## 1. Tropical Storm Florence Forms Well East of SXM

Tropical storm Florence, the sixth tropical cyclone of the season, formed over the weekend near the Cabo Verde islands in the Eastern tropical Atlantic. Although at this point the storm is not expected to affect the leeward islands, it nonetheless bears watching since it will moisten up the previously dry pathway between the coast of West Africa and the Leewards — perhaps making the trip for future tropical systems one that is more conducive to development.

Forecasters initially said the storm may rev up once it reaches the Bahamas, several days away; but now it may be that the storm misses the Bahamas entirely.

# 2. Next Up: Gordon & Helene

Tropical cyclone Florence is now active in the Atlantic. Two other storms appear to be forming: Gordon, at this writing moving from the Florida Keys into the Gulf of Mexico, and possibly Helene, expected to form off the coast of West Africa this week.

# 3. End-of-August Weather in SXM

When hurricane Irma struck St. Maarten a year ago this week, it stripped the island completely bare of vegetation. Within a few weeks, the island's typically green foliage began to return and by spring, the island was quite lush.

The Summer has been dry, however, and much of the countryside has turned brown. As we begin to move into a rainier pattern, things should start to lush up. Current forecast information is always available on our main SXM site, <a href="everythingSXM.com">everythingSXM.com</a>.

# 4. Farmer's Almanac: Long, Colder-Than-Normal Winter Coming

Forecasters have not yet used the term brutal to describe next winter's weather, but from the sound of things published in the *Farmers Almanac*, that may be coming.

Bear in mind that this report is from the Farmers Almanac, not the rival *Old Farmer's Almanac*. Meteorologists don't give much credence to these forecasts, but lots of people do.

All we'll say is that Winter in the US and Canada as well as Europe will be far colder and snowier than it will be in St. Maarten. We think the choice of where you want to be this Winter couldn't be clearer, no matter what happens at home.

# 5. Jet Blue Ups Baggage Fee on Cheapest Seats; Others Follow

Although all its airplanes have a single cabin, JetBlue does offer three different seat pricing tiers to its passengers. If you buy the cheapest seats on JetBlue, you will now pay \$30 to check your first suitcase.

One JetBlue executive said that the cost of jet fuel has increased by 65% in the last year or so, so something had to give to help the airline generate more revenue to cover the increased fuel costs. The first bag is still free for passengers buying seats in the other two JetBlue fare tiers.

Here is more on the change, which was quickly followed by Air Canada and WestJet.

# 6. Worsening Pilot Shortage Promises Effects on Passengers

With many thousands of baby boomer pilots about to retire, the world's airlines are looking to their regional cohorts as a sort of farm system for the next generation of pilots. Legacy carriers in the US don't expect serious problems as a result of the shortage, but not all observers agree.

Pilots with whom we spoke note that many have chosen corporate pilot positions which are lucrative but not necessarily always as frenetic as commercial pilot schedules.

They also cite the huge cost of becoming a pilot -- unless they learn their skills free with one of the armed services. The cost of lessons can be upwards of \$80,000, for which there is no such thing as scholarships or student loans. Worse, initial jobs are often with smaller carriers where the pay is around \$50,000, less than half the pay pilots make on larger commercial carriers.

Side effects of the shortage for passengers of legacy airlines could be delays, cancellations, schedule foul-ups, etc., although some legacy carriers insist that they are prepared and that none of this is likely. We'll keep an eye on this moving forward. This is our second story this year on this topic.

## 7. AA Resuming CLT-SXM Flights 11/4

American Airlines has announced that it will be resuming its nonstops between Charlotte and SXM effective November 4, just in time for some holiday travel.

# 8. AA's MIA-SXM-MIA Flights Returning

American Airlines is also resuming its overnight flights from Miami sometime in February, at the latest.

These flights land in SXM late in the evening, staying at the terminal overnight. The same airplane becomes the return flight to Miami early the next morning, enabling passengers to enjoy convenient same-day connections to the rest of the American Airlines domestic system.

# 9. Sunwing To Resume SXM Flights From Toronto & Montreal

Canadian carrier Sunwing plans to resume nonstop flights to SXM from both Montréal and Toronto on February 28. The flights will be weekly.

