SECTION 1: Getting There: Flights, Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. UA Pulls 737 MAX From Schedules Into June, 2020

Several major airlines that fly the Boeing 737 Max aircraft — or did until it was grounded last March — have already pulled it from their schedules through next April. But last week, United Airlines, in a move that betrayed a very bearish attitude toward the ill-fated Boeing airplane, canceled all 737 Max scheduled United Airlines flights into June, 2020.

The US Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has said that software changes proposed by Boeing to make the airplane safe to fly must still go through a significant number of benchmarks — and that those benchmarks take time. It is not rushing the program, despite Boeing's apparent over-eagerness to get the airplane back in the sky this month.

For whatever reason, Boeing had continued to build dozens of 737 Max airliners every month ever since the plane was grounded. Only now did they finally decide to stop production, since they have a glut of the planes. Certainly, no airline is eager to agree to buy a new plane — which the 737 Max still is — with a currently proven tendency to crash and kill people.

Boeing has an enormous task ahead in earning confidence around the world.

2. 146,000 737 MAX Flights Cancelled

Ever since the 737 Max was grounded last March, airlines have continued to schedule flights using it and then change them to other aircraft or cancel them outright. An industry source is now saying that since the groundings began, airlines using the 737 Max have canceled a total of 146,000 Max flights — a huge number especially considering that the worldwide fleet of the airplanes is relatively small. The airline most seriously affected was and is Southwest, where pilots have expressed anger that flights they were expecting to fly can't get in the air. They have reportedly filed suit against Boeing for loss of wages, though some observers believe the suit will get nowhere fast — just like the 737 Max's still sitting on the ground.

3. Will Boeing's 737 MAX Ever Return to Service?

Ever since the problems with the Boeing 737 Max began, some observers have suggested that the best thing Boeing can do is to dump the program, which plunked very powerful engines on an airframe that went into service more than 40 years ago. The original 737 was designed close to the ground, with short landing gear, since at that time there was no such thing as a jetway — just roll-up metal stairways which passengers descended outdoors. Since then, the airplane has been massaged 66 ways from Sunday, but it's still the same basic, very old design.

Some 737 pilots tell us the 737 is not an easy airplane to fly and requires constant attention. Obviously, the 737 Max proved to be orders of magnitude more complex and demanding — not to mention defective. Should the airplane return to service at all? That's a debate being waged by many observers. From a marketing perspective, it would be

a smart move by Boeing the scrap the Max, but from a financial perspective it would be hellacious. Assuming Boeing does return the 737 Max to service, the next question will be how they ever convince people that they really ought to fly on it.

4. Much More Coming Next Month on SXM Airport's Future...

We are currently working on a major story for publication next month that looks very closely at the future of SXM Airport from a passenger perspective. The article will talk about changes currently underway to completely renovate the second floor of the terminal building; the future of preclearance in SXM; potential enlargement of the terminal building; and significant potential changes to the layout of the airfield from a pilot perspective.Is there an airport hotel in the offing? SXM has never had one; we'll look at that question as well. Stay tuned.

5. December Winds and Rains

December is when rainy season patterns begin their transition to normal winter weather in SXM. Temperatures cool slightly and the amount of rain begins to simmer down from normal occasional deluge rainy season patterns.

In recent weeks SXM has been refreshingly windy — a usual occurrence during December. Weather has been fine from a tourist perspective, though there have been brief deluges resulting in a fair amount of ponding, particularly on Beacon Hill Road near the airport and in front of Atrium resort (see separate story in our island news section).

Weather generally completes transitioning into its usual winter pattern by mid-January.

6. See Current SXM Weather / Tracking Serious Weather

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

- 2) Our "Weather" page at www.everythingsxm.com -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.
- 3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.
- 4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see www.island92.com. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.
- 5) For a quick look at weather radar exactly where you are or where you're going, try the My Radar phone app or My Radar for Windows -- excellent programs.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC here. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later

8. New Adonis Cupecoy Hotel Close to Opening

The new 52-room Adonis Cupecoy hotel has been racing toward its promised completion by January over the last several weeks. Now, the developer tells us that the new hotel will be open in about one more week. We expect to publish pictures -- inside and out -- in our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u>.

