

1. 10,000 Cruise Passengers Due Today / Tomorrow

Cruise ship travel to St. Maarten is surging as the Dutch side of the island continues to recover faster than expected from hurricane Irma.

Today and tomorrow, Christmas Day and Boxing Day on the island, will see an expected 10,000 passengers visiting SXM. Here's the full story.

2. SXM Airport Open, w/ Arrivals / Departures; Terminal Closed

There seems to be some confusion among tourists contemplating a return to the island about the status of SXM Airport.

The airport is open, capable of handling arrivals and departures during the day and at night. The roof of its main terminal building was seriously compromised by hurricane Irma, which had sustained winds of 185 mph with recorded gusts up to 240 mph. When hurricane Maria brushed the island not too many days later, it dumped lots of rain through open roofs, causing even more damage including mold.

At SXM Airport, that has necessitated internal demolition which is now underway. Temporary tents were put up to handle arrivals and departures after the airport reopened at the beginning of October. Those tents were capable of handling the limited flight operations that were taking place at that time.

Now, flights frequencies are increasing and, particularly on weekends, the small tents are overwhelmed. Consequently SXM Airport has started to erect to new, much larger temporary structures to handle arrivals and departures until the main terminal reopens, which is tentatively scheduled in the fourth quarter of 2018. Photography of the inside of the main airport terminal, which is off limits to passengers, was posted on our Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site on Sunday afternoon, as were photographs of steel beams for the temporary new structure now being erected. 3. Crowds, Confusion at Airport Saturday Before XMas

Late Saturday afternoon was not a fun time for departing passengers at SXM Airport. Here are comments from Andy F, who left very late on Saturday and who advises no one else to do the same:

"Air France came with the 350. Caribbean came with a 330 and a 737. American with a fully loaded 737. PAWA had two here simultaneously. All on the ground at the same time. Departures was overloaded. Three hours from arrival at the airport to Immigration. We're still on the tarmac and should have left an hour ago."

4. Supersonic Jet Coming?

When Concorde supersonic jets stopped flying with British Airways and Air France, supersonic commercial air transport was moribund. That may all be changing, with heavy research underway moving toward development of a new supersonic passenger jet which would transport well-heeled passengers. Proof of concept appears to be coming with a smaller supersonic business jet and our guess is that ultimately, both of these could wind up visiting SXM under private ownership or as charters. We'll see. Here's the story.

5. Weather Center Upgraded: Get Current SXM Weather Info

Last week, we upgraded the Weather Center on everythingSXM.com, preparing it for the 2018 hurricane season and anything that may happen out of season this winter.

As you may remember, early in 2017 a tropical storm formed in the central Atlantic well before the official start of the 2017 hurricane season. Our Weather Center always has up-to-date conditions on the island in detail. To use it, go to everythingSXM.com and click Weather.

6. Sources of Current SXM Weather Info

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

- 1) Crown Weather Services whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming. They were knocked off the air by Irma but are now back.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

9. Evacuees: Where to Recover Your Missing Luggage (Repeat)

Read this, regardless of the resort you were evacuated from after Irma:

"Simpson Bay Resort (SBR) was contacted by the US State Department to let SBR know there were a bunch of bags held in 'a secure area' at the airport. We had been previously advised that all of the bags left at the airport had been donated already, and that none were left, but apparently they just lost track of them for a little while. Anyway, Trinity Houston went to the Airport to retrieve luggage for SBR members, but it turned out there were hundreds of bags there that had been left behind by people from all over the island.

"On her own time, without pay, she took it upon herself to sort through the bags that are held in an area without air conditioning (and with a bunch of standing water, mosquitoes, etc.) and tracked down every single person she could find to arrange for their bags to be sent back to them (if they wanted the bag back; some people donated them). She did this for everyone, whether they were Simpson Bay Resort members or not...."

10. About Winter Fares; Summer Fares Dropping

Current fares to SXM are high because of low supply and high demand. Increased flights from some non-US carriers are crowding the currently limited arrival and departure facilities in SXM, particularly on weekends. The lack of thousands of hotel and timeshare rooms still limits the island's ability to accommodate more visitors, though that will start to change in about a month when timeshare resorts start to come back online. So... between February 1 and March 1 the number of flights from the US, and perhaps Canada, should increase. Hopefully prices will moderate.

Meanwhile, early fares for next summer appear to be lower than in quite some time. For several months, we've been

saying how great summer travel is to the island particularly in June, July, and early August. The island is relatively quiet, the weather is gorgeous, prices are low, and there are no significant crowds. See our story (#33) about our summertime giveaway which you can still enter.

The big news here, of course, is those fares; check them out. Some are under \$400 round trip from key US gateways.

12. Flamingo, Royal Palm Likely To Be Closed Through 2019

Although a significant number of SXM timeshare resorts will be coming back online during the first quarter of 2018, nonetheless some others won't be back quite so fast.

Currently, both Flamingo resort and Royal Palm resort are not expected to be back online anytime before late 2019. Both are operated by Diamond Resorts. The future of Ocean Club remains unclear, although Eric, its owner, has pledged to rebuild. That resort suffered extreme damage from Irma.