Why the airline is not resuming flights earlier in the face of serious demand — and why it isn't introducing frequency greater than weekly — is something only the airline knows. Hopefully, it will revise its plan and resume flights to the airline earlier and with greater frequency.

We'll keep watching this for you.

- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <a href="https://www.island92.com">www.island92.com</a>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

#### **Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:**

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <a href="here">here</a>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

## 12. Update on the Status of Flamingo Beach Resort

This report was written by Yvonne Mendenhall, a Moderator on our Everything SXM Facebook Site. Here it is:

We met in room 7210, Mervin's Flamingo office. They are using that room as the existing sample of the "original" studio and have a room in the 600 building that is being maintained as the sample for Villa rooms.

REBUILDING PROGRESS: Some of the big points: The work is going well, demolition is nearly done. They are a little behind the schedule, but Mervin feels that is not a problem, they will LIKELY catch up and the reasons for the slower progress are good reasons. They also have built in time for most likely delays in their schedule.

They are making more and better construction decisions by taking the time to work with the contractor to do a superb job (not just a good job) of rebuilding. He described some of the improved changes and said Diamond and the insurer are supportive because it should build in lasting improvements.

One thing all of us who survived Irma at Flamingo should be pleased about is they are planning to affix the sliding glass terrace panels to the concrete floor AND concrete ceilings to make them stronger. In so many cases with Irma, the glass survived, but the frames gave away. They are also testing several new concrete mixtures and have test areas already in place for the contractor and insurers and Diamond to observe and evaluate.

Roofing is completed on building 7, but the flat roofs (Villa buildings) are going to be redone from the base up. That is a recent change of plans. They found that the many repairs, made through the years, has offered lots of new "trails" for water to flow and leak into rooms. Rather than "patch it up again" they will remove all the layers of repairs down to the base and add new and improved materials.

One other delay is new complete drawings are being done of all buildings to make future maintenance, care, replacement and changes better controlled. The new drawings will be electronically stored as well as hard copy, so they don't get lost through years of transition. The lack of accurate drawings are slowing the current repair process, so it is wise to avoid such delays in the future and of course having accurate current drawings will help the current reconstruction.

REOPENING HOPES: He is still careful about estimating a reopening because there are so many unknown variables (like weather), but there is HOPE that some of the units may be ready for a "soft opening" at the end of 2019 and the rest following shortly after. You can't bank on that yet!! The next few months should help see into that future a bit better. PLEASE don't make airline reservations until there is more data and a more firm calendar!! We should start hearing more on reopening dates once they really get into the reconstruction --starting soon.

STAFF: Mervin said that during demolition they hired around 4 dozen former Flamingo staff both women and men who worked for them through that process. Now that reconstruction is coming along, they will try to rehire some of the staff to help with the new work. He said many have found other jobs, a few are still working for them in landscaping and upkeep tasks. Some have retired. He believes Harold has retired, but said he will try to get an update. He is also going to see if he can find out something about Remy. Others he said are working at nearby resorts and with contract firms.

DESIGN AND DECORATING: Mervin had a small online "swatch" sampling page someone shared with him that he showed us, he warns it's not final, but they are definitely going with a tropical look! The colors were blues, greens, whites, and some nice wood hues. He said he is confident when we are at the Flamingo we will know we are in the Caribbean!!

Currently he said the room arrangement plans for the studios will include moving the bed to the front section in all units. The kitchen areas may be placed similarly to the existing layout, or they may be located where the bed is now placed. Sitting in room 7210, we could see what he described, but it's hard to imagine in the empty spaces. Likely some of those plans will adjust over the months, so we are just happy to hear it will be open and Caribbean happy! We didn't discuss the bedroom units, but they never had the sliding wall issue blocking owners from the beautiful view.

RESTAURANT: NOW, the restaurant! There will NOT be a structure on the beach. The beautiful beach will be for guests' enjoyment, views, relaxation, playing and sunning! There will be food service, but it will be mostly lighter, grill type choices, beverages, snacks, light breakfasts, etc. Possibly a small area (patio?) for a few tables. And, they are talking about beach-side service!! YAY! Mervin said that Simpson Bay area is where the growth is happening, so an onsite restaurant is not really needed, but good quality and easily available food and beverage offerings for guests and visitors will happen. The pool bar is likely to remain and they are looking at the corner near the stairs as a possible location for the main grill area.

