

1. AA Blows It at SXM Airport, Is Mute to Criticism

For now, American Airlines seems totally mute to criticism of its contractors who operate the check-in area at SXM Airport.

Passengers are told by AA to arrive three hours before their flight. But if they do that for the 230 flight, they stand in a growing line for more than an hour before anyone bothers to man the AA counter. Only American Airlines has the responsibility to decide how far in advance its passengers should arrive and how far in advance its contractors should be at the desk to serve them.

There should not be a disconnect between the two; when passengers start arriving, AA contractors should be there to take care of them. They aren't, and passengers are not happy about that. We wrote about the problem last week in *SXM Weekly News* and also talked about it on Fresh Air in the Morning with Dr. Soc on Island92 radio last Friday, and we will bring it up again today on Fresh Air in the Morning at about 945 a.m. island time.

We messaged American Airlines on Twitter and received no response. We don't care if they respond — all we care about is that they serve their customers properly, and right now that isn't happening.

It's up to American to fix this.

2. Jet Blue Declares War on AA With \$220 Round Trips

JetBlue has gone head-to-head with its much bigger rival, American Airlines, in several markets, and it has a rather

good record against them.

Now, JetBlue appears to have declared war on American in South Florida, where it is launching nonstop flights from Fort Lauderdale to SXM for \$220 round-trip, a sale price effective March through May of this year.

The only other major carrier in the market serving the route between MIA/FLL and SXM is American, which frequent flyers tell us is charging about \$500 on the "same" route (the only difference is that JetBlue flies from Lauderdale and AA flies from nearby Miami). If American wants to prevent the loss of passengers to JetBlue, it is clearly going to have to reduce its prices. It can't keep profiteering like it does, for example, in Charlotte.

This will be interesting.

3. Current SXM Midwinter Weather

Except for a somewhat unusual Saturday morning thunderstorm two days ago, SXM seems to be experiencing normal midwinter whether, with daytime highs in the low to mid 80s and nighttime lows in the low 70s, though sometimes nighttimes feel a bit cooler.

That certainly beats the severe cold that chilled much of the US last month and is certain to return this month.

4. See Current SXM Weather / Weather

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

2) Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.

3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u> .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

6. Planet Hollywood & Royal Islander Great Bay

As *SXM Weekly News* previously reported, a new Planet Hollywood Resort is to be constructed on the property formerly occupied by Sonesta Great Bay, which was destroyed by hurricane Irma in September, 2017.

Construction is still expected to start late this winter or early spring but it is not expected to be completed until late 2020 or early 2021.

The only part of Sonesta Great Bay that was not destroyed by Irma was the Royal Islander timeshare building at Great Bay, which is still standing. It is not known when that building will be rehabilitated or reopened.

When we have more details on Planet Hollywood, we'll publish them here in SXM Weekly News.

7. Port de Plaisance Timeshares Back in Business

The Princess Port de Plaisance timeshare resort is now back in business.

Effective at once, the resort has 31 rooms available for occupancy, with another 31 expected to become available by June 30, 2019.

The remainder of their 88 rooms are expected to be opened during December of this year, when the resort will have its full capacity available for reservations.

11. Frigadom Cold Storage Destroyed; French Side Effects

Towering plumes of black smoke rose from the Frigadom cold storage warehouse in Galisbay late last week. The facility was entirely destroyed by the fire, fought by firefighters from both the French and Dutch sides of the island.

Widely used by French side food wholesalers selling to French side and other restaurants, the property had a very large capacity for storing refrigerated and frozen foods and was heavily relied upon by many restaurants. In fact, initially, there was concern on the part of some restaurateurs that they would have to alter their menus to reflect unavailability of some items.

However, shipments of fresh and frozen food continue to arrive on the island and they continue to be in plentiful supply. Arrangements were quickly made to accommodate arriving goods and for the most part, there was no immediate change to the menus of any restaurants, from what we have been able to learn.

By early in the weekend, it began to look like aftereffects from the fire on the restaurants served by Frigadom may be less than restaurateurs originally feared.

We'll keep you aware of further developments.

12. First Multihull Regatta Underway in SXM

When the St. Maarten Heineken Regatta started decades ago, it began as a competition among only 12 vessels. In recent years, that number has been well over 100, with crews and vessels arriving from around the world.

So the news that the first Multihull Regatta here in St. Maarten began with only 16 vessels was taken with a shrug by most observers. So was the fact that the second day of competition, Saturday morning, began during a thunderstorm.

13. For Handicapped, SXM Still a Challenge

Many countries around the world have been responding to the need for handicapped accessibility in buildings and public places. In most cities, ramps enhance accessibility for people in wheelchairs, and facilities open to the public are required by law to be handicap accessible.

Sadly, this appears not to be the case on Dutch St. Maarten. Although most multistory buildings have elevators, and sidewalks in Philipsburg have some ramps, they aren't everywhere. Neither are there ramps entering many restaurants, handicap accessible restrooms, etc.

A number of years ago, we published <u>a page on our Everything SXM site</u>, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, concerning handicapped accessibility on SXM. Sadly, not much as changed. You can see that information <u>here</u>.

We know the island has a budget issue. But if it prioritizes tourism promotion as we have long advocated, it will have more than enough revenue to improve accessibility for everyone — and that's long overdue.

