# **1. Isaac Approaching Central Lesser Antilles**

Tropical Storm and soon-to-be Hurricane Isaac was 1470 miles East of the central Lesser Antilles Sunday as this story was written. It's moving West and was forecast to cross the central Lesser Antilles next Thursday.

If Isaac continues as currently forecasted, it will be roughly 200 miles south of SXM when it moves through the Antilles. But Rob Lightbown, head of <u>crownweather.com</u>, the widely respected tropical weather experts, warned against complacency, saying Isaac could still throw tropical storm conditions at SXM late this coming week.

It's still too early to be certain that the storm's course won't wobble and change, and that its intensity -- currently expected by the NHC to be a Category 1 hurricane when it crosses the Antilles -- won't also change. For the latest information on Isaac, Florence, Helene, and

future storms, see our weather center at our main website, everythingSXM.com, or go to our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> which will continue to have updates on the movements of these and other storms during this busy hurricane season.

## 2. Airport Terminal Rebuilding On Schedule

As we previously reported, the first floor of SXM Airport is expected to resume usage as the place where both flight arrivals and departures are handled effective during this November. Once that happens, work to complete repairs and renovations on the second floor will accelerate.

The first part of the airport's major renovations was the repair and strengthening of the roof, badly damaged by hurricanes Irma and Maria. That has been completed. Mold remediation throughout the first floor of the terminal is now underway and is proceeding on schedule, an Airport spokesperson said this week.. All of this is very good news for passengers as well as everyone else on the island.

## **3. Best Places for Tropical Updates; Hurricane Tracking Chart**

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u>.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

#### **Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:**

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

## **11. Solemnity, Determination Mark Irma's First Anniversary**

The people who lived through hurricane Irma on SXM all have reported a spectrum of harrowing experiences. Doors exploding off buildings. Windows disappearing. Winds screaming with unimaginable noise and ferocity. Cars floating away in the storm surge. Waves washing away the first floor of a number of buildings, then breaking directly into the second floor. Boats torn apart, sometimes with half sinking the other half on land. Some boats wound up tossed atop buildings.

All that happened a year ago last Thursday, September 6, 2017. There was great solemnity to the anniversary of that day across SXM as those who lived through Irma remembered others who did not survive it — and simultaneously remembered their personal ordeals surviving what went down in history as the most powerful tropical cyclone in the Atlantic basin *ever*, with sustained 185 mile-per-hour winds with 240 mile-per-hour gusts.

Both French side president Daniel Gibbes and Dutch side President of Parliament Sarah Wescot-Williams delivered the statements that follow:

#### **Ms. Wescot-Williams:**

A year of initial shock, disbelief, desperation, hope, resolve and determination is behind us. The wrath of hurricane Irma is still fresh on our minds and never more so than right now, in the peak of the 2018 Atlantic hurricane season. There are daily reminders everywhere of the furor with which that 2017 hurricane swept over our island.

The initial shock, coming out of the worst Atlantic hurricane on record, made way for any and all of the feelings described above.

Through it all, however, the heroic, neighborly and selfless deeds during and following hurricane Irma continue to remind us that during that disaster we knew no differences, no class, no creed. We had no time for pettiness, too busy trying to pick up the pieces. A year later, much of this has waned and the frustration of a recovery at a snail's pace has set in.

Let us, in reflecting back on Irma to muster strength for the continuation of the long recovery process, remember that we have come a long way despite so many obstacles and setbacks and despite the tedious process of accessing much needed funds to aid in this recovery. Through it all, the resilience of the St. Maarten people has again shone through and despite our skepticism at the pace of recovery, we continue day after day to do our part.

Construction is booming on St. Maarten; businesses are reopening, our airport is busy, people are returning, investors are inquiring, and there is that sense of "better times ahead". However, this picture would not be complete without addressing our challenges going forward. The challenges, some of which have been exacerbated by the passage of Irma. Foremost on our minds at this time should be the readiness to face any potential threat during this current hurricane season. With the best forecasts in the world, weather predictions remain just that, predictions and to use an old adage "it takes only one". We yet have to assess how Irma's impact was what it was, how some homes and buildings withstood and other seemingly stronger built ones were leveled to the ground.

