1. Jet Blue Set To Begin FLL-SXM Nonstops

As we first reported here several months ago, JetBlue is now poised to begin its much-heralded daily nonstop service between Fort Lauderdale (FLL) and SXM Airport.

<u>The flights could inaugurate lower fares to SXM from much of the country</u>, including the Midwest, Southwest, and the West Coast. Fort Lauderdale is a major hub (focus city) for JetBlue, which means that it has flights from many cities that will enable new connections to SXM.

If you're trying to find a Valentine's Day present for someone, this may be your ticket, since flights begin February 14, 2019.

2. Air Transat Resuming Flights This Month from YYZ and YUL

This month, Air TRANSAT resumes flights to SXM from both Toronto and Montréal, a major increase in seats to SXM from Canada. WestJet resumed flights to SXM a while back, as we reported.

3. 98% of 2017 Flights Back by March

If your excuse for not returning to SXM was either that there were no flights to the island, high ticket prices, or insufficient accommodations, you would be wrong on all three counts this Winter.

As we've reported here, fully rebuilt or renovated accommodations of all descriptions are opening up rapidly; the transition from pavilions/tents for arrivals and departures at the airport to terminal-based arrivals and departures gets underway this week (see separate article); and a full 98% of the number of passenger flights that had been going through SXM Airport in 2017 will be back online by March, 2019.

That's plenty of airlift, plenty of accommodations, and lots of nice warm weather for you to enjoy instead of freezing and or shoveling back home.

Please also see story #22 concerning the condition of the island.

4. Airport Transition to Terminal Begins This Week

The arrival and departure tents at SXM Airport, politely referred to as pavilions during the last several months, will soon be broken down, folded up, and removed, back to the company that rented them to the airport. The reason: <u>the much-anticipated return of both arrivals and departures of commercial aircraft back into the main terminal building begins this week.</u>

For now, both arrivals and departures will be accommodated on the first floor of the main terminal, where remediation and rebuilding have been completed. The first floor has also been modified to enable it to accept departures, previously handled on the second floor.

Meanwhile, work on the second floor will go into overdrive. It is expected that the second floor will be fully open to normal flight arrival / departure operations next Fall, well before the 2019 – 2020 high season begins.

We are arranging tours of the facility so we can give you additional information and hopefully some photography. We will also be talking to airport senior management about the status of preclearance of people headed to the US.

Preclearance — under which those passengers would go through US customs and immigration in SXM before their flight takes off — would enable SXM flights to be treated like domestic flights upon arrival in the US, without further customs or immigration. Airport authorities in the recent past have said that preclearance is a matter of if, not when.

Preclearance is expected to involve further construction at the SXM Airport terminal, currently shaped like a partial crescent. That crescent would be completed at its eastern end, adding a few more gates that would be convertible for different uses at different times. The airport would then have the structural capability of handling U.S. Customs

and Immigration preclearance.

We expect to have more on this in future articles, as well as more information about the progress toward full restoration of normal services on their normal floors at the airport.

5. December Winds Arrive

SXM's annual December winds — so named, oddly enough, because they occur in December — seem to be back. Winds have been steady and a bit stronger than in other months the last couple of days.

If you are on the island and wondering what beaches are comfortable because of the winds on any given day and what beaches aren't, just use our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> and ask our peeps. They will give you the latest information and in many cases, pictures or videos too.

Although we haven't seen them in a few years, December sometimes also brings what are called <u>Christmas worms</u>. They are bright red — hence the name Christmas -- and tend to wriggle their way across outside cement or inside floors.

One night while staying in Guana Bay a number of years ago, we went into the kitchen during the night and saw dozens of them in a very loose formation headed across the kitchen floor toward the back door, under which they slithered outside.We haven't seen any anywhere since. There was no hope of picking them up and moving them so I just let them be — a wise choice. They did their thing and left....

6. Current SXM Weather / Weather Updates

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

2) Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.

3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u>.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

Lead Story: Government Mulls Hotel Incentives

As a foreigner writing about SXM — a tourist for almost 42 years — sometimes only the expression "you can't make this stuff up" comes to mind, since things here on the island often don't resemble processes used to make decisions at home by many local governments.

Case in point, a story in the SXM Daily Herald last week noted that the government was mulling over incentives for smaller hotels, to which our reaction was wait, what?

The hurricane was 15 months ago, and the island has been in heavy recovery mode ever since. It has largely recovered, although few people off the island know that (except you, thanks to us and other travelers you know). The government doesn't seem to be doing anything in contemplation of promotion in North America to proclaim to the

world that the island is ready for tourism. It has talked about it but never done it.

So the story appears that the government is mulling over incentives for small hotels. Already on its plate are requests from Sonesta, for example, for substantial aid to help them in their cost to rebuilding, already well underway.

Cases have to be made to the World Bank for loans related to hurricane recovery. It would seem that the process would be fast-tracked to make things happen correctly and expeditiously, but if that were the case, why are these requests still on the table? And why hasn't anything been allocated toward promotion, to help bring far more people to the island who have money and are eager to spend it to help their favorite island?

We have no idea what the answer is. All we can do is continue to report the news for you, fairly and accurately, and hope that you, like us, return to the island and pitch into a highly recovered tourism destination that still really needs your business and looks forward to your return.

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Renowned French Artists Painting Hotel Mercure Wall of Art

Lead Story: SMGH Construction Delay Seems Likely

Ground was just broken not much more than a week ago for the new **St. Maarten General Hospital**, construction of which was delayed by design upgrades following hurricane Irma.

