


1. How "Busy" Hurricane Season Is Doesn't Matter

Various forecasters have issued various forecasts regarding the prospective severity of the 2018 hurricane season, which began last Friday. But at the end of the day, what matters is if one of those hurricanes hits where you are, which could be any place from the Caribbean through the US Gulf Coast and the East Coast northward to Maritime Canada.

The season may be frontloaded, meaning that much of its action could occur earlier in the season rather than later. If you live in any hurricane-prone area, get yourself prepared. See our newly expanded and updated Weather Center on our site, <u>everythingSXM.com</u>. For the most capable forecasts we've seen anywhere, sign up for Rob Lightbown's private forecasting service (very inexpensive) at <u>CrownWeather.com</u>. We think he's the best out there.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u> .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

10. The Dutch Side Drone Problem: See The Map

About a week ago, there was a short debate on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> about flying drones on the Dutch side of the island.

A drone enthusiast who identified himself as a pilot flew his drone from the beach near Royal Palm Resort in Simpson Bay not far from the airport. He said he had obtained permission "from the Tower," a bogus claim since "The Tower" is not involved at all in drone authorizations.

Here, from SXM Airport, is the exact process that must be followed by SXM visitors regarding drones:

Dear Mr. ---,

Thank you for the email. With regard to your question on the restricted area, I have attached a Google map chart of the area that would be off limits with respect to drone operations. In this regard, it is also expressly prohibited to operate the drone within the landing and take-off paths of the arriving and departing aircraft at Princess Juliana International airport. Most importantly the Department want all individuals who will be using their drone during the regatta to do so in a safe and responsible manner that will not cause a dangerous situation to aircraft, participants of the regatta, or the general public.

With your application please include the following; 1. Written request addressed to the Department Head, Mr. Louis Halley; 2. Information on the type and model of the drone; 3. Operations Specifications; 4. Takeoff and landing zone; 5. Proposed route. (chart or Google map caption).

Our Comment:

We advise anyone who has any intention of flying drones on the Dutch side of the island to simply leave them at home. Princess Juliana SXM airport is in the heart of Simpson Bay. Approaching and departing aircraft may fly quite low over much of Simpson Bay, Cole Bay, Cupecoy, and related offshore areas.

A map created by the airport specifically shows the no-fly zone that exists around the airport and over much of the Dutch side of the island; it is posted in our above-referenced File.

It's our hope that SXM government authorities expand the size of the no-fly zone. Drones have the capability of flying several thousand feet high — which means that a number of departing aircraft fly over Point Blanche when heading for Europe, and others take this route when headed northward toward the US. It is not safe or advisable to fly any drone in the potential path of any aircraft leaving or approaching the island, and that could happen unless the no-fly zone becomes more restrictive.

There have also been tourist Helicopters flying over the nearby French side plus low-flying commuter planes

frequently flying low as they begin their journey to neighboring islands or as they approach SXM Airport for landing.

We know that drone restrictions are a work in progress and we urge all of our readers to leave their drones at home, for the safety of everyone.

11. Contingent of Dutch Police Staying in Place

The Dutch side police have been short staffed for as long as anyone can remember, and they continue to be short staffed today.

Fortunately, about 35 members of the Dutch police, assigned to the island in the wake of hurricane Irma, will remain on SXM until at least the end of August, according to the most recent information received in our newsroom. Several more Dutch police officers are working with Dutch side police at the prison in Point Blanche.

We'll have more about this as needed going forward.

12. Paradise not Utopia: No One Hurt in Villa Robbery

Police-provided details remain sketchy, but the good news about an attempted robbery at an oyster pond villa on the Dutch side is that no one was hurt.

We would speculate that although the robbers were dressed in black and carried weapons, they probably believed that the villa was unoccupied and that its contents might be easy pickings (Speculation). They encountered occupants when attempting to enter the property early one morning last week. They relieved the occupants of some of their possessions and also allegedly stole some things from the villa, police say.

Beyond that, very little was released by police, who are continuing to investigate. As we've said before here, and on our <u>everything SXM site</u>, it's important to keep windows and doors locked when you are staying at any hotel, villa, or timeshare anywhere to help prevent things like this from happening. No place is immune.

13. No Sign of Chikungunya, Zika in SXM

A Canadian travel advisory concerning SXM pointed to the possibility that tourists could run into the Zika virus on SXM, among other places.

However, all of the current news from the island shows no evidence of either Zika or Chikungunya currently present. There have been ambitious programs in place to eradicate mosquitoes, particularly aedes agypti which are "vectors" that can carry these viruses. We will continue to keep you updated on this story.

Tens of thousands of Canadians visit SXM every year. Now that the threat of a WestJet strike no longer exists, passengers are making reservations as usual and coming to the island in increasing numbers.

The government of Canada is providing cautionary information to its citizens concerning SXM. It is not telling its

18. Le Pressoir Coming Back

News of the death of Le Pressoir Restaurant in Grand Case, as they say, was greatly exaggerated. Melanie and Franck Mear, co-owners, are on the island and are about to begin the arduous task of rebuilding their restaurant, one of the best gourmet French restaurants on the entire island and a winner of uncountable awards.