Without rehashing past mistakes, we must nevertheless name them and address them resolutely going forward. Shelters, command structure, state of emergency, French-Dutch cooperation during emergencies, security of persons and properties, distribution of aid, accessibility, primary needs and communication.

With the reconstruction of our beloved country well on its way, we need to focus on the wellbeing of our citizens and their needs, chief amongst which are housing, jobs and health.

The past year has not been easy and there is still a long way to go, but we have come this far....despite. By the grace of God we will weather this season too and continue the reconstruction of St. Maarten, making us better prepared and equipped for future threats to our livelihood, our environment and our development as a nation. May God bless our nation and keep us safe from harm.

#### Mr. Gibbs:

On this sad birthday date, my thoughts go to Irma's victims and i wish to express my vows of courage and friendship to families and relatives of people who have lost their lives. I also think of all those who have suffered the damage caused by this terrible hurricane.

I wish to greet with the greatest respect those and those who have spared neither their hours nor their efforts in the aftermath of the cyclone, to help their next and exit Saint-Martin from the dramatic situation in which our island has been plunged into The space of a few hours on September 6th.

I would also like to thank, from the bottom of the heart, all saint-martinoises and all saint-Martinois for the resilience and patience they have shown every day for a year.

The time of reconstruction will be progressive, we will not give up anything with my team to raise st. Martin and build him a beautiful future.

## 12. A Look Back: On-Island With Irma, Story #1

During the next several weeks, we'll be publishing some memories of 9/6/17 with Irma, experienced by several of our readers. The first is from Yvonne Mendenhall:

#### Irma, the "other woman"

More than a year in the making, plans for our 5 day 50th wedding anniversary celebration were complete. Island tours, restaurant and catered meals booked, guests invited, and accommodations reserved, even the guest "welcome" goodie bags were assembled tagged and beribboned. We arrived in SXM at the end of August, managing details.

The event was taking place at the Wittenblauw villa with overflow guest rooms reserved next door at the Flamingo (our longtime home in SXM). We arrived early and were staying in our studio at the Flamingo until move-in at the Wittenblauw. Our daughter from the US, a

former chef, joined us early to share her culinary and event skills.

Coming from as far away as British Columbia, Tucson, and San Miguel Allende, guests would begin their travels to SXM on September 4. There were reports of a possible hurricane, but early on, like MOST hurricanes, SXM would probably escape a hit. Sadly, each day, reports intensified along with one of the strongest of the storms, Irma.

Continuing her path across the Atlantic and into the Caribbean, she was obviously furious intending some real damage. Reports turned into Hurricane Watches throughout the Caribbean. By September 3 Weather Channel reports of her fury held everyone's attention. Likely, even if SXM were skipped, there would be serious travel interruptions throughout the Caribbean. Watches turned to Warnings as Irma approached our still peaceful island.

Before the first guest could board a plane to Miami, we knew we had to cancel. Guests could be stranded in Florida or Texas, both states under extreme hurricane stresses already. And, risks of being anywhere in the Caribbean were too high. We sent out the word telling people to plan to cancel their flights.

Canceling the long planned, and 50 year "earned" celebration was heartbreaking. But the real trauma was approaching with up to 200+ mph winds. There was no time for self-pity, it was time to get ready. Mervin LeBlanc, Flamingo GM, lectured the 100 remaining guests at the resort in Hurricane Safety. Guests were moved to a central location and out of rooms more vulnerable to flooding or winds. We all stocked up on water and shelf-stable foods, candles, and charged our phones. With all the party supplies, we were almost ready.

September 5 started out sunny and clear. We took our morning walk where a neighbor told us all of the trees would be stripped of every leaf and in days the ground plants would blacken from the storm and salt water. We documented with "Before" photos. By afternoon, the dreaded red warning flag was posted at calm Simpson Bay, the clouds were piling up and the seas were high and pounding. September 5 sunset photos show a sky piled high with puffy clouds in beautiful pinks, oranges, gold, and blue hues.

