1. Hurricane Season Starts 6/1; Storm Names

The 2018 Atlantic Hurricane Season begins About 2 1/2 weeks from now, on June 1, and officially ends November 30. The 2018 season is expected to be front loaded since weather conditions are transitioning from a La Niña to, eventually, El Niño, which may be more hostile to tropical development.

Here are storm names for 2018:

Alberto, Beryl, Chris, Debby, Ernesto, Florence, Gordon, Helene, Isaac, Joyce, Kirk, Leslie, Michael, Nadine, Oscar, Patty, Rafael, Sara, Tony, Valerie, William.

2. Download NHC's Hurricane Tracking Chart

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to come by. The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC here. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded, as noted in the previous article — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

3. WestJet Pilots Take Strike Vote

The Canadian airline WestJet resumed flying to SXM only last week, providing the only nonstops from Canada. But this week, its pilots, who have never had a contract, voted to strike on or about next Saturday, May 19, if their current negotiations with the airline aimed at getting a contract agreement don't bring the desired results.

WestJet said it wants successful negotiations. Rival Air Canada said it would do whatever it could to accommodate passengers displaced by any potential work stoppage, but that doesn't help people bound for St. Maarten since no one but WestJet currently flies to SXM from Canada.

Late last week, WestJet did say that it will provide full refunds to any passengers displaced as a result of the strike, if it happens.

Negotiations continue. We will publish any significant developments from the negotiations on our <u>Everything SXM</u> <u>Facebook Site</u> as soon as we receive them.

4. Spirit Air Customer Service Slammed in Poll

Over a number of years, we've seen many criticisms of Spirit Airlines, the low-cost carrier that resumed service to SXM this past week.

We decided to conduct an unscientific poll of our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> readers concerning Spirit. To us, the results were no surprise, since they reflected opinions we've been hearing for years: many SXM tourists slammed the carrier, particularly concerning the quality of their customer service and the fact that as a low-fare carrier, they nickel and dime passengers for just about every imaginable expense.

5. When to Renew Your Passport

First, please heed this admonition: never wait until the last minute to renew your passport.

The best time to renew is at the beginning of an extended period when you won't need it. Otherwise, you could find yourself discovering that your passport is about to expire shortly before you are due to travel with it.

Renewing a passport on an urgent basis can be quite expensive and time-consuming. Although in the recent past, passport renewals have taken as little as three weeks, past performance is no indication of future results; the turnaround you receive could be considerably longer.

Again, the best time to renew as it at the beginning of an extended period during which you're not going to need it. Much more about passport renewal was contained in a recent thread on our Everything SXM Facebook Site. Use the "search" window there to find the story.

6. Current SXM Weather Info (Updated)

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

- 1) Crown Weather Services whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

8. Divi Resort Reopens

Divi Little Bay Beach Resort reopened as scheduled on Saturday, May 12. They were widely expected to be one of the first resorts to reopen since they suffered comparatively little damage from hurricane Irma. After the storm, much of the resort was occupied by Dutch Marines, who came to the island quickly to help get things back in order — and many of whom stayed at Divi and at Simpson Bay Resort, which has also largely reopened.

9. Flamingo Resort Update

Yvonne M. reports from SXM:

"Flamingo update this week---there are jackhammers going all day long in many buildings, work on the outside has slowed too as inside demolition progresses. They may be waiting for roofing materials to arrive, that will be a lot of material.

"Something new--landscapers are on many grounds areas keeping things growing and looking nice. They are at most of the buildings and the effort is paying off especially with the great rains we have had in the past two weeks.

"The beach is cleaned up to the corner between the studios and two bedroom apartments... the debris is larger and heavier in that space. We plan to get over there this weekend and try to finish the job. The clearing we did previously is holding well AND we see people in the surf more often, so the beach is welcoming people back!

"I ran into our longtime and favorite (and often commended Flamingo maintenance man), Rafael Richardson. He is working on some of the interior Flamingo work in progress. (HOORAY!) But the good news is that he said the "new Flamingo" will be so much better than the former one that was "wearing out." He said we are all going to be so happy with the changes. I figure someone who worked on the "guts" of the buildings for all those years, is a pretty good judge of the old and coming new and working on it now he is in the know. He was so positive and upbeat, I left feeling hopefully inspired and posted my old photo from the balcony of 7212 of the rainbow. ... (Copied and pasted from my post on Flamingo Royal Palm Facebook page.)"

