3. Current SXM Weather / Weather Updates

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC here. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

5. Workers Abound at Royal Palm

At long last, work seems to be underway at Royal Palm Beach Resort at Kimsha beach. Workers can now be seen around the property and some internal demolition is obvious, and has been the case in recent weeks.

When we see anything of further significance happening at the property, we will report it here in SXM Weekly News.

More is here.

6. Westin's Dawn Beach Club Reopens

Dawn Beach Club, the timeshare operation of the Westin St. Maarten resort, has now reopened, at least in part. More information on that is <u>here</u>.

There is still no word on the future of the Westin Dawn Beach Resort and Casino. We know the resort had some serious issues with its insurance company, as we reported here previously. Management had told us that information would be released earlier this year, but that has not yet happened. There are lots of rumors but no substantiated information about the future of the resort, which had become the anchor of a vibrant Dawn beach since it first opened a number of years ago.

Westin is owned by Marriott, a much bigger, seemingly more vibrant brand. Whether resort owner Columbia Sussex

or Marriott will decide to rebrand the Westin is not known, but it continues to be the subject of much speculation.

We will update you as soon as we have any new information.

7. Work Starting at Royal Islander / Great Bay?

When the Sonesta Great Bay Beach hotel was demolished after being pummeled by hurricane Irma, subsequent to its purchase by Sunwing for redevelopment into an upscale Planet Hollywood Resort, the only buildings left on the property were those used for the Royal Islander Great Bay timeshare units.

That building continues to look rather derelict now, but in recent days a number of cars have been seen around it. It's possible that work is proceeding to repair and renovate the property in preparation for its reopening. There has been no announcement about the timing of this, from what we know. We'll try to find out more about the future of this specific Royal Islander property.

8. Planet Hollywood Update

According to a story published in the St. Maarten *Daily Herald* within the last week or so, Sunwing continues to polish its plans for development of a Planet Hollywood Resort on the former property of Sonesta Great Bay Beach hotel.

It is not yet known when the first ceremonial shovel of earth will be turned on that property, but most people believe it's likely this winter.

Hopefully, the property will open for the 2020 – 2021 season. SXM badly needs upscale properties appealing to a younger, more affluent demographic -- and that's what this will be.

9. About "Secrets" in St. Martin

The new <u>Secrets resort</u>, planned for the site of the former RIU Palace (previously Radisson Blu and L'Habitation), should be quite a beautiful, upscale facility. Our link gives you much more info on this all-inclusive property.

10. Pearl of China Project

When it was originally unveiled several years ago, the Pearl of China development project was to be a mammoth condominium/hotel/convention facility which, from all appearances, amounted to a Chinese sales beachhead for this hemisphere, with precious little positive impact on the St. Maarten economy and virtually no impact on tourism. The building as originally conceived was also about as appealing and creative/imaginative as your average cinderblock.

The project was widely criticized by people living in the Bel Air area because of its size and its huge projected impact on resources. It has been scaled down since then, but whether it will ever see the light of day, in any form, at this point is unknown. Although some government officials targeted it as being a huge boon to the island, there was never any proof of that, many opponents said.

We'll keep you posted.

11. Chinese Investment in SXM

Although the Chinese economy has issues, nonetheless Chinese investment folks are alive and well in the

Caribbean.

The Chinese know that North American tourists will continue to drop millions of dollars in revenue into Caribbean coffers — and they would like a share of it.

The Pearl of China project is not the only investment the Chinese have proposed for SXM; there had been others and there will be more.

As always, we'll keep you posted on what happens.

The older buildings on Orient beach were widely recognized for their honky-tonk style — but they were well loved like lots of places people have become accustomed to.

Hurricane Gonzalo did a number on those old buildings leading the Collectivite to rebuild them as rather sterile structures which the renters custom tailored to suit the personalities of the businesses. They took far too long to build than the tenants liked, and the rental costs were rather astronomical.

Tourists barely had time to get used to the new structures when Irma came along and literally blew them away, leaving the beach largely as it was in the late 1970s before anything had been built on it.

The French side wasted no time in approving new structures for the Five Stars "sisters," including Bikini Beach, Waikiki, and KonTiki — leading many people to point out that places that paid the highest rents to the government had unfair advantage over their smaller neighbors.

