

1. SXM Airport: Is Govt Sitting on a Figurative Time Bomb?

A number of weeks ago, we published a story here about a prospective \$100 million total loan that was available through the Dutch government to be used by SXM Airport for recovery.

Despite what appeared to be significant discussion between the Dutch side government and the Kingdom of the Netherlands, it seems that the Dutch side government still has not pulled the trigger on the deal — leaving the airport underfunded at a time when it is striving to move ahead vigorously with its continuing renovations.

A key fact to remember is that to date, as far as we know, the airport has received nothing in insurance and no loans whatsoever for recovery. Recent acting CEO Ravi Daryanani had told us that SXM Airport was using its own reserves to fund its recovery, while it awaited for needed funds to come from its insurance company and the government, neither of which had happened at the time of our interview a few weeks ago.

Mr. Daryanani, who was CFO and acting CEO at the time, returned to his job of CFO when Brian Mingo became permanent CEO a few weeks ago. Shortly thereafter, Mr. Daryanani resigned from his position as CFO and left St. Maarten to pursue a new position in Curaçao.

Mr. Mingo, now acting CFO as well as CEO, is seeking a new full-time CFO with airport experience from Holland. But he has already said that the airport is very low on money and needs funds quickly to continue restorations and move the terminal forward. The airport had said previously that Preclearance is a part of the future there, and one tourism official at a recent meeting said that Preclearance for passengers bound for the US was expected to become a reality by the end of 2020. Despite some press coverage indicating a potential delay in Preclearance due to the lack of current funding, we've seen or heard nothing substantiated to indicate a change in that intention.

With the arrest of a key government official last week (see story 19) and the real possibility that there could be another failure of another coalition government on the Dutch side in the next several weeks, there is the possibility of further disruption that could impact the speed with which the airport is able to recover.

Instead of arguing with each other, members of the Dutch side Parliament and its ministers need to pull together and start working to solve the nation's problems in a meaningful way.

Also, as we've said for years, the government's shortfall of funds is its own fault because of its chronic failure to promote tourism effectively. If it prioritizes tourism promotion — as Aruba has for many years — it would get the funding it needs to fix infrastructure, fix the airport, and do all the other things it needs to do to make SXM better for everyone. To paraphrase US President Reagan many years ago, politicking is not the solution to the problem, it is the problem. We hope the Dutch side government resumes doing its job instead of wasting everyone's time and endangering economic stability by practicing politics as usual.

2. "MyRadar": Tracks Winds, Storms Everywhere

The application My Radar, available free for wireless phones as well as computers, shows you the position and movement of weather as well as wind direction — very serious stuff if you're planning a flight anywhere or if you're on vacation. It's very useful throughout the year and you can find it by searching My Radar.

3. \$220 Round Trips from FLL; \$313 Round Trips from ATL

From March through May, jetBlue is offering \$220 roundtrips from Fort Lauderdale to SXM, a sharp contrast to current fares between Miami and SXM offered by American Airlines. Those AA fares are often in the neighborhood of \$500 round-trip, but JetBlue is expected to grab much of the non-connection traffic that formerly went to Miami by virtue of the sharp competitive difference its \$220 roundtrips bring to the market.

Meanwhile, roundtrips from Atlanta have recently been offered for a fare of \$313. Details are <u>here</u> -- these flights also involve jetBlue.

4. See Current SXM Weather / Weather

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

2) Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.

3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u>.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

5. Is Royal Palm Finally Doing Something?

Diamond Resorts, for a number of years the owner of both Royal Palm Beach Resort and Flamingo Beach Resort in Simpson Bay, has been suspected of dragging its feet on the restoration of both resorts in order to encourage timeshare owners to walk away, so it could sell virtually new highly renovated timeshare units at full price, increasing its own revenue.

Hurricane Irma hit the island a year and a half ago, and the only thing that Diamond appears to have done at either of these resorts is remove debris and perhaps a little exterior painting.

Now, instead of a few people occasionally walking around with hardhats but accomplishing nothing apparent, there are actually workers who appear to be doing something at the top floor of Royal Palm. In fact, metal braces capable of handling wall installations seem to have been put in place for several rooms within the last week or so.

That's nothing substantial, but it's an improvement. We'll keep watching — and we hope that Royal Palm is finally going to get its act in gear.

6. A Closer Look at Divi Little Bay

We've been doing a number of site inspections at SXM hotels and at properties on other islands, and had a chance to look more closely last week at Divi Little Bay.