10. Royal Islander Resort Update

Royal Islander recently wrote to its timeshare owners:

"Dear Valued Members,

"Since our last update at the beginning of the year, we have dedicated the past three months to rebuild and repair sections of the buildings that were damaged by Hurricane Irma. The work is still ongoing with the scraping, repairing and reapplying texture to the walls and waterproofing our roofs, and now, we have started to focus on the interiors.

"Tortuga Restaurant is also being rebuilt from the ground up into a contemporary lounge bar and restaurant.

"Although the reconstruction and recovery processes are fully underway, due to many challenges beyond our control, we cannot confirm an official reopening date yet. We hope to confirm a date soon, however, as of now, we don't foresee reopening before October 1st, 2018.

"We would like to share with you a few renderings to give you a glimpse of the new look you will soon expect to see

at Royal Islander Club "La Plage" and its facilities.

"We thank you all so much again for your outpouring generosity, patience and support during the past few months. Every phone call, email, post, message and thought means the world to each one of us."

11. Festiva Atrium is NOT For Sale

About two years ago, management at Festiva Atrium Resort produced an attractive PDF brochure about their property which included reference to its availability for sale at USD\$10-million. The brochure was dutifully posted on their website.

Time passed, and interest by resort owners in selling Atrium disappeared, management tells us.

More than a week ago, curious eyes on the Internet found that two-year-old PDF available for download from Atrium's website and a small, localized Internet sensation started. It was a reasonable conclusion that they wanted to sell, since the brochure was created by Atrium and posted on their own site.

Several people who saw the Internet post inquired about it with the resort almost simultaneously, and were quickly informed that no, the resort is not for sale, and that the PDF's presence on the web had simply been overlooked. Shortly after the flurry began, the brochure was removed from their website and the flurry was over.

Again, Atrium management says the resort is not for sale, so its timeshare owners should not be particularly nervous.

12. Sea Palace Owners Face Big Assessments

Timeshare owners at St. Maarten Sea Palace resort in Philipsburg earlier this month received detailed information on what's happening with the resort in its relationship with Nagico, the largest insurer in the Caribbean. Nagico has been the subject of massive criticism due to the alleged slowness and incompleteness of its response to claims filed in the wake of hurricane Irma.

Bottom line, SXM Weekly News has learned that assessments in the neighborhood of roughly \$500 per timeshare week owned will be billed to all St. Maarten Sea Palace timeshare owners.

Details on the status of Sea Palace are in this report from the resort to its timeshare owners.

13. Overall, Heavy Action at Major Timeshares

Visitors to SXM checking out the status of timeshare resorts across the island are reporting back on our Everything SXM Facebook Site that there is action everywhere. Many timeshare resorts have already reopened, and serious action remains underway as remaining resorts work hard to get their properties ready for occupancy later this year, in most cases.

We've been constantly updating the Files area on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> to ensure that it has the most complete information available on the status of all timeshares across the island.

If you own timesharing in SXM and/or plan to rent timeshare weeks, check our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> for details on the status of your selected resort.

14. Holland House Beach Hotel Open, Gorgeous

Late in 2016, working on assignment for a website used for reference by travel agents, we visited dozens of SXM

resorts one of which was the Holland House Beach Hotel in downtown Philipsburg. We were impressed by the beauty of the rooms, how quiet the property was despite its Philipsburg downtown location, and how clean and impressive the restaurant and bar were that are located on Great Bay beach.

Virtually every hotel or timeshare on any beach on SXM was seriously damaged by Irma. However, one of the first places to complete its restorations was Holland House Beach Hotel, which has now reopened.

We think you will find this video of interest.

15. How to Walk Away from Your Timeshare

We believe that most timeshare owners in St. Maarten have units that are fully paid for. Most people who bought aftermarket timeshare resales paid comparatively little for them, so we'd suspect there again that most of those timeshare owners also already have paid off their properties. (It's a strong hunch.)

What if you've had your unit or units for a number of years and now want to move on, and do something else — how do you get rid of the units?

Each timeshare resort has its own procedures for turning back timeshare weeks you own. Some people simply send their resorts a note and tell them they're done, without filing any forms or paying any fees. Our gut tells us it's always best to do everything legal regardless of where you are.

