1. Joon Airlines Flying To SXM: Who They Are

Large Airbus aircraft from Joon Airlines have been seen flying into SXM Airport a few times each week. They bear non-US registrations and are commercial jets, but who *are* they?

No, they're not a new low-cost carrier trying to compete with jetBlue, Southwest (which by the way is likely to start serving SXM some time next year), or any other. They're in fact flying to SXM from CDG (Paris) and are owned by Air France. Joon jets will be coming to SXM until October, when jets with the familiar Air France livery will be returning.

2. Sunwing Restarts SXM Flights in February

Canadian carrier Sunwing Airlines is expected to restart service to SXM in February. Hopefully the Canadian dollar, weak against the US dollar and even weaker against the Euro, will recover a bit by then.

3. Cruise Critic Article on SXM

For years, Cruise Critic has been a very well regarded website resource for Cruisers. They've just published an interesting <u>article</u> about SXM which we think you'll enjoy.

4. All Quiet as Hurricane Season Peak Approaches

Although a number of storms can form earlier, the actual peak of the Atlantic hurricane season is early September, a couple of weeks from now, which will also be the first anniversary of Irma.

Customarily, September is a busy hurricane month, especially for long-track hurricanes that form off the coast of Africa and chug through the tropical Atlantic toward Caribbean islands and North America.

Right now, things are relatively quiet but that is not expected to last. See our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> for updated posts about developments during hurricane season. 6. The Best Places for Tropical Updates; Hurricane Tracking Chart

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC here. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that

for later.

8. Some Hotels Seeking Gov't Help in Rebuilding

As we've reported here over the last year, many insurance claims have taken forever to settle in the wake of hurricane Irma, and policyholders whose claims have been processed and settlements agreed to have not all received insurance company payments.

We'll comment a bit more about that in story 23, regarding the island's insurance disaster. Now, some hotels, particularly on the Dutch side where the "insurance disaster" seems to be centered, are asking for government help

to help expedite recovery and rebuilding in the wake of Irma. Here is that story.

9. Still No Word from Westin

A few weeks ago, when we last ran a story about the status of the Westin, there were no new developments. Executives there have said that their claims have not yet been paid and until that happens, they are virtually powerless to rebuild the hotel.

As far as we know, there has been no change in that situation, as we are closing in on the one year anniversary of hurricane Irma.

We will keep watching this and update you as soon as we have new information.

10. Royal Islander Possibly Reopening This November

According to Royal Islander timeshare owners, they have seen very little communication from the owners of the three related Royal Islander resort properties on SXM — Le Plage, La Terrasse, and Great Bay.We've been told by people close to the properties that they may reopen as early as November, but information requests sent to the Spadaro family and the Maho Group have not been answered. Although there seem to be thousands of construction people working at all the Maho area properties, we've been able to confirm nothing further about the actual opening of the Royal Islander properties — only information about the reopening of Sonesta Maho and Sonesta Ocean Point. We've now sent more followups about this to those in charge.

We will publish additional news here as we receive it. See next story.

13. Simpson Bay Resort Getting High Marks

Simpson Bay Resort was one of the first properties on SXM to reopen in the weeks following Irma's devastation. Two others in the same area, Atrium Resort and Baker's Suites, both also reopened quickly.

Despite the fact that apparent tornadic activity spawned by hurricane Irma all but destroyed Simpson Bay's Dieffenbachia, Croton, and Calladium buildings, which the resort was forced to demolish, it nonetheless quickly reopened many rooms in its other buildings to give shelter to its newly homeless employees, Dutch Marines, and people involved in the reconstruction of the rest of the property. It also kept all its employees on the payroll busily cleaning the resort, very much unlike other nearby resorts (Flamingo and Royal Palm specifically).

As a consequence of its actions, Simpson Bay Resort did reopen quickly and has been well able to handle high demand from SXM visitors, who are giving it very high marks — the same kind of high marks it received after its huge renovation was completed early in 2017. It definitely merits your consideration if you're looking for a larger resort on the beach with a spectrum of guest services. The long-duration surge in the number of people from North America moving to SXM shows no signs of abating. In fact, it appears that that surge may well be accelerating.

