1. What The Future Holds at SXM Airport

Late last week, we interviewed Ravi Daryanani, CFO and Acting CEO of SXM Airport. Here are major items from that interview:

Jeff Berger: What effects is SXM Airport feeling from the delay on the part of the Nagico insurance company in paying claims on your policies in the wake of hurricane Irma?

Mr. Daryanani: They have paid the injunction court-ordered amount but not the final claim; the final claim settlement is currently under arbitration. The full amount we hope to receive through arbitration is still not clear but we hope to get close to our full claim. The amount received from Nagico so far is the collateral of the current Note Holders. None of that will be released until either a) a settlement is reached for the full amount of reconstruction, b) a loan is given to SXM Airport by the World Bank/EIB, or c) we finalize our refinancing plan.

Whatever work we are doing now is being paid for out of our own operating funds and reserves we had built up. That is how we were able to rebuild the first floor of the terminal and open it back up for arrivals and departures. We've exhausted all of our reserves now. That's where we're at.

Jeff Berger: What caused the problems with the roof, and what is being done by way of reconstruction to prevent any repetition in future storms?

Mr. Daryanani: There was a lot of debris flying around outside thanks to the sustained 185 mph winds from Irma. That combination of wind and flying debris seriously damaged most of the roof, destroyed the entry doors, and caused an enormous buildup of pressure inside the building which further damaged the roof and interior of the terminal. Following all that damage, a great deal of rainwater was dumped inside by Hurricane Maria when it passed the island.

In repairing the building, we have to build better and stronger. It must be capable of withstanding another Irma without the kind of damage that it suffered in Irma and Maria. Our new roof when it is completed by the end of January will be one of the strongest roofs in the entire region.

Jeff Berger: The conveyor belt area for arriving passenger baggage is not as large as it had been pre-Irma. Will that change at all between now and the time the second floor departure area is fully restored, and the first floor baggage area returns to its pre-Irma size?

Mr. Daryanani: There's not sufficient floorspace to allow a larger baggage claim area while both arrivals and departures and being handled temporarily on the first floor. However we have studied that matter in depth and calculated passenger needs against the winter schedule and we are confident things will move smoothly. We also

have ample staff available to augment manpower in that area during periods where that would be necessary. We also must follow rules and regulations and we're doing that. We're confident things will run smoothly.

Jeff Berger: When do you expect to return to full service -- departures virtually all handled from the second floor, and with check-in and baggage pickup on the first floor, as before?

Mr. Daryanani: We are going to have a phased-in return of normal gate operations starting, we expect, late in 2019, perhaps two gates reopening at a time. As more gate areas are completely rebuilt, they will be phased into service. All our jetways were severely damaged by Irma and completely rebuilding or replacing them is part of the equation of reopening all the gates. Depending on financing, we expect that everything can be completely back to normal perhaps during Q2 or Q3 of 2020. We know that passengers are delighted to be back in the terminal and they will be seeing the progress of restoration first-hand.

Jeff Berger: What about air-conditioning, rest rooms, and food and shopping?

Mr. Daryanani: The entire terminal is air conditioned, ample rest rooms are provided as always, and restaurants and liquid refreshments are available both inside the building and in full-size food trucks outside from Johney Burger and Domino's. There are many choices now for families inside the terminal.

Jeff Berger: Are any further changes expected in areas where passengers interact with the facility before things are back to normal on both floors?

Mr. Daryanani: Incrementally in steps, yes. Because of the phasing-in I had mentioned, we'll be taking small steps to migrate gate operations upstairs starting late in 2019 and continuing until everything is completed.

Jeff Berger: Is the parallel taxiway still in planning? If yes, timing?

Mr. Daryanani: All Capital Projects pre Irma are on hold for now and will be part of the new strategic plan.

Jeff Berger: Previous administration there had talked about a central car rental facility and a name brand airport hotel across the street. Are those still in planning?

Mr. Daryanani: [Again], All Capital Projects pre Irma are on hold for now and will be part of the new strategic plan.

