1. Airport Getting \$50-Million Construction Loan

Nearly eight months after category five hurricane Irma slammed SXM, Princess Juliana SXM Airport is still waiting for full settlement from its insurance company. Faced with the daunting task of rebuilding the airport terminal from the roof down, the airport has now thankfully obtained a \$50-million loan to get on with its urgent rebuilding program. Here is that story from the Daily Herald.

Hopefully we will soon have a response from airport officials to several questions we posed to them. Nonetheless, one thing is obvious: the main terminal will not reopen in time for the 2018 – 2019 high season. The good news is that the substitute temporary terminals for inbound and outbound passengers are totally ready to go and already serving many passengers efficiently. Plus, they include many amenities passengers expect including food, drink, bathroom facilities, etc.

We'll keep you posted on how things proceed.

2. AA Resuming Flights Thru CLT

Despite significant demand from passengers for seats to SXM from a variety of gateways, American Airlines still seems to be dragging its feet on stepping up to the need. A competitor in many markets, jetBlue Airways, by contrast, resumed its daily nonstop flights from JFK to SXM several months ago.

So far, American is serving SXM only through Miami, which for many people creates grossly inconvenient

connections and the need to stay somewhere overnight enroute. As of now, the resumption of flights through Charlotte is scheduled to occur early in November, clearly too late for convenient summer travel to SXM from much of the country. We hope they bring flights through Charlotte back online much sooner. The fact is that many additional resorts will be coming online over the next two or three months, providing ample space for many passengers. All that's needed is greater airlift -- and American can supply that and add to its profits, if the price is sane.

3. AA Late/Early Flights From/To MIA Returning

After hurricane Irma hit SXM, American Airlines discontinued its late-night arrival from Miami, which had previously overnighted at Princess Juliana airport. That flight had enabled many people to make same-day connections from much of the country to SXM. The next morning, the same flight returned to Miami, enabling an expeditious same-day return home for most people.

The lack of that overnighting flight during the last several months has made getting to SXM and returning home in the same day difficult, as we've noted here. The return of this flight — coupled with the return of Charlotte service, both of which are happening in November — will be a significant boost to the island's economy.

What would be even better, of course, is if American could find a way to resume the service in June, so passengers seeking summer vacations in SXM could easily make that happen. Accommodations will be online all summer long: all that's needed is convenient flights to get people to and from SXM.

We don't care who provides them: JetBlue intends to provide service to SXM through Fort Lauderdale in the future, so perhaps they could accelerate that service and eat American Airlines' lunch in the process.

4. RC "Symphony of the Seas" Downright Humongous

Not too many years ago, we wrote about Oasis of the Seas from Royal Caribbean — at that time, the largest cruise ship on the planet. Oasis has been supplanted in that position several times since. Now, Symphony of the Seas, Royal Caribbean's newest and biggest ship, also grabs the title of the largest cruise ship in the world — for now.

Of course, it will be serving SXM.

5. Seaborne Airlines Acquired by Silver Air; So What?

Seaborne Airlines has long been a codeshare partner of a number of US carriers, enabling connections to SXM via San Juan from multiple US cities.

Now, Seaborne has been acquired by Silver Airways, a small carrier with a significant footprint in Florida. Our sense is that this is likely to mean easier trips to SXM from more rural airports served by silver. Here are <u>details</u> on the acquisition. And here are <u>route maps for both airlines</u>.

6. Heavy Rains, Flash Flooding Possible Next Weekend

Somewhere east of the Bahamas and north of Puerto Rico and the Northeast Caribbean, chief meteorologist Rob Lightbown of Crown Weather is saying that a tropical system may form late this week.

If it does, that means heavy rain and some flash flooding could occur in SXM and on some neighboring islands starting on Friday and lasting through all of next weekend. If this happens and any watches or warnings are issued, they will appear on our site, everything SXM.com in its Weather Center.

If you live or work anywhere which has ever been or might ever be in the path of any tropical cyclone, we urge you to go directly to the source for all the information you need about tropical weather. That source is CrownWeather.com, the private forecasting service we have used for many years. Their forecasting service is available to individuals and businesses at a surprisingly low rate; we urge anyone potentially in the path of any tropical system to subscribe now, since this hurricane season according to Lightbown is very likely to start early.

