1. AA Resolves Its No-Pilots-for-Holiday-Travel Conundrum

American Airlines announced about a week ago that thanks to a computer glitch, some 15,000 of its flights scheduled between December 15 and December 31 had no pilots or copilots.

A bit of panic ensued from a number of quarters. American offered pilots who were willing to forgo their computer-generated days off about 150% of their normal hourly pay for taking to the air instead of staying home. Working with its union, AA said at the end of last week that the problem was virtually solved.

Now watch a blizzard come in during Christmas week to screw this all up (entirely possible).

2. Reconfirm Your Flights Repeatedly

It's not at all unusual for the price of various airline flights to change multiple times daily. But it is highly unusual for

flight times, frequencies, and other flight details to change several times per week — and that is exactly what's happening among several airlines serving destinations hit by major hurricanes earlier this year.

Although as you will see SXM is recovering rapidly and tourism is already increasing, airlift — available flights to take you to the island — will increase slowly until more timeshare resorts are back online early during 2018.

Just to make sure you have the correct, current information for your flight, *be sure to reconfirm a few times before you actually take off*. You don't want to arrive at the airport only to learn that the airline has radically changed your flights -- and you did not get the message.

3. We Asked The Airport Several Questions...

About a week and a half ago, through a senior official there, we asked several questions of Princess Juliana SXM Airport. Here they are:

1. Is there a target date for reopening the terminal? (We had previously heard "nine months" but we know the interior has significant issues, not just the roof.)
2. When will installation of the new runway lights be completed, enabling nighttime operations? (We believe it may already be finished, but we need to know the facts.)
3. Is there even the roughest information on the status of preclearance for passengers headed back to the USA? (Further discussions on this had been scheduled during September, when Irma visited.)

We know the Airport is slammed with work; they've not yet responded. We'll let you know when we hear.

4. "Smart" Luggage Being Banned on Multiple Airlines

It turns out that so-called "smart" luggage isn't.

Smart luggage with nonremovable batteries should be taken off your holiday gift-giving list: it has already been banned on multiple airlines and appears likely to be banned altogether by the FAA.

It's not that the bags are a bad idea; it's just that they require batteries, and batteries sometimes self-ignite. That would not be a good thing on an airplane especially if the batteries are nonremovable.

Major updates to the Weather section of our everythingSXM.com website were completed during the just-ended hurricane season.

In addition to many new real-time tropical weather graphics — including satellite images and new loops — our weather site has now been updated with the National Hurricane Center's latest tropical outlook; tropical weather discussion (for true weather geeks); and the latest forecasts, watches, and warnings for all active storms, plus new track models.

You can access all this information free, as always: just go to everythingxsm.com and click "Weather" in the masthead.

If you are prospectively in the path of any future approaching storm, we urge you to visit crownweather.com and to sign up for their incredibly inexpensive detailed forecasting service. It's by far the best on the web and it can prove highly useful to you, your family, and your business. It gave live updates on Island 92 radio as Irma approached, warning of potentially catastrophic winds from the storm.

As we've said before, if you are in the path of an imminent approaching storm, never use any website for life or death advice: always rely on directives from local authorities.

6. Four Sources of Current SXM Weather Info (Revised 10/8)

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, www.everythingsxm.com, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

- 1) [Crown Weather Services](#) whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well.
- 3) Our [Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site](#), which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming. They were knocked off the air by Irma but are now back.

N. B.: *Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.*

11. 2017: Most Expensive Hurricane Season in History

Harvey, Irma, Maria --- and more, all major Category 5 storms that slammed highly populated areas causing hundreds of billions of dollars in damage, together made 2017 the costliest Atlantic hurricane season in history.

In SXM alone, the final bottom line will likely be well over USD \$6-billion. Here's more from [Fortune Magazine](#).

12. Preliminary 2018 Hurricane Forecast from Crown Weather

Hurricane seasons become personal disasters when your life changes because of them. A number of Caribbean islands were blasted by hurricanes Irma and Maria, and Hurricane Harvey will never be forgotten in South Texas.

