

We'll keep you posted.

20. Viking Cruise Ship Due 12/4; Royal Caribbean Returns 12/17

The cruise ships are about to return to St. Maarten.

Viking cruises will kick off the post-hurricane cruise ship season on the island in two weeks, on December 4. Royal Caribbean will return to SXM on December 17.

December, 2017, will be far from a normal December, however — with comparatively few ships. But SXM already has more to offer than was expected at this point — far more — so ships are coming back faster than expected. Increasing numbers of cruise ships should be expected through the winter and that will have to serve the island's economy for a while. Some timeshares are coming back near the first of the year (see our story in this issue), but most won't be back online until the spring — when tourist traffic normally starts dropping off.

An interesting point here is that SXM has suddenly become more similar to what it was physically 30 years ago rather than what it was before Irma.

Virtually all the beach bars and restaurants that were on Orient beach have disappeared. In their place, there is a very wide, beautiful beach from which virtually all debris has already been removed. If you review pictures of it on our Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site, the image you'll see will be just like the beach was in the late 1970s before development began.

This means, of course, that there are virtually no beach bars, restaurants, or even chair rentals; bring a blanket and snacks and something to drink, and don't expect a lot of company. When we first visited Orient during the winter of 1978, the entire beach had perhaps a few dozen people on it. By contrast, average winter days over the last several years have seen a few thousand people on Orient.

Many people like it as it was 30+ years ago — and as it is right now. See story 23.

21. Why More Planes Aren't Yet Flying to SXM

Airlines fly their planes on routes that offer the opportunity for full flights. Since St. Maarten offers thousands fewer beds for stayover tourists now than usual, airlines believe they have no reason to fly full traditional schedules to SXM. The demand can't exist because there's no place for many of these people to go.

Of course, there is demand from St. Maarten loyalists. But many long-time St. Maarten travelers own timesharing or rent out condos at timeshare resorts when they come to SXM — and most timeshares will be closed for at least the next few months.

It's a vicious circle. Describe it anyway you like, but it's bad for St. Maarten's economy and it gives shivers, literally, to people who won't go anywhere else and who are staying home in the frigid North this winter.

Although the demand is less now, there are plenty of places to stay, more than adequately covering that demand. Please see stories 11 and 12.

22. Travel Writer's Impressions of SXM Airport Now

Susan Campbell is a seasoned, highly accomplished travel writer. She spends much of her time traveling the world and writing about it, though she spends a plurality of her time in the Caribbean. If you read travel reviews, it's highly likely that you've read some of Susan Campbell's writing without knowing it. Here it is:

"As a long time visitor and senior writer for *St. Maarten Nights* magazine, I was closely following everything Irma on the island, and was slated to fly through there en route to Saba for quite some time. But as the devastation unfolded, and the airport was ravaged I wondered if I would have to find another route. But when the airport reopened so quickly, I was curious as to the kind of experience it would be, and I'm happy to report it was very pleasant indeed considering the circumstances.

"Upon flying in, the water looks as enchantingly inviting as ever, but you do begin to notice tell-tale signs of the storm -- the bright blue tarps pop against the checkerboard landscape from above, and the little planes still lying totally upside down along the runway are your first clues. And when I saw the state of Mary's Boon, I almost cried. But upon disembarking I began to feel a different, actually positive, energy.

"It began with an airport worker bounding up the stairs of my Delta plane to help me with my bags when he saw I was struggling with my carry-ons getting tangled in the rope. He simply grabbed them and smiled and ran down to wait for me. That NEVER happened before, and I was grateful.

"Then we passed through customs in less than a minute. There is one desk and one window, they asked few questions and then, I was off. I had a fairly long layover so decided to leave the airport and look around before circling back to the entrance, wherever that was located now.

"Taxi drivers where lined up eagerly waiting for customers and were most helpful in guiding me back to where I would check in for my next flight to Saba via Winair. Rolling my bags around the corner I began to see some aftermath -- not so much of the island, construction crews were busy on the surrounding land -- but of the airport itself, starting with the sign. Then suddenly, it began to pour.

