1. Airport Loan Docs. To Be Signed in DC This Week

The government of St. Maarten formally reported late last week that its representatives will meet with representatives of the World Bank and others this week in Washington, DC, to sign the all-important SXM Airport loan documents which will ultimately release upwards of US\$120-million for completion of all of the necessary renovations of the entire SXM Airport terminal..

When this happens, we will report it at once in our **Everything SXM Facebook group**.

Please read the following stories which also concern the future of the airport.

2. Airport's Future Discussed by Member of Parliament

Rolando Brison, a member of the St. Maarten Parliament who is currently running for office in the new government for which elections will occur early next month, last week made these comments about SXM Airport:

Today was the FIRST meeting we have had where ALL documentation including contracts, term sheets, full conditions, reports, communications, meeting notes were given to all members of parliament. This is what I had been asking for since April of 2018. NOW we are armed to make informed decisions about the airport.

My presentation was based on 4 key assurances given to me by the government, which I adequately received:

- 1. That there is room for construction to begin by Early 2020 as opposed to late 2020 that the previous government was aiming for
- 2. That plans for pre-clearance cannot be hampered by the signing of this agreement, as pre-clearance is the most viable long term competitive advantage St. Maarten can have, particularly over neighboring islands who continue to expand their plans for airlift.
- 3. That the agreements do not infringe on the ability of the airport to seek further financial options, such as buying our bond holders, pre-clearance facilities or other financing needs
- 4. That all airport employees are to be retained, and that all salaries and other employee benefits can be paid in full and on time.

A motion is presented to clarify to all that the motion of no confidence never intended to stop any progress of the airport. Now that is clarified, the airport construction can begin, and as I said, not late 2020 as the previous government had, but MUCH earlier as is needed to save our tourism industry..

3. SXM Prime Minister's Thoughts on Airport's Future

Silveria Jacobs, Prime Minister of the current caretaker government on the Dutch side of the island, said the following concerning the future of SXM Airport. These comments are from the SXM *Daily Herald*:

In response to a question on how much money PJIAE will have to use for reconstruction and whether the new building will able to withstand Hurricane Irma wind speeds, Jacobs said the total obligations are estimated at US \$159.5 million and total funds available are US \$171.9 million. The EIB/World Bank package will give the Airport

access to US \$101 million for reconstruction and US \$21 million as potential liquidity support. The remaining funds will come from the insurance proceeds. Once rebuilt, the Airport should be able to withstand Irma wind speeds, the prime minister noted.

She said the plan is to have the entire Airport reconstruction completed by the first quarter of 2022. The reconstruction will be done in phases. For example, if the first floor is completed this will go online while the other phases are being executed.

She said the airport has a very poor liquidity status with numerous liabilities. "Without the release of insurance proceeds, the Airport can no longer fulfil its financial obligations in December."

On the issue of pre-clearance, Jacobs said the first step that needs to take place is the conclusion of a legal agreement between the Kingdom of the Netherlands on behalf of St. Maarten, and the United States. There is other homework to be done as well by the Airport and government, including a financial feasibility study which includes a business case. "At this moment, there is no clear timeline until implementation, but ... as Prime Minister I will do everything in my power to finalise the necessary agreements."

The current reconstruction plan of PJIA is fully compatible with US pre-clearance, which means that all upgrades and new installations will conform to US pre-clearance specifications. It can be added once financing is available for pre-clearance.

4. Heads Up: Evac Slide Drops from Delta Jet Approaching Boston

A nonstop Delta Airlines flight from Paris to Boston Logan airport dropped an uninflated evacuation slide in suburban Milton, Massachusetts, just south of Boston on its final approach.

A homeowner there was working in his yard when the slide careened to the ground, knocking some branches off his Japanese maple tree. In an interview with local media, the homeowner said he was lucky — only his tree was slightly damaged and no one was hurt. He knew it was from an airplane when he saw the word Boeing on the slide.

It was not known what type of Boeing aircraft lost the evacuation chute, but on flights from Paris to Boston it is known that Delta uses Boeing 767 and 777 aircraft.