As previously announced, Summit Resort Hotel was completely destroyed by Irma and has closed permanently. To the best of our knowledge, all other resorts are working to reopen as quickly as possible. Much more information is in

16. Christmas Eve Earthquake, 5.2

For people on St. Maarten, Anguilla, St. Barts, and St. Kitts, late Sunday morning was a bit unsettling as a 5.2 earthquake rocked the area. Most felt the shaking, but some who were outside didn't notice it. There was no confirmed damage and no tidal wave, even though the tremor was centered roughly 17 miles east of SXM. Tremors are not infrequently felt in SXM, though this one was a bit stronger than many.

We always keep an eye on this and of course we'll keep you posted. News about quakes goes out instantly on our

17. Quit Freezing: How To Go To SXM Now

We know that the temperatures in the Northeast US this week will feature lows near zero Fahrenheit and highs in the teens — with wind chills below zero or well below zero.

We know a storm is expected to hit the Northeast Christmas Eve night and during the morning of Christmas day. And another, potentially bigger storm may affect much of the country a week from now, to welcome the new year.

Since the average daytime temperature in St. Maarten at this time of year is about 82, with nighttime temperatures plunging to a bone-chilling 76 or 77, the only ice you're going to find in SXM is in your drinks.

Even though winter just began last Thursday, if you really want to come to St. Maarten (and can bank your timeshare week for some point when you can use it in SXM), you *can* get down here. Although it's not open for timeshare owners thanks to a lack of usual vacation amenities, Simpson Bay Resort nonetheless is open and it's available for reservations right now; you just have to sign a paper agreeing that you understand that services are limited.

If you're already tired of the cold, go to our site, everythingSXM.com and click on timeshare rentals. Mixed in with our 2018 listings you will find links enabling you to make reservations at Simpson Bay resort. You can use those links or call the resort directly to make reservations. Although you won't be able to ask for specific rooms you can ask for specific types of rooms that are available. There are plenty of rooms, car rentals are available, and lots of restaurants are open now both in Simpson Bay and several in Grand Case.

The number of flights to SXM is increasing too. Why freeze?

18. Back to Normal; GEBE's First Huge Post-Irma Blackout

It's official: SXM is back to normal.

How can we tell? GEBE, the Dutch side's electricity and water company, traditionally has Dutch side-wide blackouts during December. This season's first Dutch side-wide blackout occurred earlier this week and within the usual number of hours it was blamed on something obscure and the lights came back on.

There were complaints about a year ago that Dutch side SXM's electricity generation reliability was somewhere in the same neighborhood as that of Zimbabwe. That is not a distinction that should be relished by GEBE. It would be nice if they were a bit more dependable.

19. The Time Warp That Is Orient Beach

Increasingly, both tourists and locals walking on Orient beach, where all the businesses disappeared in Irma's immense storm surge, are actually liking what they see -- a huge, natural, pristine beach.

Granted, they do believe there should be places for drinks and bathroom facilities. But the reaction of most people seems to be that Orient had become overbuilt, and that the resulting clutter hurt the attraction which brought people to the island in the first place.

Not everyone who had a business on Orient beach before Irma is expected to come back. We know that a number of people have returned to France and are going to stay there, unwilling to chance going through anything like Irma again.

What's going to happen is not finalized, although the Reserve Naturelle has said that it would like future structures on Orient to be collapsible and removable before oncoming storms. Facilities, in addition, don't necessarily need to be on the beach; they could simply be behind it.

As always, we'll keep you posted.

Spiga Restaurant in Grand Case has now reopened for its 2017/2018 season. The restaurant is open for both lunch and dinner. It has long been one of the top restaurants on the island, and we strongly recommend you visit it during your next SXM trip -- you won't be disappointed.

Lunch 12-2pm. This is new; Spiga has never before served lunch. Great salads, fresh homemade pastas, and more.

Dinner 6-10 pm. Closed Sundays. New menu -- a bit lighter and also a bit lighter on your pocketbook. Open Christmas Eve and Christmas Day dinner only, and New Year's Eve and New Year's Day dinner only.

The setting is a simple one on Simpson Bay lagoon just south of the causeway. Its central, quiet, and attractive. The prices are very cheap for St. Maarten and the food is plentiful.

Lal's hours: Open for breakfast & lunch serving local food from 7.00/3.00pm. Indian cuisine from 4.30/10.00pm.

22. Le Pressoir Said to be Closed, For Sale

Le Pressoir in Grand Case, long one of the island's top restaurants and a consistent award winner, was savagely hit by hurricane Irma, the most powerful storm in Atlantic basin history. Although its website remains up, based upon information from other restaurateurs in Grand Case we believe that Le Pressoir is closed and for sale.

It's hard to imagine that one storm can do so much damage to some of the island's best restaurants, but it has happened. Temptation, in Cupecoy beach, was also destroyed by Irma; chef Dino Jagtiani is now running the new Emilio's Restaurant at the Emilio Wilson Estate/Rainforest Adventures near the new Carrefour on the Bush road. 23. Grand Marche Rebranded Carrefour -- But There's More

Le Grand Marché, the supermarket that for many years was the island's biggest and busiest, is no more. But, that's a good thing: Grand Marché owner Anil Sabnani had converted his other supermarket in Cole Bay from Grand Marche to Carrefour a few years ago. Here's what he says:

"We changed it because Carrefour works very well. We were able to renovate the store in Bush Rd allowing 40

percent more products so not only do we have everything we always had in Bush Rd but we have been able to add all Carrefour products as well."