SXM Weekly News thanks SXM Airport for our recent building tour and for this interview. As always, we will stay on top of what's happening there, and of service changes, and we'll keep you posted right here.

2. Last Week's Weather

After several weeks of excellent weather here, last week was marked by largely showery whether punctuated by heavy rain Friday night and rain and wind Saturday. Sunday's weather was expected to be an improvement over Saturday's. During the rain episodes, wind gusts reached about 30 mph at times.

3. Seven Ships, 39,000 People Arrive on 12/26

Seven cruise ships — the highest number hosted throughout 2018 — visited the island on Boxing Day, December 26, carrying almost 29,000 passengers plus nearly 10,000 crew members.

We stayed out of Philipsburg that day. There was widespread hope that many of the visitors would spend a significant amount of time in shops on Front Street.

4. 587 Aircraft Movements at SXM Airport 12/24-12/26

There were some 587 aircraft movements at SXM Airport between December 24 and December 26. Most of these were private or corporate jets, which are now parked nose to tail in various tarmac parking areas throughout the airport.

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC here. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

8. Royal Palm, Flamingo Rev Up Recovery

Yvonne Mendenhall, a JMB member who is also a Moderator of our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> gathered this important info regarding both Diamond Resorts properties on SXM.

Here you go:

For Diamond Resort owners--Flamingo and Royal Palm--and those members who wonder what's happening with that vacant building space with the world bustling around them on Simpson Bay...

Supplies are coming in. There have been several containers unloaded in the past week -- more to come.

Workers are beginning to arrive. They are skilled construction contract workers hired from various locations by the international contractor who is doing the construction on both resorts.

Diamond said the workers will all have SXM work permits, temporary residency, and insurance -- good for the workers and for SXM. They will arrive as their paperwork is completed. Local workers are on the job as well and are expected

to continue through the building process, but there are not enough construction workers on the island to go around, so some have to be brought in. The workers will be housed at Flamingo, but work at both properties.

Work will be done concurrently at both properties, so [first] windows and doors on both to secure the buildings, then interior electrical, plumbing and HVAC on both concurrently, etc. That will mean the two properties will be completed close to the same time. This rebuild is being done to very high specs -- stronger and new "everything." Projected completion (and I understand that to mean 100% complete) is June/July 2020.

Model Units (1 or 2 at each property) will be prepared and projected opening for the public to view those is end of March 2019. More to come on this as it progresses.

Here's hoping for quiet weather and few interruptions to delay work.

I met with Mervin LeBlanc, Diamond Resorts, GM for Flamingo and Royal Palm, last week. We are hoping to meet again when he returns from his Christmas visit to family. I'll post anything new I learn. For more details, check the Flamingo/Royal Palm Timeshare Owners site on Facebook, https://www.facebook.com/groups/127960504672487/

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13. New Year's Eve on SXM

Tonight, New Year's Eve, will be hopping across the island, with special New Year's Eve dinner selections at many restaurants (a number are already sold out) plus fireworks at midnight from Great Bay beach in downtown Philipsburg.

We hear Mariah Carey will be performing in St. Barths at one of the billionaire celebrations there. If you're staying in the vicinity of Dawn Beach Club or Oyster Bay Beach Resort, and have a view over the water, stay up until midnight and glance across to St. Barths. If the weather is good, which it usually is, you will be able to see two or three simultaneous private fireworks displays underway, as if in competition, at some of the private New Year's Eve celebrations on the island.

14. Stars Shine in SXM for New Year's Celebrations Nearby...

In addition to billionaires on their megayachts, many luminaries come through SXM to St. Barths for private New Year's Eve celebrations.

Among those known to be in the area are Mariah Carey, Pharrell Williams, Michael Jordan (basketball), Lionel Richie, and many others.

15. Cruise Ship Presence a Double-Edged Sword?

Are large numbers of cruise ship passengers visiting the island really as big a benefit as some would have us believe?

That question is being asked increasingly by some Front Street Philipsburg merchants whose business actually declines when significant numbers of cruise ship passengers invade the island.

