1. Preclearance at SXM Airport Starts Next Year

US TSA / Customs and Border Patrol preclearance of Americans headed home from SXM will begin next year at SXM Airport, a Dutch Side SXM tourism official said while speaking to reporters late last week at a Caribbean tourism conference in Jamaica.

Asked when exactly in 2020 preclearance would begin, the official said by the end of the year, but wasn't specific.

We've asked officials at SXM Airport to corroborate this information, but we had not heard from them at presstime.

Only a few weeks ago, CFO and at the time acting CEO of the Airport Ravi Daryanani said there were many moving parts to making preclearance a reality, including funding (which appears to have been solved), planning, design, construction, contractual arrangements, plus other details. He had said government had long expressed support for the project and that it was a matter of when, not if.

We'll publish specifics from the Airport when we receive them. Bottom line: preclearance is moving beyond a favored concept and appears to be on the road toward reality.

2. Weekend Departures Slow at SXM Airport

With arrivals and departures now both carried out temporarily on the first floor of SXM Airport, the busiest days --Saturday and Sunday -- for a while will be the slowest for check-in and security, We suggest all passengers get to the airport at least three hours ahead of your scheduled flight departure time. By now, AA has been told about the stark difference from its messaging to passengers about when to get to the airport and the time in which its employees actually show up to process passengers (see next story). One would hope that they respond to the current lack of appropriate customer orientation with a change in their employees' schedules which will provide more timely, quality service to AA passengers.

3. AA 1455 1/27 A Flight To Remember

A good example of particularly bad service by a legacy airline at SXM Airport occurred last Tuesday as passengers for American Airlines flight 1455 from SXM to Charlotte queued up at the AA check-in counter.

American Airlines tells people to arrive at the Airport about three hours ahead of its flights, Last Tuesday, a few dozen passengers had queued up for processing but AA employees were nowhere to be found. When an airport employee was asked what was going on, she said that AA typically doesn't arrive at the airport until 12:30 -- about two hours before their first flight boards.

We were there, inside the terminal, and heard lots of criticism of AA before anyone showed up, including the word "arrogance," "It may be American but it's USAir," "They don't care about customers," and others that weren't fit to print. Perhaps as a result of AA's slow service, there were also heavy lines in the passport check area, at Security, etc. — and that was what we observed on a Tuesday.

Quality service requires cohesive organization that delivers seamless processing of customers that meets or exceeds the expectations of passengers, regardless of who sets those expectations. American Airlines failed to do that during the processing of flight 1455 and other flights last week — and apparently it continues to do that on many other flights throughout the week simply by not providing the processing service it sets expectations for among its customers. If the airline wants to be respected by its passengers, it must have crews ready to process passengers when it tells them to be at the airport. Right now, it isn't doing that, and passengers aren't happy.

While we were at the airport, we also observed that jetBlue had several employees processing passengers quickly and efficiently at nearby check-in counters. Perhaps American Airlines could take a lesson from the younger, and perhaps more responsive folks at jetBlue.

4. Midwinter Weather Hits SXM

While bitter cold battered much of the US and Canada last week and this past weekend, St. Maarten was living through its normal diet of winter Caribbean weather — daytime temperatures of about 83 or 84, with nighttime temperatures sometimes plunging to the low 70s. The only ice storms in SXM are in glasses which otherwise are filled with cold drinks of varying descriptions.

It's chilly stuff, but somehow we all manage to survive it.

5. Parched Hills Show Dry Season's Early Effects

When we arrived in SXM early in November, which was still the rainy season, the island was as lush as we have ever seen it — green everywhere, especially beautiful in the hills and valleys on the French side headed toward the Orient beach and Grand Case areas.

Now, however, we're in dry season — and the principal evidence of that is in the parched hills now being seen across the island. It will get worse as dry season continues, despite occasional infrequent tropical downpours.

Please be cautious with smoking materials across the island; nobody wants any brush fires, which can be dangerous in such dry conditions.

6. See Current SXM Weather / Weather

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

2) Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.

3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u>.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

8. Two Huge SXM Timeshare Projects Imminent

Although neither of the projects that are the subject of this article has been officially announced, both will have a profound impact on the competitive landscape of SXM against other islands.

SXM has long been one of the few islands that has a successful base of timeshare owners who can be depended upon to return to the island every year — by the tens of thousands.

Now, *SXM Weekly News* has learned exclusively of two major timeshare building projects that will come to fruition later this year. Since neither project has been formally announced either to current timeshare owners or to the public, we can't yet let you know which two existing resorts will see these projects launched this year.

What we can tell you, first, is that neither project involves resorts that have closed: neither Ocean Club nor Summit Resort is involved in this breaking timeshare news.

Instead, the two projects which we were made aware of last week involve two other major timeshare resorts that are currently open on the Dutch side of the island.

In one case, a timeshare resort will be doubling its capacity with all new construction.

In the second case, another currently open and equally well respected timeshare resort will add a number of new upscale condominium units to its existing campus. We are in contact with the management teams of virtually all SXM accommodations properties, and we will release further information immediately when properties are ready to formally announce it.

Bottom line, the timeshare business in SXM continues to be highly successful and it continues to attract many thousands of new visitors to SXM. These projects promise to bring substantial new tourism to SXM. Please also see article 18 which regards a new zipline project near downtown Philipsburg, which will be another major boon to SXM tourism.

9. Oyster Bay Beach Resort Completely Reopened

Oyster Bay Beach Resort, which reopened many of its rooms on a staggered basis toward the middle of last year, has now completed reopening its entire campus.

10. Towers at Mullet Bay: Progress?

The Towers at Mullet Bay timeshare resort has been ensnared in a web of financial intrigue involving Mr. Hushang Ansary and the ENNINA insurance group. The resort was originally supposed to reopen last November, but as a result of an assortment of financial issues, it is still not open.

The good news is this situation *could* be moving closer to resolution -- but note that observers are saying *could* be, not *is*. Please see <u>this story</u>.

11. Alamanda Resort Closed Up Tight

Alamanda Resort at Orient beach, which was severely damaged by hurricane Irma almost 18 months ago, is still closed, with no obvious information posted about its future.

There appear to be some people living in the complex, but other than the sign for the hotel — which we photographed last week — no new renovations appear to be underway.

If we find out more, we'll post it here in SXM Weekly News.

When jetBlue enters a new market, as it is doing with its nonstops between Fort Lauderdale and SXM effective Valentine's Day, it goes full bore to make a lasting impression and a permanent dent in the market.

It involves an unimaginable array of street vendors, marching bands, art, trinkets for sale, souvenirs, food, and more. It gets very busy and quite noisy.

When Harmony Nights first began, we were quietly sitting in the Grand Case restaurant formerly known as L'Alabama enjoying a wonderful dinner when a booming marching band went by making talk impossible.

If you like street fairs, it's a hoot. If you like quiet dinners with someone you care about, Harmony Nights (every Tuesday night in Grand Case for the next several weeks) is a good night to do something else at someplace other than Grand Case.

The French side government has said that it would repave Boulevard de Grand Case, the main drag in the town, by the end of January; harmony nights will enable you to see what it has done. New street lighting also was promised.

Desserts — all homemade by Vesna — are outstanding. When arriving for dinner, you might want to stroll by the dessert case before sitting down and order your selection: that dessert case gets emptied quickly.

Variety, large portions, delicious food, and reasonable prices along with excellent service are hallmarks of this very welcoming, couples- and families-oriented restaurant.