"I took shelter in a covered corner where one of the doors to the entrance used to be and peered inside, what a mess... and it was leaking like a sieve. I waited for the rain to subside along with workers who were stopped in their tracks because of the rain, but they were surprisingly upbeat. As I waited, it occurred to me though this was a short inconvenience for me, these folks probably had no power or maybe roofs, or even houses to return to, yet were bent on helping me out. It was a reality check.

"Once the rain stopped and I rounded the corner, I spied a bunch of white tents, not looking as I had imagined as a refugee camp for travelers, but more a Kiwanis tent set up at a town fair. And again, those waiting for passengers to approach were surprising cheerful and helpful. Checking in was a breeze, there are a few pop-up counters under another large tent, and security was far faster than I had ever encountered when the airport was all snazzy. It was very well organized.

"On the way to security there is a big market café set up and a pop-up store for sundries and duty-free smokes, but by now I was seeking a washroom. I imagined I would have to go outside to some kind of "porta-potty" installation, but no, inside there are four bathrooms with running water, well kept and well stocked.

"Yes, it was hot without air-conditioning, but there are plenty of giant fans you can position yourself in front of while you wait to board at one of the two gates open. But don't wait there; keep walking behind a makeshift wall to find a surprising little village of offerings. There is a bistro style take out, a Relay store, a small duty-free and even ice cream and Domino's pizza set ups. But best of all, there is a bar!

"Taloula's Flight Bar (an offshoot of the famous anchor bars on the boardwalk -- The Blue Bitch Bar and Taloula Mango's) has a very comfortable pop-up set up with lots of tables around it and big fans pointed at customers. And though you cannot order complicated tropical cocktails like Pina Coladas, you can enjoy ice-cold beer and basics like rum and coke etc. And their bartender Trudy Witter is a delight- a true ray of tropical sunshine. The bar was packed with travelers, all with their own St. Maarten stories and connections to share, and before I knew it was time to board. There and back, all went so very smoothly, it was not a challenge at all. So don't be shy to travel to or through SXM Princess Juliana Airport right now. It might be badly bruised, but definitely not broken. #SXMStrong.

23. The Changing Face of Grand Case and Orient Beach

A year from now, both Orient beach and Grand Case could look significantly different than they did either before or after Irma.

Long unenforced seaside zoning regulations will affect apartments on the beach and restaurants over the water in Grand Case. Sources with knowledge of the regulations tell us that neither private apartments nor condominiums will be allowed on the water side of Boulevard de Grand Case. Consequently, one Grand Case restaurateur tells us, you're likely to see a number of new restaurants in Grand Case along the water. Before or after Irma, some restaurateurs concluded that enough was enough and they left the country. But there will be new building — with restrictions — and the face of .Grand Case will inevitably be different. As we said recently, not better ... not worse ... simply different.

The Reserve Naturelle, which controls Orient Beach and a very large part of the surrounding area, isn't fond of all of the development that has happened on the beach and in other locations in recent years. It has already said that it wants what it calls collapsible structures on the beach which can be taken down and carted away quickly before any major storm hits, sort of like tradeshow booths.

There is certainly a demand for services on the beach — chair rentals, bars, restaurants, and public bathrooms. So there will be a need for vendors in these proposed "collapsible" buildings to be located on the beach. The biggest obstacle to rebuilding in both Grand Case and on Orient Beach now is not the insurance companies, it's the French Side government.

So, significant changes coming to both areas and as always, we'll keep you posted.

26. A Series of SXM Travel Disasters

Not every trip to SXM winds up the relaxing event you'd expect.

A recent Summer trip ended in disaster when a child visiting her grandmother in Grand Case was bitten in the head by the grandmother's bulldog, imperiling the girl's eyesight. She was flown to Miami in a medical evacuation jet for emergency eye surgery that saved her sight. Flight cost to the patient: \$0.

A woman from Virginia shopped at an island grocer and headed back to her car carrying two bags of groceries. She tripped and fell on a curb and knew at once she had fractured her hip.
