Lead Story: Airport Announces Phase Two Reconstruction

After what seemed to many observers to be an interminable delay due to the government approving funding options, gross disagreements with its insurance company, and planning issues, the long-awaited second phase reconstruction of SXM Airport has finally been announced.

There are two pieces of annoying news, however.

First, the project won't start until the fourth quarter of this year, a few months away, most likely due to the arrival of the funds to pay for it. And second, no mention is made in the current story from SXM Airport about preclearance. On that topic, airport officials have repeatedly said it is a matter of when, not if — but we still don't know when.

We have queried the airport on that question — and on the question of the next airport master plan, and when a parallel taxiway may be built: that could significantly expand the airport's ability to handle more flights. The major taxiway project was delayed by Irma, necessitating the rebuild of the main terminal and rewriting of the entire airport master plan.

1. jetBlue's Expanding Airlift to SXM

Because of the reconfiguration of jetBlue's fleet of mainline A320 aircraft, the airline's capacity for carrying passengers to SXM nonstop from Boston, New York, and Fort Lauderdale is increasing.

The cabin reconfigurations include the replacement of traditional thick seating with thinner but equally comfortable new seats, enabling the airline to add two new rows of seating to each of its planes — 162 seats now, versus the old 150. The program will be completed some time during 2020. Reconfigured planes are already in use on a number of the airline's busiest routes.

In addition, as we previously reported, the reconfigurations include new, larger-screen individual entertainment centers. In a second update to be completed next year, jetBlue will fully replace its inconvenient armrest entertainment controls with touchscreen capability, which will enable people to use armrests as armrests and will eliminate unintentional channel changes by you or anyone sitting next to you.

At the same time, jetBlue continues to take delivery of new A321 aircraft with or without their upscale Mint seating configurations; all of their A321 aircraft have more seats than the shorter-cabin A320s.Looking to the future, we expect new connections to SXM to emerge through the jetBlue focus city in Fort Lauderdale — particularly from Phoenix, a growing JetBlue city; Las Vegas; and Long Beach, a major jetBlue focus city. We also would not be surprised to see the airline expand its service from Fort Lauderdale perhaps as soon as this coming winter to accommodate increased demand which we're sure the airline would expect from available new connections.

There will be more coming than what we've reported — stay tuned.

2. Jet Blue Expands Schedule into Mid-Feb., But...

JetBlue recently expanded its schedule into mid-February, as we announced beforehand on our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>. The biggest demand of winter 2020, however, will be during March because of the 40th Heineken Regatta — the biggest vacation week of the year on the island. The 2020 Regatta is slated for March 5 through 8, slightly later than usual.

When flying internationally, it is imperative that the name on your airline tickets be <u>exactly</u> the same as the name on your passport. That means if the name on your passport is John Quentin Public, the name on your ticket must be the *exact same* — not John Q Public.

4. Carnival Fined \$28-million in Pollution Case

Carnival Cruise Lines has been find \$20 million by the US government for violating antipollution statutes. That's on top of a previous fine of \$40 million. The line is accused of dumping gray water, plastic waste, and other pollutants into the oceans of the world.

Carnival isn't just Carnival: they own a number of other cruise lines including Princess and Holland America, and their fleet consists of more than 100 cruise ships.

Their revenues last year were reportedly well into the billions, so the current \$20 million fine is next to nothing for them financially — but it is a large slap in the face (or whack upside the head) as well as copious bad PR for a company that should know better.

- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.
- 5) For a quick look at weather radar exactly where you are or where you're going, try the My Radar phone app or My Radar for Windows -- excellent programs.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <a href="https://example.com/here.com

8. New "Secrets" Resort Opens March 1, 2020

Construction of a new Secrets all-inclusive resort continues to progress on the site of the former Riu Palace in Anse Marcel on the French side.

We published an extensive article about the new resort a number of weeks ago here, describing the many features of the new complex including its multiple restaurants. We will revisit the site late this year and publish extensive photography and more information.

The former Riu Palace was practically obliterated by hurricane Irma, which roared ashore with wind gusts well in excess of 200 mph, tornadoes, and a flooding storm surge with major league waves back in September 2017. The site had previously been the home of a Radisson Blu resort and before that, L'Habitation. The opening date for secrets was originally expected to be at the beginning of 2020, but the latest publicly released opening date is now early March, 2020.

We'll be providing updates as construction progresses. Here's more info.

9. Two Objections Filed Against Planet Hollywood Resort

In a news story published here several weeks ago, we reported that plans for the new Planet Hollywood Resort on the property that formerly housed the Sonesta great Bay beach resort were to be made available for public review and comment within recent weeks.

A report in the daily Herald noted that there were two objections to the plans but it didn't specify what the objections were or are, so we can't report them. Our expectation would be that if they were significant, they would've made their way into the newspaper. The plan was for the objections to be reviewed by all concerned and acted upon, if necessary.

We don't foresee anything getting in the way of the Planet Hollywood Resort project. It's a home run for SXM since it appeals to a younger demographic. Construction should begin in the next several months and the resort is expected to be open in time for the 2021 high season — or possibly before.

10. At Atrium, Noise Invades The Nights

At first, when people heard all the noise -- that incredibly loud late-night music -- they blamed the new Roxxy Beach

bar/restaurant next to Royal Palm beach resort. But they were listening from a distance — at Atrium Resort or Simpson Bay, and the blame they were placing was a knee-jerk reaction instead of an observed phenomenon.

Soon, as people began checking where the most egregiously overzealous musical amplifications were actually originating, they found that Roxxy was a minor player but that the eardrum-breaking noise after midnight was actually coming from the supposed-to-be cement parking lot south of Roxxy, where cars and trucks appear to arrive at night, set up amplifiers, and start blasting away.