We prepared a "safe room" in the bathroom with our case of anniversary wine safely stashed in the shower. Power was on when we went to bed at 11. After 1 a.m. we were awakened by the concrete Flamingo building shaking and rattling, winds howling and screeching through small cracks, thudding as small and large objects hit the building at 180+mph. Water was making its way into the room around the glass doors creating a "lake." Electricity was turned off to avoid electrocution from standing water. The wind battered the buildings and our beautiful, SXM "happy place."

The incredible roar and many crashes heard and felt through the building were terrifying. Our greatest fear was Irma penetrating our shell —the glass doors, or the hallway room entry. If Irma got in we would become part of her storm. We could see the glass doors "bending" from the abuse...the hurricane glass should hold but we were not so sure the metal frames would hold.

We hunkered down, prayed, held close our connections to the universe, and waited for what seemed like eternity.

The storm gradually slowed down around 4 a.m. By dawn, 5:45 a.m, we experienced the eye. Things suddenly calmed, rain stopped where we huddled...but as Irma spun around, some barely on the other side of us were whipped again by the tail of the storm. Then by 8 a.m. it was suddenly gone and we all tentatively ventured out to see what kind of destruction was wrought.

The aftermath is a longer story still going on. Irma continued her rage at other islands, but this is how she turned our once-in-a-lifetime celebration on SXM into what we hope is a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

# **15. Reservations Surging for Next Winter**

From everything we're hearing; and from anecdotal evidence we are seeing in our own offices; it looks to us as though winter reservations on SXM are surging.

Normally at this time of year, we receive a slew of timeshare unit ads to rent out timeshares owned by our JMB Website Supporters members. Cost-u-Less is next door to Pizza Hut/KFC opposite the Carrefour near Philipsburg, formerly Le Grand Marché. It is the island's only real warehouse-type store that carries some Costco Kirkland brand merchandise, though at nowhere near the low Costco prices.

As we reported a couple of weeks ago, Cost-u-Less has now reopened with a beautiful assortment of fresh items. It was quite literally mobbed the first several days it was open, but now business is settling back to normal — meaning normally busy. People are giving it very favorable accolades.

When the new Carrefour reopens across the street, it will have more competition, since that Carrefour carries the full line that was carried in the other Carrefour near the Union Road plus all the other items formerly carried by Le Grand Marché.

The other highly competitive markets on the island are Super U near Marigot, which has great produce at reasonable prices, and the new Super U now being built near the Hope estate on the French side, between Orient and Grand Case. That second Super U may open before the end of the year.

Three Amigos, the Mexican restaurant in the Maho district, has now reopened — and it looks great. Its executive chef, Ernesto Guzman, is quite well known from his days in Arizona and his appearances on various TV cable channels.

Dino has adopted the restaurant as his own and has flown with it, using people from his staff at Temptation, some of his favorite recipes, and has built the place into a new restaurant with a phenomenal reputation — pretty amazing since it opened less than a year ago.

## 23. What's Rainforest Adventures?

The Emilio Wilson Estate is a large tract of undeveloped land in the central part of the Dutch side of the island. The intent was to leave it in its natural state in perpetuity for the enjoyment of the people of the island.

A couple of years ago, island officials agreed to lease a small percentage of the land to a private developer for the creation of an Ecological Park (vaguely analogous to Loterie Farm on the French Side) on the estate, featuring a zipline and chairlifts to the nearby summit. That Park is Rainforest Adventures.

Although the idea and the construction were met with antipathy by a number of environmentalists and environmental preservationists, nonetheless the construction continued and was completed last year. The chairlift opened last winter and immediately got rave reviews from tourists plus sometimes begrudging admiration from others.

Our reaction to the project was that it offered a fantastic activity opportunity for both stayover tourists and visiting cruise ship passengers and indeed, so far that is proving to be the case. It seems to be the highlight of many daytrippers visits to the island and is widely talked about — perhaps as widely talked about as the Airport.Emilio's restaurant on the Emilio Wilson estate, where Rainforest Adventures finds its home, is the subject of the prior article.
