2. Get to SXM Airport Three Hours Early

SXM Airport is at its busiest on weekends and before holidays, which explains why it was mobbed last Thursday, as many people prepared to head home for the Easter weekend holiday.

Pictures of the crowds wound up on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> and the usual discussion ensued about how early people should get to the airport.

Some people arrive an hour and 1/2 to 2 hours early which, in our humble opinion, is foolhardy. The bottom line is that it is far better to be at your gate an hour early than to arrive a few minutes late, once the door of the plane has closed. Most airlines have their counters open well ahead of flight time, so there's plenty of time to check in when you're leaving the island.

However, if the first flight of the day for American Airlines is the one you're booked on, *American says to be there three hours early but its people aren't there at that time to process you*. Although we made it known to American that we and many others aren't happy with that situation, they never bothered to answer our complaint — a lack of responsiveness that didn't surprise us. See story 4 to see why we and many other people feel that way about American.

Bottom line, do go three hours early for all flights leaving SXM, especially on weekends and days before holidays. Do that and you are extremely unlikely to miss your flight.

3. Sunwing Flies Twice Weekly To SXM From 12/19

Canadian carrier Sunwing will begin flying nonstops from Canada to SXM twice-weekly effective December 19, shortly after high season and the very busy Christmas week vacation period begin. Sunwing is about to begin construction of a new Planet Hollywood on the site of the old Sonesta Great Bay Beach Hotel, which was destroyed by hurricane Irma. The hotel is expected to open late in 2020 or the beginning of 2021.

4. Poll: jetBlue Best, AA Worst Airline Serving SXM

Occasionally, we conduct polls on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>. We recently conducted two concerning our readers' favorite and least favorite US airlines serving SXM.

Surprisingly, jetBlue, which now serves the island nonstop from three points of embarkation in the US, came out on top in our unscientific survey, outscoring all other airlines as the Favorite airline of US SXM passengers. Readers mentioned customer service, on-time performance, comfort, and the increasing availability of JB's upscale Mint service as items that won them over in favor of jetBlue. The airline serves SXM daily from both New York Kennedy and Fort Lauderdale, and provides weekend nonstops during high season from Boston.

On the losing side, American Airlines was voted the Least Favorite US airline serving SXM in our poll. Schedule changes, unwillingness to make itinerary changes necessitated by AA's own problems, bad attitude, uncomfortable planes, and an indifference to customer concerns seemed to highlight apparent anger felt by many passengers toward AA, which some people said has worsened since the merger with US Airways.

Comment: JetBlue could easily provide daily year-round direct flights from Boston to SXM via Fort Lauderdale simply by having the aircraft that flies from Boston to Fort Lauderdale early every morning be the same aircraft that then flies to SXM and back; hopefully some folks at jetBlue will see this no-change-of-planes direct flight from Boston via Fort Lauderdale scenario through *SXM Weekly News*; you never know.

5. Delta Cutting Seat Reclines on All Its A320s

As an airline passenger, you probably love being able to recline in your seat while flying to SXM or anywhere else. At the same time, however, you probably hate it when the person in front of you reclines *their* seat, since it cuts your personal space and may make it uncomfortable or impossible for you to work on a laptop or anything else using your

tray table.

For better or worse (or both), Delta airlines is attempting to solve this problem by reducing the extent to which seats recline on its entire fleet of Airbus A320 aircraft. That means people who like to recline will be much less happy, while people who don't like the person in front of them reclining will likely be happy.

You can't please everybody. This is the story.

6. See Current SXM Weather / Weather

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

2) Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.

3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

Ever since it first opened several years ago in Simpson Bay, Sale and Pepe Italian restaurant has been plagued by two significant issues — inadequate room, and effects from the weather during rainstorms. It expects to solve both of those issues next month when it moves to new, larger quarters in the new building being built in the northern part of Simpson Bay on the lagoon side of Airport Road.

23. Coco Beach Rebuilding

The Coco beach bar and restaurant, located on Orient beach in front of Esmeralda resort, is now being rebuilt. Public plans for its reopening call for it to be back in business by the end of the year, but people familiar with the pace of reconstruction are telling us it could be much sooner.

24. The Repaving of Blvd. de Grand Case

In January, the French side government publicized that it was starting a project to repave Boulevard to Grand Case,

which was significantly degraded by hurricane Irma and has not been repaired particularly well ever since. The clear implication of the announcement was that the repaving would be completed before Mardis de Grand Case, Harmony Nights, began almost two months ago.

It still hasn't been completed.

Some utility lines are being buried in an effort to secure utility service whenever the next storm hits. Had the project received the prioritization that the announcement implied it would, it seems to us it could have been completed in a week or two. The French side has been widely accused of not having the same sense of urgency about restoring tourism businesses to full operation that the Dutch side has, and this may well be an example that reinforces that argument.

25. Orient Nature Reserve Journal Publishes Updates

The French side Nature Reserve has published an update on the status of the entire reserve, which encompasses Orient beach and surrounding territories. It has been published in both French and English and can be downloaded as a PDF <u>here</u>.

26. Sargassum Seaweed Coming Back

A few weeks ago, the SXM Nature Foundation forecast the return of Sargassum seaweed from the Sargasso Sea to the waters around SXM. Now, it appears about to happen and is already being seen in a few places.

This appearance of Sargassum seaweed is particularly alarming because it comes as sea turtle nesting season gets underway. During this period, sea turtles lumber ashore, dig holes in the sand, lay eggs (up to 100 of them), and lumber back into the sea. They will do this from now until mid Fall. Eggs hatch and the vulnerable sea turtle hatchlings scamper from the nest to the shore and back into the ocean. Most are eaten, but a few survive.

Large amounts of Sargassum seaweed can pile up on the shore, imperiling the movement of the fragile young hatchlings. Sea turtles are endangered species and any disruption in their ability to reproduce is regarded with alarm by conservationists and others.

Please stay away from marked turtle nesting sites. Local authorities are doing everything they can to clear the beach of Sargassum seaweed without disrupting any part of the turtles' reproductive lifecycles. If you see any turtle nesting sites that are not blocked off, steer clear and please report them to authorities.