Close to both Starz casino (scheduled to reopen by next season) and the new casino at Porto Cupecoy, where there

are also a number of great restaurants (Mario's Bistro and Mama Pizza among them), Adonis is modern and near but not on Cupecoy and Mullet beaches.

9. "Fourteen" Condo Twin Towers Rising Steadily in Cupecoy

The two 21-story "Fourteen" condos now under construction in Cupecoy are moving along quickly. The first tower is now six stories tall, with concrete for the seventh story now being poured.

It does appear that additional site work is being done for the second tower in preparation for its construction to begin in earnest.

10. Towers at Mullet Bay Debacle Demands Intervention

The Towers at Mullet Bay debacle demands intervention by the island government, once a new administration has been elected. Some repairs were made to the building after hurricane Irma. Even now, people are living in the building and apparently are paying to do so — but no timeshare owners. What we're hearing is that a financial fiasco related to ENNIA Insurance and some court intervention is what is preventing timeshare owners from staying at this property, and perhaps preventing the property itself from completing post-hurricane renovations.

28 months after the hurricane hit is ample time for all this to be resolved and for timeshare owners to be given some respect by all parties. That still hasn't happened. There have been other timeshare debacles on the island, most notably the Caravanserai debacle which continues and about which we've written here on many occasions.

Let's not have another one persist here. If the new government to be elected early next month wants to prove that it is oriented toward tourism and timeshare owner consumer protection, it needs to get into this quickly and effectively on behalf of timeshare owners — the biggest part of the Dutch side's stayover tourism industry.

It's a big deal.

11. "The Morgan" at Caravanserai Continues ...

The single most unusual "resort" on the island is currently called Alegria, on the site of the former Caravanseral timeshare resort.

You can check our <u>SXM Weekly News PDF Archives</u> online and do a search of either Caravanserai or Alegria to check the back-story here. That might explain some of the abandoned building shells on the site as well as the new building now under construction which had been part of the prior timeshare resort. The owner of the property, who renamed Caravanserai to Alegria a few years ago, is renaming it again to the Morgan, supposedly an upscale hotel.

In recent years, the property has been used primarily by tour buses bringing loads of cruise ship tourists to Maho beach to gawk at arriving airplanes and each other. The bars near the runway have been busy, but there seems to be little guest activity at the property, just ongoing construction.

There should be a court decision in the near term stemming from a case brought by timeshare owners whose contracts were unilaterally canceled by the current owner of the property in possible contradiction of local laws. Some of the timeshare owners sued (there is no such thing as class-action here) and the final appeal verdict should be known soon. We'll get back into some of the other details of this once the verdict is handed down.

12. No Street Lights in Mullet Bay: Where's GEBE?

You would think that GEBE, SXMs electric and water company, would be able to monitor its system and tell when certain geographic tracts have no street lights. Or you'd assume that their own people would be doing some monitoring and would tell them when lights are out in various districts. Regardless of the cause, street lights in the entire Mullet Bay area where the golf course is have been out for weeks — and although we're not always there, we've been looking for GEBE maintenance trucks in the area and have seen none.

Where's GEBE?

Rank and file employees there work hard. But management, it would appear, still doesn't.

16a. Retiring To or Starting a Business in SXM

This story is from BrightPath®, a St. Maarten-based company that provides specialized help to US residents and others who seek to establish St. Maarten residency to retire, start a business, buy income property. etc. It is loaded with useful information. See more at www.brightpath.sx. This was written by Vivian Chamas, BrightPath founder:

BrightPath® Origin. I founded BrightPath about five years ago. It was a concept to attract investors into St. Maarten and to introduce the island to people who wanted to retire or start a new business here. Many wanted life in St. Maarten because of the benefits here — it's real estate tax-free and duty-free, and residents can have bank accounts established in either dollars or euros without any special paperwork necessary.

It's a very tranquil lifestyle but everything is here that people need or want — supermarkets, restaurants, nightclubs, recreation, and very agreeable winter weather. It's a very good destination to promote.

In early 2020, BrightPath is expanding into several other islands, including St. Kitts, Dominica, and Antigua.