5. Public WiFi Live at Airport

Public Wi-Fi is now again live at SXM Airport. In fact, we reported that it was turned back on a number of weeks

Current reports say that the signal is spotty and not particularly strong in the gate areas currently.

6. JB Nonstops Coming From US to Anguilla

Press reports from neighboring Anguilla this week say that JetBlue Airways is about to sign an agreement with the Anguillan government to provide weekly jet service from Fort Lauderdale nonstop to Anguilla starting as soon as four months from now aboard 80-seat aircraft.

There are some facts missing from this report, however. First, JetBlue doesn't own any aircraft that seat just 80 people: all of its current aircraft seat more. Even the new A220 aircraft it has ordered — which have not yet arrived — will seat well more than 80 people.

Second, although the Anguilla Airport is known to be able to accommodate some Boeing 737 aircraft, JetBlue's plans don't include 737s — the airline doesn't fly anything from Boeing, but it does fly narrow-body twin-engine Airbus

A320 and A321 aircraft but those will not be used on these flights because of their excess capacity and higher operating costs.

Either JetBlue is going to make another acquisition of different aircraft to use on the route, or it will codeshare with a smaller airline. There's also a question about who it might codeshare with, since the airline said it plans to expand nonstop service to Anguilla later, as demand warrants, from both New York and Boston, which would require jet aircraft.

We'll watch this and keep you posted.

7. JB Expected To Complete Cabin Makeovers in 2020

More than a year ago, JetBlue started a major makeover of its A320 cabins. Thanks to thinner but just-ascomfortable seating, it has been able to add two new rows of seats — 12 more seats per A320 -- without compromising its generous legroom. It also greatly upgraded its seatback entertainment systems and will complete another upgrade of those same systems this year, converting them from armrest controls to touchscreen controls. The new entertainment systems offer much bigger screens, many more stations, and superior sound. The airline has said it expects the upgrades to be completed by the end of 2020.

The airline is also expected to start flying some A220 aircraft on a number of new routes possibly as early as this year if it acquires some used A220's as is now expected. The cabins of those aircraft will likely mirror those of the upgraded A320 fleet.

8. LIAT Still Flying - But for How Long?

LIAT Airlines, Leeward Islands Air Transport, is still flying, although many attempts at financial resuscitation of the ailing carrier have not been successful.

Owned by several Caribbean nations, the airline has a genuinely mediocre reputation; its acronym has sometimes been perverted to read, "leave island any time," incorporating criticisms of its on-time performance.

When considering where to make airline reservations, if you choose LIAT, use a respected credit card so you can hopefully get a refund if the status of the airline worsens.

9. See Current SXM Weather / Tracking Serious Weather

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our Everything SXM Facebook Group, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.
- 5) For a quick look at weather radar exactly where you are or where you're going, try the My Radar phone app or My Radar for Windows -- excellent programs.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC here. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

Sky Dinner is a novel, quirky, and highly unusual tiny restaurant suspended high above Princess Port de Plaisance Resort & Casino by a crane. It's off the union road in Cole Bay.

In an announcement concerning the launch of the project last week, its promoters wrote:

Here's the news you've been waiting for: WE ARE READY!

Starting Friday December 6th, at 4pm we will be doing preopening cocktail-flights every night until we open the kitchen. Everybody's welcome.

NO RESERVATION. Come early in our beautiful lounge and bar, with a magnificent view on the Yacht Club of the Port De Plaisance, on Snoopy Island, on the Causeway Bridge and the Airport. The SKY DINNER platform will be going up and down all night.

You can watch from the lounge or be a part of the "ELITE" for our preopening price of only \$60/person for a 25 minute "flight" including 2 cocktails.

Come alone or come with your friends, we can accommodate up to 22 persons at a time. Be the first ones on the island to be part of the "fifty-meter-high-club". This will be CRAZY!

Take good note of this:

Starting Friday December 6th 4 pm till midnight, 7 days a week

(End of their post)

We posted this information along with photography supplied with the announcement in our Everything SXM
Facebook Group. We had posed a number of questions to these folks through social media over the last few months but none were ever answered, and they still have not been.