What will happen in 2018? Preliminary predictions from Rob Lightbown, head of Crown Weather Services, [crownweather.com](#), our go-to source for tropical and other weather information, tell us what to expect. *A busy prediction for the season does not necessarily mean that SXM will get hit again — it just means there may be a significant number of tropical storms with tracks that can't now be predicted.*

Meteorologist Rob Lightbown says that the 2018 Atlantic hurricane season at this moment appears likely to be as busy as 2017 was — and possibly busier.

As conditions that create the environment for the genesis of storms in 2018 continue to evolve, we should know more about where storms are likely to form and where they might go. Some of that on a preliminary basis already has been released by Crown Weather. We'll talk a bit more about it as conditions continue to develop and more nearly final seasonal forecasts become crystallized.

If you are potentially in the track of tropical cyclones either in the Caribbean or on the shores of the Gulf of Mexico or the US or Canadian Atlantic coast, be ready — and that includes getting regular updates during the season from [CrownWeather.com](#), which has a remarkably inexpensive program that communicates important details to everyone who may be in the path of approaching storms. If you live in areas which may be affected by severe *winter* weather, he covers that too; see his site for more information.

13. French Side Pres. Wants Island Congress, More Joint Decisions

Daniel Gibbs, President of the French Side Territorial Council, wants a united "Congress on Cooperation" between the two sides of the island, saying last week that added cooperation is more essential than ever in the wake of Hurricane Irma.

One of his objectives is to put policies in place that survive changes in government on both sides of the island. He said, "In the Congress, decisions are made by an electoral body, from the executive of both sides, and once a decision is *sealed by a vote it is more difficult to retract.*" [Emphasis added.-Ed.] Continuity is what he's suggesting, perhaps in response to recent chaos particularly on the Dutch Side.

The idea has great merit, in our view. The new Dutch Side government may well embrace it, though the previous Marlin government would doubtless have dismissed it out-of-hand. We'll watch this and keep you posted.

Further **Comment:** *One island competing against itself from a marketing perspective is absurd. A high tide floats all boats -- a unified marketing effort that is well-funded and supported continually can make all of SXM more competitive, and such an effort is decades overdue.*

14. Kingdom Official: No Dutch Takeover Coming

Given the governmental chaos that ensued on the Dutch side in the weeks following hurricane Irma's strike on SXM three months ago this Wednesday, there was a bit of paranoia on the Dutch side about whether the Kingdom of the Netherlands might want to take over the island rather than deal with any more issues. The new head of island relations and the Dutch government put that idea to rest in a wide-ranging interview with *Daily Herald* reporter Alita Singh. 16. Tourism Reawakening, Especially on Dutch Side

We've been carefully monitoring the sentiment among tourists who customarily visit St. Maarten but had been unable to do so because of closed timeshares. Many have said that due to scheduling, cost, or both, they've had to take advantage of alternative accommodations offered by their timeshare providers. Although they would rather be in St. Maarten, their circumstances don't allow it now. That's something only the island can address on a long-term basis by providing incremental new hotel accommodations on the island that are hurricane-proof — and require the same hurricane-proof construction in repairs of timeshares, along the lines of South Florida building codes.

Tourists who have more flexibility are already making plans to return to SXM, in many cases during the first half of 2018. Progress toward hurricane recovery has moved much faster on the Dutch side than on the French so far, despite post-Irma Dutch Side government chaos noted elsewhere in this issue and in previous issues.

It's not that the French don't want to catch up — it's that they want to make sure French side businesses aren't rebuilt in the same vulnerable manner as were structures in areas recently pummeled by Irma.

Bottom line: tourism is reawakening, considerably faster than most dared to imagine. And today we remain convinced — as we have been for quite some time — that a number of timeshares will be opening their doors sooner than expected, rather than later.

17. JMB Removes Some Rental Listings from January, February

As we reported in articles 8 and 9, there are plenty of accommodations available on SXM now; those articles contain information that can help you make reservations.