HOWEVER, they are still looking at other possible sites on the property for the food service area(s), so it's not a final decision. Doug and I agreed with him that a "destination restaurant" would struggle with the new competition in this area and is unnecessary with all the new and varied restaurant options already underway down the street on Welfare Road.

People who come to Sint Maarten should get out into the diverse, exciting, interesting and active island to experience this amazing place!!

PHOTOS: All but the last three photos were taken this afternoon. I nearly cried when I went into OUR studio at 7212 and took my "annual photo" of the beach. It is so hard to be in our "happy place" and have it be empty without the liveliness and full happiness we have known for 30 years. Mervin said he walks the two properties at the end of each day, and often feels the same wave of sadness: this place is for people and it is not complete without us!! I feel it every time we walk by, and that's usually twice a day. A tug of the blues!!

DISCLAIMER: I tried very hard to hear Mervin and not put words into his mouth! He is a very positive man, and since this all started when he was a little hesitant about becoming a property construction manager for TWO properties, he has grasped the details and seems to be a great negotiator! Doug and I both felt Mervin is very positive, he watches the weather patterns, local politics and business activities, economics, and the community. I think he's good at seeing the pieces and realizing how it all works together. And, he loves the island!

## 13. Westin Begins Renovations?

As we've noted here, reconstruction and renovation are underway at the Dawn Beach Club, the timeshare component of the Westin St. Maarten Resort and Casino.

Several weeks ago, we wrote that the Westin was still waiting for payment on its insurance claims so it could finalize plans moving forward.

Although we have not heard from the hotel regarding any changes in its status, Michael Dean and Jim Tate have posted comments and photographs online from which it could be inferred that repair and renovation work is underway at the Westin itself, in addition to the Dawn Beach Club.

We have not been able to confirm this information with our sources at Columbia Sussex or elsewhere. As soon as we have feedback, we'll pass it along. In the meantime, if you view the Westin from Dawn beach, you should expect to see a fair amount of renovation/reconstruction activity in its campus.

# 18. First Anniversary of Irma, 9/6

All the major land-falling hurricanes conjure up pretty terrible memories. Katrina. Andrew. Carol. Sandy. Luis. Harvey. Maria. Georges. And countless others.

Despite thousands of deaths and hundreds of billions of dollars in damage, these storms all have one thing in common: they were not as powerful as hurricane Irma, the most powerful Atlantic hurricane ever — and only the second most powerful tropical cyclone in recorded world history. (The most powerful tropical cyclone was a super typhoon a number of years ago which had sustained winds of 190 mph, just 5 mph more than hurricane Irma.)Irma also brought with it a storm surge estimated at upwards of 18 feet and gusts recorded up to about 240 mph, the same speed as many super-powerful tornadoes.

Although the island has made a remarkable recovery, there is quite a lot of PTSD there because of the personal nightmares shared by so many. The first anniversary of the storm is this coming Thursday, September 6. We'd like to suggest that all of our readers observe a moment of reflection at 9:06 a.m. that day in reference to the lives lost and the lives changed forever during that terrible storm.

# 20. Baie Rouge's Chez Raymond Closed and Bulldozed...

At the beginning of last week, after *SXM Weekly News* had already been transmitted, a troop of gendarmes surrounded the Chez Raymond beach bar that has been a landmark on Bay Rouge for decades and ordered it shut down. A few days later bulldozers arrived and the place was demolished.

As if to add an exclamation point to all this, the bulldozers even destroyed the stairs which enabled people to get to the beach easily. Beyond that, the parking lot was fenced off and people were told to park on the street, a remarkably bad idea on the curb of a busy highway through the lowlands from both a safety and security perspective.

A firestorm ensued. It seems that much of this was private activity — including the demolition which was not initiated by, condoned by, or conducted by the French side government. The firestorm resulted in the removal of the fence late last week, enabling people once again to use the parking lot.

The Soualiga Post published the following article shortly after Gendarmes seized the property:

"Restaurant on Baie Rouge Operating Illegally"

English auto-translation:

A new report in flagrance of the illegal operation of a beach restaurant in Baie Rouge was made Sunday, August 18 by the gendarmes," announces the parquet floor of St. Martin. The operating equipment of the establishment has been seized.