Objective. Our objective has always been to supply solutions to people who want to transition to life here in the Caribbean. We do that by assisting them with their immigration process and their banking needs, if needed. If they wish to start a business we can assist them with all the requirements related to making that happen. There are no real estate taxes in St. Maarten and none are currently anticipated in the foreseeable future.

From a tax perspective, it is important to understand that St. Maarten does have the benefits of no import duties and no property taxes. However, it's important to understand that worldwide income is considered by St. Maarten when the country is determining the amount of taxes an individual or family or business will pay. Any income you generate outside of St. Maarten has to be declared in St. Maarten. For us to make sure we give you optimal advice custom tailored to your specific situation, we normally speak with your tax advisor. Given specific information about your current jurisdiction and your tax status, we can do our advisory due diligence properly and give you the best advice about starting or continuing a business here in St. Maarten.

Documentation requirements vary by country and also by whatever program we need to place you in. In general for first-time applicants, across-the-board for the St. Maarten government paperwork we do require your birth certificate, if you're married then your marriage certificate, and if you're divorced, your divorce certificate. All of these documents have to be issued within the last three years, per Dutch side government requirements. All of them also must have a legalization stamp from a Dutch Embassy or an apostille stamp to certify the authenticity of each document. Usually such a stamp is issued by the Secretary of State of the state in which the applicant lives in the US.

Although the apostille stamps may be difficult to obtain, it's one of the services that we provide both in the United States and Canada. We do obtain those documents for our clients and obtain the stamps and appropriate signatures. These stamps are a higher level than traditional US Notary Public stamps. The government of the Dutch side of the island also requires an original police record issued within the last six months. Note that if there are just

misdemeanors, such as DUI, we may usually still be able to proceed successfully with the request. However, if there are crimes of a more serious nature then we prefer to send that information up for review. At the end of the day, we do have a responsibility to our community for the quality of immigrant that we are bringing into the country. In some cases, we will refer the matter to some local authorities to get their feedback before proceeding further.

There is substantial paperwork required for SXM residency — and we handle all of it for our clients. Our objective is to make the transition much easier for clients. Adopting residency in a new country is a big step; there are issues including housing, schools, and more -- all issues that will affect your lifestyle. We try to handle all of the details that don't make the transition exciting anymore.

We follow the process in stages and we notify our clients as individual stages are completed. The process, though still considered by many a bit complicated, is relatively easy for US citizens. It is a process that we complete from start to finish within 90 days, usually. For residents of other countries, the process can take from 3 to 6 months. The benefit for Americans is largely because of the Dutch-American Friendship Treaty.

Because of the Dutch American Friendship Treaty, US citizens don't require a specific work permit to work in Dutch St. Maarten. Once we obtain a residency permit for US citizens, it customarily has a validity for an indefinite period, which means that it is essentially a permanent residence. As a result, you can freely work on the island. You do not need a separate process with a separate work permit on the island as a US citizen.

Regarding taxation, your taxable income level would depend on your worldwide income.

Regarding schooling, once you have your residency permit, your children will be able to attend local schools. If you are going to have them attend private schools, once you have your residency permit and the children have passed the entrance exam, it's a matter of simply paying the tuition there.

<u>Most banks on the island are able to offer financing</u> once your residency permit is in place. There are attractive options especially for first-time homebuyers on SXM.

What we do best is handle and expedite paperwork regarding immigration, relocation, establishing new businesses, and developing relationships with banks. We generally work in collaboration with licensed real estate agents on the island because their depth of experience serves our clients best.

People coming to the island are sometimes concerned about medical care. The availability of medical care is pretty good compared to our peers. Would it compare to first-world hospitals and dedicated care? No. Within the Caribbean, however, I do think it stands amongst the best.

Initial Consultations. Everyone has different needs, different experiences, different expectations, and different financial situations. Our initial consultation is always free, which enables people to learn what we can provide that's custom-tailored to their needs. That way there are no expenses related to us determining what the most suitable options are for each individual case. It's important for everyone to realize that they can ask all the questions they need to ask without being on the clock, so the free consultation is an important benefit for our clients. Our prices are standard and are listed on our website, www.brightpath.sx. Government fees vary depending on what governments are involved and what documentation costs are in various jurisdictions.