An early start to real construction now seems in doubt because of financial instability on the part of the company selected to build it, which is European.

Some local news agencies in SXM last week were reporting that the construction company had gone bankrupt, a claim since denied by SXM health minister Emil Lee, a long-time booster of this project. But there may well be enough financial instability now that the initiation of construction may not happen as quickly as everyone had hoped.

Meanwhile, a few miles away in Cupecoy, the Summit Resort Hotel, perched high on a hill overlooking Simpson Bay lagoon, was for all practical purposes blown away by Irma. Huddled in one of the buildings during the storm was resort General Manager Edna P. "Energy" Evans, one of the most managerially talented hospitality dynamos ever seen on the island.

When it became clear that Summit had been totally destroyed by Irma, folks from Belair Beach contacted Ms. Evans and asked her to take over the resort and orchestrate its renovations so it could return to service in the spring of this year. She took on the task, and was named Director — the top executive of the resort — and orchestrated its remarkably speedy return to availability for its many loyal timeshare owners.

Across the island, some other talented executives orchestrated other returns to business, among them neighboring Divi Little Bay Beach Resort and also Oyster Bay Beach Resort on Dawn beach. We previously published the story here about Simpson Bay Resort, which saw three of its buildings destroyed by an apparent tornado but got the others open quickly so they could house homeless employees and Dutch troops who greatly helped in the weeks and months immediately following Irma's devastation. Royal Resorts Chief Executive Richard Sutton and Resort General Manager Marcel Javois and their staffs did brilliant work there.

Walk-through Belair Beach Hotel as a timeshare owner now, and you will be amazed at the condition of the resort from top to bottom. Our hats are off to Ms. Evans and to top executives at other resorts who did an extraordinary job of returning them to operation for their timeshare owners.

15. Taking A Taxi? Avoid Gypsies -- & Get the Price First

SXM has a significant number of licensed, insured taxis on both sides of the island.

On the Dutch side, taxis have a registration plate which says TAXI in large letters on the plate. On the French side, the plate includes the letters TXI. If you see a taxi without these registration plates, it is a gypsy with an untrained, uninsured, unlicensed driver who could be literally anybody. A few years ago, one of them rear-ended me in an accident eyewitnessed by a Dutch side police officer. He came to the illegal car and started berating the gypsy, who

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described himself as a "lowly pensioner," which made the cop yell louder.

In addition to making sure the taxi you take is real, also ask the fare to your destination. Most taxi drivers on the Dutch side are members of associations and primarily wear orange or yellow or blue dress shirts. They have standard published prices for different types of trips.

16. Volunteering on SXM

19. December Traffic Reflects Heavy Christmas Shopping and...

Usually after Thanksgiving, things get relatively quiet in St. Maarten.

Things are not quiet now in St. Maarten. Restaurants are busy, roads are clogged, and stores are busy. Christmas shopping time is usually busy here, but <u>there are more tourists this month so far than I recall seeing early in</u> <u>December in many years</u>, a great thing to see.

When we originally planned this article for this issue of *Weekly News*, we expected to relate heavy traffic to holiday shopping. But the reality is that things here on SXM were so much busier last week than expected — with some resorts at or near full capacity — traffic is even heavier than expected, and most people on the island are very happy.

So, traffic is heavy — but the weather is great, the island has made a fantastic recovery, and things look great for the coming high season as we've been saying here for months. See also article 22.

20. Island Culture: The "Silent" Thank-You

In the US, if you yield the right-of-way to someone at an intersection, they generally wave or flash their lights at you in thanks. When anyone toots at you in the US, it may be accompanied by a one-finger wave.

Things are very different in SXM.

Here, you sometimes get a wave of thanks when you yield to someone or allow someone to cross the road. You sometimes get lights flashed at you in thanks. But you may also get a toot of the horn — which is a way people here say thank you.

Or, you might simply get no reaction at all. That's not a sign of arrogance, it's just a cultural thing. You can be sure they appreciate your gesture, it's just not culturally necessary for them to express it so many don't. That takes some getting used to but once you understand it, it's fine.

21. Gluten Free Dining on SXM

If you suffer from celiac disease and are required to seek gluten-free dining on SXM, and gluten-free groceries, most of the larger markets now carry such gluten-free products, usually in special sections. In fact, there's more attention paid now to gluten-free than there is to sugar-free, which should also be getting better play in supermarkets.

The island's recovery has been so totally stunning that although you'd notice some roofs are missing, some buildings are missing, and a few boats are still sunk in the lagoon, you would think the island looks rather awesome and be happy to see that everything is functioning pretty much as usual.

Yes, some cars are bit banged up and there are scattered other hints that something happened, but you'd have no real idea that it was a hurricane with sustained winds of 185 mph with recorded gusts up to 240 mph, possibly higher in tornadoes -- the single most powerful Atlantic hurricane in history.

23. Restaurant of the Week: Spiga

Some places in Grand Case were altogether destroyed by Irma, but Spiga lost its dining porch (since completely replaced), and suffered some other damages. But the restaurant survived and reopened many months ago, and along with it, Grand Case has now begun to blossom anew.

The inside of Spiga looks a bit different, with a new bar to accommodate diners waiting for their table. That gives people a chance to talk before dining and share some island experiences. One experience all have in common is the love of this very fine, friendly restaurant, which offers consistently amazing dinners year-round.

Although the menu currently isn't as huge as it once was, everything you love about the restaurant is here. The food is creative and incredibly delicious, as always. The service is exemplary. And Lara and Ciro are always there to provide that outstanding service and magic in the kitchen.