Our questions -- related to items we felt readers would want more information on -- included whether the project was reviewed and approved by SXM Airport, which could have some concerns about it since the crane hoists the restaurant far above the ground near the water of Simpson Bay lagoon close to a route sometimes taken by arriving small planes approaching via the lagoon. They never specifically answered. We asked other questions about medical emergencies, mechanical failures of the crane, and more, but their answers were general and not specific.

Some of the approximately 24,000 members of our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u> responded to the announcement negatively. The post remains in our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u>; you can find it by searching for "sky dinner" in that group.

<u>Here are their comments</u> in response to our specific questions. We requested <u>specific proof of approvals from the Airport</u> and they refused to provide it:

This concept was born in Belgium, it is now franchised in about 40 countries. We wouldn't have invested all that money without having had clearance from the Airport authorities. This kind of crane has all sorts of redundancies in case of an unlikely mechanical mishap. The crane is brand new and along with every other crane on the island has to go through periodical inspections. That's without talking of the meticulous maintenance that is planned for every one of these systems all around the world according to a very detailed charge book. And that's without talking that these cranes are built to lift, day in and day out, weight that are 5 times what we use it for. in conditions that are less than ideal. The lounge downstairs has all the bathrooms needed. If there is a medical emergency, the crane can lower the whole platform in a minute and a half. If there is a toilet emergency it's the same thing, but everybody on board is warned that the "cocktail-flight" lasts 25 minutes and the dinner is 55 minutes. I think it is the a reasonable amount of time to hold it in if you forgot to go beforehand. Everywhere around the world, hundreds of thousand of satisfied passengers have lived with that. [Spelling corrected -Ed.]

We still sought documentary evidence of airport review and approval and told them repeatedly who SXM Weekly News is. This was their reply:

We have all the approvals from the airport Authorities, Economic Affairs, the Fire Department and the Health Office and we are associated with one of the biggest casino, hotel and marina on the island. We wouldn't have been allowed to finish this project without it....

And we are not obligated to show official documents to whomever asks for them. If I say we have it it's because we have it. That project has started a year ago and the first people we met was the Airport Authorities. We had to change the original location on the property to meet their requirements, we installed all the warning lights and flags that they asked and our crane is allowed to go as high as 150 feet, not more but this is enough for us. We have been inspected left and right for the last 6 months and have met all requirements from all departments of government.

We don't need to show any of this to just anybody who asks for it and is not an authority. Call the Civil Aviation and they will tell you we are up to code with them and that we do have all the approvals. We're not building a skyscraper here, this is a crane that is lower that a comunication tower. {Sic -Ed.}

The proof we requested was never provided. Saying something and it being true are not necessarily the same thing. No mention here of sudden brisk winds which happen in the tropics seconds before squalls move through. Our comment online about them one week ago was: "We asked whether the airport approved this. No answer [and no proof]. (It may be on the flight path of approaching East-to-West small planes going to the airport) We asked what happens if there are mechanical issues. No answer. Medical emergencies. No complete answer. Food sent back. No answer. No bathrooms." We deferred publishing this article for one week to give them a further opportunity to further answer in detail all our specific questions. They did not.

If you feel like you should pay them to dangle from a crane over Port de Plaisance, enjoy yourself... but if you have any questions about safety or emergency plans, and want detailed information and want to see actual approval documents (which we asked them to email to us) they probably won't answer you in detail, either.

If they do send more proof or details of what they do in mechanical or weather emergencies, we'll happily publish that information or a link to it. We wish them well -- but our advice is that they should answer consumer concerns, not brush them off.

22. French Court Tells Baki Arbia His Art Wall is Too High

Baki Arbia Owns and operates what was formerly known as the Mercure St. Martin hotel in Nettle Bay, west of Marigot on the French side.

During the property's recovery from hurricane Irma, he flew in artists from across the seas to paint many murals on the fence at the perimeter of his property along the main road to the lowlands. The work is beautiful and an uplifting sight for many people in that area, which was devastated by Irma.