Making sure that what you do goes through normal legal processes simply involves contacting your resort and asking them what paperwork is required, and having then email it to you, along with any necessary instructions.

Regardless of what you do, we urge you to try to sell your week before turning it back to your resort. No harm in trying. See the timeshare rentals page on our main website, everythingsxm.com; you can place ads on that heavily visited page if you are a JMB Website Supporters member. Info on membership is on the site as well; access it by clicking the page curl on everythingsxm.com.

Note: There is no common form or procedure with all resorts across the island. Most resorts want you to complete a one-page form and pay a nominal fee. If you sell your week, which is always a better alternative than just turning it back, in our opinion, you must file whatever forms are required by your resort. Some need notarization — and virtually all require fees set by the resort. Our main SXM website, everythingSXM.com, publishes sale and rental ads for our paid JMB Website Supporters members. The page is quite busy and timeshare owners seem to get very good results from it.Selling your timeshare week isn't the same as walking away, but it will probably make you feel better because everything is very tidy -- and you do get paid.

With several timeshare resorts back online — Belair, Sea Palace, Divi, and Atrium Resort, with Simpson Bay and Oyster Bay Beach following quickly -- timeshare owners are now posting units available for rent on our <u>timeshare</u> rental site on <u>everythingSXM.com</u> and on our new companion Villas for Rent page, also on everythingsxm.com. Lots of news briefs from our ace reporter on the French Side who for now has chosen to remain publicly anonymous. Here we go:

- a) The site where Simply Market was in Hope Estate near Orient has been completely cleared and fenced in. Simply had been bought by the **Super U** folks some time ago. Their intent was to open a new (presumably somewhat bigger) Super U in Hope Estate. Those plans were blown away by Irma. Site prep is underway. We'll keep an eye on it and let you know what happens. - c) **Bacchus** is opening on Front Street, Philipsburg, next month, and in Cupecoy where Escape (formerly FIG, Citrus and the Market) were located. **Bacchus at Cupecoy** is slated to reopen in November, and yet another Bacchus will open at the former location of **La Vie en Rose** in Marigot, where there are currently no other bakeries open.

22. Sargassum Seaweed Situation Stinks, Suffering Citizens Say

The Dutch Side dump is not the island's only festering problem; Sargassum seaweed from the Sargasso Sea has set its sites on SXM's scenic shoreline again. The stuff stinks -- until it's removed it is a nuisance to tourists, and for endangered sea turtles, hatchlings trying to get to the ocean find it difficult to traverse.

We contacted both Sarah Wescot-Williams in the Dutch Side government and Kingdom of the Netherlands State Secretary Raymond Knops for comments. Mr. Knops told us that the seaweed situation "is a responsibility of the country SXM. Just like the landfill this must have priority and needs to be solved."

We'll keep you posted.

23. Carnival Dream's Brief Nightmare

A great example of "Fake News" appeared last week thanks to poor reporting by BBC (TV news in the US) and others of a broken pipe in the fire suppression system of the Carnival Dream cruise ship.

They used the word "Titanic" and "water pouring into staterooms" from which their audience could infer that the ship was taking on a lot of water and everyone was in danger.

It wasn't and they weren't.

A water supply pipe in the ship's fire suppression system let go in a hallway near several cabins. Crews came to shut the water off and fix the pipe, and spent several hours cleaning the hallway and all the staterooms. It was not that huge a deal. Carnival refunded the fares of all affected passengers, though that was only a small number....

The "nightmare" was more the adverse publicity than the actual event. It was unpleasant but was never dangerous to passengers or crew.

24. Chinese Hotel Still On, But Smaller

The "Pearl of China" apartment / hotel / trade center project on Little Bay near Little Bay Pond (down the beach from Belair Beach Resort) is going forward, its backers say, though in a slimmed-down version that supposedly looks less like an oversized cinder block and more like a resort.

We'll keep you posted and we'll have pictures -- if it ever actually starts construction.

25. Condo & Hotel Projects Moving Forward...

A number of condo and hotel projects, mostly on the Dutch Side, continue to move forward. We've reported on them over the last year. We'll be looking closely at which ones are moving into construction and we'll be reporting on that in detail as we move closer to the next high season.