Cruise ship lines routinely offer many island tours on which they make money. But the tours siphon away passengers who might otherwise be going to Philipsburg and spend money. Some are telling us that the government of St. Maarten should think twice about its relationships with cruise lines which seem to covet numbers of tourists over where the cruise line puts them once they get to the island. It isn't all gravy, they allege.

Stayover tourists, who are historically big spenders in downtown Philipsburg, stay out of town when there are a number of cruise ships in port, diminishing revenue for Philipsburg and for island tax coffers.

To be sure, many tourists are first introduced to SXM after having spent a few hours in port thanks to a cruise ship visit, and the value of those introductions can't be overstated.

But the island should be working closely with cruise ship lines to find a way to get more people to come into Philipsburg. Having thousands of cruise ship passengers from the Dutch side cruise port taken away from town doesn't make much economic sense for the island -- all it does is enrich the cruise lines at the island's expense.

We've spoken before here about the need for promotion of stayover tourism. We will be covering that subject again.

16. Kon Tiki in Soft Reopening

KonTiki restaurant on Orient beach on the French side has now reopened — soft reopening. We'll let you know when or if they do a formal reopening.

17. Noisy at Night? Complain to Minister of Tourism

With much ballyhoo a couple of years ago, a new parking lot was constructed on Kimsha beach next to Royal Palm beach resort.

Its intent was to ease parking woes in the area, according to announcements made at the time.

The reality is the Dutch side has never paid much attention to parking; it allows new structures to be built with almost no attention to parking. The result has been clogged roads.

In the case of the parking lot, about one third of it is now taken up by little businesses that have the same kind of honky-tonk look that used to be prevalent on Orient beach before the Collectivite got tired of it.

Now, late at night, in Simpson Bay the parking lot is the home to little bars that blast amplified music throughout the area, irritating local residents and some visitors as well. Increasing numbers of area residents are objecting - loudly.

If you live, lease, or own timesharing in the area affected by this noise, you should write a letter to the editor to the *Daily Herald* and mention by name tourism minister Stuart Johnson, and complain to him about the effects this incessant nighttime blaring of music is having on your family and its impact on your vacation.

Although the island has executed what must be regarded as a spectacular recovery, antics like those being executed in Simpson Bay ought to be stopped cold. The island's tourism product is still fragile thanks to Irma and it must be protected from irresponsibility.

18. Zhaveri Jewelers Morphs into Zhaveri Luxury; Grand Re Opening

Zhaveri Jewelers, long a staple of the jewelry business on the island, recently moved to new quarters just west of the historic courthouse in downtown Philipsburg, on the same side of the street as the courthouse.

Zhaveri was running out of space in its former store, opposite Little Switzerland, and had to make a move. The new space, at 68 Front Street, is four times the size of Zhaveri's previous location, and enables Zhaveri to offer a much more extensive array of products for the entire family.

Indeed, they've morphed from Zhaveri Jewelers to Zhaveri Luxury to reflect the wider spectrum of products now offered, which includes a number of handbags from prestigious international designers whose products are not sold elsewhere on the island

We've been recommending Zhaveri for years: now you have even more reason to try them. You can park at the convenient downtown lot a couple of blocks behind the courthouse, walk to Front Street, then turn right and in a moment you'll be right in front of Zhaveri Luxury: tell them we sent you.

19. Buying a Camera in SXM: Where to Go

Until now, we have not recommended buying a camera or any other electronics on SXM. There were two reasons: first, you can often get better deals through Amazon and other providers in the US; and second, US warranties are not always provided — and you want a US warranty.

When our high-end Sony camera went into a coma early on our trip, we knew there was no place local to fix it and we had no interest in shipping it anywhere. Our only choice was to either use our cell phone camera or to buy something new.

We went on Google to look for cameras meeting our specifications but at a low price point. Amazon offered the best deal, but we really didn't want to wait for something to arrive. Computer stores had nothing of interest in our price range. One other electronics store in town said "nobody buys cameras anymore, they all use cell phones," at which point we left the store, having decided never to buy anything there. Ever. No one who is serious about photography or knows anything about it would want to be stuck only with a camera phone. They're good but have nowhere near the versatility of real cameras.