Anne-Marie Brooks and her staff there have done a remarkable job restoring virtually every room and in the property and beautifying the resort, where we took a number of pictures. You can expect to see those pictures — and pictures of other properties — soon on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>.

We just wanted to give these folks some well-deserved kudos, as we previously did with their next-door neighbor, Belair Beach, which has had an equally remarkable recovery orchestrated by Director Edna P. "Energy" Evans.

7. Up On The Roof at OBBR

We recently also did a site inspection at Oyster Bay Beach Resort in the Dawn beach area. That resort is now 100% restored from the effects of hurricane Irma, though its neighbor, Coral Beach Club is still a work in progress.

While we were there, we visited some suites in the Mainsail building and saw their rooftop Sundeck complete with sunning area, a huge hot tub, and an outside grill. The view was tremendous although the circular stairway back to the deck on the suite might be a bit challenging for some people. We had seen video when Irma was passing through, and the situation there was stunning. OBBR's recovery has been simply incredible.

Our congratulations to Ricardo Perez, Anju Snow, and their great crew for some remarkable work. OBBR looks amazing.

8. Timeshare Association Wants Noise Ordinances Enforced

As tourists/foreigners, it is sometimes astonishing to us — and we're sure to you — that the government of St. Maarten doesn't take a more active role in consumer protection and in enforcing existing laws and ordinances to protect its people. This shouldn't be anything huge — but it does seem to us that the government should be making sure that people obey the law relating to noise pollution.

A very large cement slab was installed off Welfare Road at Kimsha beach some time ago which was said to be to help improve parking in the area: it was called a *Parking Lot*.

We're not sure what exactly happened, but a number of small portable bars have now appeared on the property that was to have been used for parking and at night, the parking lot has become one huge noise generator, blaring obnoxiously loud noise to every nearby property. It shouldn't be necessary for people to complain before the government fixes such ludicrous, irresponsible behavior. But it seems to keep its hands off — just as it did during the Caravanserai Debacle (which we named), during the immense problems at Sapphire Resort, and now this.

The St. Maarten Timesharing Association — fearful that music to be played late at night at the new Roxxy Bar directly next to Royal Palm beach resort will aggravate area noise pollution — has urged the government to curb area noise pollution. That request shouldn't be necessary, and in fact in the permitting process it should have been considered (as should a number of other impacts) — but again, the government seems to maintain a hands-off attitude, to the serious detriment of its country.

We fully realize the government is busy dealing with a financial crisis and the recovery from Irma — but this is routine stuff that ought to be handled routinely and not left give locals and tourists ongoing major headaches.

9. Why the Maho Parking Garage is Closed

We recently spent some time taking a closer look at Sonesta Ocean Point resort, which is beautiful, and at the immense amount of work that's going into bringing Sonesta Maho back online in the coming weeks.

We knew that the parking garage associated with the Maho shopping area was closed but we didn't know why. Now, we do.

The ground floor of the garage is packed with enormous quantities of construction materials being used in the rebuilding and restoration of Sonesta Maho; it's a mammoth staging area and it's one of the reasons restoration of that property is moving so quickly now.Both Royal Islander properties are now back online as is Sonesta Ocean Point, and Sonesta Maho will soon follow.

It's great to see that area even better than it was before Irma -- and now fully capable of withstanding any future category 5 storms.

10. New Clothing-Optional SXM "Yacht Hotel"

If you're getting tired of lugging heavy suitcases on your trip, this place just might offer a rather liberating solution.

Hint: it's off Orient beach.

Here's a look at all the details.

11. Why No Word From The Westin?

For many months after the Westin Dawn Beach Resort and Casino was slammed by hurricane Irma, spokespeople for the property were saying the delay was caused by insurance and they would be talking soon.

That argument has worn thin since the resort continues to say nothing about its future.

Clearly, there is work being done at the Dawn Beach Club, the partially reopening timesharing partner of the Westin. But since a year and a half has passed, it seems to us to the resort has had ample time to settle its insurance, decide what it's going to do, announce it, and start working.

Work being done on Dawn Beach Club shouldn't exclude the ability of the resort to work on the Westin simultaneously.

The only thing we've heard, unofficially, is that once Dawn Beach Club renovations have been finished, the owners will decide what to do with Westin and announce it; that would be the end of 2019, more than two years after Irma hit.

Why the delay and why the wait?

12. SXM Needs Real Hospitality Training ...

The best run businesses on St. Maarten -- of all kinds -- carefully train their employees to make sure their interactions with customers and prospective customers are optimal from the perspective of the business.