From experience, we can generalize a bit and say there are usually three types of people coming to SXM:

- There are **younger people** who want to try their luck living someplace else and they may want to start a
 business here. A lot of those come in and come out; they start a business but don't always give it the time
 that it needs to become successful and they leave, either to go home or to another island to try something
 else or something similar there.
- 2. Another segment that comes here from abroad is **existing companies** that want to branch out to St. Maarten or leverage our transportation and distribution facilities to have a regional headquarters here for product distribution throughout the Caribbean region. *Companies can consolidate their imports duty-free here in St. Maarten and then re-export.* For trade, it's great. Our big harbor is also excellent for product distribution for regional subsidiaries. Those companies can also invoice in US dollars and keep those US dollars.
- 3. The third segment is **individuals**, usually from the United States or Canada, who want to retire here. We usually help them partner with a licensed real estate agent and help them set up local banking and all the paperwork necessary for residency. We help them with opening the bank account, getting the residency permit, handling rent real estate, and getting the financing.

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17. Big Trucks Overturn, Snarl Traffic for Hours

Midweek last week saw one of the worst traffic jams in Dutch side history. Two separate truck accidents occurred in one afternoon, one on top of "the hill" and the other at the turnabout near the St. Maarten Medical Center. Traffic in Simpson Bay, which is normally very heavy before Christmas every afternoon, was backed up not simply beyond the Airport, but all the way to Sapphire Resort in Cupecoy, near the French border.

Some people traveling from Cupecoy toward the airport said that trip took them about two hours, considerably less than it would've taken to walk the same distance. We have heard no reports about the condition of the drivers or any passengers in the vehicles involved in the accidents.

We do know some passengers headed for SXM Airport got out of their vehicles and walked the rest of the way to the airport to try to avoid missing airplanes.

Some cruise ship passengers trying to return to the cruise ship terminal were able to notify the ships which, we were told, held up departures a bit to accommodate their accidentally stuck passengers.

If you were involved in this backup, know that this is not a normal part of life in SXM. Many locals said it was the worst backup they've seen in the last 30 years.

18. Why French Side Residents Were Protesting; Fr. Side Access

The French acronym is PPRN. Although it is simply a draft program by the French government, nonetheless it has been enforced in the wake of hurricane Irma, and its effect has been devastating to a large part of the French side population.

Explained simply, the PPRN draft does not allow the reconstruction of homes in areas flooded during hurricane Irma — areas on which insurance cannot now be obtained. For the sake of the draft, it doesn't matter whether your family has owned the property in question for 100 years or more: permits to build or rebuild simply were not to be had.

The government of the Collectivite and the people of the French side vehemently objected to the draft, which was being enforced as if it were law — which it isn't. The Préfet — who is the woman representing the actual French state in Europe on the island — has been extremely doctrinaire and stubborn in enforcement, and hadn't budged despite many months of opposition to PPRN from both the French side government and thousands of French side citizens.All of this is what caused the boil over on the French side of the island which continued to the middle of last week.

At that point, facing major demonstrations and disruptions, the Préfet said that it would re-examine the PPRN and "correct" it — though there was no definition of exactly what "correct it" meant and no promise that PPRN would not be back after what amounts to a 90 day cooling off period, which will end in the middle of March.

At the beginning, decent people were expressing frustration with the intransigence of the Préfet. They were ultimately joined by disenfranchised youths who, for a time, created roadblocks in Sandy Ground, French Quarter, and other areas, which for a time made customary travel throughout the French side impassable and caused schools and businesses to be shut down temporarily by the government.

In France itself, there are major demonstrations going on concerning pension reforms which will cut pensions. Although the French side is part of France, the demonstrations here on the French side were laser-focused on the PPRN and not, for now, on the pension issue.

The three primary French side areas which interest tourists the most are Grand Case, Marigot, and Orient beach, and to a lesser extent villas in the French lowlands. All of these areas are readily accessible and conducting business as usual. The only difference is that you may notice an increased presence of gendarmes patrolling the areas — a good assurance.

There are some indications that progress is being made toward rectifying problems created by the draft PPRN — but they are only indications at this point, not certain solutions. As of late last week, blockages remained in French Quarter (north of the McDonald's Roundabout on the main road north from Philipsburg to Orient beach) and in Sandy Ground, west of Marigot.