Meanwhile, saddled with expenses mandated by the government, the smaller businesses waited for their "carbet" structures to be rebuilt — and they are still waiting. It's quite fair to say that they are livid and its equally fair to say that many people who normally patronize the carbets are actively talking about boycotting the "bigs" in retaliation for the Collectivitie's delay.

More on that is below. This situation is far from resolved.

19. Will Orient Beach Tourists Boycott "Bigs" To Protest Alleged Preferential Treatment by the Collectivite?

A number of tourists discussing the situation with the carbets on Orient beach actively broached the idea of boycotting the bigs to "penalize" the Collectivite for dragging its feet on helping the carbets. Whether this will materialize into anything isn't known, but if the sentiment is there the action may be sure to follow.

If the Collectivite wants to avoid any kind of social action in response to the mess it created, it needs to start responding to business leaders desperate to rebuild and get their businesses back into the shape necessary to start earning revenue. It has mired them in red tape so far with apparently little thought to the damage it is doing to the French side economy. Any social action — whether it's a strike, blocked roads, or anything else — will aggravate the situation on the French side. All of those things have happened before regarding the very same buildings that Irma destroyed. Hopefully the government, now sadly hamstrung by its own regulations, we'll figure out a way to solve this expeditiously.

20. Winair Adds Holiday Flights To/From Islands

WINAIR airlines, the small St. Maarten-based carrier that uses twin engine STOL (short takeoff and landing) aircraft for flights to a number of neighboring islands, has added new flight frequencies to accommodate the people on the islands who want to do some holiday-related shopping and travel.

21. Scotiabank to Sell Its Caribbean Branches

Scotiabank, the Bank of Nova Scotia, has elected to sell all of its Caribbean branches to a bank based in the Caribbean.

A number of islands are reminding Scotiabank that the proposal must be reviewed and approved by local authorities and cannot simply be executed.

<u>For tourists</u>, the impact mainly falls on Americans who are Bank of America customers. There has been a reciprocal agreement under which Bank of America customers using Scotiabank ATMs can withdraw money without bank fees, as they would on their home Bank of America ATMs. Without Scotiabank, that advantage seems unlikely to persist.

Scotiabank employees are supposed to be retained by the new buyers, assuming the transaction is approved. But their true status is open to question; they will need to reapply with the new owners, if the ownership change actually happens.

We'll keep an eye on this for you.

22. Tijon Parfumerie Reopens M-F

Tijon Parfumerie in Grand Case, diagonally across the street from Spiga, recently reopened Mondays through Fridays at its traditional location.

The Parfumerie, which is been open for many years, has attracted thousands of tourists to its line of fragrances uniquely oriented toward the Caribbean — as well as to its brief courses which enable visitors to create their own fragrances, a rather amazing experience for both women and men.

Taloula Mango's restaurant in downtown Philipsburg, founded at about the time the Great Bay Promenade was launched, includes a drinking establishment called the Blue Bitch Bar. Thanks to bar memorabilia, the Blue Bitch has become better known than Taloula Mango's. Consequently, a rebranding is coming, we've heard, to discontinue the Taloula Mango name and run with the Blue Bitch Bar moniker.

Taloula's was named after a family dog in the family of Norm and Su Wathey, owners of the establishment. So it stands to reason that the Blue Bitch Bar relates to the color of an imaginary dog and not to a person going through melancholy.

Thought you'd want to know.

27. Emilio's Launches a "Jeff Berger Burger" at Lunch

29. No Mosquito Issue, But Preventative Spraying Done

There is currently no issue on SXM with any mosquito borne illnesses — Zika, Chikungunya, or dengue fever.

The island wants to keep it that way, so the Dutch side recently completed mosquito fogging in all of its municipalities.

Whether you like beef, poultry, or seafood, you will find many items here that will delight all of your senses.

For the first time during our visit to Mario's last week, we tried his Filet Mignon, which was exquisite. In fact, I would use those Christmas Carol words "tender and mild" along with perfectly spiced as my description; loved it.

If you have special dietary needs, the staff at Mario's bends over backwards to accommodate them, consistently delivering truly extraordinary dining.

<u>Don't leave Mario's for the end of your trip</u> — it deserves repeat visits, so visit it early and you are certain to plan return visits during your current trip.

One quick last word: save room for dessert. We've been tempted to eat dessert first here, but the appetizers are so special that we couldn't.