In a country where the dominant business is tourism, there are clearly subject matter experts across the island who could enrich the fabric of the country by sharing that knowledge via specialized training for high school and college students in the hospitality business.

Hospitality isn't simply being polite to people. It's far more than that, involving management, organization, culinary arts, accounting, and far more. Some locals do go away to college in the United States or in Holland for training in all of these areas. Indeed, Johnson and Wales University has seen a fair number of people from SXM arrive for true in-depth training.

We hope some entrepreneurial folks will make it possible for highly qualified local people to leverage their extensive knowledge to create a much larger pool of people available with the talents necessary right here for great hospitality careers.

As the island continues to grow and new hotel and condominium properties open, the opportunities will be almost boundless. There's a HUGE need for highly trained people to fill those current and future jobs.

People nearby said she appeared not to be moving in the water, so she was brought to shore where ambulance crews unsuccessfully attempted to resuscitate her by performing CPR.

19. SXM's Most Popular, Productive Politician Arrested

The grandson of the man who has been described as the father of tourism in SXM, Dr. A. C. "Claude" Wathey, was arrested last week here in SXM and is currently in detention in the Philipsburg jail, despite the fact that some have called the jail unfit for human habitation.

Theo Heyliger, whose many accomplishments have been covered extensively here in SXM Weekly News, in our opinion has accomplished more than every other Dutch side politician combined and has long been the most popular

elected official on either side of the island.

Mr. Heyliger was the driving force that established the A. C. Wathey cruise and cargo facilities in Philipsburg; the Simpson Bay promenade, popularly known as the boardwalk, which is on the verge of being extended all the way to the cruise port; the redesign and beautification of both Front Street and Back Street in Philipsburg; the all-new Princess Juliana Airport Terminal that was completed several years ago; the Simpson Bay Lagoon Causeway, which some have suggested be named after him; and the new St. Maarten General Hospital, construction of which is expected to begin soon.

He also has been tirelessly devoted to the promotion of Tourism, the dominant portion of the entire island economy.

We don't normally report much about island politics here. Quite frankly, our hope is that Mr. Heyliger will be able to continue to be a highly productive proponent of SXM tourism for many years to come. The island does need his tremendous foresight and productivity, during one of the most challenging times in its history.

20. Is The Dutch Side Govt About to Fall AGAIN?

The detention of Theo Heyliger, covered in the previous story, was originally not expected to reverberate through the Dutch side government, which has tremendous challenges still in managing many economic problems lingering long after the island was hit by hurricane Irma in September, 2017.

The island now is in the middle of its best tourism season in many years, but recovery from Irma has been an incredibly expensive, Herculean task. The last several Dutch side governments have been coalitions whose fragility has led to continuous government structural instability.

But St. Maarten is a country within the Kingdom of the Netherlands, not an independent entity, so from a tourist perspective it continues to be quite stable. Nonetheless, total stability with the government laser-focused on total recovery — would be a far better alternative than the possible collapse of yet another coalition. We hope the politicians pull together to maintain stability and ensure that the incredible progress the Dutch side has achieved continues at an accelerated pace. The people of SXM deserve nothing less.

Of course we are watching this potential story as always, and will keep you posted.

21. Progress Toward Grand Case repaving

French side officials for the end of January promised that Boulevard de Grand Case, the main drag in that famous seaside culinary village, would be repaved before Mardis de Grand Case, popularly known by its original name of Harmony Nights, restarted earlier this month.

That didn't happen.

There appears to be work being done preparatory to repaving, but the government appears to be mum about when the repaving will actually be completed.

In the meantime, expect the Boulevard to continue to be a bit bumpy. At least some new streetlights have been installed near the main parking lot in the vicinity of Le Pressoir, though increased nightly patrols by gendarmes would also be welcomed.

22. Protecting Your Valuables in SXM

SXM is paradise, not utopia, and there are a number of things you can and should do to protect your valuables.

Some tourists think it's a dandy idea to take pictures of naturists despite the fact that there are large signs on the beach that bluntly read, No Photos. But No Photos means No Photos, and security personnel are likely to take action against you should you choose to take pictures in restricted areas — and those actions can include seizing or wrecking your camera....

The pear tartlet for dessert with imported French salted caramel ice cream was superb.Don't wait to go to Mario's for a special occasion. Go early in your trip, since you'll want to return multiple times while you're here. You will not be