You'll find increasing numbers of people discussing the advantages and disadvantages of relocation to SXM on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, on the beach in SXM, and elsewhere in SXM.

17. Sint Maarten General Hospital Seeks Building Permits

Dutch political figures and other Dutch Side notables have been saying for years that the St. Maarten Medical Center needs to be replaced. That conversation seemed to gather steam when it became obvious that the so-called "American Clinic's" medical tourism facility proposed for Kimsha beach wasn't going to happen.

Plans for the new St. Maarten General Hospital appear to be sufficiently close to completion to allow building permits to be requested — and that is now exactly what is happening. The location would be very close to the current St. Maarten Medical Center.

We don't know officially how soon after permits are granted construction will begin, much less have an estimated completion date. Everyone has the same hope: the sooner, the better.

18. Lots of Big Restaurant News

We have lots of significant restaurant news for you this week — plus one repudiation of a widely spreading rumor concerning an extremely popular restaurant. There are also several other restaurant-related articles in the rest of this edition of SXM Weekly News.

Here goes:

- 1. The widespread rumor that **Lee's Roadside Grill** is going to move to the site of Cugini restaurant in Simpson Bay near the carousel is false, according to the folks from Lee's. They wrote us: "Cugini would be a great location but no this is not true. Lee has always held his ideas and passions to a certain level of quality and while the offers have been plenty nothing has matched the standards he requires. Yet we believe we will be operational and have a new location in the Simpson Bay area within the next 3-6 months, a location that will respect the size and legacy that Lee wants to hold up with his brand." We of course will keep you posted on what happens with Lee's. (Other speculation regards Kim Sha beach. In any case, we'll keep you posted.)
- 2. **Sale E Pepe** we are told is moving to a new building next to the gas station in Simpson bay (used to be Sol). The current Sale E Pepe location, we're told, will be turned into a pizza place. Fine dining will go into the new building.
- 3. Alina Sushi & Sake Bar in Simpson Bay moves to new space on top of Casino Royale, Maho district...
- 4. **Taste Factory** we are told is for rent.
- 5. The Boathouse is for sale.
- 6. **Bajatzu** is moving from Maho to the current location of the French Touch (formerly So French) Restaurant (opposite Buccaneer, near Atrium and Simpson Bay Resort.
- 7. **Lal's** "Curry in a Hurry" has been sold to Indian investors from Prime Distributing. The entire staff is still there and the menu is unchanged. Lal has decided to take a rest after decades of work and many thousands of late nights. If we know Lal, though, he'll be into something else in 2019; we'll keep you posted, as always.

More restaurant news is below; please read on.

19. SkipJack's Targeting Reopening Later This Year

SkipJacks has always been one of the islands largest and busiest and of course most popular restaurants. Although it looks a bit small from the street, the restaurant had a very big dining deck over Simpson Bay lagoon until Irma decided to blow it apart.

The good news is that the main building survived, but the entire deck and the adjacent decks had to be rebuilt. That is all underway. The owner told us that they are expected to reopen sometime late this year. We will recheck next month to see if there has been any change in that scheduling, although our bet is that Skipjacks will open as stated.

20. IZI Planning Seasonal Vacation, October Reopening

iZi Ristorante Italiano, open for lunch and dinner, under its founder and owner David Foini has been the most dominant Italian nightspot in Simpson Bay and clearly one of the island's top Italian restaurants ever since it was founded more than 10 years ago. It has been open for lunch and dinner since several weeks after Irma struck.

iZi closely guards its recipes — developed painstakingly by David through years in business. The quality of David's food has long been unexcelled and the service is always impeccable.

If you have not yet visited iZi Ristorante Italiano opposite Pineapple Pete in Simpson Bay, just do it. The only bad news is that their annual closing starts next week (about the 26th) and they won't reopen until October. If you haven't added them to your list, do it — you won't regret it. They are also our Restaurant of the Week; see story number 36.