At Atrium, many people are complaining. Calls to police at least in some instances are working, with the bed-shaking Behemoth speakers silenced soon after complaints were phoned to the police.

Everyone is entitled to enjoy themselves — but not at the expense of others, and absolutely not to the point where SXM's tourism product is degraded by so much noise that people can't sleep. Existing anti-noise ordinances need to be enforced and that enforcement must be rigid and immediate, to avoid high season confrontations after Royal Palm Beach reopens and their situation becomes untenable.

We realize the police have more to do than to control overzealous noise. Responsible people should look in the mirror and if they see a source of mind-numbing noise, they should do what's right for the island and shut it off.

19. SXM Mourns Shooting Victim, Goes All-Out To Nail Shooter

Late at night on Wednesday, June 5, a man and his daughter were walking near a bar on Maho beach when an unidentified man approached them, apparently with robbery in mind. A struggle ensued during which the father attempted to thwart the attempted robbery. During that struggle, the would-be robber's weapon allegedly fired a bullet into the father's head. The alleged perpetrator and some other people reportedly left the scene in three small cars.

The victim has been identified according to Canadian press reports as Sylvain Valade of the Laurentians town of Ste-Agathe-des-Monts, in Quebec, about 90 miles north of Montreal..

Reaction was swift across the island as efforts galvanized among all parts of government and police island-wide to

expeditiously examine what happened, go over all the evidence, determine with public help who was responsible — and go after them. On Tuesday afternoon, June 11, police captured three men on the Dutch side but were tightlipped about whether they had any relationship to the shooting six days before. It was widely suspected that those apprehensions were related to the July 5 shooting. (The release of this issue was delayed pending news about those individuals.) Previously, government officials had promised to do everything humanly possible to find and bring to justice those responsible.

Sentiments poured out to the family and to 48 year-old Mr. Valade's daughter who was with him when this happened. Yanie, his daughter, made this public statement: "Words I miss to describe the evil I feel for losing you in this way. A tragic and unimaginable end. The images are constantly turning in my head, and the sound of the shot is haunting me. My Daddy of love, you left as a hero, you saved my life and you protected me until your last breath, as you've always done. Today I lost a part of me, the man of my life, the best father we can have. I'm counting on you to give me the strength and courage to continue. Iloveyou from unconditional love and irreplaceable love. Watch over me as you have been doing since my childhood. You will be in my heart forever, I love you." (Yanie)

Although St. Maarten is one of the most peaceful and serene islands in the Caribbean, the reality is that it remains paradise — but not Utopia. All of us involved in *SXM Weekly News*, everythingSXM.com, and our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Site</u> offer our profound sympathies and condolences to the family of Sylvain Valade, the victim of this senseless tragedy, and his daughter Yanie.

The government of Dutch St. Maarten sent this out on June 7:

The Ministers of Justice and Tourism on St. Maarten have united in their condemnation of Wednesday night's shooting incident involving a Canadian tourist vacationing on St. Maarten calling it "a senseless act of violence." The two, Minister of Tourism Stuart Johnson and Justice Minister Cornelius De Weever, issued a press statement on Thursday evening joining the call by local authorities for the community at large to provide any information that would lead to the swift arrest of the perpetrator(s) of Wednesday heinous crime.

Minister De Weever says "The investigation of the events on June 5th, 2019 in the Beacon Hill area of St. Maarten continue with the highest level of priority from the Ministry of Justice. We fully intend to prosecute those responsible for this senseless act of violence and for compromising the peaceful and friendly nature of St. Maarten. Our thoughts and prayers are with the victims and their family."

In his response to the incident, Minister Johnson said, "My thoughts and prayers are with the relatives and friends of the victim." He said, "This was a senseless act of violence perpetrated against another human being, which we will not tolerate. The people of our Country have always been friendly, hospitable and welcoming we will continue to keep these as our guiding principles. Meanwhile, as the details of this incident continue to unfold, we are working assiduously to ensure the perpetrators of this crime are brought to swift justice. Our home in St. Maarten is a haven for all to live and visit, and we take seriously any acts of violence."

The male victim was walking through the Beacon Hill area with a member of his family, when unknown assailants in what police believe to be an armed robbery, approached them.

"This isolated incident saddens us, and we, as the representatives of St. Maarten's tourism sector are dedicated—together with the Ministry of Justice and the private sector—to do everything in our power to find this assailant and bring him to justice." said St. Maarten Director of Tourism May-Ling Chun.

After a wait of more than two years, the big new Super U supermarket in the Hope estate area on the French side between Orient and Grand Case will finally open on June 18.

The previous Simply market, sold before Irma to the Super U folks, was ripped to shreds by Irma, necessitating many changes to the new building's design, enabling it to maintain structural integrity in case another catastrophic category five storm should return to SXM at some point in the future.Bigger than its sister store in Marigot, the new Super U has a lot going for it — including plenty of parking.

Ironically, the Carrefour supermarket in Cole Bay that was also destroyed by Irma has also been completely rebuilt, and it will be opening in the next several weeks, during July.

All in all, some very welcome news for everyone on the island. Here's more.

21. Seaweed Update

The seaweed situation on the island right now is generally pretty good. Seaweed from the Sargasso Sea tends to come in from the east.

Tadzio Bervoets, head of the SXM Nature Foundation, tells us that observations indicate that a fairly large amount of Sargassum seaweed from the Sargasso Sea may bump into East facing beaches during the next couple of weeks. It is expected to have virtually no effect on beaches facing other directions.
