Lead Story 'AW&ST: '17 WestJet 737 Came W/In 40 Feet of Crashing in SXM

Business and Commercial Aviation magazine (*Aviation Week & Space Technology*) has just run a feature article on the near crash of a WestJet Boeing 737-800 jet on approach to SXM Airport in 2017, a story which we broke within about two hours of it happening after being contacted by two eyewitnesses on the ground and multiple passengers on the flight.

We are working to get a copy of the complete article so we can publish excerpts from it here that will be meaningful to our readers.

The airline originally did not report the incident to Canadian authorities, publicly regarding it as a routine go-around. It was not a routine go around: apparently the flight crew was distracted by bad weather and was approaching lights it thought were the runway but the reality was that it was approaching Sonesta Maho Beach Hotel. The airliner was flying below minimum altitudes and came as close to 40 feet above the ocean when it executed a "missed approach" and flew around to land successfully 45 minutes later.

After seeing photography of the original approach from two angles, we alerted some aviation writers and pilots we know about the incident and contacted the *Toronto Globe and Mail* about it. Canadian government officials responsible for airline regulation in Canada also were alerted. We have previously published their findings here in *SXM Weekly News*.

We're mentioning this AW&ST article because of the likelihood that it includes new insights into what happened and hopefully information on what is being done to prevent a repetition. Our understanding is that Canadian authorities blamed pilot error for this incident.

Thankfully, the go round was-safely executed and none of the aircraft's 169 passengers was hurt.

This was not the only incident at SXM Airport involving missed approaches. They're a common occurrence at airports worldwide, caused by a variety of changing circumstances as pilots approach runways. Sometimes other planes are in the way. Weather is often to blame. Pilots have also been known to land on wrong runways, taxiways (neither of which is possible in SXM), or even wrong airports.

1. Another Busy Hurricane Season Is Almost Over

The 2018 hurricane season will finally end on November 30, after having spawned 15 named storms, none of them significantly affecting SXM.

The 2017 hurricane season, of course, was just as busy — and it included hurricane Irma, from which SXM has now largely recovered.

Our thanks to Rob Lightbown, chief meteorologist of Crown Weather, our primary source of up-to-the-minute tropical weather information. We will continue to work with Rob through the winter to make JMB Website Supporters members and members of our Everything SXM Facebook Site aware of any winter storms hitting the US or Canada which could impact travel plans to SXM. Rob will also post such information online directly.

If you are ever in the path of any major storms, it will pay you many times over to become a user of Crown Weather's private weather service which is remarkably inexpensive and remarkably useful, whether your interest involves your business or simply your personal activities.

2. Why Plane Ticket Prices Vary Widely

An official from a major US airline who has read widespread criticism about the cost of airline tickets provides this interesting perspective to readers of *SXM Weekly News*:

About those airfares folks. Always book direct with the airlines. Fares are tiered and go from low to high. For

instance say there are ten tiers of fares. They sell so many at the lowest price and then when those are gone it goes to the next level to the top level until the flights are sold out. So you may find that 99 dollar fare but the person that books after you may pay 129 and the one after that 159. And so on and so on. It's based on supply and demand. Also there is an even bigger picture and that is what can the island accommodate? The airlines actually talk with the tourist boards on the island and see if it would be feasible to add more flights. Again supply and demand.

If SXM gets to be fully functional they will add flights and have more deals to fill up the extra aircraft they are sending in. They can't afford to send in aircraft that are only 75 percent full with the cost of fuel tripled today. They can't make a profit if they do. Let this sink in also about the price you pay. It's not we don't like our customers but we are in it to make a profit. Not only the cost of fuel but the cost everything from workers to airport takeoff and landing fees. A lot goes into it. You would be surprised at how little money actually goes to the airlines. Taxes make up the majority of your ticket costs believe it or not. Look at the breakdown on your ticket. Even if you are only going from the East Coast of the united states you are actually flying in a chair at over 36,000 feet over 1700 miles. Within the same day! If you could drive your car (which you can't) it would cost you about 320.00 each way and then the cost of parking. Two days later!!!. Well you get the picture. Add to that the cost of extra weight (Luggage) and carry on that stack onto the equation. Sorry for the rant. Happy fare hunting to all!

3. Airlines Adding Flights As Resorts Reopen

The number of flights headed to SXM by various airlines continues to increase, even as the availability of accommodations further accelerates. For example, JetBlue has announced the addition of new flights from its third US port of embarkation to SXM, Fort Lauderdale, which is in addition to New York Kennedy and Boston. And an American Airlines overnight flight that arrives from Miami late each evening and returns the following morning also is coming back. American also recently announced the return of its Charlotte nonstops.

