1. SXM Airport Main Terminal Reopens

The main terminal of SXM Airport reopened last week. Both arrivals and departures are now processed on the first floor of the terminal.

Work on restoring the second floor is not expected to be completed before late in 2019. We have no word yet on when preclearance might be available, but it is not expected without significant further terminal construction. See next story.

Dismantling of the pavilions — the tent structures that have been used for many months for both arrivals and departures — is already underway.

2. So When Is US Preclearance Coming?

We'll have further, more precise word on this very soon, but the bottom line is that preclearance is not expected to happen during 2019. As noted in the previous story, additional construction is needed so that precleared passengers heading to US destinations are kept separate from passengers heading to other destinations.

When we last spoke with airport officials, they told us preclearance was a matter of when, not if, and we have no reason to feel that has changed. It certainly was delayed by Irma and it cannot be created by waving any magic wand -- it's complex and requires work and extensive new construction before it can happen.

More is coming on this....

3. AA Overnighting Flight from Miami Set To Return

We've been told that American Airlines' overnighting flight between SXM and Miami — the flight that arrives late at night from Miami, stays in SXM overnight, and flies out early the next morning back to Miami — returns December 19

The flight enables many people from across the country to arrive in SXM the same day. Because of the early departure, it also enables most of these people to return to their destination airport on the same day they leave SXM.

The flight is a welcome addition to the American Airlines schedule.

4. Early-Season Storms Screw Up Flights

An early season snow storm about a week ago hit the Charlotte area hard, shutting down a key hub for American Airlines. The shutdown snarled travel plans for thousands of passengers, including some traveling to and from the hub from SXM.

It was an early sample of what can happen in wintry weather and what may be ahead for some people traveling this winter.

5. Current SXM Weather / Weather Updates

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC here. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

7. Simpson Bay Resort Receives Our First '18-'19 Award of Excellence

9. Anse Marcel Beach Reopening 12/20

10. Towers at Mullet Bay Won't Say Reopening Date

Several months back, the Towers at Mullet Bay had said that it would be reopening in November, 2018. It didn't. We walked into the main lobby several days ago and it was manned as it would normally be when the resort is open. There were no guests, and nobody wanted to say anything about when exactly the resort would be reopening.

There were some issues early-on related to damage from hurricane Irma, and there were additional issues of a complex legal nature. The resort looks like it should be able to open soon — but we can't and won't guess when.

11. Lots of Work at Sapphire as Renovations Continue

One SXM resort known for its history of poor communications with timeshare owners seems to be making strong progress in its post-Irma renovations — finally.

When we casually spoke with a few resort employees about a week ago, they told us that 30 rooms were already

open and that new elevators were at that time in the process of being installed. They said that as soon as the elevator installation was complete, the resort would be moving quickly to accelerate the pace of its room renovations and repairs following Irma.

Other resorts managed to open weeks after Irma. Why not Sapphire? We know their damage was significant — but so was damage elsewhere. What's the resort's reason for moving so slowly at getting repairs underway and finished?

A number of SXM resorts need to answer that same question directly to their timeshare owners. Some resorts did a superb job of communications — witness Simpson Bay Resort, for example. Atrium, Divi, Belair, and Oyster Bay Beach Resort all did an excellent job in communications and in getting the job done.

We'd like to know what the excuse was at Royal Palm, Flamingo, and especially Sapphire. The worst of all: Ocean Club, which leaves derelict buildings standing and says nothing substantive about the future here on SXM. Alegria has also been twiddling its thumbs since Ray Sidhom bought it.

No excuses. For the sake of its tattered economy, the island government should launch a full scale inquiry into why these businesses have been dragging their feet -- and compel them to get it in gear now. Enough is enough -- hardball is long overdue.

12. Cupecoy Twin Towers Pumping Water into Mullet Bay

As we previously reported, work is underway on previously undeveloped property at the junction of University Drive and Rhine Road in Cupecoy. University Drive leads to the American University of the Caribbean medical school campus; to the road's North is the remains of the Starz Casino and to its South lies the land now being developed and the Mullet Bay golf course.

While excavating in the area to build the foundations for both towers, contractors encountered water, not unexpected for construction so close to the shore. The water needs to be pumped from the excavations so the construction can proceed — and pumping of thousands of gallons of water from the site is underway. Large blue tubes (larger than fire hoses) carry the pumped water around the edge of the golf course and across the access road to the Towers at Mullet Bay Resort, dumping the water into mullet pond, part of Simpson Bay lagoon.

Because the excavation site is shielded from public view, we were unable to contact construction officials to ask how long pumping will continue or whether any pumping will be necessary on a permanent basis — and either way, whether the water will continue to be pumped into the pond or removed for disposal elsewhere. We hope to be able to find out more about this and when we do, we will report it here.

15. Louis Vuitton Buys Belmond Resorts, La Samanna Owners

LVMH Moët Hennessy Louis Vuitton, the world leader in luxury goods, is acquiring London-based luxury hotel brand Belmond Group (formerly Orient Express) for USD\$3.2-billion.

As the wealthy further boost their spending for luxury goods and services, the acquisition seems perfect for LVMH, and further solidifies its leadership position.

Belmond La Samanna is part of this deal. <u>La Samanna reopened</u> just last week, on December 10. Much more about the purchase is in this <u>article</u> by *Fortune*.

17. Air Lekkerbek Airplane Bar Is No More

Built from the fuselage of a retired commercial airliner, Air Lekkerbek stood near the Pondfill in Philipsburg for many years, with bar and restaurant services for primarily local clientele.

The property was severely damaged by hurricane Irma and the owner had been told to fix it but didn't, so the building was demolished in the fuselage hauled away last week — so Air Lekkerbek is no more.

Both sides are working hard to recover and welcome tourists, but the Dutch side seems to have done a much better job of recovering than the French, which seems to have come up with an enormous amount of red tape instead of progress.

When a government commits to do something, it should do it -- or have a very good explanation. So far, there's a lot of nothing -- and the plan was announced roughly three years ago. We know Irma was a huge blow, but...

24. Jubilee Library Closed; \$12-million Replacement in Design

The 75-year-old St. Maarten Jubilee library in Philipsburg was pummeled by hurricane Irma but has remained open after a fashion ever since. It has now been ordered shut down by the government because of the serious condition of the building.

The Jubilee library staff is been attempting to raise money for some time. In fact, it is now looking at a possible \$12 million replacement for the library, though how exactly that would be paid for in a down economy (thanks to Irma) isn't known.We'll keep you posted.