21. Cost-U-Less Plans Early-Sept. Reopening

Cost-u-Less near Philipsburg, SXMs only warehouse-style store, has a huge variety of items at reasonable prices for SXM — and it is now planning an official reopening early next month, which will be a big relief to many shoppers. If you like Kirkland products sold by Costco, you will be happy to know that a number of Costco Kirkland products are also sold at Cost-u-Less. The bad news is that due to shipping costs, pricing in SXM isn't what it is in your nearby Costco warehouse back in the USA. But you will find a large variety of fresh food here. Liquor, as well.

22. On Philipsburg's Carrefour & New Super U in Hope Estate

Progress continues toward the reopening of the large Carrefour supermarket near Philipsburg, which was heavily damaged by a roof fire almost two months ago. We have not yet heard a reopening date but knowing these folks, we're sure it will be as soon as humanly possible. Our hunch: some time in October, possibly late.

Construction of the large new Super U supermarket in Hope Estate on the French Side, between Orient and Grand Case, continues. We don't know their grand opening date but we've asked someone to check out the progress this coming week. As soon as we learn anything, we'll pass it along. It's possible that they could be open by late this year or next winter.

23. For Many, SXM's Disastrous Insurance Mess Drags On

The reality is that SXM didn't suffer just one disaster over the last year. It suffered three.

The first of course was hurricane Irma which, with its 180 mph winds and recorded 240 mph gusts, and its 18 foot storm surge gave the island a pummeling that was beyond belief. Fortunately, the island's recovery has also been beyond belief even though it has had to cope with two additional disasters.

The second disaster was hurricane Maria. Irma ripped the roof off many homes and businesses.. When Maria came not long after, it dumped copious water into buildings left roofless by Irma. The result was lots of mold.

The third disaster in the view of most people was 100% avoidable: the unconscionable delay in processing and paying claims from policyholders of NAGICO, the St. Maarten-based insurance company that dominated the insurance market at the time Irma hit.

We absolutely understand that Irma broke all records for intensity and damage ever suffered on SXM, and that it was the most powerful Atlantic hurricane in history. Since that was obvious days before it struck, NAGICO's emergency plan for a natural disaster should have involved post-storm intense claims analysis and processing activities to match the challenges presented by the storm. Instead, NAGICO in particular has, according to its own policyholders, nickel and dimed people by requesting records destroyed in the storm, allegedly failed to pay legitimate claims, and has also allegedly stonewalled payment of claims it already has agreed to settle, according to NAGICO policyowners we spoke with. Those actions have hurt the economy of the entire island though we must point out that many businesses and individuals ingeniously have worked to recover on their own, using whatever resources they can lay their hands on, even though they say they were legitimately entitled to insurance payments they still have never received.

There is no doubt there were three disasters on the island and the third of them, SXM's insurance debacle, is not yet over.

24. Captain Frenchy's Looking Toward Bigger / Better

The former Capt. Frenchy's restaurant on Boulevard de Grand Case in the heart of Grand Case is going to make a major comeback. Its owner has said he plans to build a new restaurant and a small hotel in Grand Case; here is that story.

25. Sargassum Seaweed Still an Issue

There is good and bad news today about Sargassum seaweed from the Sargasso Sea.

The smelly, ugly stuff has been invading virtually all of the Caribbean plus much of the Gulf of Mexico, the Texas coast, and the Mexican Gulf coast for the last several years.

First the good news: much of the island is virtually unaffected by the seaweed, particularly western and southwestern

facing beaches like Simpson Bay..

The bad news is that Eastern facing beaches like Guana Bay and even the Point Blanche area have been heavily affected by the seaweed.

26. Police Station Fire Alarm Caused by Drone Battery

Firefighters poured into SXM police headquarters the other day to find out what the source was of smoke which set off the building's fire alarm system. What they found was that a police drone battery being recharged had overheated and was generating smoke. The charging process was stopped before any real damage could occur.

Drones are powerful tools long used by businesses, law enforcement agencies, the military, news gathering organizations, firefighters, and search and rescue personnel. But like other devices containing batteries, they may function improperly and at times become dangerous.

If you charge anything containing a lithium-ion battery in your home or business, make sure there is a smoke detector nearby just in case.

27. SXM Monuments Suffer Severe Damage from Irma

The Dutch side has national monuments spread across the country. A just-completed analysis has found that they have suffered severe damage from hurricane Irma. <u>That story is here</u>.