Consult your airline for more information on flight availabilities. Please also see the prior article for some perspective on flight fares.

4. Best Places for Tropical Updates; Hurricane Tracking Chart

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC here. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later

Throughout the resort, most units are now equipped with upgraded windows and doors, and the 38 units that were severely damaged are fully outfitted with new furniture. All units are now equipped with upgraded WiFi.

Also, we have made significant progress in the reconstruction and restoration efforts at La Terrasse, and we are now focusing on the interior of the units. We hope to be able to set a reopening date for La Terrasse very soon.

Maho Village is also making remarkable progress and it's getting to be its busy, buzzy self again. Casino Royale underwent a massive renovation and its façade is one of the island's most stunning contemporary architectural masterpieces. Some of your favorite restaurants are also now open.

It has been a major endeavor and, while there is still much to be done, we hope that you will be pleased with the massive work that has been done to restore the resorts to their original Caribbean splendor.

Thank you for your patience and your overwhelming support during the past months. We look forward to welcoming you back to your home away from home.

9. Reminder: Sonesta Ocean Point Reopening Dec. 15

Sonesta Ocean Point Resort in the Maho area of the island has announced that it will be reopening on December 15. Here is <u>complete information</u> directly from the resort.

10. Royal Palm, Flamingo T/S Owners Going to SBR

Both Royal Palm Resort and Flamingo Beach Resort were originally part of what is currently known as Simpson Bay Resort.

Both Royal Palm and Flamingo remain closed as they recover from the effects of hurricane Irma 14 months ago. More on their recovery is in a separate story here, #12 below.

What's interesting is that timeshare owners from Royal Palm and Flamingo have chosen not to endure more time away from their favorite island, so many owners from both resorts have gravitated this fall to Simpson Bay resort.

11. Key to SBR Owners Getting Space: Move Early

Some 80% of the timeshare owners at Simpson Bay Resort who had owned weeks in the Dieffenbachia, Croton, and

Calladium buildings there — all of which were destroyed by hurricane Irma — converted to the resort's points program, enabling them to reserve time at the resort. In fact, many of them are enjoying a vacation there this fall and plan to spend additional time at Simpson Bay Resort during the winter.

The key to their success at reserving time has been contacting the resort early, well ahead of the season, to make their reservations. Those who have done that have had no issues at all, given some flexibility on dates.

12. Delays at Royal Palm & Flamingo

Timeshare and other SXM resorts that were gung ho about resolving their issues in the wake of Irma, completing all their renovations, and reopening in time for the upcoming high season have been effective in doing so. Those resorts include Simpson Bay, Royal Islander la Plage, Atrium Resort, Divi, Belair, Oyster Bay Beach Resort, Grand Case Beach Club, and many others.

Conspicuously absent from that group are Royal Palm and Flamingo. We realize that many resorts had serious insurance and permitting issues and that others were destroyed altogether — like Ocean Club and Summit Resort. There has also been some difficulty on the part of some resorts in obtaining the materials necessary to completely renovate and rebuild. But it strikes us that if Royal Palm and Flamingo had decided early on that they wanted to be open now, they would be opening now, and not just getting started on their renovations. We don't know what their motives are, but they don't seem to be focused on customer satisfaction or helping the island economy or their employees...

13. What's Going on at Sapphire?

Sapphire Resort is another good example of a resort that could have been completely renovated by now had it been going in that direction — but that's not in the case.

Philippe Verdier, in fact, has repeatedly failed to answer questions sent to him by this newsletter, which is read by thousands of his timeshare owners. The resort ownership has a long history of ignoring the interests, needs, and wants of its timeshare owners — but we'll save exploration of that topic for another day.

The fact is that right now, the resort is refusing to be open and candid with the public about its exact plans for reopening. In the lobby, a few people with towels give the indication that some units are open and that the hobbled resort is functioning, at least in some measure. The on-site manager, Jan Borsje, refers all inquiries to Mr. Verdier, who routinely seems to ignore them. Only he knows why, and only he knows what his personal definition of Public Relations is — it certainly is not communicating with people who have bought timeshare weeks from him.

Do what you want. Ask current timeshare owners, perhaps through our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>. But, if we were in the market for SXM timesharing in SXM, Sapphire right now would not even be on our list.
