

1. Finally, Hurricane Season 2017 Ends Thursday

The 2017 hurricane season is essentially over. In its latest tropical outlooks, the National Hurricane Center has said that tropical storm formation is not expected in the next five days, which means that the season is almost actually finally *over*.

Hurricane season begins June 1 and ends November 30, although storms have been known to form outside of that schedule. We will keep our eyes open even after the season ends.

To see a substantial amount of information about Caribbean weather all year long, go to our everythingSXM.com website and click Weather; that brings you to our Weather Center which offers current satellite images and image loops, weather radar, and tropical forecasts.

Should anything unexpected happen affecting weather in SXM, we'll report it quickly on our <u>Everything St. Maarten</u> <u>Facebook Site</u>.

2. Get Up-To-Date Tropical Outlooks, Watches, & Warnings

Major updates to the Weather section of our everythingSXM.com website were completed during this busy hurricane season.

In addition to many new real-time tropical weather graphics — including satellite images and new loops — our weather site has now been updated with the National Hurricane Center's latest tropical outlook; tropical weather discussion (for true weather geeks); and the latest forecasts, watches, and warnings for all active storms, plus new track models.

You can access all this information free, as always: just go to everythingsxm.com and click "Weather" in the masthead.

If you are prospectively in the path of any future approaching storm, we urge you to visit crownweather.com and to sign up for their incredibly inexpensive detailed forecasting service. It's by far the best on the web and it can prove highly useful to you, your family, and your business.It gave live updates on Island 92 radio as Irma approached, warning of potentially catastrophic winds from the storm.

As we've said before, if you are in the path of an imminent approaching storm, never use any website for life or death advice: always rely on directives from local authorities.

3. Four Sources of Current SXM Weather Info (Revised 10/8)

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

<u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well.

3) Our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming. They were knocked off the air by Irma but are now back.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u>.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

8. Flights / Accommodations Overview: It's Complicated

As you saw in section 2 of this week's *SXM Weekly News*, there are lots of accommodations available for determined people — it just takes some persistence and some ingenuity to put things together.

Airlines have been reticent to restore normal passenger service to SXM when thousands of timeshare units, the island's main source of accommodations, have been off-line. However, as you'll see in story 29, it appears to us as though many of those units may be back online sooner than expected. See story 29 for why.

It may be that airlines will wind up making sudden changes in their schedules — kind of like they do during winter storms — when they find more accommodations will be available in SXM faster than imagined.

Put simply, airlines aren't going to send planes to places where they are not likely to be filled. Heads up to airlines: keep a closer eye on SXM because things may well be changing faster than you think.

9. Is This a Good Time to Buy a Timeshare?

We're seeing this question posted repeatedly on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>. Some people are assuming that it makes sense to buy a timeshare while the island is fighting to pick itself up, dust itself off, and get going again.

If you're considering buying generally, or if you're looking at a specific resort, we urge you to post your question on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>. Be sure to mention the specific resort you're thinking of, if there is one. You may find interesting reactions based upon the date when the resort will reopen (if it will reopen); its reputation; its annual maintenance fees; the confidence of timeshare owners in its management staff and ownership; and its history concerning Supplemental Maintenance Fees when hurricanes hit.

Our readership on the <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u> is approaching 19,000 people, many of whom are timeshare owners on the island. You'll get truthful, highly useful answers to your questions from the people most in a position to answer. We urge you to use this resource.

10. Emilio's Restaurant Opens at Emilio Wilson Estate

If you think of the name Emilio's in conjunction with a restaurant, you might think, "Oh great, another Italian place is coming to SXM."

If you made that assumption, you'd be wrong. SXM has a number of great Italian restaurants, but this restaurant isn't Italian; it's simply great food by a phenomenal chef in a beautiful ambience at a great new location.

Although the development of part of the Emilio Wilson estate -- an environmental treasure for decades -- by Rainforest Adventures has been highly controversial, there are two key bottom lines here: first, the development has not taken over a huge portion of the property or desecrated it, and second, it represents a huge attraction for tourists at a time when the island desperately needs it.