Now, in what many are interpreting as another roadblock to progress toward normalcy posed by the government of the French side, Baki Arbia is being told that his fence is too high, that he will be fined, and that the problem has to be fixed over the next few months. Hopefully the government will see fit to give him whatever obscure permission is required to leave the murals as they are, which is a bright, enthusiastic, forward-looking vision toward the future of the French side once it fully recovers from hurricane Irma.

As a tour of the French side will clearly show, French red tape has greatly affected French side recovery attempts by private, tourist-oriented businesses. In this case, overregulation is hurting French side businesses, employees, and tourism revenue for the entire island....

23. "Soggy" Doing Lots of Events For Adults

You may think that the Soggy Dollar Bar behind Vesna Taverna in Simpson Bay about 100 yards north of the drawbridge is a place for kids and young adults — but the fact is that it has an increasing number of attractions focused on the interests of mature adults who are also interested in having some nighttime entertainment.

For example, every Tuesday Night is Latin night during which you can get very low-cost salsa lessons — why not do it? There are also occasional oldies nights — but perhaps of the greatest interest to tourists is that very well known Caribbean performer **Percy Rankin** appears at Soggy Dollar Bar every Sunday at 9 PM to a large, mixed crowd of enraptured tourists and locals.He sings a lot of Bob Marley and a whole lot more.

Check out **Soggy Dollar Bar** and the entertainment they offer seven nights a week — you might just find several entertainment nights of interest during your visit to SXM.

24. Announcing "Atrium Lake"

When there is a heavy rainstorm on the island, it appears you can now count on a small lake forming on Billy Folly road in front of Atrium Resort. Thanks to poor drainage, the "lake" lasts for several days.

We're sure that local business people and a number of others who live in the Pelican Key area have already asked the government to solve this unwelcome lake in front of Atrium Resort. It affects hundreds of tourists and hundreds of locals every day and needs to be eliminated.

25. "Tasting Menu" Earns Wows at IZI

If you like fine dining, it's time you made reservations for David Foini's tasting menu at iZi Ristorante Italiano in Simpson Bay.

Tasting menu reservations need to be made a few days in advance and are required — and totally worth it. David frequently served tasting menus to discriminating groups who visited his high-end Italian restaurant La Gondola a number of years ago. He has now brought back and further refined those superb tasting menus, offering a great

spectrum of flavors and textures in his multicourse tasting menu selections, paired with very fine wines.

Again, advance reservations are a must and you do need to specify tasting menu; it's best to talk to David personally when making reservations. Groups welcomed. More is here.

26. Someplace Unique for Lunch: La Patrona

La Patrona is the authentic Mexican restaurant on the water at Simpson Bay Resort — definitely not your typical Tex Mex eatery. But at lunch — when you're seated outdoors overlooking beautiful Simpson Bay (the Bay itself, not the geographic section of Dutch SXM) it's even more beautiful than at night, when you're appreciating the fine dining Mexican food and thoroughly authentic surroundings.

There are salads, seafood dishes, and much more. We had red snapper fish and chips which offered a generous portion of delightfully spiced fish. Want something spicy? No problem: Ivan is usually there (pronounced EE-Vahn) and he knows exactly what to do.

La Patrona may be an alternative for lunch that you haven't thought about — but it certainly is time to try it. Very scenic with great service; we loved it.

27. Lobster Thermidor? Pineapple Pete

Pineapple Pete is Pierre "Pete" Ferland's venerable lunch and dinner spot in Simpson Bay serving a huge spectrum of his own brand of great comfort foods at reasonable prices. For those who prefer Japanese dining, right next door you'll find Wasabi Charlie, with hibachi style cooking as well as traditional roll and Nigiri sushi. The quality is consistently excellent: remember, Pierre used to run the former Sushiito restaurant on the other side of the lagoon, closed after Irma. Wasabi Charlie has some of the same staff members and a similar menu with the extraordinary service that you expect from every Pierre Ferland enterprise on the island.

<u>But here's the kicker</u>: Pineapple Pete serves what is arguably the best lobster thermidor on the island. There are times at night when a conga line of lobster thermidor dishes is coming out of the kitchen headed for the palates of discriminating guests. If you love lobster thermidor, Pineapple Pete is absolutely the most popular place to get it.