14. "Perfume Ladies" Backfire for Businesses

In many places around the world, so-called Perfume Ladies stand in front of businesses acting as hawkers to get people to come inside. Some SXM Perfume stores, Cigars stores, Jewelers, and new skincare establishments use these people who, according to an unscientific roundup of comments from tourists, are widely ignored and avoided by tourists.

Many people who commented about this in a recent thread on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> spoke negatively about the practice. There was no criticism of the people involved, just of what they are doing and how they're doing it.

Many people simply avoid any business that has such people hawking near their front door, which means that "Perfume Ladies" may well be backfiring for businesses using them.

Using tourist-focused social media might well be a more effective way to get their message across.

Don't forget that perhaps the most gorgeous month of the year on the island is July, with perfect weather, no crowds, no endless traffic jams, and quiet beaches. If you haven't tried it yet, this is the year.

16. For Tours, Dinners, Ladies Nights Out: "Happy Harold"

For years, one of SXM's most popular, knowledgeable, reasonable, and fun to be around taxi drivers has been "Happy Harold."

Once you've availed yourself of his services, you'll understand why he's called happy — he greets you with a smile which never goes away, and you are engaged in interesting conversation.

You can contact him either by cell at 721-550-5243, or at his home at 721-548-4492. If you're on Facebook, you can look up Laura (<u>https://www.facebook.com/laura.quesenberryboucher</u>) who can make the reservation for you. If you're arriving at the airport, she will also be standing outside with a sign to take you directly to Harold who will be nearby.

We used him for our recent trip from SXM to California and back and he was great, as always. We've recommended him for years. He is taxi number 87 and his taxi can be rented for the day for tours any place you want

17. "All in One Place" Store

If you stay on SXM for any length of time, chances are you'll need something and not know where to find it.

Formally called the Super Dollar Store, the All in One Place store is located on the road that heads north from the Carrefour supermarket near Philipsburg toward the Emilio Wilson estate, Emilio's restaurant, and the new zipline. It is on the right-hand side of the road a few hundred yards north of the Carrefour roundabout.

Although the store is small, it's packed with thousands of items -- everything from pads to picture frames to greeting cards, small gift items, some cosmetics, electrical extensions — you name it and they probably have it, at very reasonable prices. Alvin and Pam, the owners, are usually on hand to help you find whatever you need. They're from Toronto and have been here for many years and have a great little operation. Mention you heard about it from Jeff Berger's *SXM Weekly News*, and they'll light up a smile.

We've shopped there for as long as we can remember and we highly recommend it. Off-street parking is convenient in front of the building which is brightly painted yellow and green.

18. Sugar Free Food in SXM

If you're a diabetic on SXM accustomed to buying sugar-free soda, blueberry muffins, ice cream other than vanilla, cookies, etc., you will find things on SXM in strictly limited supply.

Yes, there are sugar-free cookies in some places — but not much of a variety or much taste. The sugar-free lce cream you'll find will usually be vanilla, which is popular but monumentally boring. The old Le grand Marché used to carry Nestlé (parent of both Edy's and Dryers) Pistachio sugar-free ice cream but now, for some reason, doesn't, and butter pecan is not often available either. We know that many diabetics live on the island and many diabetics visit, so why supermarkets here don't cater more to them is not readily understandable.

-- Finally, Salsa Classes For Adults, from Experts

If you thought that the Soggy Dollar Bar (behind Vesna Taverna in Simpson Bay) was only for kids, you'd be wrong — adults also love it.

One of the reasons is that on Latin night, they have salsa dancing lessons from 7 to 9 PM for a cost of only \$10 per person — wicked cheap, as they say in Boston. **Every Tuesday Soggy Dollar celebrates Latin Night with a Live Band in addition to the 2 for 1 drink specials on Brugal and El Jimador with FREE entrance and Margarita for everyone!** Come that night to Vesna's for dinner at 5pm, then walk back next door to Soggy at 6:45 for the Salsa Lessons. No need to register in advance.

It's every Tuesday night ... stay tuned.

19. Restaurant of the Week: Mama Pizza

After hearing about it for more years than we care to remember — and having the impression that "mama pizza" was just another pizza place — we finally visited them last Friday night at their relatively new location in Porto Cupecoy.

Now we see what all the fuss was about. Indian friends who love vegetarian food and who also had not visited this Mama Pizza suggested we go, so off we went.

Lactose intolerance has a way of dis-inducing me to desire pizza, so I was looking for something else. Everyone else had large pizzas which were very reasonably priced and left room for lots of leftovers. The appetizers were delicious (I had a chicken Caesar salad) and my main dish, chicken parmesan with spaghetti (often my default meal at many Italian restaurants) was excellent.

After dining, we asked Desmond, the owner, who had been working all night in the kitchen, whether Friday night was unusually busy, since the place was packed with families, extended families, friends, and everyone else imaginable. He said no, every night is like that. Many locals were attending along with lots of visitors from Italy and many tourists.

For dessert most of us shared a pannacotta with strawberry sauce. Prices were reasonable, the food was great, and the service was quite attentive.

As we've mentioned before, the Porto Cupecoy area now has a concentration of very good restaurants including Mario's Bistro, Altro, Thai Garden, Mama Pizza, Rendezvous Café, and others. Mario's Bistro, in fact, recently received our Everything SXM Award of Excellence -- the only restaurant in Porto Cupecoy to receive it.

Definitely make reservations at all of these restaurants or anyplace else you visit while on the island. Mama Pizza is well worth your attention.