The operation took place within the framework of the committee of environmental and urban policies (COPOLENU) of the Northern Islands, which "aims in particular to allow the reconstruction in the legality and the respect of the rules of town planning".

The investigation is in progress. "The prosecution will soon indicate the nature of the proposed criminal prosecution against the operator and his daughter, who are in the process of hearing," said the deputy prosecutor Monday morning in a statement. "The farmer and his daughter occupy without right or title, a private property, where they have done work without a building permit, in a non-buildable area according to the local POS and with strong constraints of the PPRN (exploitation thus irregularizable), without declare the staff nor pay taxes and charges corresponding to the turnover, and without a license to sell alcohol ", adds the floor.

This same restaurant had already been closed in December 2012 following a control of the veterinary services. Its up to standards and work in the kitchen had allowed its reopening by the prefecture.

However, it remained illegal on the beach. In fact, the restaurants operating in Baie-Rouge must not request a temporary occupation permit (AOT) from the Collectivité (as requested in 2012 from the operator) but from the Terres Basses association. However, the association has not issued any authorization.

The French Side President, Daniel Gibbs, recently said this:

On the fallout from the Baie Rouge eviction affair, he stated: "The general issue of private beaches is legal and must be addressed at the source. There are two ways of doing this. I have chosen to deal with the issue in depth, because we are agreed that beaches of this territory must be accessible to all.

"On the problem of the Lowlands in particular, I met both parties. Each was able to explain to me his point of view and his difficulties. I am listening, but everyone knows that the Collectivité cannot intervene in a court decision. As far as access to the beach is concerned, we made sure with the Préfète that the parking lot was reopened. That is done and everyone can enjoy the beach.

"As for beach management in general, I am working with Préfète Sylvie Feucher to find sustainable solutions and I can tell you solutions exist to ensure that all beaches – public or private – are promoted and accessible to the public. At the same time, I am also committed to ensuring that public order and current regulations in force are respected on our beaches. I am speaking in terms of occupation of the public domain.

"As President, I want to send a message: this is not a time for division, but for unity. My role as president is to maintain calm and social peace. Believe me, St. Martin doesn't need division. And I condemn any political manoeuvring that exacerbates tensions unnecessarily and obscures the real debate. Let us ask the real questions, what is best for St. Martin?

"We are rebuilding our territory, we know that a new society will emerge from reconstruction. What is at stake today? The answer is to give St. Martin all the tools possible so that its tourism can shine, because we must never forget tourism is our first economic resource."

## 22. Baie Rouge Parking an Obstacle Course - Briefly

As a result of what could properly be called now the *Bay Rouge Fiasco*, the victims who got the worst of this appear to be beachgoers.

All French side and Dutch side beaches are free and open to the public, even though it doesn't always seem that way. But after Chez Raymond was bulldozed by private interests (see above), a fence was put up at the edge of the road preventing vehicles from parking in the parking lot. Worse, the stairs down to the beach had also been bulldozed, making foot travel onto the beach problematic for many people.

For a while last week, people were parking on both sides of the road and walking across to get permission from Guards to walk through the empty parking lot and down the hill where the stairs had been. Guards posted at the gate shrugged their shoulders when asked whether beachgoers would be accosted for going on what was being described as private property. (It isn't; all beaches on both sides of the island are public. See story #20 above for French Side President Daniel Gibbs' comment on this.)

Toward the end of the week, people were again allowed to park in the parking lot. If you go to Bay Rouge over the next several weeks, take your own drinks and snacks. We'll continue to monitor this for *SXM Weekly News* readers.

# 23. Multihull Challenge, Coming in Feb., Offers Free Weighing, Measuring

A couple of weeks before the Heineken Regatta early next March, a new Regatta will occur on SXM: the Multihull Challenge.

For those who haven't been following this story, the dump is actually a mountain of trash behind Philipsburg and it's one of the first things tourists notice as their ships approach Great Bay harbor and the Dr. A. C. Wathey Cruise and Cargo facilities.

Fires at the dump have increased in frequency in recent years and have been spewing noxious smoke and odors over nearby residential areas and businesses. Many people have been clamoring for a solution. The first step in that direction is to stabilize the trash so it stops combusting.