28. Simpson Bay Lagoon vs. Simpson Bay

Tourists sometimes get confused between Simpson Bay lagoon, Simpson Bay, and Simpson Bay (yes, there really are two Simpson Bays). Were going to solve the problem.

First, Simpson Bay lagoon is the inside-the-island body of water on the Dutch side that stretches from the airport southward to Cole Bay. During high season, dozens if not hundreds of small boats and yachts moor here, entering through the Simpson Bay drawbridge.

On the ocean side of the Simpson Bay drawbridge, you'll find Simpson Bay itself, which extends off the coast from South of the airport all the way down to the beginning of pelican key and is one of the island's largest, most peaceful and serene beaches (Simpson Bay beach). Shhhh -- it's a quiet local treasure that's vastly underutilized, so don't tell anybody.

The other Simpson Bay is really the dining and entertainment center of the Dutch side, with more concentrated restaurant and nightclub activity than the rest of the island combined. The main road through this area is Welfare Road, which extends from South of the Simpson Bay drawbridge to Cole Bay which begins at the bottom (Southernmost part) of Simpson Bay lagoon. Locals sometimes spell Simpson Bay as one word.

We should add a quick word here about Kimsha beach. As we previously reported here, geographically there is no such place as Kimsha beach. However, the name Kimsha is commonly applied to the Simpson Bay beach section between Royal Palm beach resort and Atrium resort. Why? There was a Chinese restaurant here decades ago and the area came to be known affectionately by the name of that restaurant — Kimsha. Legally, though, it's simply part of Simpson Bay beach.

But it is, quite commonly and frequently, referred to by locals and an increasing number of visitors as Kimsha, either

as a single word or two (Kim Sha)

29. '20 Destination Magazine Warrants Reading

On a recent Thursday at Mullet Bay Beach, a woman at the edge of the water fell and accidentally knocked down her friend, standing close by. The friend felt pain in her leg as she got up, went to a hospital, and was told she had a "soft tissue injury" and should relax in the sun. Pain continued. Next day she went to the Maho Clinic for another opinion since she couldn't put any weight on the leg without pain. The doctor there sent her to the French Side for a new x-ray. That diagnosis came back - broken leg and she had to be medically evacuated back to the US for surgery. A few days before, the woman had bought short-term SkyMed medevac protection for her short trip to SXM. Cost, under \$100. She was sent home by jet by SkyMed. The charge for the jet: \$0. Without SkyMed, had she needed a medevac jet, the \$26,000 (approx.) price of that jet home would have had to be paid in cash in advance; with SkyMed she was home and in the hospital of her choice the next day for \$0 out-of-pocket.

A Summer trip ended in disaster when a child visiting her grandmother in Grand Case was bitten in the head

by the grandmother's bulldog, imperiling the girl's eyesight. She was flown to Miami in a medical evacuation jet for emergency eye surgery that saved her sight. Flight cost to the patient: \$0.

A woman from Virginia shopped at an island grocer and headed back to her car carrying two bags of groceries. She tripped and fell on a curb and knew at once she had fractured her hip. After being stabilized locally, she was flown home on a medical evacuation jet from SkyMed where she had the surgery she needed. Flight cost to the patient: \$0.

Two men were riding their horses on a hill in Cay Bay when a car backfiring spooked one of the horses, which

threw its rider. The other rider got off his horse to check his companion when the car again backfired, spooking the horse again which led it to kick its dismounted driver in the head, luckily causing "only" a severely dislocated jaw. The local hospital had no ability to solve that problem so the victim was airlifted by SkyMed back to Pennsylvania for surgery. Flight cost to the patient: \$0.

A member of the clergy fell down cement stairs and broke her leg. She too was airlifted home by SkyMed for surgery. Flight cost to the patient: \$0.

His new place is Reveil Matin, "Alarm Clock" in English, a highly creative breakfast / brunch / lunch restaurant with, we're told, excellent pricing. The restaurant is just in its soft opening now but will be ready for high season soon.
