

1. SXM Dodges a Bullet as Isaac Swirls Westward

The best news about Isaac is that it has now dissipated over the central Caribbean Sea. (But that is not the rest of the story.)

Isaac was the first storm since Maria (and since Irma) to come within roughly 125 miles of SXM. SXM certainly does not need any more angst from storms.

It's possible that as Isaac's remnants flow westward, they could regenerate...but that shouldn't last long and is no threat whatsoever to SXM.

As always, we are carefully watching the tropics along with you. For all the latest watches, warnings, and advisories, as well as satellite images and radar loops, plus storm track projections, go to our weather center at everythingsxm.com, our main website.

2. Crown Weather: Hurricane Season "Not Over"

As hurricane season began on June 1, some meteorologists were predicting that the season would be front-loaded. There was activity early in the season, including the first named storm which actually formed in May. But Mother Nature has continued to show her independence as she has made this a back-loaded season, with most of the activity right now.

Meteorologist Rob Lightbown, head of CrownWeather.com, is reiterating that hurricane season is not over. The season is not scheduled to end for another 2 1/2 months — at the end of November, and Mr. Lightbown believes it won't be quiet.

For years, we've strongly recommended that people who live in the potential path of tropical cyclones subscribe to Rob's frequent seasonal tropical weather updates. They are extremely reliable in our experience and incredibly useful in making plans related to where you need to be and what you need to do in case any storms approach. 3. Best Places for Tropical Updates; Hurricane Tracking Chart

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

<u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
 Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
 Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u> .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

7. Towers' November Reopening In Jeopardy?

The long-anticipated reopening of the Towers at Mullet Bay, previously announced as this November, may now be in jeopardy.

Here is the latest from the Towers:

As a result of the moratorium the construction has been put on hold pending a review, which makes our November 1, 2018 scheduled reopening questionable. Unfortunately we are unable to give any future reopening date.

Please rest assured that in spite of this delay, your investment at the towers is secured, and once the go ahead with the repairs are given every effort will be made to speed up the process, so you can start enjoying your home away from home.

In our previous update we informed you of exactly what is being done at the towers, nothing has changed, you will continue where we left off, I assure you that you will like the new changes.

We will continue to keep you informed and regret any inconvenience.

11. Tiko Tiko Sold

For those of you who don't know, Tiko Tiko is the sailing catamaran used for clothing optional voyages from Club Orient.

JP (marketing & reservations) We contacted Club Fantastico, the villa-based hilltop naturist resort overlooking orient bay, to see whether they may be Philippe's takeover hotel target, but one of the site managers there said Fantastico "is not on the market."

12. Why "Low Season" Isn't

As summer vacations end, kids return to school, owners of some SXM restaurants head off on their annual closing, people return to work, and we all see the statistical height of hurricane season warily in our rearview mirror, people throughout the Caribbean declare that we are in low season.

Although there are still thousands of tourists on the island, things are less busy than high season — but we altogether disagree with the term *low season*, since a lot is actually going on.

Nowhere during the season is more going on concerning SXM than in low season. People are assessing itineraries, booking flights not already booked during summer, making sure their accommodations are set, and they're actively conversing with many other tourists and friends about what's happening on the island. We know that because during the month of September, we generally have somewhere in the neighborhood of 65,000 interactions between members and our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>. That's busy, and it certainly is not "low."It's when people are actively making detailed plans for what they'll do on their next visit, regardless of whether it's in the fall, November, or "high season," from November on through Regatta and beyond to Carnival.

In fact, we'd like to see the term low season abolished altogether.

To do that, the French and Dutch sides of the island need to cooperate even more fully with joint tourism promotion starting now. Summer is essentially over, and people throughout the USA, Canada, and much of Europe are looking forward, pardon the expression, to winter, the time many detest for its biting cold temperatures, icy roads, and blizzards.SXM should be leveraging that widespread hatred of the cold with tempting ads about the island's amazing beaches, it's many fully renovated resort properties, its hundreds of gorgeous villas, and its many hundreds of incredible restaurants. <u>Advertising is an investment that is long overdue and could certainly come from some of the funds already allocated to be paid to the island by the World Bank for the island's recovery.</u> How can you recover if you don't spend money to promote and advertise?

13. Leader Price Supermarket Reopens

Leader Price Supermarket, the smallish market between Orient beach and Grand Case near the French Side airport, has now reopened — and there are a few reasons it is worth your consideration.

First, it has always had good Baguettes and a limited assortment of other breads and pastries.

Second, it has a very nice assortment of general grocery items, despite its small size.

Third, and new since Irma, the T-shirt store that sells the **one life, one love, one island** items is now next door instead of off Orient beach.

16. Sargassum Seaweed Temporarily Visits Maho

Sargassum seaweed from the Sargasso Sea well north and east of the Caribbean islands appeared in the Maho area this past week. Most of the time in the past, the annoying seaweed has affected primarily East facing beaches — but Maho faces the West to Southwest.

Several people told us that they believed wind conditions related to the far distant major hurricane Florence pushed the errant seaweed toward Maho, and they expected tradewinds returning to normal to blow it back out to sea.

Hopefully, they're right.

17. Climate Change: Solar Lighting in Orange Grove, LED Elsewhere

People around the world are beginning to realize that climate change is a reality. A video produced a number of years ago entitled St. Maarten past, present, and future graphically illustrated possible future effects of climate change on the island.

People are paying attention. New solar lighting was recently installed in the Orange Grove area on the Dutch side and a great deal of LED lighting is now in use across the island.

<u>Tourists can have a positive effect on the environment by reducing the use of electricity</u> generated by expensive and polluting burning of fossil fuels.

Here are several suggestions: 1) turn off the air conditioning in your hotel room or condo when you are not there; the unit will cool down quickly when you return; 2) take faster, cooler showers; 3) if you are in a unit for an extended period, replace incandescent bulbs with LEDs; 4) use automobile air conditioning only when absolutely necessary; 5) join in the discussion on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> by posting your own ideas on saving energy.

18. Info About Dengue Fever

Although there hasn't been much of it around recently, dengue fever is one of the serious illnesses that can be transmitted by Aedes-Aegypti mosquitoes. Unlike ordinary mosquitoes, these are black with white joints in their legs, much different from ordinary mosquitoes.

They can also carry viruses that can cause Chikungunya, Zika, the West Nile virus which is relatively common in the US, and other serious illnesses. Governments on both sides of SXM take the threat from mosquito borne illnesses seriously and carry on regular programs of spraying and other means of disease prevention.

You can help protect yourself from mosquito borne illnesses. Island pharmacies and certain other stores carry a product called Mosquito Milk. Available in a roll-on, this concoction includes lemongrass and other ingredients designed to repel mosquitoes, who hate the fragrance of lemongrass. If you like, you can also by a handheld bug zapper on the island, although similar but larger products sold in the US may be less expensive and more powerful (Ocean State Job Lot, in New England, has 3350-volt models for \$5). To prevent problems, never have batteries in such devices when they are in transit in your suitcase or elsewhere.