7. Current SXM Weather Info (Updated)

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

- 1) Crown Weather Services whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

13. For Many SXM Residents, "Irma" Is Far From Over

Although work continues everywhere across the island on rebuilding and repairing, beaches are open and inviting; many restaurants have been open for months and are greeting vacationers with extraordinary fare; and a significant number of timeshares, hotels, and villas have already reopened and are welcoming lots of guests.

The experience of withstanding the most powerful category five hurricane in Atlantic basin history will never be escapable for anyone who was on the island.

There's a lot of PTSD in SXM — still. And if you think homes were repaired quickly and everyone is back to normal, you'd be wrong. Many homes were destroyed and many more lost their roofs. Many SXM residents continue to live with friends or family now, some eight months after Irma tore through the island. We continue to hear that a number of people are still living in their cars, many of which were also heavily damaged or destroyed. So if you are warmly greeted by many locals, it's a thoroughly honest greeting by people who have been through rather enormous trauma and who are grateful to see you visit and support their island.

If your plans for vacation this summer are not yet solidified, you owe it to yourself to consider coming to SXM. The island will be uncrowded; virtually all restaurants will be open; and the beaches are as beautiful as you can imagine. Car rental prices will be about half their regular winter rate, and possibly lower.

14. SXM Hurting Financially

These are not good times for SXM's economy.

The island has long depended on tourism as its major source of revenue. Thanks to Irma, and the serious damage it caused to island hotels and timeshares, many of which are only now starting to reopen, until this point few accommodations have been available for tourists. That's changing rapidly, but serious damage has already been done to the economy since revenues throughout high season have been far lower than normal. Here's an editorial of interest from the <u>Daily Herald</u>.

The good news, as we reported last week, is that more than half a billion dollars in aid is coming from the World Bank to the Dutch side alone, with even more going to the more heavily damaged French Side,

15. SXM Domino's Pizza Honcho Sounds Off on Tourism

When John Caputo first came to SXM more than two decades ago, he was selling out of a pizza truck where his current Welfare Road store is now located, not far from Pineapple Pete.

Today, his Caribbean Domino's operation covers multiple SXM locations and several other Caribbean islands.

Since he's been involved in business on SXM for many years, he can speak with authority about tourism on SXM and business in general.

He made these comments on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> and we want to repeat them for our SXM Weekly News readers:

"Once again sitting in the departure hall about to board my flight back to St. Maarten and I can't help but notice...and worry that our tourist loyalists are aging out and we as an island are doing very little to attract new ones.

"This was an issue well before Irma and Maria so we can't use that crutch as an excuse. Take a look at the tourists dining, walking down the beach, or shopping and you will see what I'm speaking of.

"We have now an amazing opportunity as we are at the ground zero of rebuilding our hotels, airport, port, and overall infrastructure. We need to take this chance to also rethink and rebuild our tourism strategy as a whole. We need to incentivize airlines and properties to be able to provide value and thus attract a new generation of tourists to visit what in my opinion STILL is most amazing place on earth....St. Maarten."

<u>Our Opinion</u>: The island is making moves in the right direction with the new 450-room Planet Hollywood Resort / Casino coming to Great Bay (see story 34) and the new Rainforest Adventures project at the Emilio Wilson Estate. But much more needs to be in the pipeline; see next story.

16. SXM Invisible To Tourists: How That Must Change Now

For as many years as anyone can remember, St. Maarten has been invisible in the US media.

You see virtually no advertising for the island in magazines, newspapers, or on radio or TV or the web. Nor do you ever hear of vacations in SXM being offered as prizes on television programs. We think it's entirely fair to say that the biggest boon to SXM tourism is what we do on everythingSXM.com and on our Everything SXM Facebook Site — but those efforts are nowhere near what SXM needs to get people to return to the island next high season, let alone this coming summer.

As we understand it, SXM spends perhaps a couple of million dollars a year to promote tourism through highly limited promotion. By contrast, Aruba spends in excess of USD\$20-million per year and it gets far more tourists than SXM.

As we reported, SXM is receiving in excess of USD\$580-million in funds from the World Bank via the Kingdom of the Netherlands — and that just covers the Dutch side. We believe that the French side will be receiving substantially more.