Like it or not, the timing or the entire Rainforest Adventures project really couldn't be better for the island economy.

Beyond that, the management of this restaurant also could not possibly be better. Leading a highly experienced team are Norman and Su Wathey. Su is a highly accomplished business manager (and baker), and Norman has been the principal architect of Kangaroo Court a number of years ago and Taloula Mango's more recently, two highly successful Philipsburg restaurants. Although this is their operation, Irma stepped in and destroyed renowned CIA chef Dino Jagtiani's landmark SXM restaurant, Temptation in Cupecoy, leaving him suddenly no place to ply his extraordinary talents.

Then, the idea struck and soon, Dino was in charge of all the culinary direction and details for this rather extraordinary new restaurant.

This match was made in heaven -- literally.

If you head North from Simpson Bay to Le Grand Marché near Philipsburg, you'll find Rainforest Adventures by going straight ahead toward the hills — northward — instead of turning right toward Burger King, Cost-u-Less, and Philipsburg. Rainforest Adventures will be on your left a bit after the stadium and that's where you will find Emilio's, named for Emilio Wilson on whose estate it is located.

A grand opening of sorts was held this past week and the reports were all outstanding. Definitely give it a try when you next visit SXM.

11. Norwegian Caribbean 50s Cruise Coming in March

We had received word that Norwegian Caribbean Cruise Lines (NCCL) would have a 1950s celebrity music cruise coming to SXM in March, 2018, and forwarded an immediate inquiry to Norwegian Caribbean to get details.

Unfortunately, they didn't respond before press time. If you're interested in pursuing this, contact Norwegian Caribbean.

12. The Difference Between Irma and Ordinary Hurricanes

Unless you've been through a major category five hurricane, there is no way to describe the difference between what happened in SXM and "ordinary" hurricanes.

Even 1995's hurricane Luis was "ordinary" compared to Irma's devastation. Irma hit SXM on the 22nd anniversary of Luis.

The only way we can describe Irma is with relation to an automobile accident. Ordinary hurricanes are bumper thumpers -- memorable and a bit scary at the time, but in the long-term scheme of things not really cataclysmic.

By comparison, category five storm Irma was pretty much the same as you driving a subcompact and getting slammed head-on or broadside by a fully loaded 18 wheeler and having your car totally destroyed and your life pass before your eyes — a totally different animal.

As a consequence of that very real difference, it may be some time before locals who actually lived through this lifechanging catastrophic event to feel comfortable about expressing what happened to them personally. It was recent, it was devastating, and it absolutely was cataclysmic.

Give them time.

If you've been on the island over the last few years, you've seen them and bought them by the thousands — T-shirts and other items with the "One Love" script about St. Maarten/St. Martin. All is not lost, however; the store has now relocated to a large shipping container near the Al Dente restaurant, just east of the traffic circle leading to the Pinel island ferry. We don't believe they currently take orders to be shipped, which means if you want a One Love shirt or anything else scripted with their theme, you'll just have to get down to the island.

18. King, Queen, Sec'y of State Due This Thursday

The King, Queen, and Secretary of State of the Kingdom of the Netherlands will be visiting SXM from November 30 for a couple of days. Despite the fact that fewer cars than usual are on the roads, security will necessitate slower than usual traffic wherever the Royals are.

The relationship between the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Country St. Maarten is on the mend after it had been battered by former Prime Minister William Marlin who had held up Kingdom aid money while people were suffering because he wanted to receive it unconditionally. The Kingdom of the Netherlands, however, wanted a proper accounting of how the money was spent — a totally sensible request.

Marlin's coalition majority soon disappeared, a no-confidence vote was passed and he was relieved of his position as prime minister recently. We reported last week about the new prime minister.

Our sense of this visit is that it will enable the King and Queen to see how relief money and material already deployed by the Kingdom is working on the island, and to reaffirm already arranged continued assistance programs totaling hundreds of millions of dollars.

Total damages from Irma on the Dutch and French side is now widely expected to approach USD\$6-billion. For the most part, electricity, running water, and even Internet has been restored, though thousands of people are still unable to occupy damaged or destroyed homes and are living with friends or relatives.

Progress is noticeable but so is devastation. There's no magic wand except tourist dollars....

19. Viking Cruise Ship Due Sat. 12/4; Royal Caribbean Due 12/17

Cruise ships start to return to SXM late this week.

Viking cruises will kick off the post-hurricane cruise ship season on the island next Monday, on December 4. Royal Caribbean will return to SXM on December 17.

December, 2017, will be far from a normal December, however — with comparatively few ships. But SXM already has more to offer than was expected at this point — far more — so ships are coming back faster than expected. Increasing numbers of cruise ships should be expected through the winter and that will have to serve the island's economy for a while. Some timeshares are coming back near the first of the year (see our updated story in this issue), but others won't be back online until the spring — when tourist traffic normally drops off.

29. Which Timeshares Will Reopen First?

It's very interesting to peer behind the announcements from SXM's top timeshares and see what they're actually doing. Our strong hunch is that the philosophy at the best managed timeshare resorts is underpromise and overdeliver.

What many have said is that they're seeking an opening date of April, 2018, or later. But we believe several are truly -- and quietly -- trying to beat that.

The reason is simple business. Get it done, get it open, and you can get it filled and get revenue. As airlines see resorts reopen, they'll increase flight frequencies and pent-up demand for travel to SXM will fill available accommodations.

Some won't reopen at all; **Summit Resort**, built back in the early 70s of wood, was destroyed by Irma and won't reopen. **Ocean Club** suffered severe damage and is one of several apparently similarly damaged resorts under the same ownership throughout the Caribbean. It will need to be rebuilt and that will take time, especially if the

rebuilding is strong poured cement construction.

Atrium Resort was damaged but not severely and is already renting rooms to craftspeople involved in reconstruction and to some others. Simpson Bay Resort is working hard at rebuilding though its insurance folks haven't finished their analyses; it's a big campus. Run by timeshare experts and shrewd business people, it had just finished a \$36-million renovation when Irma hit. It has been occupied by hundreds of Dutch Marines and by some employees who had lost their homes. Its focus is its main structures. It is taking some reservations now though more amenities will be ready if you wait a bit before reserving. *It could, we think, be one of the first to partially reopen.*

Oyster Bay Beach Resort suffered major damage to its low-floor ocean-facing units especially and has said its reopening will be "phased." We think parts of OBBR could be ready early as well.

Both **Sapphire Beach Resort** and **The Atrium** are well built and capably managed and they're expected to be the first two timeshares to officially reopen, not long after the first of the year. Yes they had damages, but not as severe as many others.

Flamingo and **Royal Palm Beach**, both Diamond Resorts operations, are saying they'll reopen by 2020 which is absurd. Perhaps they want timeshare owners to walk away so they can essentially build new and sell at inflated "new" prices. Both were hit hard, but 2020 is a bizarre statement even for Diamond (Google them).

Royal Islander / Ocean Point was hit hard on lower floors but some upper floor units weren't as bad, according to some who have seen the buildings. **Sonesta Maho** appears to have previously installed windows not rated to withstand category 5 hurricane winds; many blew out during Irma.

We've not heard much yet about **Divi Little Bay**. In the case of Divi, employees are not at all happy about their situation; in press reports they allege the resort wants them to settle for two days/week pay. Divi has been accommodating Dutch Marines but we've heard little from them about the readiness of timeshare rooms.

Bel Air Resort is very well managed and, we think, is quietly marching to open early. We're constantly impressed by organizations that tell you what they're doing by actually doing it -- walking the walk -- and Bel Air we think, especially now, has truly become such a company. Don't be surprised to see them be ready early: we're watching them closely, too....

Dawn Beach Club may be ready next Summer or so but whether people will come with the Westin still closed is a complete unknown. Except for Infinity at Oyster Bay Beach Resort, very few area restaurants are open. Big Fish, Daniel's by the Sea, Busby's, and Canoa are all closed and none is expected to reopen any time soon. We'll watch this closely for you too.