It's still a relatively simple matter to get to the areas noted above. To get to Marigot or Orient beach drive north on the union road on the east side of Simpson Bay lagoon or drive north on airport road to the causeway, and take the

Causeway East to the union road and turn left (north) toward Marigot. From there, you can freely travel to points throughout Marigot or to Grand Case or Orient beach. You can return the same way. As of late last week, you could not get to Orient beach or Grand Case by way of French Quarter, though that situation may improve soon. Blockages continue to exist from just east of the French side drawbridge through Sandy Ground. We currently recommend no travel through Sandy Ground — which is not necessary to get anywhere of interest to tourists.

If you want to get to the French lowlands, use the Dutch side road through Mullet Bay and Cupecoy beach. Currently this gives you full access to the lowlands.

19. The Protestors' Utopian Demands...

The French side protesters have issued a series of demands against the French side of the island. Although the list is very extensive, at its heart is the death of the PPRN proposal. There are many other elements to the proposal, a significant number of which regard capital expenditures for the improvement of the lives of many French side citizens.

Although many French side citizens would support the full series of demands in the "manifesto", most people seem to think that the extent of the demands makes them more of a starting point for negotiations than a cinderblock wall of requirements that the protesters are unwilling to alter. The fact that the list exists at all is positive, since it gives a starting point for negotiations between the protesters and the government.

The fact that the people will not accept the PPRN as currently presented has been proved beyond doubt by the recent demonstrations. We know the French side government certainly gets the impact of the demonstrations. The critical factor to be determined is whether the Préfet gets it as well, since the Préfet's responsiveness to the demands will set the course for the future of the French side.Please see story 18 concerning current French side access.

Here are the demands of the French side protesters.

20. Prodigious Pelican Pond Persists: Why?

At this writing on Sunday night, the pond that had appeared on Billy Folly road in front of Atrium Hotel has temporarily disappeared, though everyone who must wade through it by car, truck, bus, or taxi fully realizes that any significant shower will bring it back in a hurry.

There is inadequate drainage in the area plus other factors that contribute to the problem. The area is fill, a fact that is highly obvious when you look at the land between atrium and Burger King and see that it is full of mud, a former channel for water between Simpson Bay lagoon and Simpson Bay.

Adding to the problem is the fact that there is been a great deal of development on Billy Folly Hill. That development has put cement on much of the hill, preventing the land from absorbing water from heavy rains. Consequently, after heavy rains, water cascades down various streets in the area including Onyx Road which drains into Billy Folly Road right in front of Atrium Hotel, in the same area as the new Chabad center and the new Lee's restaurant.

The water in the road at times is so deep that it causes electrical issues in some of the cars forced to drive through it.

Additional development in the area may well aggravate the situation. Pumping the water out of the area and dumping it into Simpson Bay is not an option. The government, which claims to be strapped for money, is being pleaded with by local residents and businesses to step in and help the area. Some local residents say that the situation has also been aggravated by rising water tables resulting from climate change, which is also being blamed for the record shattering storms Irma and Maria in 2017, Harvey that same year, and Dorian this year, which like Irma delivered 185 mile-per-hour sustained winds and catastrophic destruction when it hit the Bahamas.

We'll keep an eye on the situation and report on any further developments.

21. The New Culinary Panoply at Cupecoy Beach

With little fanfare, within a few hundred yards from each other, two significant culinary communities have blossomed near Cupecoy beach. The first is along Rhine Road just outside the gates of the medical school of American University of the Caribbean (AUC) and the second, more upscale, is next door at Porto Cupecoy.

On Rhine Road, you'll find a Smokehouse, pasta, Lebanese food, Japanese food, pastry, Indian food, pizza, and a bodega.

At Porto Cupecoy you will find Mario's Bistro, one of SXMs top restaurants of any kind (it's Continental); Thai Savanh; plus Mama Pizza, an Asian bistro, and a French restaurant.

Cupecoy is becoming a place where culinary attractions are increasing. More will be back when Starz Casino reopens before the next high season.

22. Sea Turtle Hatchings Expected

Sea turtle nesting season is over and most nests on area beaches are clearly marked: stay clear to protect endangered sea turtles.

Hatchings will occur over the next several weeks. Again, stay well away.