Recovery is more than replacing bricks and mortar (or cinder blocks and mortar). It is also making sure that there is thoroughgoing promotion once the island is totally ready for tourists — and early fall is when those decisions are going to be made.

To be sure, timeshare owners will be back, as long as their timeshares are available. But SXM needs more hotel rooms, as John Caputo suggested in the preceding story, and it needs to make sure those rooms are filled with stayover tourists. Of course there are also timeshare rentals, other condo rentals, and hundreds of villas available for rent on SXM. And the infrastructure of the island also needs to be upgraded to ensure that people can get around easily, perhaps with hurricane proof people-mover systems through busy areas like Simpson Bay to cut the number of cars jamming that area.

But none of this will mean anything without a committed program of marketing, particularly in North America. Magazines, newspapers, radio, television, web, heavy social media, and more.

The island should be able to squeeze first-year funds from the \$580 million coming from the World Bank: it's a legitimate expenditure to bring people back to an island which many people still think was totally destroyed. It's one island: it's essential that it be marketed as one island with the Dutch and French Sides working together for their common good.

You cannot convince people to come back to SXM if you don't show them and tell them that there's a lot for them on the island, right now. SXM has never taken promotion seriously and now, of all times, especially because of its financial situation, it's time for the island to grab this opportunity and fight for the business that the island deserves. Sitting back and assuming that people will simply arrive is great if your objective is bankruptcy. That is not the island's objective: it must get serious about promotion to drive revenues across the island in the coming years.

17. "American Clinic" Medical Tourism Project Is Dead

Several years ago, forward-thinking government and private sector individuals gathered in Simpson Bay to talk about a major marketing opportunity that was available to the island: medical tourism.Basically, medical tourism involves creating a sophisticated medical center with advanced technology and leading-edge capabilities staffed by world-class experts and making their services available to well-heeled tourists from overseas who would have surgery on the island and spend time recovering there in high-end facilities. Of course, it would also be available to locals who formerly had to go overseas for the most sophisticated treatment options.

The original plans called for the facility to be built in the open area just south of Royal Palm Beach Resort, on Kimsha beach. When it became obvious that the Roxxy nightclub was going in that exact spot, we contacted one of the people involved with the American Clinic. He told us that the project, at least for now, is dead.It's our hope that the project will be revived by the same forward-thinking people; it's an outstanding idea with great potential. SXM is a perfect spot for it, since it is the second largest airline hub in the Caribbean....

18. "Below Deck" Relocates from SXM to Tahiti

Bravo's Below Deck series, which purports to show crew interactions aboard a megayacht, was based for multiple seasons in SXM. It filmed on SXM in March of last year, and episodes were broadcast late last summer and early in the fall. The final episode included heartfelt comments about SXM devastation from hurricane Irma from Capt. Lee, longtime yacht skipper on the program.

The show — not to be confused with Below Deck Mediterranean, a similar series with a different venue and Capt. — relocated to Tahiti for this year's filming, which has already been completed. It is expected to be broadcast late this summer and early this fall. It is not yet known where the original Below Deck series will film next March, assuming it is renewed. A number of crew members who were on the yacht in SXM are also featured in the program that was shot in Tahiti.

19. Last Week, Another Annoying GEBE Blackout

With much fanfare about a month after Irma hit SXM, GEBE announced that virtually all its service had been restored. Despite that, the reality was that there were some residential areas that didn't get full power back until quite a bit later.

Beyond that, GEBE -- which is government owned but independent -- continues having a hard time generating electricity dependably. In fact, St. Maarten media has been compared its reliability to systems in Zimbabwe -- which may well be an insult to Zimbabwe.

Last week, there were one or two additional blackouts which tarnished the island's hard-earned reputation as a vacation Mecca and aggravated its already precarious economy. The independence of GEBE is a problem; despite new management over the last few years, undependability persists. It's not the workers' fault: management is ultimately responsible for quality and dependability and it appears quite clear even to casual observers that it continues to deliver neither.

SXM cannot afford this. It's time for the Dutch Side government to move decisively, to clean house, to remove current senior management and bring in people with a real track record of productivity in this business. Enough is quite enough.

26. Unexpected Surprises End Several SXM Vacations

Think your vacations are full of eventful days? Look at these:
