1. When Exactly is Preclearance Coming to SXM?

Over the last few months, as SXM Airport continues its recovery from hurricane Irma, we've been watching closely government actions concerning customs and immigration preclearance for Americans returning to the US from SXM.

At a recent tourism conference in Jamaica, an SXM tourism official said that preclearance would be a reality during 2020. When pressed by a savvy reporter, that official said it might be by the end of 2020, a comment echoed by both another tourism official and an airport official during recent interviews. However the delay in finalizing airport recovery funding by the Dutch side government and squabbles between the Dutch side and the Kingdom of the Netherlands have added a large amount of confusion and disagreement to the timetable for preclearance. The lack of funding isn't helping.

The government also seems to have a problem recently in getting a quorum to arrive at some of its meetings, further delaying some government activity related to the airport. Within the last few days, we have sent questions both to the minister of tourism and to the head of the airport to get some clarity for our approximately 325,000 readers worldwide on when exactly they should expect preclearance to become a reality.

As soon as we have their answers, we'll publish them here in *SXM Weekly News*. We do know that officials are in agreement that they want preclearance to be available to passengers as soon practicable.

2. Will Americans Need a Visa to Visit SXM?

According to this article from NBC news in Miami, the European Union is considering requiring Americans to obtain visas for travel to European countries effective about two years from now.

We expect bloggers and others to run with this and to assume — falsely — that this will also apply to European islands in the Caribbean.

We spent a considerable amount of time on Saturday looking into this and what we found, with the help of an experienced reporter in SXM, is that *the draft proposal would be effective only in nations on the European continent,* not in the Caribbean. So, for now, it's not something to be concerned about. At the same time, we'll keep an eye on it since proposals may change and so may decisions, though SXM has significant autonomy in making decisions about items like this itself.

Even if visas were to be required, it looks to us like the process would be simple — online, at a cost of about \$8 per person with a visa that would last three years. As of now, it's not happening to Americans (or Canadians, we believe) who travel to the Caribbean, but again, we'll keep our eye on it for you.

3. More Troubles at AA: Shrinking Seats & Grounded Planes

Apparently blissfully unaware of growing discontent among its passengers, American Airlines is proceeding with plans to further increase seat density on its 737 800 aircraft but is running into trouble doing so.By increasing seat density, which is bound to cause howls of discontent from already uncomfortable passengers in its cabins, American at the same time has had to increase the size of its overhead bins. Trouble is, once the renovations are completed, the new bins sometimes don't close.

Consequently, the airline has been forced to cancel a number of its flights recently, further exacerbating the PR debacle it is experiencing with dissatisfied passengers.

When will this ever end? Were AA to start paying attention to customer satisfaction instead of its bottom line, its bottom line would inevitably get better. By paying attention to its bottom line first, its service has continued to worsen and its customer satisfaction has all but disappeared. Despite the size of the airline, many other big airlines have disappeared thanks to their own incompetence in the past — and American is certainly not immune.

More is <u>here</u>.

4. \$220 Round Trips from FLL; \$313 Round Trips from ATL

From March through May, jetBlue is offering \$220 roundtrips from Fort Lauderdale to SXM, a sharp contrast to current fares between Miami and SXM offered by American Airlines. Those AA fares are often in the neighborhood of \$500 round-trip, but JetBlue is expected to grab much of the non-connection traffic that formerly went to Miami by virtue of the sharp competitive difference its \$220 roundtrips bring to the market.

Meanwhile, roundtrips from Atlanta have recently been offered for a fare of \$313. Details are <u>here</u> -- these flights also involve jetBlue.

5. See Current SXM Weather / Weather

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

2) Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.

3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u> .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

Always the top event on the island's annual calendar, the Regatta drew thousands of spectators and more than 100 boats from around the world. It was exciting to watch, as always — and many spectators enjoyed meeting participants at area restaurants each evening during the Regatta.

Complete race results including top winners are posted here, and many photographs are there as well.

Although details about next year's 40th Heineken Regatta have not yet been announced, it promises to be an even bigger event, with the island fully recovered from Irma and even more boats expected. Its dates are March 5-8, 2020 — a bit later than this year's Regatta. Officially called the *St. Maarten Heineken Regatta*, it is the largest warm water Regatta in the world — and of course, your attendance is respectfully requested in 2020. Come on down.

17. How Is SXM for People With Disabilities?

A number of years ago, we ran an article on our main site, everythingSXM.com, about getting around on SXM with disabilities. At that time, the island wasn't easy for the disabled — and it still has its challenges.

But to our surprise and delight, when we asked readers on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> to send us private messages about their experiences dealing with disabilities on SXM, we were happy to hear that things apparently have improved to a significant degree.

If you make arrangements with your airline and are in need of a wheelchair both arriving and departing from SXM airport, those arrangements are readily available. That's not an unusual situation, of course; but the people in SXM Airport are very good at their jobs and very attentive at taking care of people who need their help. Other airline passengers aren't as considerate, as you'll see below.

Here are a few stories with more about experiences for disabled people on SXM:

Susan C. R. wrote ...

My husband has had a stroke. He can walk but cannot use one arm/hand. We had a fantastic time in SXM. We had wonderful experiences on Aqua Mania. They were so helpful on assisting getting on and off that he got to enjoy the full experience. We used them to visit Saba, Anguilla, St Barts and to do the tour/snorkel around SXM. Most restaurants had easy access. We used the "bus" to go to and from Philipsburg and that worked great. We stayed in the Simpson Bay area.

Kevin L. wrote ...

Jeff, We visited in late January and I was in a wheelchair. The arrival at the airport was flawless. The chair was

waiting at the base of the stairs, and they patiently waited as I crept down. Helped me with luggage and found our rental car van. Helped to load me in, and we were off. Stayed at Simpson Bay Villas. My wife would drop me at reception and I could roll to our unit. Every restaurant took extra pains to accommodate. I was surprised that Front Street was open so it was easy to get to the places where we wanted to shop. Departure was a different story. The drop off is pretty far away from the terminal, and it took 20 minutes to find some help with a wheelchair. Then they seated me at the departure end and took the chair away with a promise to get me closer to departure time. Of course we were left to the last minute, but we were expedited through the security.... AA announced that they were ready for preboard passengers. People were jockeying to charge the gate, but we were first and boarded the shuttle. Then all Hell broke loose as the first class and high status folks stormed into the shuttle with us. Typically swinging their back packs around banging me in the face. The preboarders were supposed to have first access to the stairs, but that was not to be! The "ritzy" crowd rushed up the staircase and seemed offended that I had to crawl up to the plane. I really felt bad for the person that had to be lifted up the steps. So the natives of the Friendly Island lived up to the island's reputation, whilst the ugly Americans lived up to theirs.

Amy M. wrote...

Hello Jeff, I am responding to your request from Everything SXM regarding the handicap/disability message you left. I have recently been diagnosed with ALS – Lou Gehrig's disease and continue to travel to Saint Martin. My last trip was my first one where I had to use a wheelchair to get around the airport and on the plane and off the plane. The airport staff was very helpful and amazing. Very attentive. I am looking forward to their assistance again when I return in 19 days. Also, I stay at the Royal Islander la plage And the rooms are pretty much handicap accessible, the staff is very helpful in getting around – including the security guards. There are ramps and rails to help get in and out of the pool. I would also like to say that several restaurants were also very helpful with me getting around as I have difficulty walking [and] now need a walker.

18. Miss RIMA? It's Back...

Remember Rima?

Until a few years ago, Rima on the pondfill was SXM's headquarters for T-Shirts, Sweats, and Souvenirs of every description. The store was packed with thousands of goods of all sizes and was also packed with tourists. It was Rima-manufactured articles that were sold by vendors across the island and in fact, on many other islands throughout the Caribbean.

As we mentioned since Rima closed, their online site and their manufacturing continue — and they continue to offer discounts to our JMB Website Supporters members both online and in their store.

In their store? Yes, there is a retail store on the island offering outstanding prices on virtually the entire range of Rima items — clothing for adults and kids, souvenir items of all descriptions including playing cards with the name St. Maarten on them, hooded sweatshirts for just \$10 (a temporary special), and pretty much everything you remember about Rima's from back in the day.

The retail operation is now on Front Street, Philipsburg, roughly 125 yards West of the center of town on the shore side of the road. *If you are lucky enough to be a JMB Website Supporters member, bring your membership card and you will get a nice surprise discount from Kenny, the owner.*

<u>The store is called Kenny's, but it is the official Rima store</u>. If you visit without a JMB Website Supporters card, you won't get our discount but Kenny will most likely greet you warmly anyway. Rima/Kenny's is your answer for virtually everything you can imagine in island ware, souvenirs, etc. The store is truly packed and the prices are excellent. Bear in mind that they also carry all of the same Rima-manufactured beach bags that the vendors sell but at Rima / Kenny's, the prices are really excellent.

19. Zhaveri: The Jewelry Store That Sells Luxury Handbags

About 50 yards closer to the center of town than Kenny's Rima store, on the opposite side of the street from Kenny's, you'll find Zhaveri Luxury/Jewelers at its new location, four times the size of their prior location.

Zhaveri is the first of a new genre of jewelry stores that also offer high-end designer handbags [Armani, Hugo Boss, etc.] in addition to their vast selection of jewelry for men, women, kids, and a huge selection of watches. On your next visit to Philipsburg, make it a point to check out their store. They also have a great selection of wallets.

20. New Simpson Bay Store for Zhaveri Jewelers/Luxury

If you're in Simpson Bay or the rapidly growing Cupecoy area and need a jewelry item but don't want to go into Philipsburg, you now have a new choice: one of Philipsburg's most popular jewelry stores, Zhaveri Jewelers/Luxury, now has a store right in Isle de Sol yacht club, the main home of megayachts in Simpson Bay lagoon.

IZi Ristorante Italiano is a great restaurant disguised as a mild-mannered, fun place to eat — but owner David Foini is downright fanatical about making sure that every aspect of your culinary experience is exactly as it should be.

You'll find proof of this from the way you're greeted through the following couple of hours you spend there. The food is downright spectacular, from their delicious appetizers through to their main courses (check especially the daily specials) and dessert.

On Friday night, they had Chilean Seabass, lobster ravioli, and beef tenderloin all as specials — each of them grand slam home runs in my experience. I couldn't make up my mind between the tenderloin and the lobster ravioli, so I had the beef with a side portion of the ravioli. Just spectacular.

<u>While I was there, a few of David's visitors were experiencing his incredible expertise at tasting menus — several courses of smaller portions enabling people to taste a variety of spectacular appetizers, entrées, and more.</u> Increasingly, David is entertaining groups during the day and at night, with 24 hours notice, with his extraordinary tasting menus — something he also did years ago when he was at the former La Gondola, his extraordinary landmark restaurant that was at the former Atlantis Casino in Cupecoy.

Like we said, iZi is a spectacular restaurant aptly disguised as a fun place to dine. His wine list is also extraordinary. Regardless of whether you're going for special occasion or just a great night out, make reservations and go to iZi Ristorante Italiano in Simpson Bay, opposite Pineapple Pete. You will not be disappointed.