Dating from the mid-1800s, the home in which the restaurant was located had its kitchen in the back, near the

beach. Its dining rooms were in the front, facing busy Boulevard de Grand Case.

Nine months ago this week, Irma paid a visit with an 18-foot storm surge around the island, sustained 185 mile-perhour winds, and recorded gusts up to 240 mph with a tornado or two. Grand Case was very hard-hit but a number of restaurants have already reopened and now, Le Pressoir is preparing to be added to that list.

19. Boca Marina Reopens

Boca Marina, on the lagoon alongside the airport runway, has now reopened. It says the location is opposite Bada Bing, but our understanding is that the location has not changed; it's still not far from the western terminus of the lagoon Causeway, on Airport Road.

20. La Rosa Reopens

La Rosa Restaurant, in Maho Plaza, reopens today, Monday, June 4, and is available for reservations.

21. Maho Coming Back to Life

The entirety of SXM, "our" dual-nation island in the Northeast Caribbean, was pummeled by Irma. There is some disagreement about what areas were hit hardest but the fact is that the entire island was nailed, with no areas spared of devastation.

That was then. This is now:

One area that immediately became a ghost town after the storm was the Maho area, normally teeming with activity. Sonesta Maho and Sonesta Ocean Point, along with both sections of the sprawling Royal Islander resort were practically knocked to oblivion by the storm. It was previously announced here in *SXM Weekly News* that Sonesta Maho and Sonesta Ocean Point will be reopening sooner rather than later — see the specifics in our <u>Everything</u> <u>SXM Facebook Site</u>. Those resorts are already accepting reservations.Symbolic of the return of the entire island, the Maho village commercial area is now coming alive again as well. See that story <u>here</u>.

22. Lee's Says It Reopens This Year

The old Lee's Roadside Grill was forced out of its long-time location near the Simpson Bay drawbridge a number of months ago after Lee lost his long battle with his landlord. Although Lee's is gone, don't fret: *it's coming back*, as we've reported several times.

Folks from Lee's are saying that the restaurant has not yet found a new location, but that it expects to finalize one and reopen sometime later this year.

As always, we'll keep you posted.

23. SkipJacks Plans Late-Year Reopening

One of SXM's largest and busiest restaurants, Skipjacks saw its huge lagoon side dining deck virtually destroyed by hurricane Irma. Rebuilding is underway, and owner George has told us that he expects to reopen sometime late this year. If that changes, we'll revise this.

Although seafood lovers are probably Skipjacks biggest audience, this huge restaurant on Simpson Bay lagoon south of the drawbridge offers practically everything including delicious meat dishes and some vegetarian selections. The service is experienced and very responsive and the food is phenomenal.

Definitely put Skipjacks on your list for a future SXM visit.

24. Are Your Favorite Restaurants Open?

As you can tell, early June shows a tidal wave (you should pardon the expression) of restaurants reopening across SXM. Big restaurants, little restaurants, offering all kinds of dining.

But — are your favorite restaurants now open?

Every day, sometimes multiple times per day, we update our complete list of Dutch side and French side open restaurants in the Files area of our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>. We are not publishing that list here because by the time all 306,000 of our readers received it, that information would be obsolete. Having it available on Facebook enables us to update it instantly, every time we hear of changes.

25. Heavy Equipment Arrives on New Super U Site

Some time ago, the French-based chain that owns the Super U grocery store in Marigot bought both of the island's Simply markets — both the very small one immediately East of the French side drawbridge and the much larger Simply market in hope estate between Orient beach and Grand Case.

Not too long ago, the damaged remains of the Simply market in hope estate were completely demolished, and some site preparation work began. Now, heavy equipment has been moved in, building expectations that construction of the repeatedly delayed new Super U market may be about to start.

We have no reason to think that this site will be anything other than a market. The Super U folks in France operate a few different size markets. Their Hyper U markets are apparently the largest, with Super U down a notch or two in size rankings. The property now being developed appears to be significantly larger than the Super U in Marigot, but we don't know whether the new market will be a Super U or a Hyper U. As soon as we find out, we'll let you know.

The largest market on SXM, and the busiest, is currently the new Carrefour market near Philipsburg, formerly Le Grand Marche. It has the complete Carrefour line plus all the other items previously carried by Le Grand Marche.

26. Cost Pro Opening at Fresh Market Site

The long-closed site of the former Fresh Market in Mme. estate, Dutch side, will soon be reopening with the name Cost Pro.

We don't know whether Cost Pro will imitate the US Costco chain like the nearby Cost-u-Less does. Cost-u-Less even carries some of Costco's private label products, including its canned chicken breast.

What we do know is that Cost Pro picked a name that sounds like Costco. We don't know when it will open, but as soon as we hear we'll let you know.

27. Dutch Side Getting Its Initial USD\$130-million

Government sources are telling *SXM Weekly News* that the island's initial USD\$130-million from the World Bank in post-hurricane redevelopment funds will be arriving on the Dutch side shortly.

We've asked for details on the projects for which these funds will be used, and we expect to have that information shortly. We do know that some \$25-million of the total will help fund the new hospital which will ultimately replace the St. Maarten Medical Center. We're not going to speculate what the rest is going for but we will publish that information here in *SXM Weekly News* once we have it.