I then went to Boolchands on Front Street. They had the camera that I was looking for and were willing to match the best offer that Amazon had, including a large memory card and the standard US warranty.

Bottom line, digital cameras do die, sometimes at inconvenient times. You do have a very good option now at Boolchands. But do make sure you get a warranty you can actually use. Non-US warranties are not desirable generally.

20. A Big End-of-Year Thank You...

21. Not to Be Missed: Emilio's

When his legendary restaurant Temptation was destroyed by hurricane Irma, chef Dino Jagtiani wasn't sure what he would do next.

But fate has a way of setting things right sometimes. Long-time SXM restaurateurs Norm and Su Wathey at the time were developing their Emilio's restaurant at the Emilio Wilson estate were the Rainforest Adventures facilities were being created.

It was a match made in heaven. Chef Dino, working closely with Norm and Su, has built an astounding fine dining restaurant which features many of his most popular items from Temptation. The Emilio Wilson estate has been well taken care of, including the Museum on the site, the buildings themselves, and some artifacts you'll see in the area. The wine cellar is a very special treat.

The restaurant is open for lunch and dinner and even serves a "Jeff Berger Burger" at lunch, on request. Do go for dinner but make reservations:

Emilio's has quickly vaulted to a select few restaurants that are among the island's very best.

22. Update on Sargassum Seaweed

There has been a limited return of Sargassum seaweed to the Northeast shores of SXM. The areas mostly affected seem to be the central to the northern part of Orient beach (the club Orient clothing-optional beach area is usually fine), and Dawn beach.

On Orient, a small area just north of where Pedro's had been seems to have been slammed worse than the rest of the island with Sargassum seaweed.

We have not seen Sargassum seaweed of any consequence on any Western, Southern, or southwestern facing SXM beaches.

By the way, you can now drive along the shore at Orient from the Club Orient area all the way North to Bikini Beach; the road is now open.

23. Update on Starz Casino

Starz casino in Cupecoy is finally seeing some rebuilding action. There had been virtually nothing visible going on throughout the site — except removal of debris after the storm — until the last week or so. Now, active rebuilding is underway.

It's impossible to tell from what you see from the street whether the casino is being rebuilt better — with an eye toward preventing the kind of widespread destruction wrought by Irma. Hopefully Starz Casino will be issuing press releases to update the quality of their reconstruction and not just its timing.

Meanwhile, renowned Temptation chef/owner Dino Jagtiani moved on many months ago to Emilio's; see story 21 for more.

-- Finally, Salsa Classes For Adults, from Experts

If you thought that the Soggy Dollar Bar (behind Vesna Taverna in Simpson Bay) was only for kids, you'd be wrong — adults also love it.

One of the reasons is that on Latin night, they have salsa dancing lessons from 7 to 9 PM for a cost of only \$10 per person — wicked cheap, as they say in Boston. **Every Tuesday Soggy Dollar celebrates Latin Night with a Live Band in addition to the 2 for 1 drink specials on Brugal and El Jimador with FREE entrance and Margarita for everyone!** Come that night to Vesna's for dinner at 5pm, then walk back next door to Soggy at 6:45 for the Salsa Lessons. No need to register in advance.

It's every Tuesday night... stay tuned.

24. Warning on Quads / ATVs & Weather

If you are tempted to make reservations to drive Quads — open four-wheel all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) in SXM or any other vacation destination, you might want to think twice about it.

First, Quads have a high center of gravity. If you take them over hills, or moguls, there could be a balance problem. We have heard of a number of injuries resulting from inexperienced people driving Quads or ATVS in unfamiliar territory.

Second, it's probably not a good idea to rent Quads to be driven in bad weather, like rain storms. Add the conditions noted in the paragraph above to wet pavement, and instability can become worse and comfort goes out the window (if there were windows). If you know on one day that the weather is going to be perfect the next day and you really want to rent a Quad or ATV, that's one thing — but making reservations far ahead and driving them in rain for most people will not be a fun experience.