Not all timeshares are open, and some won't be open for some time. Consequently, we have just updated our timeshare rental listings on everythingSXM.com to remove rental offers for properties which will not be open during those two months. *Properties now posted for January and February rentals have announced plans to reopen at that time.*

18. JMB Expecting to Expand Charity List

We understand that not all SXM businesses had hurricane insurance, which is enormously expensive. We don't think anyone ever expected a storm like Irma. 19. Update on Our Christmas Shoebox Project

At the suggestion of one of the members of our [Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site](#), our staff looked into spearheading a Christmas ShoeBox program for the kids of St. Maarten.

The idea was to stuff useful goodies into Shoe Boxes to be shipped to the island and given away to deserving, less fortunate children: a happy Christmas after the disaster that was Irma.

It was a great idea which had many supporters including JetBlue Airways, which had expressed interest in transporting the shoe boxes to the island.

In vetting the proposal, JetBlue encountered concerns on the part of the TSA, the US Transportation Security Administration, charged with the safety of air travel. That's when the project stalled. We have been looking into other shipping options, but we are moving very close now to the holiday and carrying this off in time may not be possible.

We're continuing to look at ways to make this happen and we'll publish here what the outcome is.

20. Chabad Needs your Help

The Highline Ballroom in Manhattan will be the location on December 13 at 6:30 PM of a Hanukkah celebration to help raise money for Chabad of St. Maarten's fundraising for its rebuilding effort.

21. Will Kim Sha Beach, Dutch Side, Be the New Orient Beach?

Orient beach right now is big, naturally beautiful, and desolate. All of the businesses on the beach were destroyed by Irma. Debris from some of those businesses was pushed by storm surge and enormous wind-driven surf all the way to the road to Le Galion beach, a good distance away.

Taxi drivers used to drive many hundreds of people to Orient beach every day. But as cruise ships started to return to the island this week, they aren't going to Orient beach: they'll be going to Kim Sha beach, located between Royal Palm Beach Resort and Atrium Resort on the Dutch side. There, chairs and umbrellas are being made available for their use.

Meanwhile, Club Orient at the clothing-optional southern end of Orient beach is now renting out chairs again and has a newly constructed "Perch" bar also in operation along its part of the beach.

Kim Sha can't replace Orient; it's not as pretty and it's also not clothing optional. But for a while — perhaps for as long as a year — it will be one beach to which tourists are taken for a taste of the island.

They can opt to go to other beaches as well, but Kim Sha will be the primary focus.

25. Christmas Winds - And Christmas Worms - Due This Month

SXM in December is characterized by two particular things.

First, Christmas winds appear — stiffer than usual tradewinds that may blow a bit of sand on you, particularly if you're on Orient beach (not likely right now because nothing is there).

Christmas worms are an entirely different matter. They can appear outside or in, and are very bright red, almost iridescent. Although they are about the same length as earthworms, they move more like inchworms. We once stayed in an apartment in the Guana Bay area several hundred yards from the beach. One night, we found dozens of them crossing the kitchen floor to head under the back door of the apartment to leave.

It was peculiar, but that was the only night it happened. Normally, both Christmas winds and Christmas worms appear only in December — hence the name.

And also hence the reason this is story number 25.

26. Will Maho Beach Ever Come Back?

For tourists, Maho Beach is one of the favorite sitting sites on the entire island. It's not that the beach is particularly gorgeous — it isn't. It's also not that the people watching is all that fascinating — it's mostly ship people without much of a tan.

But Maho beach has been covered in the press worldwide for years, because planes landing at Princess Juliana SXM Airport fly only a few dozen feet above your head.

Now, with a temporarily vastly reduced number of flights, there isn't that much to watch from the Airport -- besides which Irma removed virtually all the sand from the beach and left only boulders.

Many people have asked, will Maho beach ever come back? Of course it will. Sand comes and goes at many SXM beaches, including Dawn, Cupecoy, Orient, and even Mullet Bay as well as Maho. During rough surf, sufficient sand is often dumped on the road between the fence and Maho Beach to require plowing.

The Dutch Side has a lot of things on its plate right now, so don't expect it to dump dredged sand on this beach — that's probably going to be Mother Nature's job.
