SECTION 1: Getting There: Flights, Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. American Airlines Changes Itineraries W/O Telling Passengers

For airlines to make sure their passengers are made aware of changes in flight itineraries, relatively simple automated procedures need to be followed.

American Airlines does a lot of things right, but for years it hasn't quite managed to make sure *all* impacted passengers get the word about itinerary changes. In fact, their history of not completing some notifications is one of the reasons that for years we have recommended all passengers repeatedly contact their airline to make sure their flight information has not been changed without them being notified.

Case in point... Three SXM-bound passengers flying from the US were told when they arrived at the airport to check-in last week that their flights had been changed and they had missed their plane, which was flying to Charlotte for their connection to SXM.

The passengers were not the least bit happy, but they did the right thing by remaining calm and working with the airline to rebook — making sure the airline was made fully aware of the fact that *they had not been notified of any itinerary change*.

Regardless of which airline you are flying to or from SXM, make sure they know how to contact you regardless of where you are, and also make sure you confirm dates, times, and flight numbers up to a week before you're scheduled to fly.

Assume that the airline will change your itinerary without telling you. Although the changes they make will usually be minor, sometimes they won't -- forcing you to fly on a different day or with different connections. It happens and you do need to be prepared for it.

2. Delta's Arrogant, Absurd, Abhorrent Decision

A French student who was born in French St. Martin and who was studying in Paris wanted to come home to SXM between years in college. When he compared prices flying nonstop from Paris to SXM versus doing a connection in Atlanta using Delta Airlines, the Delta price was so much lower that he elected that option.

Delta unilaterally and without prior notice later changed the ticket by which the student would return to Paris — making it several months earlier than the student had planned. Delta told the student he needed a visa since he

would be in French St. Martin more than 90 days. He told them he was a native of French St. Martin and was simply returning home, but Delta refused to listen. Consequently, the student's family had to buy a new ticket to get him back to Paris in time for his semester since the return ticket Delta provided was useless

The student's family has complained to Delta, the FAA, and others. Upon hearing of this incident, officials in the French side government offered to intercede, though we don't know whether their intercession will be successful. The student did volunteer to produce documentation of his birth in French St. Martin but apparently Delta wasn't interested.

It is the business of airlines to provide comfortable, dependable, and safe transportation from point-to-point for their customers. It is also the business of airlines to do their best to make the experience of passengers one that they will remember favorably, so they will want to fly the airline again. In this case, Delta didn't listen; it unjustifiably canceled a passenger's ticket for reasons which were dead wrong and contrary to fact; and it refused to pay attention to authoritative information which should have swayed its opinion.

Delta needs to fix this. Why would anyone in their right mind want to fly an airline that ignores its passengers? More on this story is <u>here</u>.

3. One by One, Private Jets Head Home After New Year's

Luminaries, dignitaries, and billionaires gathered by the thousands here in SXM, in neighboring Anguilla, and on St. Barths during New Year's week to celebrate the arrival of 2019.

Many of them arrived in various flavors of corporate jets ranging all the way up to mammoth 777s, but mostly the more traditional twin engine corporate jets. Many switched to their own or hired megayachts for a week of partying, which ended for most this past weekend. One after another, the airplanes departed. Yesterday (Sunday) morning, we saw some unnamed "fancy people" (rich and famous) having their pictures taken outside a Winair airplane that we believe had just flown in from St. Barth's, before switching to their own private jet home; who they are, we may say later.

A quick look at flightaware.com, the air travel tracking website, over the weekend showed a number of additional private jets headed here. High season has begun and a lot more megayachts, luminaries, dignitaries, and billionaires are sure to follow.

4. January Weather Takes Over, & It's Gorgeous

Two weeks ago, the weather was very rainy here in SXM. But last week it was generally gorgeous, with only a few brief showers until some deluges came overnight on Saturday night.

By mid January, normal winter weather should be in place. It promises daily high temperatures of around 83 or 84, mostly blue skies with scattered clouds, and occasional widely scattered light showers — the kind of weather you expect in SXM and one of the reasons you come here.

Great weather is here; are you?

5. Buying Fares, Simplified

In all honesty, buying fares is something of a crap shoot. It's a matter of supply, demand, and competition.

In SXM, there is high demand for Saturday travel since there are so many timeshares on the island and they generally operate Saturday to Saturday. So, Saturday airfares tend to be high.

Holiday periods, school vacations, and high season travel also all tend to be high.

But some days are better than others, and midweek travel is often cheapest of all. Don't necessarily assume that it's essential for your travel to be on Saturdays if that's when your timeshare week begins. You might well save money by arriving a couple of days earlier and staying a couple of days later to avoid high Saturday fares. Most airline websites now enable you to compare fares for different days, which makes it easier for you to extend your trip and actually lower your fare costs.

Give it a try ...

6. Current SXM Weather / Weather (Updated)

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

2) Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.

3) Our Everything SXM Facebook Site, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is

threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u>.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

13. Lee's Is Returning - With Parking

Until almost a year ago, when Lee's landlord threw Lee out after a long court battle, Lee's Seafood Grill had been a Simpson Bay landmark for decades.

14. What's In Store for Blue Mall?

As we had reported here in *SXM Weekly News* prior to the arrival of hurricane Irma, the Blue Mall in Cupecoy, located opposite Cupecoy beach, was on the verge of being bought by and converted into a major hotel — a Hilton — until Irma virtually destroyed it.

Owned by a group from Venezuela, Blue Mall was never much of a commercial success. People don't come to SXM to do mall shopping — and malls in the US itself seem to be hurting, with few exceptions, as a result of the phenomenal growth of online shopping.

The Hilton deal fell through, but the site is still for sale and is likely to wind up a name-brand hotel.

The site is also the location for "Blue Mall Residences," condominiums on the top floors of the building. Those condominiums offer commanding views of the island, a rooftop swimming pool, and lots of amenities including a rather fully equipped gym. We expect to publish more information about the Residences property in future issues of *SXM Weekly News* and on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>.

We will keep you posted as we hear about further developments at Blue Mall.

15. Lemondroppers Returning to Cupecoy Beach

22. A Plea to Restaurateurs to Slam No-Shows

A leading SXM restaurateur told us that on New Year's Eve, his restaurant was fully booked including one party of 30 who never bothered to show up or even cancel.Of course, if you can't use a reservation, cancel it as early as you can so the restaurateur can leverage its availability.

We also urge restaurateurs taking reservations for large groups to take a credit card to secure the reservation. What they do from there on is their business, but in our opinion, restaurants should be free to charge reasonable fees to anyone who makes and subsequently dishonors reservations (doesn't show or cancel). Restaurants holding space for people should be entitled to reasonable compensation if the people don't show/cancel and they shouldn't get away with it.
